NO REGRETS FOR REPENT

The first pool of the Kentucky Derby Future Wager closed just two minutes before the start of the GIII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds, with **Repent** (Louis Quatorze) the early 8-1 co-third choice for the 128th "Run for the Roses." Those odds would have been shorter if the pool had been open just a little longer. Making his first start since his game 1 1/4-length victory in the Nov. 24 GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill Downs, Repent was out of the picture as **Bob's Image** (Halo's Image) cut out the early fractions, was hung out to dry as he made his move at the quarter pole and never changed leads in the stretch, but overcame a less-than-perfect trip to win by 2 1/4 widening lengths. And, as impressive as the performance was, trainer Ken McPeck commented, "I do believe Repent will improve off this race. He is a real special horse; we just need to make sure we don't tap him out early in the year because there are a lot bigger fish to fry later on." The colt could go next in the Mar. 10 GII Louisiana Derby.

ARE WE HAVING FUN YET?

Favorite Funtime (Seeking the Gold) tired to be fourth going seven furlongs in the Jan. 26 GI Santa Monica H., but carried her speed all the way to the wire in the 1 1/16-mile GI Santa Maria H. at Santa Anita yesterday. "I just let her take me to the lead without any effort," jockey Gary Stevens said. "I let her dictate the race until we straightened into the lane, then I asked her hard and she responded...she's all heart." Second in the Cal Cup Matron at this distance Nov. 3, the bay mare ended 2001 with a win in the 7 1/2-furlong Cat's Cradle H. for state-breds Nov. 23. Allowed to coast through easy fractions in the Santa Maria, the Bob Baffert trainee turned back a challenge from **Spain** (Thunder Gulch) after six furlongs and was all out to keep **Verruma (Brz)** (Emmson {Ire}) at bay and win by a head. **Printemps (Chi)** (Hussonet), the slight choice, was many lengths last after a half and still trailed as they neared the stretch, then was carried widest of all, but closed with a rush to get third. Affirmed Success, winner of the off-the-turf GIII Jaipur H. at Belmont May 27 and the eight-furlong GII Poker H. on the grass July 4, rarely puts on a poor showing for his connections and, at the ripe old age of eight, the gelding towers over this field in earnings, with \$1,799,095 already in his account. A close second in the GI Atto Mile at Woodbine last fall, the gelding ran an uncharacteristically poor 11th in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Belmont Oct. 27 and ended the year with a fifth-place finish in the Nov. 24 GI Cigar Mile at Aqueduct. Facing easier company in his 2002 debut, the gelding missed by just a half length in an allowance test over the Aqueduct inner track Jan. 5. The bay gelding, who won this event two years ago, has been working sharply since his season opener. **Here's Zealous** comes into this on a two-race win streak, posting a 4 3/4-length romp in an Aqueduct allowance Nov. 2 and an impressive four-length victory last time in the Big A's GIII Gravesend H. Dec. 15. The five-year-old has also been training forwardly for his 2002 bow. **Wrangler** steps up to the grad-stakes ranks for the first time. The four-year-old moved to trainer Jimmy Jerkens' barn at the end of last year and is undefeated since, cruising to an easy allowance win at Aqueduct New Year's Day and adding a victory in the Jan. 26 Paumonok H. at that track last time out.

Six-year-old **Astra** has started only 11 times, but she has made the most of her opportunities, winning eight races including the 2000 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. and the GI Beverly Hills H. and GII Santa Barbara H. last season. Making her first appearance since a disappointing last-place finish in the Aug. 18 GI Beverly D. S. over a boggy Arlington turf, the bay is also making her first start for trainer Laura de Seroux, who said the mare was sidelined by a foot problem. "Basically, I had to start from square one with her," DeSeroux said. "Her foot was abscessed, and when I got her, much of the hoof was cut away. It took awhile for it to grow out." But the trainer is not concerned about Astra's readiness for her return. "She trains like a locomotive, so it didn't take much to get her fit," she said. The 121-pound highweight tries eight furlongs for the first time. **Blue Moon**, first or second in five of seven tries at a mile, has not been out since finishing a close-up sixth in the Nov. 4 GII Las Palmas H. over this course. "She bruised a foot in her last race, but she's doing great now," trainer Ron Ellis said. The five-year-old has only started nine times, winning a Listed stakes while racing in France and finishing second, beaten less than a length, in the 2000 GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland in her American debut. The chestnut was off for nearly a year after that effort, returning to take an optional claimer at Santa Anita in her Las Palmas prep. "She's been training really well coming into this and I expect her to run good," Ellis said. "She runs really well fresh."

Dash For Cash cemented his rising status as Australia's pre-eminent three-year-old with a comprehensive win over some royally bred rivals. The Rick Hore-Lacy trained colt settled in third position early, then easily held off Royal Code to give unheralded rider Scott Seamer his 10th Group 1 win since he opened that account last June with Ethereal (NZ) in the G1 Queensland Oaks. Seamer, who also won the G1 C.F. Orr S. at Caulfield Saturday aboard Barkada (Aus), will take up a three-month contract in Hong Kong in April and hopes to partner his Oaks winner in an international campaign that could encompass the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe this year. Dash For Cash will next aim for the G1 Futurity S. at Caulfield Mar. 2 and the G1 Doncaster H. at Randwick Mar. 23. "He is the ideal Doncaster horse," said Hore-Lacy, who has shelved plans to contest the G2 Godolphin Mile in Dubai because of the 22-hour flight. "He deserved the win, he fights like a tiger." Purchased for A\$75,000 at the 2000 Magic Millions sale, Dash For Cash was third in the Magic Millions Trophy in January and won the Australia Day Vase from Barkada a fortnight later before snaring the G3 Debonair S. in his last start Feb. 9.

Looking to follow in the hoofsteps of her half-sister Innuendo (Ire), who won this race last year, Moon Queen went right to the front and never looked back, winning as much the best. The grey did do some looking around in the stretch, first gawking at the grandstand, then, as she drifted inside, ducking away from the rail. "In deep stretch, she jumped from the inner rail and it surprised me," winning jockey Jerry Bailey said. "But she was full of run the whole way." The four-year-old ended her European campaign with a victory in the Oct. 6 G2 Prix de Royallieu at Longchamp. The 9-5 favorite in her U.S. bow, the Nov. 10 GII Long Island H., she tired in the stretch to be fifth behind Queue (French Deputy). Whata Brainstorm Ready for Return:

GSW **Whata Brainstorm** (Honor Grades), away since finishing fourth in the GIII Explosive Bid H. at Fair Grounds last March, is expected to make his return in the Feb. 23 GIII Canadian Turf H. at Gulfstream Park. The five-year-old won the GIII Calder Derby at three and the GII Pan American H. last year; he was also second, beaten a neck, in the 2001 GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. "He suffered an injury to the top of his sesamoid bone in his left hind leg last year," trainer Jimmy Picou explained. "It happened after he ran in [the Explosive Bid]. He underwent surgery and I gave him the summer off." The dark bay suffered another setback last month, coming up with a stone bruise that cost him 10 days of training, but Picou said his charge is back on track now. "He has been training excellently," he remarked. "I've worked him twice on the turf since the stone bruise and he went well both times. I'm planning on running him in the Canadian Turf H., and Jorge Chavez will ride."

MAGIC MILLIONS ADELAIDE SALE BEGINS

The Magic Millions bandwagon rolls on to Adelaide for its third installment of the Select Yearling Sale, set to begin at 1 p.m. today at the Morphettville Complex, with the second session slated for tomorrow at 11 a.m. Magic Millions, whose takeover of the ABCOS sale company two years ago has been widely heralded as a needed boost for a racing and breeding state resplendent with tradition, but light on commerciality, first staged the sale in 2000 and introduced the A\$400,000 Adelaide Magic Millions incentive race--the richest race on the calendar of the sleepy South Australian capital. The sale was not exactly struggling under the ABCOS banner, but the catalogue lacked quality, and the Magic Millions provided a new buoyancy. "We pride ourselves on being more selective on type than any other sale in the country, and while horses here might not have a lot of pedigree, we think there is the best value for money. Better quality quickly translated to success on the track and an increase sale average brought increased vendors and new buyers," he said. Included among the sale's recent graduates; Guineas runner-up Royal Code (Aus) and Blue Diamond Preview winner Bardego (Aus). Collingrove's Lot 259, the only Danehill (USA) in the sale, out of Cult Figure (NZ) (Ahonoora {GB}) from the family of Hong Kong stakes winner Schubert (Aus) (Salieri {USA}), is expected to be among the stars of 418 head catalogued. Local vendor Peter Liston of Lakewood Stud is keen to see freshman Distorted Humor (USA) mirror the success of fellow freshmen End Sweep (USA), who had 27 sell at the Gold Coast at an average A\$86,611 (3 1/2 times his '99 fee) and a top price of A\$205,000 and Gold Fever (USA), whose top price at the Sydney Classic Sale was A\$180,000. Distorted Humor has had just one yearling go through the Australian ring this year, at A\$40,000, but he has 19 catalogued in Adelaide. Distorted Humour did two seasons in Victoria at A\$12,500 and A\$10,000 before changing hands, with his new owners unwilling to continue shuttling him. Liston said, "He was Forty Niner's fastest son and he won a lot of prizemoney compared with End Sweep." Overall, he is optimistic about the sale, "I've got a good feeling about this year's sale and if we can hold our average, we'll be happy."
