SEEING RED

A Group 1 winner on the turf and Group 2 placed on the dirt in his native Brazil, **Redattore (Brz)** (Roi Normand) raced three abreast nearly the entire way around the racetrack and wore down second choice **Euchre** (Personal Flag) for a surprising half-length success in the GII San Antonio H. yesterday at Santa Anita. Heavily favored **Lido Palace (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold) finished an uninspired fourth. A winner in two of his first four grass starts in the U.S. in 2001, trainer Dick Mandella tried Redattore back on the main in last year's seven-furlong GIII Triple Bend BC H., where he finished a good fourth. He returned to the grass to record a two-length win in the GI Eddie Read H. last July 28 and was third in the GI Arlington Million before ending the year with a fifth in the GII Oak Tree BC Mile Oct. 7. Making his first start since then, Redattore was sent up to contest the pace set by Euchre and **Irisheyesareflying** (Flying Continental). He drew on even terms three deep at the head of the stretch and prevailed in a long drive. "He won by a half length, but he did it vey easy," said winning rider Alex Solis. "I had a lot of horse the whole way. It was a good race."

ALL DRESSED IN WHITE

Cellars Shiraz (Kissin Kris) had done little wrong in two career starts over the turf, but made those that ignored her at the windows pay dearly yesterday with an 18-1 victory in the GIII Herecomesthebride S. at Gulfstream. The bay finished runner-up in a pair of Calder allowances in the slop in the fall before taking her turf bow by 1/2 length at Calder Nov. 18. Fifth in the off-the-turf Tropical Park Oaks Jan. 1, she rebounded nicely to finish second to **Kathy K D** (Saint Ballado) in her first taste of the local green Jan. 13. **August Storm** (Storm Creek) was hustled to the front and set a leisurely pace for the opening half mile, tracked intently by Cellars Shiraz from second. Those two raced side by side into the stretch, August Storm towards the rail and Cellars Shiraz to the outside, with the latter getting just the better of her rival in the final 50 yards. "I laid close to the pace because I didn't want that other horse (August Storm) to get away from us," commented winning rider Cornelio Velasquez. "I had a lot of horse under me the final eighth. This filly will go farther."

Duckhorn To Contest Donn:

Michael Tabor's **Duckhorn** (Not For Love), unraced since suffering an ankle injury when third in the GII Washington Park H. at Arlington last July, will make his return to the races in Saturday's GI Donn H. at Gulfstream, trainer Patrick Byrne confirmed yesterday. "I cleared it with [Tabor's racing manager] Demi [O'Byrne] this morning after I worked [the horse] five furlongs. He went very well and came back in good shape." The five-year-old, who upset Lido Palace in last year's GII Hawthorne Gold Cup, was clocked in 1:02 3/5 for his work. The long-range goal for the grey horse is the GI Gulfstream Park H. over 10 furlongs Mar. 30.

Hutcheson Wrap-Up:

Saturday's GII Hutcheson S. winner **Showmeitall** (All Gone) emerged from his hard-fought victory in good order according to trainer Manny Tortora. "He came back super. He ate up everything last night and is feeling good this morning." The conditioner remains non-committal on the next start for the gelding, but expressed some doubt about a start in the Feb. 16 GI Fountain of Youth S. "It's probably a little too soon for him to come back," Tortora explained, "but we'll see how he does in his training over the next few days." **Monthir** (Gulch), a tough-luck runner-up in Saturday's main event, also remains of the fence for the FOY. "I'm not sure where or when he'll run next," said trainer Mark Hennig. "The Fountain of Youth seems to be coming up a bit soon for him. I'll play it by ear for now." Trainer Shug McGaughey said yesterday that fourth-place finisher **Maybry's Boy** (Broad Brush) remains on track for the Fountain of Youth despite his fourth-place finish in the Hutcheson. "He got very tired on that deep track," McGaughey commented. "He seems to be in fine shape. If everything goes as planned, then the Fountain of Youth will be his next race."
