IS THE SANTA MONICA A STRETCH?

Kalookan Queen (Lost Code) has won seven of her 17 career starts, all sprints, but she is 0-for-four at seven furlongs. The six-year-old mare will try to break that streak with a victory in today's GI Santa Monica H. at Santa Anita. The dark bay has run well at seven panels in the past, finishing third in the GI La Brea S. at the end of 1999 and second, beaten only a length by Honest Lady, in the 2000 edition of the Santa Monica. She has also taken three of her last four outings, winning the July 23 Fantastic Girl S. and the Aug. 19 Gill Rancho Bernardo H., both going 6 1/2 furlongs at Del Mar, before running third after a rough start in the GII First Flight H. going seven-eighths at Belmont Park Oct. 26. In her most recent effort, Kalookan Queen cruised to a six-length score in the six-furlong Corona H. at Hollywood Park Dec. 16. **Spain** (Thunder Gulch), on the other hand, is a two-turn specialist dropping back to a sprint for her 2002 debut. The 2000 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine, beaten a head when trying for a repeat in that race, is also a Grade I winner at seven furlongs, however, taking the 2000 La Brea over this track. She has tried the distance just once since, ending up fourth in the GI Ballerina H. at Saratoga last August. She will crack the \$3 million mark in earnings with a win or a second in the Santa Monica. Golden Eagle homebred **Favorite Funtime** (Seeking the Gold) steps up after taking the 7 1/2-furlong Cat's Cradle H. for Cal-breds Nov. 23. The five-year-old mare has used gate-to-wire tactics to post four of her five career victories. "This will be a big step up for her," trainer Bob Baffert said. "But if [owner/breeder John Mabee] can get her black type in a Grade I race, being that she's by Seeking the Gold, it would be really important."

T.M. OPERA O TO EAST STUD

Japanese champion **T.M. Opera O (Jpn)** (Opera House {GB}--Once Wed, by Blushing Groom {Fr}), who made his final career start when fifth in the Dec. 23 Arima Kinen at Nakayama, will begin stallion duties at East Stud on the island of Hokkaido this year. He goes to the breeding shed as the all-time leading money winner in Thoroughbred racing history with earnings of \$16,200,337, more than \$6.2 million ahead of American superstar Cigar. T.M. Opera O was named Japan's champion three-year-old colt after taking the Japanese 2000 Guineas, then had a perfect season at four, winning all eight starts. The chestnut concluded that campaign with a victory in the G1 Japan Cup and was named Horse of the Year and champion older horse of 2000. Just two-for-seven last year, he picked up his final victory in the Oct. 7 Kyoto Daishoten. The six-year-old missed defending his Japan Cup title by a neck, finishing second to Jungle Pocket (Jpn). He retired with 14 wins (including 12 stakes wins), six seconds and three thirds from his 26 starts. He will be joined at East Stud by the 2000 Japan Cup runner-up **Meisho Doto (Ire)** (Bigstone {Ire}--Princess Reema, by Affirmed). The six-year-old, a five-time stakes winner of \$8,088,202, also made his final start in the Arima Kinen, running fourth. He retired with 10 wins, eight seconds and two thirds from 27 starts.

FEVERISH RETIRED

Mr. and Mrs. Marty Wygod's **Feverish** (Pirate's Bounty--Blonde Fever, by Flying Paster), a graded-stakes winner of \$908,983, has been retired and will be bred to Bertrando. The seven-year-old Cal-bred made her final start in the Dec. 15 GII Bayakoa H., finishing fifth. "The only benefit to running her again would be getting her over \$1 million, but that would only benefit us, not her," trainer Dan Hendricks said. "We decided she didn't owe us anything." The dark bay mare, who won eight stakes including the 2000 edition of the Bayakoa, has been sent to the Wygod's River Edge Farm in Buellton, California and Hendricks will have a hard time replacing her. "She wasn't the best horse I ever had, but she was surely my favorite," he said.

NICHOLS NAMED BHB CHIEF EXECUTIVE

Greg Nichols, General Manager of Racing Victoria, has been appointed Chief Executive of the British Racing Board. The 44-year-old was the acting chief executive officer of the South Australian Thoroughbred Racing Authority and Jockey Club before moving to Melbourne, Victoria in 1999. "I am tremendously excited by the enormous challenges facing British Racing over the next few years and shall do my best to make a major contribution to the changes which are well under way," said Nichols. "I am greatly looking forward to working with the BHB board, the whole BHB team, and am confident that my experiences in Australian racing will prove invaluable in my new role."

DICK SAUNDERS DIES

Dick Saunders, made famous by his win on Grittar (GB) in the 1982 Grand National, died at his Northamptonshire farm on Thursday night after a long illness. As the oldest rider to win the famous steeplechase at Aintree at 48, Saunders retired immediately afterward to work as the track administrator. Elected a member of the Jockey Club in 1981, he was also chairman of the Licensing Committee and a Jockey Club steward from 1986-87. The 68-year-old also served as a racecourse steward for over 20 years at seven different tracks, including Aintree, Newmarket and Leicester. Christopher Spence, Senior Steward of the Jockey Club, said: "Dick Saunders was one of a kind. Universally respected and liked by all within racing. He earned that respect through his skill as a horseman, his courage and commitment to the sport, attributes matched only by his warmth and kindness. His success on Grittar in the Grand National has deservedly given him a place in racing's history, but he will be remembered for much more by all those who were lucky enough to know him. He gave so much to racing, and to the Jockey Club in particular. The Club is very proud to have had Dick's services for over 20 years, during which time he demonstrated an unwavering commitment to integrity and horse welfare."

Bullet Work for Repent:

GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up **Repent** (Louis Quatorze), winner of the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. in his last start, worked five furlongs in a bullet 1:00 at Gulfstream Park yesterday morning. "He went faster than I wanted," trainer Ken McPeck said. "I don't know how the track is playing, but I know it was a fast workout. I'll work him back in another week and then decide what to do with him. I'm leaning toward the Risen Star at the Fair Grounds [GIII, Feb. 17], but it's still a possibility that he could run in the Fountain Of Youth [GI, Gulfstream Park, Feb. 16]." McPeck added that **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan), runner-up in the GIII Holy Bull S. last time out, is a definite for the Fountain Of Youth, but will race without blinkers. "I wanted to take the blinkers off for the Holy Bull, but the stewards wouldn't let me because he was coming off a winning race," the trainer said. "He works better with them off."

Two Jockeys Hurt at Aqueduct:

Jockeys Heberto Castillo Jr. and Roberto Villafan were injured during a spill in Aqueduct's seventh race yesterday afternoon. Castillo's mount, **Madame Viceroy B B** (Northern No Trump), fractured her left front leg at midstretch and unseated her rider. Trying to avoid the injured horse, Villafan's mount, **Born to Bop** (Carr de Naskra), swerved and sent her jockey to the dirt as well. Castillo was taken to Jamaica Hospital for treatment of a head wound and pain in his shoulder and ear. "Mr. Castillo is undergoing a CAT scan and is in stable condition," Jamaica Hospital spokesperson Ole Padersen said. Villafan was sent to North Shore University Hospital for X-rays of his right hand and the right side of his face. Madame Viceroy B B was euthanized.

California Gets OK for Derby Future Wager:

The California Horse Racing Board approved a rule during its Jan. 24 meeting which will allow bettors in the state to participate in Churchill Downs' Kentucky Derby Future Wager for the first time, *The Blood-Horse* reports. Pool 1 of the Future Wager opens Feb. 14 and closes Feb. 17.

CHRB Licenses Companies for Account Wagering:

The California Horse Racing Board Thursday approved licenses for two companies--TVG and Magna Entertainment's Xpress Bet--to conduct advance deposit wagering (also known as account wagering) in the state. Xpress Bet, which received a two-year license, will offer racing from the Magna tracks Santa Anita, Golden Gate and Bay Meadows. TVG, which shows Del Mar, Hollywood Park and Oak Tree at Santa Anita, will begin accepting accounts from California residents immediately.

"She had surgery on Monday and I went out there on Tuesday and she looked really good," trainer Peter Eurton said. "She fractured both sesamoids completely. She had no support whatsoever, and she also pulled her lateral and co-lateral ligaments, which tie it so it can't go side-to-side, so she was very close to having her bones stick right through the skin. We're just trying to save her so she can have babies. Right now, our primary concern is infection or foundering...but so far, so good." The six-year-old mare won the Cal Cup Matron Nov. 3 and came back to be fourth in the GII Bayakoa H. last time out Dec. 15. From 40 starts, she has 11 wins, five seconds and eight thirds for earnings of \$433,318.
