BOOKLET WINS ROUND TWO

Last time out, **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) was the 9-10 chalk in the Jan. 19 Gill Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream Park, but couldn't catch front-running **Booklet** (Notebook), finishing second by 3/4 of a length. With that race under his girth, Harlan's Holiday was sent off the 2-1 favorite in the GI Fountain Of Youth S. yesterday afternoon. But Booklet, the 5-1 third choice, went right to the lead once again and he held on this time as well, beating his more fancied rival by a nose. "He was a little bit tired, but he likes to fight," winning jockey Jorge Chavez, aboard the colt for the first time, said. "He didn't want to get beat." The speedy three-year-old has been beaten only once, finishing third in the Gill Saratoga Special last August. He came back to win the Sept. 22 Dover S. at Delaware Park and the final leg of the Florida Stallions series Oct. 13 before calling it a campaign. The Florida-bred had been working bullets since his Holy Bull victory and showed his customary speed in the Fountain Of Youth, opening up daylight as he sped through a half in :46 4/5. Booklet turned back a challenge from longshot **Political Attack** (Hawk Attack) after six furlongs and had two lengths on Harlan's Holiday at the eighth pole. The crowd's choice came at him, but the bay would not be denied. "If I had to describe him in one word, it would be tenacious," owner John Oxley said. "He's a little horse, but he doesn't like to be passed." The winner will go next in the GI Florida Derby at a mile and an eighth Mar. 16. Jockey Tony D'Amico, aboard the runner-up, said, "We had a perfect trip, he just couldn't get by that horse. He tried and he ran his race, but he just wasn't good enough." **Stephentown** (Wild Again), the second favorite at 5-2, sat just off the early leaders for six furlongs, but weakened in the stretch and finished sixth. "He warmed up well and everything seemed fine," jockey Pat Day said. "We were right where we wanted to be, but he couldn't muster a challenge." XTRA SPECIAL

Weight may indeed stop a freight train, but it couldn't stop **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat) from running away from her rivals in the GI Barbara Fritchie H. yesterday afternoon at Laurel while giving away from 12 to 16 pounds to her rivals. The speedy bay, second in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and third in the GI De Francis Memorial Dash, got back on track with a wire-to-wire victory in Aqueduct's Interborough H. on New Year's Day and was given a six-week freshening. Breaking alertly, the 128-pound highweight went straight to the front and set a comfortable pace of :22 4/5 and :45 2/5 with 7-2 second-choice **Gold Mover** (Gold Fever) at her flank. Xtra Heat opened up turning for home and was never threatened down the lane. The G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 23 is the four-year-old's next target.

The only Grade I winner in the field, Cetewayo had also captured the 1998 GII Bowling Green H. and the 2000 GII Red Smith H. at 11 furlongs, but the eight-year-old was overlooked here off last year's form. Winless since his Red Smith score, the bay started only four times in 2001, finishing third in the Sept. 29 GI Turf Classic, but ending the campaign with a 10th-place finish behind Mr. Pleasantfar (Emmson {Ire}) in the Oct. 26 GII Knickerbocker S. and a 12th-place showing as he attempted to defend his title in the Red Smith Nov. 17. The veteran was given a break after that effort and was making his seasonal debut. Co-second longest shot on the board, he was checked as they raced into the first turn and saved ground at the back of the pack down the backstretch. Cetewayo closed while still sitting toward the inside on the final bend, switched to the outside to drive past the leaders and drew clear. "[Trainer Michael Dickinson] told me to get good position off the pace," said winning jockey Cornelio Velasquez after picking up his first Grade I victory. "I found room between horses when we were rallying into the stretch and I had a lot of horse left when we passed the eighth pole." Precocious enough to win going 4 1/2 furlongs at first asking last April at Keeneland, Take Charge Lady returned to be a 3/4-length winner of her two-turn bow in Turfway allowance company Sept. 8 prior to a one-length success in the GII Walmac Int'l Alcibiades S. at Keeneland Oct. 5. Sxith in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, the bay closed the year with a runner-up finish to Belterra in the Nov. 24 GII Golden Rod S. at Churchill. Shipped from her Gulfstream base for her sophomore bow, she was the surprising second choice in the wagering behind Tiffany Lass S. heroine Lake Lady (Salt Lake). Sent immediately to the front by jockey Jon Court, Take Charge Lady set a very strong pace along the inside, began to draw clear turning into the long Fair Grounds stretch and covered the final five-sixteenths of a mile in a sparkling :30 1/5 en route to a powerful score in track-record equaling time. "She was really on her game today," the winning rider commented. "Even in the post parade she had running on her mind. She relaxed when I asked her to and she gave me a run when I called on her."

The lightly raced Nazirali came flying on the outside to just get the decision at the wire over Continental Red as 3-5 Denon (Pleasant Colony) endured a poor trip on his way to a fifth-place finish. Born in Ireland, Nazirali made three starts in the French provinces for trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre, breaking his maiden at Clairfontaine last August before running second in a handicap at Craon Sept. 8. He made his stateside bow in a 10-furlong allowance at Hollywood Nov. 21, but didn't run again until Jan. 9, when he ran second in an \$80,000 optional claimer over this course. The five-year-old was unhurried through an opening mile split of 1:37 1/5, then began to advance on the far turn. Continental Red, who missed by a nose in the GII San Marcos H. last out, found himself in a similar position as Nazirali closed strongly for a last-gasp victory. "I was a little bit afraid in the post parade, because he was getting a little bit wound up," said winning rider Brice Blanc. "But as soon as we broke out of the gate, he relaxed nicely, and we had a little bit of pace in the race today. I think we've got a good horse for the San Juan Capistrano [Apr. 21] now, because this horse can gallop all day." The replay can be view at [56K 100K 300K](#).

A winner at the highest level on both turf and dirt, **Agnes Digital**, the Japan Racing Association's champion older horse in 2001, rates a strong favorite in Japan's first Group 1 of the New Year. The winner last season of the G1 Mile Championship on the dirt, the five-year-old added victories over reigning Japanese Horse of the Year T.M. Opera O (Jpn) in the G1 Tenno Sho and most recently a thrilling success over Tobougg (Ire) in the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 16. **Toshin Blizzard** is the second choice based on his near perfect record of eight wins from nine starts, his only defeat coming at the hands of **Toho Emperor** in the G1-NAR Tokyo Daishoten Dec. 29. Six-year-old mare **To the Victory** achieved international acclaim with her runner-up finish in last year's G1 Dubai World Cup. The heroine back on Japanese soil of the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup in November, she was third in the G1 Arima Kinen in her latest effort Dec. 23.

A triple Group 1 winner on dirt in her native Chile, **Printemps** captured her first two U.S. starts, including Hollywood's GII Hawthorne H. over today's distance last May. Third after a seven-wide trip in the GI Spinster S., the chestnut closed out 2001 with a second in the GIII Falls City H. at Churchill, with **Spain** back in fifth. Spain's drought continued with a third in the GI Santa Monica H. over seven furlongs Jan. 26; the five-year-old hasn't visited the winner's circle since taking the GII La Cañada S. over this surface last February. She needs less than \$5,000 to go over the \$3-million mark. The Grade I ranking of this race has lured several turf runners to the main track, including **The Seven Seas**. The six-year-old chestnut's lone previous foray on dirt earned her a third in the 2000 renewal of the GII La Cañada S. and she comes into the Santa Maria off a fourth in the Reloy H. going 10 furlongs on the lawn.

SIPHONIC SPIKES FEVER Kentucky Derby winter-book favorite **Siphonic** (Siphon {Brz}) was forced to miss his scheduled breeze Saturday after coming up with a slight fever. "He's got a little temperature and we'll give him a couple of days off," said trainer David Hofmans. The three-year-old colt was given some time to recuperate after nearly falling at the start of his second-place finish in the GII Santa Catalina S. Jan. 19. At the beginning of the year, Hofmans earmarked the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 17 and the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 6 as Siphonic's personal road to the roses.

WEAVER RETIRES

Jockey Jason Weaver yesterday announced his retirement from the saddle after 14 years. Although only 30, Weaver, who partnered Mister Baileys (GB) to win the 1994 G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, revealed he has struggled with his weight for the last few years. "The weight has become a problem," he told *PA Sport* yesterday. "Obviously that's a bit scary to suddenly say it's finished, but I'm only 30--still young--so I said let's give it a go. I only made the decision four or five days ago." Weaver, who rode more than 1000 winners during his career and seven Group 1 winners, is one of only seven jockeys to have ridden 200 winners in a season. He did so when chasing home Frankie Dettori in the 1994 jockeys' championship. He also rode Bijou d'Inde (GB) to win the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot in 1996 for trainer Mark Johnston, who he forged a successful partnership with from the mid-90s onwards. "There have been plenty of highs," he continued. "I've had a great time and racing has been very, very good to me. I just feel that the time is right for a change of direction."

MILKSHAKE WINS ADELAIDE CLASSIC

Milkshake (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) gave a dozen first-time owners an enormous reward on their A\$20,000 investment, easily collecting the A\$228,000 first prize in yesterday's Magic Millions Adelaide two-year-old Classic. "It's great to see so many people enjoying a win, I love that feeling too," said Magic Millions principal John Singleton. "It shows it can happen to anyone." The Classic, tied to the Magic Millions Adelaide Sale, has established itself as a genuine feature in the Australian calendar as well as further enhancing the luster surrounding Encosta de Lago, who has nine colts and four fillies catalogued in the sale which begins Monday. "He has got to be one of the leading young sires in Australia at the moment, he is really hot," said Magic Millions General Manager David Chester of the sire whose progeny fetched up to A\$170,000 at last week's Melbourne sale. Milkshake raced well back early in his Caulfield debut Jan. 12 before settling for sixth and later ran an encouraging second at Sandown Jan. 28. Trainer Colin Little said traveling to Adelaide had helped settle the colt. "He has been working along with Blur (Aus) (Flying Spur {Aus}) and Blur was competitive in the Gold Coast Magic Millions," said Little. "I'm really not sure whether we'll keep going now, he has taken a big step today and proved his up to it, but I'll consider races like the VRC Sires 'Produce over 1400 meters or the Black Opal in Canberra. As a yearling, he was a very nice horse, but the mare had not had much luck--he was the fifth foal and none of the other four had raced, so there was a question mark." **Wyndham Glory (Aus)** (Rory's Jester {Aus}) went straight to the front and dictated terms throughout, with Milkshake sitting in fifth until the turn when jockey Peter Mertens sent him down the outside to win by 2 3/4 lengths from Rachel's Pride (Aus), with Wyndham Glory (Aus) a further length away third.

WATERHOUSE GIVEN GO AHEAD

Bill Waterhouse has been given the green light to resume his bookmaking career despite being knocked back by the NSW Bookmakers' Co-Operative. Providing a financial guarantee to sidestep Bookies' Co-Op regulations, The NSW Thoroughbred Racing Board (TRB) reissued the licence of Waterhouse, 80, on Friday, and he is expected to return to the track at next Saturday's Warwick Farm meeting. Rob Waterhouse, who returned six months ago from a 17-year outing in the wake of the Fine Cotton ring-in in Brisbane in 1984, will appear before stewards Friday when an inquiry in to inflated prices he gave punter Peter McCoy at Canterbury last week resumes.

SUZY GREY TAKES SWETTENHAM STUD

Suzy Grey (Aus) (County {Aus}) charged home late for an emphatic win yesterday in the G2 Swettenham Stud S. at Cheltenham in Adelaide. The unfashionably-bred mare won by 1 1/4 lengths over **Regal Kiss (Aus)** (Royal Adcademy {USA}) with **Lady Belvedere (Aus)** (Royal Academy {USA}) a further half head away in third. The consistent four-year-old's owner-breeder Phillip Jacobsen has ambitious plans for the mare, encompassing the G1 Coolmore Classic and a winter campaign culminating with the G1 Stradbroke H. Bred at Jacobsen's breeding base, located in the tropical Noosa Hinterland on Queensland's Sunshine Coast, the mare's success has surprised many because as a yearling, Jacobsen could not convince Magic Millions to sell her, so he retained her for himself believing she would be a speedy front-runner. "But she really gets back and swoops home, she does everything she shouldn't be doing. She is the first Group 2 winner I have bred," said Jacobsen, who raced Manikato S. winner You Remember (Aus) and also G1 Melbourne Cup fifth placegetter Frontier Boy (Aus).
