

BREW TAPS BIG 'CAP

Milwaukee Brew (Wild Again) hadn't tasted victory since his win in the GII Ohio Derby back in July of 2000, but he gave his connections good reason for a keg party after his four-length score in the GI Santa Anita H. yesterday afternoon. The bay had put in several solid efforts since his Buckeye success--he finished third in the GI Haskell Invitational H. and second in the GIII Durham Cup at three and was third in the GIII Westchester H. and second in the GIII Baltimore Breeders' Cup H. at four. But the 2001 season ended early for the Stronach Stables

colorbearer, who closed the campaign after trailing home last in the July 21 GII Washington Park H. Moved to trainer Bobby Frankel's barn for 2002, the five-year-old kicked off the year with a sixth-place showing in the Feb. 10 Whirlaway S. at Fair Grounds. Stretching out off that 1 1/16-mile test, Milwaukee Brew was unhurried early as **Western Pride** (Way West {Fr}) zipped through splits of :45.06 and 1:09.55. The pace slowed dramatically as Western Pride still led after a mile in 1:35.09, but Milwaukee Brew was on the move, splitting horses at the top of the stretch to drive past the front runner and drawing away as much the best. Frankel, who had to pull pre-race favorite Mizzen Mast because of a quarter crack, said, "I didn't know he was going to run this kind of race. But I thought he had a real good chance. He might be moving right up there [to first string]." Added jockey Kent Desormeaux, "When we turned for home, there seemed to be a pocket and when I split horses, he just barreled through there with a powerful run. Bobby got another one perfect for a big day." **Futural** (Future Storm), the 3-1 favorite in his second start since August, sat just off the leaders early and faded in the drive to be 12th. "He ran out of gas at the three-eighths pole," jockey Chris McCarron said. Second choice **Euchre** (Personal Flag) also tired from his early efforts and ended up 13th. HOME FREE

The odds-on favorite to take yesterday's GII San Rafael S. at Santa Anita, **Came Home** (Gone West) sailed past pacesetter **Werblin** (Unbridled's Song) as they raced out of the turn and cruised to the wire to beat rallying longshot **Easy Grades** (Honor Grades) by three lengths. "I was more than pleased, I was ecstatic after the race," jockey Chris McCarron said. "Obviously, he looked like the best horse on paper, but the way he finished was very promising." The winner of the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship and GI Hopeful S. at two, Came Home tired in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and finished seventh. Freshened after that start, he returned to take the Feb. 2 GII San Vicente S. at 7-10 and was the heavy chalk once again in his first two-turn attempt. The dark bay kept Werblin in his sights from the start, went after him on the turn and proved much the best down the lane to run his record to five-for-six. "Going into this race, I didn't have any qualms about his ability to get a mile, but now he showed me he'll go a mile and an eighth," McCarron said. "The next eighth of a mile, who knows?" The colt could go next in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 6.

Dash For Cash recorded his second successive Group 1 win and his fourth straight victory here. Barkada (Spectrum {Ire}), winner of the G1 Orr S., led in the early stages of the race, but tired in the final 200 meters as Dash For Cash moved between horses and held off the late surge of Chattanooga to continue his streak. Last year's dead-heat winner Desert Sky (Hurricane Sky {Aus}) was third across the line, but was disqualified and placed fourth for interfering with Aquiver. Dash For Cash, a A\$75,000 yearling, now has A\$1,148,425 in earnings to his credit, with five wins, five seconds and two third from 15 appearances. He will be pointed for the G1 Doncaster H. at Randwick Mar. 30, possibly prepping in the G1 George Ryder S. Mar. 16 and the Alister Clark S. Mar. 23.

This race marked the 2002 debut of GI Breeders' Cup Mile hero Val Royal (Royal Academy), but it was Eclipse Award-winning breeder Juddmonte Farms which stole the show with their homebred Decarchy. The bay, who started his career with one win from three starts in England, took 15 months off before making a successful U.S. bow in an optional claimer at Del Mar last August. He reeled off three consecutive victories before stepping up to stakes company for his 2001 finale, ending the year with a second-place finish in the Nov. 24 GII Citation H. The five-year-old returned to his winning ways in the Feb. 9 GIII Tanforan H. at Golden Gate, but was let go at 8-1 here despite his solid record. Never far from the front as Malabar Gold (Unbridled) set a moderate pace, Decarchy swept four-wide into the stretch and finished with determination to best Sarafan and Designed For Luck at the wire. "I had so much horse that I thought I could go by any time I wanted," jockey Kent Desormeaux said. "But we squared up, started the run for the wire and barely made up an inch. Finally, Decarchy switched leads and found another gear." Val Royal was also coming on at the end, but had to settle for a close-up fourth. "He finished awesome, but it took him a couple of strides longer than usual to really get going," said jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. "This should set him up for the next one." With the benefit of a race over the track, Forest Secrets ran past Summer Colony in the stretch to end her rival's winning streak at six. In the process, she added a Grade II score to her wins in the GI Acorn S. and Gill Falls City H. last year. Forest Secrets was 50-1 when she beat Victory Ride by a neck in the Acorn, then finished off the board in the GI Mother Goose S. and GI Test S. and was given a break. She returned to be third in the Oct. 10 Raven Run S. at Keeneland, improved to second in the Nov. 3 Gil Churchill Downs Distaff H. and ended the campaign in the Falls City, posting another upset at 22-1 in that Nov. 22 event. The bay filly made her seasonal bow in the Feb. 8 Gill Sabin H., but ran into a tough Miss Linda (Arg) and had to settle for second. The even-money favorite this time, she shadowed front-running Summer Colony while three-wide, ranged alongside that one on the final bend and drew clear in the stretch. "I was a little worried yesterday and started second-guessing myself because she was so quiet [at her base at Palm Beach Downs]," Donna Ward, the wife and assistant of trainer John Ward, Jr., said. "I was afraid I hadn't trained her hard enough. Now I think she's just gotten to be very professional. I still don't think she is 100 percent, but she's getting close. I was surprised she won so easily." As for what's next, she said, "We'll take her with us to Keeneland and go on from there." Summer Colony, the 6-5 second choice, was coming off a win in the Feb. 9 Gil La Cañada S. at Santa Anita. She set the pace and held on gamely for second.

Divine Task was given a near impossible task in his career bow last year when 16th in the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas in May, but returned in September to break his maiden on the turf at Lingfield. Seventh in the Listed Joel S. at Newmarket Oct. 4, the chestnut was rested up for a desert campaign, which began with an unlucky runner-up finish in the Al Fahidi Fort over 1600 meters Feb. 10. Asked to take up the running turning for home this time, Divine Task was shifted to the outside for the drive and held off Lightning Arrow for the win. Snow Ridge, two-for-two at Santa Anita, started the campaign with a victory in the Jan. 1 GIII El Conejo H. and came back to beat sprint champion Squirtle Squirt by a handy four lengths in the Jan. 27 GII Palos Verdes H. in his latest appearance. **Aldebaran** makes his dirt debut, but should handle the surface switch. The four-year-old was second, beaten only a neck by Mozart (Ire), in the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot last year and ended his European stint with three straight on-the-board finishes. He captured the Oct. 28 Nassau S. going a mile at Belmont Park in his U.S. bow and, last time out, added a third-place finish in the Nov. 25 GI Hollywood Derby. **Ceeband**, on the board in seven of nine tries at the seven-furlong San Carlos distance, closed after a rough start to be third in the Palos Verdes and should appreciate the extra eighth here.
