WHO WILL STAND TALL IN OAKS?

The Oaks season gets underway in earnest this afternoon in California and Louisiana, as sophomore fillies take center stage in the GI Santa Anita Oaks and GII Fair Grounds Oaks. For the fourth consecutive time, West Coast standouts **You** (You and I) and **Habibti** (Tabasco Cat) lock horns, with the former holding a two-to-one advantage. Three for four to begin her career, You went off the odds-on choice for the Breeders' Cup

Juvenile Fillies, only to finish a disappointing fourth, five lengths ahead of Habibti in seventh. The Thoroughbred Corporation colorbearer exacted her revenge with a head success over her arch rival in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 16, but the Bobby Frankel-trained filly turned the tables in their last meeting, winning the GI Las Virgenes S. at Santa Anita Feb. 10. Trainer Bob Baffert thinks his pupil can even the score today. "She was just kind of lethargic," he said of Habibti's Las Virgenes effort. "She kind of peaked on me late last year. She lost some weight, but now she's coming back around." Meanwhile, back in

Winner of the GII Walmac Int'l Alcibiades last season, the bay was sixth in the Juvenile Fillies before closing the year with a runner-up finish to Belterra in the GII Golden Rod S. at Churchill Nov. 24. Trained by Kenny McPeek, she was a smashing winner of her three-year-old bow, equalling the track record of 1:42 in recording an 8 1/2-length success in the GIII Silverbulletday S. over course and distance Feb. 16. A win today could result in a shot against the boys in the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 13.

Gulfstream Park BC Sprint Chp. H. cont.

Undefeated in four starts over the local main track, **Hook And Ladder** is strictly the one to beat this afternoon. The dark bay, purchased for \$800,000 at the 505 Dispersal at Barretts in 2000, capped a three-race winning streak last winter with a 1/2-length win over Trippi in this event Mar. 9. Unable to find the winner's circle in six subsequent efforts in 2001, the five-year-old was shelved after finishing last in the Breeders' Cup Sprint Oct. 27, but returned from a 2 1/2-month hiatus to annex the GIII Mr. Prospector H. Jan. 13. Entrusted to trainer Bill Mott for the winter, **Burning Roma** makes his four-year-old debut today. The winner of five stakes events against fellow sophos last year, the bay was beaten just 1/2 length into third behind Point Given in the GI Haskell Invitational in August and has been off since a second in the GII Pegasus H. Oct. 19.

Castellano to Ride D'Coach in Florida Derby:

Jockey Javier Castellano has been named to ride **D'Coach** (Dehere) in the Mar. 16 GI Florida Derby. The colt worked a half mile in :49 3/5 at Gulfstream Thursday. "He's doing well," trainer Shug McGaughey said. "Castellano will be coming down from New York to ride him--he rode him in all his races up there."

Puck Sharp at Calder:

Puck (Mr. Greeley) worked six furlongs in 1:12 4/5 over a sloppy surface at Calder yesterday morning and now looks even more likely to make his next start in the \$1 million Florida Derby. "I thought it was an outstanding work," trainer Bill White said. "He appears to have come out of the work just fine and we'll continue to look at him to see how he does over the next few days, but it looks like there is a good chance we'll enter him in the Florida Derby." Cornelio Velasquez, aboard for yesterday's breeze, will have the mount in the race if the colt is entered.

Irish Prize Will Not Make the Trip:

Originally scheduled to depart Southern California this morning for the G1 Dubai Duty Free, Gainsborough Farm's **Irish Prize** (Irish River {Fr}) will stay at home and be pointed instead for the \$700,000 GII Explosive Bid H. at the Fair Grounds Mar. 24. The decision was made following the six-year-old's uncharacteristic seventh-place finish in the GII F.E. Kilroe Mile at Santa Anita last Saturday.

KRIS S. TEMPORARILY OUT OF BREEDING

SHED Kris S. (Roberto--Sharp Queen, by *Princequillo), who stands at WinStar Farm in Versailles, Kentucky, has been taken out of service temporarily because of complications arising from cervical pain which developed two weeks ago. The 25-year-old stallion is not exhibiting the loss of coordination which is sometimes associated with neck problems, but his condition has caused a predisposition for bouts of laminitis. WinStar reported yesterday that the dark bay is responding positively to treatment, but said in a press release that "it is impossible to approximate when he may resume service." Kris S., the sire of champions Hollywood Wildcat and Soaring Softly, had three yearlings sell for seven figures on the opening day of the 2001 Keeneland September Sale. His 17 crops to race have produced more than 60 stakes winners and the earners of more than \$47 million. He has covered 10 mares this season, six of which are in foal.

A P VALENTINE HAVING FERTILITY PROBLEMS

A P Valentine (A.P. Indy--Twenty Eight Carat, by Alydar), who entered stud this year at Ashford Stud in Kentucky, is "experiencing a low rate of pregnancies to covers" according to a brief statement released yesterday by the farm. A promising two-year-old, A P Valentine was impressive in victory in the GI Champagne S., an effort which carried him to Breeders' Cup Juvenile favoritism. The bay never got untracked that afternoon, finishing last of 14 and was sidelined thereafter with bucked shins. His sophomore campaign proved more frustrating, with just one win from nine starts, but solid runner-up finishes to Point Given in the Preakness and Belmont S. Coolmore did not elaborate on the immediate future for the four-year-old, saying only that "specialists are monitoring the situation and the matter is under constant review."
