### SNOW RIDGE LIKE A FAST RIDGE

As unusual as the rain was in sunny Southern California, it had to be the snow that caught people's eye at Santa Anita yesterday as **Snow Ridge** (Tabasco Cat) put on a display of pure speed to take the GII Palos Verdes H. by four lengths over Breeders' Cup Sprint winner **Squirtle Squirt** (Marquetry). Snow Ridge battled on the front end to take the Jan. 1 GIII El Conejo H. in his last start and the four-year-old employed those same tactics for yesterday's win. Sent right to the lead by jockey Mike Smith, Snow Ridge set fractions of :21.13, :43.31 and :55.23, pressed all the way by Squirtle Squirt, who was making his first start since the Breeders' Cup last October. As Squirtle Squirt faded down the lane, Snow Ridge looked strong as ever as he strode under the wire unchallenged, stopping the clock in 1:07.70. "He really took to the [sloppy] track very well, he seemed to relish it," Smith said after the victory. Trainer D. Wayne Lukas commented, "He's quick. I think when he gets away like he does, he's as quick as any of them." Jerry Bailey, on Squirtle Squirt, said of the beaten favorite, "He ran a good race, you know. This might not be his favorite track, but he ran hard. The other horse just ran better today."

### LATE-RUNNING CAKE TAKES FORWARD GAL

Rebounding from a dull sixth-place effort in the Jan. 6 Old Hat S., **Take the Cake** (Fly So Free) came running late to win yesterday's seven-furlong GIII Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream Park by 3 1/4 lengths. The chestnut filly began her career with a maiden win at Keeneland last October and quickly added a Nov. 10 Churchill allowance victory, but she showed little in her three-year-old debut in the six-furlong Old Hat. Dismissed at 22-1 yesterday, Take the Cake was bumped at the start and settled into sixth-place in the seven-horse field. She moved into contention on the turn and gained the lead a furlong from the wire before drawing clear of 2-5 favorite **A New Twist** (Storm Cat). "She was a little short in her last race," trainer Carl Nafzger admitted. "Six furlongs isn't really what she wants. She wants to go longer and it was longer today." Winning rider Rene Douglas added, "[Nafzger] told me this filly likes to make a late run but will wait on horses. So I wait, and wait, and wait, and when I finally moved, she got the job done."

### Azeff Upgraded to Stable:

Trainer John Ward's assistant Yvonne Azeff, who suffered head injuries in a freak early morning accident on Saturday, was upgraded to "stable condition," in Hollywood Memorial Hospital last night. After another brain scan Sunday morning, the hospital said Azeff is suffering some brain swelling and hasn't regained consciousness since the accident in which her pony fell on top of her.

### Donn Works:

**Graeme Hall** (Dehere) worked seven furlongs yesterday in 1:30. The five-year-old starts next in the Feb. 9 GI Donn H. "I thought it was a good workout," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "I'll give him one more hard work and that should set him up for the Donn."...Trainer Shug McGaughey sent Donn hopeful **Traditionally** (Mr. Prospector) out for a five-furlong work yesterday. The GI Oaklawn H. winner finished the work in 1:01 4/5. "I was very pleased with the way Traditionally worked," McGaughey commented. "I had him going out six furlongs in 1:13 and change."

### Sophomores on the Work Tab:

**Saarland** (Unbridled), off since winning the GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct last November, worked five furlongs at Gulfstream yesterday in 1:02 1/5. The colt is expected to start next in the GI Fountain of Youth on Feb. 16. "He's coming along fine," said trainer Shug McGaughey yesterday. "I'll start getting a little more serious in his workouts from now on." Also aiming for the Fountain of Youth, **Grey Beard** (Unbridled's Song) worked a half mile at Gulfstream Saturday in :49 2/5. The bay colt won a 1 1/16-miles allowance contest over this track Jan. 9...**Showmeital** (All Gone), second in the GIII Spectacular Bid, worked a half mile at Calder on Wednesday in :48 2/5. He starts next in the GII Hutcheson S. on Saturday. "He worked real good," said trainer Manny Tortora. "In fact, it was almost too good. I tried to slow him down a little, but he ran like a wild horse."

### Hefty Ban for Coa:

Gulfstream stewards suspended jockey Eibar Coa for 30 days for rough riding in Saturday's GIII Ft. Lauderdale H. Coa, riding **Mr. Livingston** (El Prado {Ire}) in the race, several times appeared to impede the progress of eventual winner **Del Mar Show** (Theatrical {Ire}) and jockey Jerry Bailey. If he doesn't appeal, Coa's suspension begins on Thursday.
