### KEEP 'EM COMING

Coming off a three-month absence, spotting his six rivals weight and returning at the demanding distance of seven furlongs, **Came Home** (Gone West) was going to need a top effort to take the GII San Vicente S. yesterday at Santa Anita and that's just what he produced. A nine-length maiden winner at first asking last June 3, the dark bay negotiated the jump to stakes company with aplomb, annexing the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship July 15 by four lengths. Shipped cross-country, the homebred came from off the pace to defeat the talented Mayakovsky in the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga Sept. 1, but suffered his only off-the-board finish to date when seventh in the 8 1/2-furlong GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Belmont Park Oct. 27. Eased back off the early pace set by **Werblin** (Unbridled's Song) and **Mighty David** (End Sweep), **Came Home** was angled off the rail by jockey Chris McCarron rounding the far turn, bid three deep into the stretch, overtook **Werblin** with less than a furlong to run and kicked impressively clear. **Jack's Silver** (Soft Gold {Brz}) finished well to gain the place spot. "I knew he was training very well coming into this race," commented winning trainer Paco Gonzalez. "He was at his best." Added the winning rider, "He broke very well and showed his usual speed, but he was giving me signals down the backstretch that if I wanted to ease him back, he was going to let me. It worked out really well. He's quite nice." The winner and runner-up go next in the GII San Rafael S. at a mile Mar. 2. **Chart, p2**

### MONARCHOS TO CLAIBORNE?

It was widely reported Saturday that Kentucky Derby hero **Monarchos** (Maria's Mon--Regal Band, by Dixieland Band) will enter stud this season at Claiborne Farm in Paris, Kentucky for a fee of \$25,000. Owner John Oxley is expected to issue a release on Monday regarding the grey colt's future. The four-year-old was retired last Monday after suffering a tendon injury. **Monarchos** had been sidelined after a third-place finish in the GI Belmont S. last June with a hairline fracture in his knee and returned to the races this year with a third in an allowance/optional claiming race at Gulfstream Jan. 19.

### MAST SAILS TO STRUB VICTORY

Maintaining his perfect record on the main track, **Mizzen Mast** (Cozzene) displayed his patented stretch kick to take the GII Strub S. at Santa Anita yesterday afternoon. The gunmetal grey colt had taken the G3 Prix de Guiche in France, but his first two U.S. tries were disappointing. After finishing 10th over a yielding Arlington course in the GI Secretariat S., he tired to ninth in the GII Del Mar Derby Sept. 3, forcing trainer Bobby Frankel to go back to the drawing board. **Mizzen Mast** returned Nov. 7 to impressively win the Bien Bien S. going a mile on the Hollywood lawn, then tried the dirt in the GI Malibu S. over this surface Dec. 26. He bobbled at the start that day, but came flying in the lane to defeat **Giant Gentleman** (Montbrook). That result was mirrored here. The Juddmonte homebred sat a couple of lengths off a hot pace, split horses to mount a three-wide challenge and burst clear in midstretch to set a new stakes record. "Right now it doesn't look like he has any distance limitations," commented winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "It looks like he's pretty much a push-button horse where you can just sit on him and just let him finish." The Mar. 2 GI Santa Anita H. is next for **Mizzen Mast**.

Showmeitall battled bravely on the front end to earn his first stakes success as even-money Maybry's Boy (Broad Brush) finished fourth. The Florida-bred grandson of Fappiano had broken his maiden by 10 1/2 lengths at Calder Sept. 29, then finished sixth to Harlan's Holiday in the GIII Iroquois S. at Churchill Nov. 4. He rebounded to take a Calder allowance Nov. 23 and followed that up with a second in Tampa's Inaugural S. Dec. 15. Stepped back up to graded company Jan. 3, he was caught near the wire by Maybry's Boy in the GIII Spectacular Bid S. With a pair of bullet works at Calder under his belt since that effort, Showmeitall broke from the rail and vied for the lead with Royal Lad. The bay shook free at the top of the lane and had to dig deep to fend off Monthir's challenge from the outside to prevail in a photo finish. "We were going to try and rate him behind horses, but he broke so good and he didn't want to relax, so I let him go on," said victorious jockey Jorge Chavez, who had four winners on the day. Showmeitall will likely head out on the Triple Crown trail. "I don't know where we'll go next, but he's nominated to everything, including the Illinois Derby [Apr. 6]," said winning trainer Manny Tortora.

A dual Grade I winner last season with victories in the GI Ramona H. at Del Mar in July and the GI Yellow Ribbon S. at Santa Anita in September, Janet checked in third in the Nov. 4 GII Las Palmas H. at Santa Anita before failing to handle a yielding turf at Hollywood when sixth in the GI Matriarch S. Nov. 25. The bay was a rejuvenated second to Tout Charmant in the GII San Gorgonio H. in Arcadia Jan. 13 and was the heavy chalk in her return to Northern California. Settled just off the pace set by Impeachable, jockey David Flores asked the five-year-old for run leaving the three-eighths marker, put away Impeachable in upper stretch and proved much the best. "I just wanted to put her where she was comfortable," said the winning rider. "I just hung on and made sure her mind was focused on the race. She was very focused today." The winner goes next in the GII Santa Barbara H. over 10 furlongs at Santa Anita Apr. 20.

Unable to secure suitable travel arrangements to the East Coast for the GI Donn H. next weekend, trainer Bobby Frankel has finally decided on this spot for the five-year-old debut for stable star **Lido Palace**. A force in the handicap ranks last season, the chestnut was runner-up in both the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup and GII Suburban H., but turned the corner with powerful wins in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga and the GI Woodward S. at Belmont. Owners John and Jerome Amerman decided it was not in their best interests to supplement the horse to the Breeders' Cup Classic for \$800,000 and passed on a chance at horse of the year in favor of the G1 Japan Cup Dirt in Tokyo. He turned in a dull effort in the Nov. 24 event, but has trained well for the return and gets regular pilot Jerry Bailey back in the irons. Frankel holds a second bullet in the form of **Euchre**. Winner of the GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker BC H. last July, the gelding has returned to log second-place finishes in the GIII Native Diver H. two back and most recently the GII San Pasqual H. Jan. 5.

**WHAT'S DOING DOWN UNDER**

**RACE HORSES STAR IN AUSSIE SURVEY**

Thoroughbreds emerged as the star performers in the latest Access Economics Asset Price Survey, with the price of bloodstock growing strongly in 10 years (to Dec. 30). Thoroughbreds, banknotes, wine and stamp errors are among the top performers in all asset classes, including property.

"The glamour investments of the past decade--global shares and Sydney residential property--may have performed strongly, but they failed to keep pace with niche investments such as Thoroughbreds," Alison Kahler stated in the *Australian Financial Review*.

But many believe that the Thoroughbred market is poised to undergo a 5 to 10-percent correction in 2002, a theory backed by the results from the Magic Millions Premier Sale, where the average took a 3-percent dip, and the Inglis Classic Sale in Sydney in January, where the average was off 9 percent.

The average at the recently concluded New Zealand Bloodstock Premier Sale was off even more dramatically, falling 16.5 percent from a year ago.

"The market has leveled a little, it is not going to get any bigger at this stage and I can't see big average increases at any sale this year--but there could be some good buying," predicted prominent purchaser Ron Dufficy.

Some note there are fewer Malaysian and Singapore purchasers about at Australasian sales thus far this year, although the Hong Kong bench is still significant. Few are predicting that Japanese purchasers will play a role here in 2002. Griffiths says although the Thoroughbred market has proven particularly robust in Australia, indications are that it will not be immune to a wide-spread market correction in 2002.

"Thoroughbreds are obviously a very specialized market, but in terms of a general market correction, there are a whole lot of asset prices that are also likely to undergo a correction," Griffiths commented.

Clearly, the market is steadying a little after heady gains: the benchmark Inglis Easter sale recorded average increases of 18.7 percent and 19.8 percent, respectively, in 1999 and 2000, compared with a more moderate 8.8-percent increase in 2001.

Many believe that, by the end of the season, Australian bloodstock will have continued to hold up very well. Not least among those who remain positive is Inglis managing director Reg Inglis.

"Markets won't go up and up forever," Inglis said. "Inevitably there will be a correction at some point and we've got to live with it, but I am not saying we are going to take a dip at Easter."

"We sold five yearlings for A\$100,000 or more at the Classic and if there had been a couple more, the average would have exceeded 2001," he continued. "It was a strong sale, especially in the A\$50,000 to A\$100,000 bracket, and there were plenty of people who couldn't buy the horse they wanted. We have a sensational catalogue for Easter, a wonderful number of horses and a lot of international interest in the sale." Bloodstock agent and Aushorse director Mark Pilkington concurred.

"The true indicator of the strength of sales so far is that you have had to pay plenty if you wanted a really good horse," he said.

Added Coolmore Australia General Manager Duncan Grimley, "I think we are off on a great footing. There are fewer Asian buyers than in previous years, but Magic Millions held up extremely well."

But respected agent Les Young cautioned against across-the-board conclusions, saying the quality in each catalogue is ultimately a telling factor.

"If we hold a line on most sales in 2001, we will be doing well, but some will record increases or otherwise depending on the catalogue," Young said. "Adelaide and Melbourne are both good catalogues this year, and I expect they will have great sales. That is not so much a reflection on the market as on a better lot of horses."

Time will tell.
