LIDO PALACE OUT OF DONN

MGISW **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold) will not fly to Gulfstream Park from California for the Feb. 9 GI Donn H., the *Thoroughbred Times* reports. Unhappy with the expense of the cross-country flight, trainer Bobby Frankel said he would instead send his runner in the Feb. 3 GII San Antonio H. at Santa Anita. The Chilean Horse of the Year, a finalist for the Eclipse as champion older horse, has not been out since running eighth in the Nov. 24 Japan Cup Dirt.

BREEDERS' CUP CHAMP MAKES RETURN

GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hero **Squirtle Squirt** (Marquetry) makes his 2002 debut in today's GII Palos Verdes H., but don't expect his best effort first time out. "He'll run OK, but I haven't really cranked on him," trainer Bobby Frankel told *Daily Racing Form*. "I'm not killing him to get ready; hopefully, his class will come out." The colt puts his three-for-three record at the Palos Verdes distance of six furlongs on the line. In addition to the Sprint, the dark bay captured the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship in 2000 and a Hollywood allowance last year at three-quarters of a mile. He earned his first Grade I score in the seven-furlong King's Bishop S. at Saratoga last August. Squirtle Squirt is likely to be joined on the front end by **Snow Ridge** (Tabasco Cat), who battled for the lead before taking the Jan. 1 GIII El Conejo H. But an abundance of speed could set things up for the late-running **Ceeband** (Chimes Band). The gelding beat Squirtle Squirt by a half length in the GII Triple Bend Breeders' Cup H. last July, and added wins in the California Sprint Championship H. and Cal Cup Sprint last fall. Last time out, he was third in the restricted On Trust H. going 7 1/2 furlongs Nov. 22.

KALOOKAN QUEEN MAKES THE GRADE

Third in the 1999 GI La Brea S. and second in the 2000 GI Santa Monica H., **Kalookan Queen** (Lost Code) finally made the grade, taking the 2002 edition of the Santa Monica by a half-length over a rallying **Leading Light** (Mr. Leader) at Santa Anita yesterday afternoon. The six-year-old mare, making her first start of the new year, ended 2001 with three wins from her last four starts. After taking the restricted Fantastic Girl S. and the GIII Rancho Bernardo H. at Del Mar, the dark bay took a two-month break, returning to be second in the Oct. 26 GII First Flight S. at Belmont Park. She called it a campaign after winning the Dec. 16 Corona H. at Hollywood Park. The even-money chalk yesterday, Kalookan Queen broke sharply and took the lead while racing off the rail, but allowed **Favorite Funtime** (Seeking the Gold) to sneak up inside her and set the pace. She eased past that rival again on the far turn and opened up on the field as they hit the stretch, then had enough left to hold off the challenge of the runner-up. The winner will be pointed to the Feb. 23 GIII Las Flores H. at Santa Anita.

Assistant Trainer Seriously Injured at Gulfstream Park:

Yvonne Azeff, assistant to trainer John Ward Jr., was seriously injured in an incident during training hours at Gulfstream Park yesterday morning. Azeff was riding back from the track on the stable pony when the pony became upset, threw her and then fell on top of her. The 41-year-old ex-jockey, knocked unconscious in the accident, was taken to Memorial Regional Hospital in Hollywood, where she was listed in "serious" condition in the intensive care unit. "I just left her and she's in no immediate danger," Ward said. "There's no swelling on the brain and no broken bones. Her vital signs are OK. We are all hoping she has a full recovery."

Gold Mover, the only graded stakes winner in this field, won the seven-furlong GIII Forward Gal S. impressively as a three-year-old over this track last January. The striking chestnut attempted top company later that April in the GI Ashland S., but was not up to the task and came home a disappointing eighth. Following a string of solid stakes finishes, including a handy win at Belmont in the six-furlong F'bral Park S. Sept. 9, the filly was narrowly defeated last time in Calder's GIII Chaposa Springs H. Dec. 29, finishing second by a nose. Heavily backed against fillies lacking her accomplishments, the four-year-old took command early and held the advantage all the way home for an easy score.
