

### STREET CRY IS ALL WORLD

**Street Cry (Ire)** (Machiavellian) fired along the inside approaching the stretch and kicked clear to take Saturday's G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba Racecourse by 4 1/4 resounding lengths, while heavily favored **Sakhee** (Bahri) checked in a well-beaten third. Homebred Street Cry was the star of the first set of Godolphin horses based in the U.S. under the tutelage of Eoin Harty in 2000 and stamped himself a top juvenile with runner-up finishes to Flame Thrower in the GII Del Mar Futurity and GII Norfolk S. Third to future champions Macho Uno and Point Given in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, he gave Team Godolphin the idea that he would be their main hope for the 2001 Classics. ### Derby Dreams Derailed

Committed to doing things "their way," Godolphin returned Street Cry to Dubai for the winter of 2001 and the dark bay made a successful sophomore debut with a two-length win over Noverre in the G3 UAE 2000 Guineas. Led over for the G3 UAE Derby on the World Cup undercard a year ago, the son of the 1985 Irish Oaks winner led late, but was caught in the shadow of the post by stablemate Express Tour. Unfortunately for the 'Boys In Blue,' the latter would be their lone representative in the Kentucky Derby, running eighth, as Street Cry was injured in the weeks leading up to the race and was sidelined for seven months. Returned to training last fall, the colt made his final start of the year in the GIII Discovery H. at Aqueduct Oct. 31, finishing third after racing wide on both turns. The Irish-bred looked every bit ready for action in his seasonal bow in Round 3 of the G2 Maktoum Challenge Series Feb. 28, storming home beneath jockey Frankie Dettori to defeat **State Shinto** (Pleasant Colony) by 8 1/2 lengths, but with the stable jockey opting for Sakhee in the World Cup, Street Cry would be ridden for the first time by Jerry Bailey, the winner of three of the first six runnings of the big race.

### Rail Run Gets The Job Done

**Western Pride** (Way West {Fr}) set the early pace from **To the Victory** (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) as Sakhee stalked from the outside and Street Cry raced comfortably in midpack. As Western Pride vacated the rail nearing the stretch, Bailey pointed his mount towards the opening and the race was his in a matter of half a furlong. He easily held off Saudi-based **Sei Mi (Arg)** (Potrillazo {Arg}) for the win, with Sakhee well back in third. "He's a wonderful horse," said the winning jockey, who adds this to his victories aboard Cigar, Singspiel (Ire) and Captain Steve. "He broke fairly well and he was in about the spot I wanted and the spot that Sheikh Mohammed wanted. Sakhee was going to follow me. It didn't seem the right thing for me to do to go wide, so we stayed along the inside and I waited for my time. You don't want to ask your horse too much on the turn because you still have three furlongs to run. I probably could have moved a little earlier or later, but he was much the best." **A Bittersweet Result for the Home Team**

Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford was full of praise for the winner and detailed tentative plans for the balance of the year. "Street Cry is an exceptional horse, he showed it as a two-year-old in the Breeders' Cup," Crisford said. "The Breeders' Cup Classic is his ultimate goal and his race program will be worked out around it." Favored Sakhee, runner-up in the Breeders' Cup Classic and easy winner of a Feb. 24 conditions event over the World Cup distance, ran up into second position at midstretch, but was overtaken late and settled for third. Crisford is not ready to give up on the five-year-old as a dirt horse. "It's always disappointing to see a horse like Sakhee have his flag lowered," he said, adding, "His future will be on both the dirt and the turf and we will discuss his race plans with Sheikh Hamdan. Just because he did not win the World Cup does not mean he is not a great horse, because he is."

**Good Work If You Can Get It**

He was not booked on a mount for the \$6 million World Cup, but jockey Gary Stevens had a memorable evening at Nad al Sheba. The winner of the 1998 World Cup aboard Silver Charm, Stevens kicked off the program with a last-to-first victory aboard **Grey Memo** (Memo {Chi}) in the G2 Godolphin Mile for trainer Warren Stute before guiding four-year-old **Total Impact (Chi)** (Stuka) to a runner-up finish behind **Essence of Dubai** (Pulpit) in the G2 UAE Derby. The 39-year-old added his most important and valuable score of the day astride **Caller One** (Phone Trick) in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen. Stevens' mounts on the afternoon earned \$2.2 million.

**A Second World Cup for a World-Class Sire**

Street Cry is the second World Cup winner sired by Darley stallion **Machiavellian** (Mr. Prospector--Coup de Folie, by Halo), following Almutawakel in 1999. The 15-year-old stallion was off to a slow start in the breeding shed this year, but has recovered completely and is breeding a full book. John Ferguson, bloodstock adviser to Sheikh Mohammed, was thrilled with yesterday's result. "It was a class performance by a homebred colt," he said. "That's Machiavellian's second winner of the world's richest race and we are very proud of both father and son. Machiavellian is covering a book of 110 mares, including 30 from the U.S., and after an uncharacteristically slow start in the shed, he's now back firing on all cylinders." The bay is standing the 2002 season for £80,000. (*World Cup Handle Up, p10*)

The G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen figured to be dominated by the American sprint quintet and it was only Japanese representative Broad Appeal who denied a top-five sweep for the U.S. Caller One set a track record in this event a year ago en route to a 4 1/2-length victory over Men's Exclusive and returned on relatively short rest to add the Gill Los Angeles H. at Hollywood May 27. Second to Kona Gold in the Gil Bing Crosby Breeders' Cup H. at Del Mar July 27, the gelding did not race again until his third-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Sprint, but was sixth in the Gl DeFrancis Dash and third in the Gil V.O. Underwood S. to end the year. Xtra Heat sprinted to a narrow early lead, but Caller One tracked her every move as Echo Eddie chased from the inside. The filly began to tire nearing the final furlong, leaving the two California-based runners to decide the issue. Echo Eddie poked a head in front in deep stretch, but beneath Gary Stevens, Caller One fought back gamely on the outside to prevail narrowly. "That was great. Nayef has been unbeatable since taking the G3 Rose of Lancaster S. at Haydock last August. Taken off the Classics trail after tiring to be eighth in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket last May, the bay returned to be third in the July 31 G3 Gordon S. at glorious Goodwood. He followed his Haydock score with a six-length romp in the Sept. 12 G3 Select S. and a 1 1/4-length victory in the Sept. 30 G3 Cumberland Lodge S., then made it four in a row with a game 3/4-length triumph over Tobougg (Ire) in his 2001 finale, the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 20. Making his 2002 debut here, the four-year-old was sent off the 2-1 favorite by American bettors and lived up to his odds. Tucked in along the rail as Demophilos (Dr Devious {Ire}) set an uncontested pace, Nayef made his move as they straightened for home, took the lead under his own courage and widened the gap when jockey Richard Hills asked for more to win handily. "He always showed he was going to develop into something and he has shown it today," Hills said. "He has just developed as an athlete and will be a great horse for all the bigger races this year." Terre a Terre put together three consecutive stakes wins at 1 1/4 miles in France last year, following a pair of Listed victories at Deauville and Longchamp with a 1 1/2-length success in the Oct. 7 G1 Prix de l'Opera. The gray shipped to Sha Tin for her final race of the campaign and, sent off at 34-1 in the G1 Hong Kong Cup, finished just a neck behind Agnes Digital and Tobougg (Ire) despite the fact that jockey Christophe Soumillon lost an iron 200 yards from the wire. Trying a mile and an eighth for the first time here, the French-bred mare settled in third as Summoner (Inchiner {GB}) cut out the early fractions, snuck inside the pacesetter a quarter mile from home and held off the late charge of Noverre for the victory. "When the run came, she kicked so well," Soumillon said. "She is a great filly, which we knew before Hong Kong. Now everyone knows it." The runner-up ran into some traffic on the final bend, but closed well once clear for second. "I had to check Noverre twice because of another horse and that cost me," his jockey, Frankie Dettori, said. "I would have won otherwise." Completing the international triple was Australian-bred Hoeberg, who raced in South Africa before moving to Singapore at the end of last year. "It was easy for everyone to overlook this filly, but I had faith she could run a great race and she has," trainer David Payne said. G1 Breeders' Cup Mile hero Val Royal (Royal Academy) loomed a threat at the top of the lane, but flattened out in the final furlong. [Click here](#) for a race replay.

Godolphin had been looking to see which of their runners would step forward as a contender for the Kentucky Derby and may have found the one in Essence of Dubai, who rallied from last to snatch victory from Total Impact in the final strides. The dark bay debuted victoriously at Hollywood in July, but followed that up with a third (of three runners) to Officer in the GIII Best Pal S. Aug. 15. He bounced back to defeat stablemate Ibn al Haitham in the GII Norfolk S. Sept. 29, but tailed off in his final start at two when last of 12 in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Oct. 27. After outbattling stablemate Firebreak (Charnwood Forest {Ire}), in his seasonal bow in the UAE 2000 Guineas Feb. 24, Essence of Dubai was regarded as a 5-1 shot by UK bettors in stretching out to 10 furlongs. Jockey Frankie Dettori settled the three-year-old at the back of the pack and shifted him to the outside approaching the long Nad al Sheba straight. California-based Total Impact held a clear lead with a furlong to run, but began to drift out as Essence of Dubai came running on the outside. "He sure got to the line strong," the winning jockey commented. "That makes us feel pretty good about the Kentucky Derby." Essence of Dubai has a two-year-old half-brother by Swain (Ire) who was purchased for \$750,000 at Keeneland September.

Grey Memo got the day off on a positive note for Team USA, rallying from last in the field of 16 to take the G2 Godolphin Mile and doubling his career earnings in the process. A specialist at 7 1/2 furlongs, if there is such a thing, the grey won the 2000 On Trust H. at Hollywood Park at the quirky distance and scored his lone victory in 14 starts last season in the Ack Ack S. at Hollywood at that trip last June. Fourth in the GIII Native Diver H. going two turns Dec. 9, the California-bred prepped for this with a second consecutive third-place finish in the GI San Carlos H. at Santa Anita Jan. 30. Given a patient ride by jockey Gary Stevens, Grey Memo was asked for his best in the final 400 meters and quickened nicely to win comfortably from Skoozi, winner of Round 1 of the G3 Maktoum Challenge Series. "That's the way he runs," winning trainer Warren Stute told *Racing Post*. "He's won two or three stakes races in California that way. He looks hopelessly tailed off and then he comes. Luckily, Gary Stevens is a great jockey and he didn't push him early. If you push him early, he doesn't finish like that."
