DONN'S EARLY FLIGHT

It'll be crowded on the front end in today's GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park, with **Keats** (Hennessy), **Best of the Rest** (Skip Trial), **Ubiquity** (Colonial Affair), **Duckhorn** (Not For Love) and **Rize** (Theatrical {Ire}) all likely to be among the first flight. That could set it up for a closer such as...**Hal's Hope** (Jolie's Halo)? It's true--the dark, dark bay who led gate-to-wire to win the 2000 GI Florida Derby and zipped a half in :45 4/5 before tiring to be 16th in the GI Kentucky Derby, has shown a new dimension in his most recent races and will be running at the end in the Donn. "He has matured a lot physically, and in the way he runs," Harold Rose, the five-year-old's owner/breeder/trainer, said. "Now we've changed him around to where he comes from off the pace and he has been intelligent enough to handle it." Using his new tactics, Hal's Hope was second behind **Kiss A Native** (Kissin Kris) in the Dec. 29 GIII Fred W. Hooper H. at Calder and third to Sir Bear and **Red Bullet** (Unbridled) in the GIII Skip Away H. Jan. 12. The 2001 GI Preakness winner will be the one to beat here. Coming off a seven-week layoff, the chestnut rallied to take the lead late in the Skip Away, only to be passed in the final yards. "I think he'll move forward off his last race," trainer Joe Orseno said. "We trained him for the 1 1/16 miles and we almost got him there. A classy horse ran him down. I'd rather have him peaking for the Donn."

SITTING PRETTY IN SABIN

Making her first start since a fourth-place finish in the Nov. 22 GIII Falls City H. at Churchill Downs, **Miss Linda** (Arg) (Southern Halo) was sent off the slight 2-1 choice in yesterday's GIII Sabin H. at Gulfstream Park and led nearly every step en route to a 4 1/4-length score over Falls City heroine **Forest Secrets** (Forest Wildcat). Twice a Group 1 winner in her native country, the dark bay picked up her first U.S. victory in the Lady's Secret S. at Monmouth Park last August, added a Saratoga allowance win three weeks later and, after a short break, made it three in a row as a 21-1 outsider in the Oct. 7 GI Spinster S. at Keeneland. She ended her 2001 campaign with a pair of off-the-board efforts, running sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff before her seasonal finale in Louisville. Favored to turn the tables in her 2002 debut, the imported mare went right to the front, was pressured through a half in :46 4/5, then opened up on the field as they raced down the lane to win handily. "I'll have to plan her schedule for the rest of the year, but the Rampart [GII, Mar. 2] is well within her time frame," trainer John Kimmel said.

The Ron McAnally-trained **Affluent**, winner of three straight graded stakes, bids to become the first filly in nearly a quarter of a century to sweep the La Cañada series, but she will have **Royally Chosen** to beat once again. The two finished 1 1/2 lengths apart in the first leg of the series, the Dec. 29 GI La Brea S. going seven furlongs. Stretching out to a mile and a sixteenth for the first time for the Jan. 20 GII El Encino S., Royally Chosen once again went right to the front and nearly held on, getting caught on the line by her arch rival to miss by a nose. "We'll see if we can't stop McAnally from making history," her trainer, Bruce Headley, said. Royally Chosen's jockey, Alex Solis, feels the extra sixteenth of the La Cañada will help his filly. "The first few times I rode her, I told Bruce, 'When we go long, she's going to be even better.' And she has won from off the pace, too--she doesn't have to be in front." It's a good thing, too, with the speedy **Summer Colony** shipping in from the east. The dark bay is unbeaten since breaking her maiden by 32 3/4 lengths at Saratoga in August, most recently taking on graded-stakes foes for the first time and leading every step to win the GIII Ladies H. at Aqueduct Dec. 22. "Ever since we sent her around two turns at distances she prefers, she has been a real monster," trainer Mark Hennig said. "This is certainly a step up in class for her, but she's doing very well right now, so it's the right time to try. We'll find out how good she is."

Crash Course Sidelined:

Crash Course (Holy Bull), winner of the Jan. 20 GIII Mac Diarmida H. at Gulfstream Park, will not make his next start in the Feb. 16 GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H., as had been expected. The six-year-old gelding bled after a morning gallop this past week and will be forced to miss the race. "It wasn't the first time he has bled, but I thought we had it under control," trainer Jimmy Croll said. "But it's awful humid here now and he's too good a horse to mess around with. I sent him to J. Mack Robinson's farm in Georgia and will keep him there about 60 days. Then I'll pick him up and take him to New Jersey with me."

Giving It a Whirl:

A field of nine three-year-olds will go postward in the Whirlaway S. at Aqueduct, headlined by the unbeaten **Saratoga Blues** (Twining). After airing in his debut by 11 3/4 lengths at Laurel, the chestnut colt added a two-turn allowance victory over the inner track Dec. 20 and breaks from the rail in his stakes bow. He is joined by **Smoked Em** (Smoke Glacken), who has been impressive in a pair of Big A victories; and **D'Coach** (Dehere), a late-closing second in the Count Fleet S. Jan. 5. A pair of European shippers gives the Whirlaway a foreign flavor: **Goshin's Lad** (Nicholas), who has won twice over Lingfield's all-weather surface; and **More Specific (GB)** (Definite Article {GB}), unbeaten in two starts over the sand at Southwell.

With Ability got back on track with this easy wire-to-wire victory. A seven-length winner of the Fashion S. at two, the bay filly was sidelined following a third in the GIII Sorority S. in August 2000. She returned to action with an allowance score at Aqueduct last April, but was shelved once again after a seventh-place finish in the GI Acorn S. June 8. The homebred just missed in her comeback effort, an Aqueduct allowance Nov. 25, but bounced in her next start, finishing sixth to Xtra Heat in the Interborough H. New Year's Day at the same track. Trying two turns for the first time, the odds-on choice quickly made the lead, set an honest pace and opened up at will under a hand ride. With Ability is a half to the dam of GSW Summer Colony, who goes in today's GII La Canada S. at Santa Anita.

Ohio-bred U S S Tinoso, a two-time stakes winner in his native state last year, posted a second-place finish in the open-company Manila S. on the Arlington turf Oct. 20, then ended the season as the runner-up in the Gold Rush S. on the Golden Gate main track Dec. 15. The grey came back in the Jan. 12 Gill Golden Gate Derby and, after running into traffic on the final turn, finished a game third. The third choice facing restricted company here, he tracked pacesetter Shah Jehan (Mr. Prospector), the \$4.4 million KEESEP yearling, from third, drove to the front as they came into the stretch and pulled away to a decisive score. "I have a lot of plans for this horse," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said. "I nominated him for everything--the Illinois Derby, the Santa Anita Deby, the Kentucky Derby. Future Book Wager Set for Next Week:

Pool 1 of the Kentucky Derby Future Wager will be held next weekend, with four new states joining the wagering market. California, Massachusetts, Michigan and Washington are scheduled to offer the future wager, bringing the total number of states to 34. Wagering will begin at noon Feb. 14 and will close Sunday, Feb. 17 at 5:30 p.m. EST. Pool 2 will be held Mar. 14-17 and Pool 3 is set for Apr. 4-7; all pools will run from Thursday through Sunday. The Kentucky Derby Future Wager is a \$2 minimum wager and is a win bet only. The list of horses in each pool consists of 24 betting interests, which include 23 individual horses and a 24th option that is a mutuel field containing all other three-year-old Thoroughbreds, regardless of whether those horses have been nominated to the Kentucky Derby and the Visa Triple Crown.

Irish American Bloodhorse Sued by Hopewell:

Rick Trontz of Hopewell Farm has filed suit in Woodford County, Kentucky for the collection of \$79,500 from Michael Fennessy's Irish American Bloodhorse, the *Thoroughbred Times Online* reported yesterday. The suit stems from Irish American's failure to pay two \$37,500 stud fees for 1998 Horse of the Year Skip Away. According to the suit, the Irish American mares Dayjur Vu Again and Offthe Bridle both produced Skip Away foals earlier this year. Tom Dunn, manager of Irish American, told the *Thoroughbred Times* that the suit was over "differences about the bill."

AUTHORITIES QUIET ON SCANDAL After the arrest of 19 people, including jockeys John Egan and Robbie Fradd, on Wednesday, the Hong Kong Jockey Club yesterday declined to divulge on the exact details of the alleged fixing scandal. In a crackdown on an illegal bookmaking operation conducted by the government's Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC), four HKJC employees, a suspected illegal bookmaker and a gambling consultant, as well as the jockeys, were raided. The HKJC yesterday stated: "We are not in a position to comment on the ICAC operation codenamed 'Green Grass' nor should we disclose any related information to the public. As always, the Club is determined to ensure that racing in Hong Kong is of the highest level of integrity and to protect the interest of the Hong Kong people." An ICAC statement said: "It is alleged that the two jockeys and the four Hong Kong Jockey Club employees had accepted advantages from illegal bookmakers as rewards for supplying racing information and manipulating race results."

NEW EUROPEAN-BREDS IN HONG KONG

A pair of European-bred runners have recently been purchased by Hong Kong interests to race in that country. Seven-year-old **Eastern Purple (Ire)** (Petorius {GB}), a Listed winner during his sophomore season, scored his lone victory in 1999 in the G3 Greenlands S. at The Curragh. Victorious in the G3 Phoenix Sprint S. in 2000 and 10th in the G3 Hong Kong Sprint that season, he went winless in his final 16 starts in Europe and was last seen when runner-up in the Listed Wentworth S. at Doncaster Nov. 11. Three-year-old **Winning Benny (Ire)** (Paris House {GB}) was extremely consistent in seven starts in Ireland last season, finishing second in maidens at Naas, Galway and Cork before graduating in his fifth career start at the South Ireland track. The conqueror of Listed winner and Group 1 placed Miss Beabea in the Goffs Autumn Bonus Sept. 21, the gray gelding, formerly named Paris Express, was second at Naas Oct. 21 in his most recent appearance. He will be trained by Y.O. Wong.
