YOU STILL THE ONE

For the second time in their budding rivalry, **You** (You and I) bested **Habibti** (Tabasco Cat) as the dark bay got first run turning for home and was able fend off her chestnut foe by a half-length in the GI Santa Anita Oaks yesterday afternoon. The GI Frizette S. heroine by 6 1/4 lengths last October, You finished fourth as the favorite in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, with Habibti back in seventh. The Thoroughbred Corp. colorbearer denied You by a head in the GI Hollywood Starlet Dec. 16, but the Bobby Frankel trainee bounced back to take the GI Las Virgenes S. going a mile at Santa Anita Feb. 10. Settled into striking position just three lengths from the front, 4-5 You came four wide into the stretch, fought her way past **Ile de France** (Storm Cat) and had enough left to prevail over the late-charging Habibti. "He [jockey Jerry Bailey] didn't want to hit the lead too soon, 'cause if you notice, when she hits the lead she pulls up," remarked winning trainer Bobby Frankel. While Frankel was pleased with Bailey's ride, trainer

BIG FAVORITE IN THE BIG EASY

Repent (Louis Quatorze) has come a long way since finishing second at 42-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 27, adding a pair of graded-stakes triumphs to his resume which make him the 1-2 favorite on the morning line in the \$750,000 GII Louisiana Derby this afternoon at Fair Grounds. The dark bay colt made his three-year-old bow over course and distance Feb. 17 in the GIII Risen Star S., rallying eight wide into the

stretch to win by 2 1/4 lengths despite not switching leads. Trainer Ken McPeek briefly considered sending the dark bay to Dubai, but decided on this race and announced that Jerry Bailey would ride the colt instead of Tony D'Amico, who had been aboard in all of Repent's previous starts. "Personally, it was a tough decision for me to take Tony off," McPeek said. "Professionally, it was easy. When you can get a guy like Bailey this early who has been down this road, you've got to do it." **Bob's Image** (Halo's Image) fought off the other speed in the Risen Star before succumbing to Repent. The grey colt will break from the outside this time and will likely be accompanied early by Gulfstream allowance winners **Charioteer** (Silver Deputy) and **White Flame** (Langfuhr). Shipping in from Bay Meadows is **Publication** (Petionville), winner of the GII Arlington-Washington Futurity and fourth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile at 103-1. He has not started since finishing fifth to Siphonic in the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 15.

Sunline carried topweight of 60kg to capture her second Coolmore Classic, pushing her earnings beyond the A\$9 million mark and her Group 1 tally to 11. Sunline jumped brilliantly from her inside post, but jockey Greg Childs held off taking the lead in a bid to avoid the worst going on the inside of the track. Poppett (Aus) (Mukaddamah) took up the role and two furlongs from home, Childs let Sunline surge forward, but with several others looming late down the outside, victory was far from certain. Sunline duly scored by half a neck from 200-1 shot Gentle Genius with Nanny Maroon the same margin away third. "She has proven again what a champion she is. With a big weight we got to the front at the 400--she was there to be beaten, but they could not get past her," said Childs. "She was struggling, she was under pressure, but she never gave up." Co-trainer Trevor McKee said, "We might try something different next season. We have planned her racing until autumn, and what happens after that is up to Sunline herself, but she has come up really well this time in. There is always pressure because she is always expected to win." Sunline is likely come right back in next week's A\$400,000 Darley S. before contesting either the A\$2.5 million Doncaster H. at Randwick Mar. 30, or the A\$400,000 All Aged S. over the same trip Apr. 6.

Under an inspired ride by Justin Sheehan, Universal Prince denied Tie The Knot (Aus) (Nassipour) his 14th Group 1 win and a place in history alongside Kingston Town (Aus). Take Charge Lady lived up to her name, gaining command early to post her second straight graded-stakes triumph. The bay filly captured the first three starts of her career, capped by the GII Walmac Int'l Alcibiades S. at Keeneland Oct. 5, then suffered a pair of defeats, finishing sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Oct. 27 and second in Churchill's GII Golden Rod S. Nov. 24. Take Charge Lady had held her own with stablemate Repent in the mornings and opened 2002 with a flourish in the GIII Silverbulletday S., romping home by 8 1/2 lengths while equalling the Fair Grounds track record Feb. 16. Breaking sharply from the six hole, Take Charge Lady angled in to the rail and showed the way down the backstretch under a tight hold by Tony D'Amico. He asked her for run turning for home and she responded, widening her advantage to five lengths despite swerving near the tire tracks in deep stretch. "This was a good spot for her even as the big favorite," said winning trainer Ken McPeck. "This looked like a carbon copy of the Silverbulletday. I thought she handled the track okay." McPeck will nominate Take Charge Lady to the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 13, but Keeneland's GI Ashland S. at Apr. 6 seems a more likely target. *Click [here](#) for the Equibase chart.*

Gulfstream Park BC Sprint Championship H. cont.

Third in the GII Illinois Derby and runner-up in the GIII Derby Trial last spring, Dream Run returned from a four-month absence to be third in the GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint before recording his first stakes success in the Perryville S. at Keeneland Oct. 28. Sidelined off a seventh in the M G Schaefer S. at Hoosier Nov. 17, the bay was coming into this off back-to-back sharp wins in local optional claiming company, including a 2 1/4-length score at this trip Jan. 24. Reserved off the early pace, Dream Run rallied four wide around the final turn, charged down the middle of the stretch and was going away late. Hook and Ladder (Dixieland Band), the 11-10 favorite, went up to press the pace after being bumped at the start, but stopped abruptly at the three-eighths pole and was eased in the stretch. "Seven furlongs is a good distance for him and it fits him well, obviously," said winning trainer Paul McGee. "He's a quality horse and I think he's better at seven furlongs than he is going around two turns. My plans are to keep him going one turn and preferably at seven furlongs." One such possibility is the GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup at Keeneland Apr. 14. Of the beaten favorite, jockey John Velazquez said, "He just didn't run his race today. I don't know why. The winner prior to the Cal Cup of the restricted Pinjara S. over the Santa Anita turf, the chestnut registered back-to-back clunkers when a distant sixth to Siphonic in the GI Hollywood Futurity Dec. 15 and fourth to Danthebluegrassman in the GIII Golden Gate Derby Jan. 12, but rebounded with a runner-up finish to Cappuchino (Capote) in this track's Golden State Mile Feb. 10. Allowed to settle off the pace set by Turf Paradise Derby winner Captain Squire (Flying Chevron) and the eventual runner-up, Yougottawanna was eased to the outside rounding the far turn, was three wide into the lane and caught Danthebluegrassman at midstretch en route to a driving victory. "He went good over what was a difficult racetrack," trainer John Ward said. "[Exercise boy] Allen [Rennie] said he went evenly and when he came back he didn't blow out a match." The winner of the GIII Holy Bull S. and the GI Fountain of Youth S. in his two starts this season, the bay will be looking to make it two straight wins in the million-dollar event for his connections, who took last year's race with eventual Kentucky Derby winner Monarchos. Despite a pedigree that might suggest otherwise, Ward is convinced his charge can handle the added distance. "I'm not worried about the distance," he said. "I think he'll get a mile and an eighth and I think he'll get a mile and a quarter."

Also on the worktab was **Stephentown** (Wild Again), who worked three-quarters of a mile in 1:13 2/5 for trainer Tony Reinstedler. "I thought it was an excellent work," the conditioner commented. "He's in good shape and I'm not going to second guess myself. It's that time of the year when we go through the sorting-out process and now is the time for him to prove himself in the Florida Derby." One of the more impressive allowance winners early in the meet, the bay colt looks to atone for a disappointing sixth-place finish in the GI Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 16.

He didn't really show any symptoms, but the blood test confirmed something was wrong." Second to Repent in the GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile last fall, French Assault had most recently run fourth to that rival in the GIII Risen Star S. Feb. 17. Depending on how much training time the colt misses, Desormeaux may point him towards the GIII Lone Star Derby May 11. "It's disappointing, but that's the game," Desormeaux remarked. "We'll be back; it's not the end of the road."

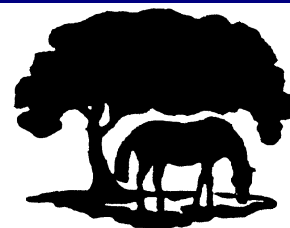
