

EXPLOSIVE FINISH FOR SARAFAN

It seemed like deja vu all over again for the late-running **Sarafan** (Lear Fan) in yesterday's GII Explosive Bid H. In the five-year-old's

last start, he came up a neck short of Juddmonte homebred Decarchy in the Mar. 2 GII Frank E Kilroe Mile H. Yesterday, he was chasing down those same silks, only this time they were carried by the talented **Beat Hollow (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) and this time, Sarafan would not be denied. In the early

going, Sarafan settled in eighth as favored Beat Hollow sat just off the leaders. Beat Hollow gained the lead a sixteenth from home, but Sarafan closed powerfully and just got up for a neck victory. "He was training really well back home," jockey Corey Nakatani said of the winner. "That was why we came down here. I just put him in the spot to where I think I could win it. I had Beat Hollow right in front of me and I was real patient. When I brought him out around the eighth pole, he kicked on and was pretty impressive." Alex Solis, aboard Beat Hollow, said of the beaten favorite, "He ran a good race. He just got a little tired in the end. This race clearly shows the ability this colt has. The last sixteenth he just got a little tired on me." The race was Beat Hollow's first since January, when he won a Santa Anita optional claimer off a 19-month layoff. ORCHID WINNER NO SHRINKING VIOLET

Julie Jalouse (Kris S.), making her first North American start, rallied stoutly down the stretch to just nip favored **Sweetest Thing** (Candy Stripes) for a narrow victory in yesterday's GII Orchid H. at Gulfstream Park. The filly, a listed stakes winner in Ireland last fall for trainer John Oxx, had been off since a 10th-place finish in the Garnet S. at Naas last October. Making her first start for trainer Christophe Clement, Julie Jalouse settled off the pace before moving to the outside at the top of the lane. She closed relentlessly and just got a neck in front of Sweetest Thing for the win. "When I finally got my filly to the outside, she ran much better. I hit her left handed when she was rallying into the stretch then switched to my right hand and she responded," said winning jockey Jose Santos. TWINING TO VINERY Twining (Forty Niner--Courtly Dee, by Never Bend), who has sired the winners of more than \$10.5 million from five crops in the U.S., has been acquired by Vinery and will shuttle to Vinery Australia for the 2002 Southern Hemisphere breeding season. "He is a proven horse, he has been extremely consistent and he has a winners-to-runners ratio of 73.3 percent, which speaks for itself," Vinery Australia General Manager Peter Orton said. "Forty Niner sire sons such as End Sweep and Gold Fever consistently finish among the leading U.S. sires, and the Forty Niner line is emerging among the most dynamic Mr. Prospector lines. Notably, the first crops of both End Sweep and Gold Fever have been extremely well received by the Australian buying bench because they are producing horses particularly well-suited to our conditions, and I have no doubt Twining will follow suit." The 11-year-old stallion started his stud career at Wimbledon Farm in 1995, but was sent to East Stud in Japan in 1999. He returned to Wimbledon, in partnership with Coolmore Stud, on a one-year lease agreement this season, standing for a fee of \$10,000. "Twining will complete his 2002 season at Wimbledon before coming to Australia, then he will return to Vinery Kentucky," Orton said.

WESTERN PRIDE DEAL NIXED The sale of multiple graded stakes winner **Western Pride** (Way West {Fr}) has been nullified, according to *Thoroughbred Times*. It was announced earlier in the week that the four-year-old had been purchased by Saudi Prince Faisal bin Khaled bin Abdul Aziz for an undisclosed sum. Owners Carolyn Chapman and Theresa McArthur, were given, "a sizable sum," according to the *Times*, for letting Western Pride run in the prince's colors in Saturday's G1 Dubai World Cup, but a contingency in the sale agreement required he be returned to the American owners should he not win at Nad al Sheba. After setting the pace, Western Pride faded to ninth in the World Cup. The arrangement left the United States without a representative in the \$6-million race for the first time in its seven-year history.

Sunday Break Preps for Wood Memorial:

Sunday Break (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), winner of a Santa Anita allowance test Feb. 22, will make his next start in an Aqueduct allowance Wednesday, and a big race will put the three-year-old on the Kentucky Derby trail. "He needs another race before he moves up to group competition," trainer Neil Drysdale said. "If he runs well, we'll run him back in the Wood [GI Wood Memorial, Apr. 13]." The colt, who worked five furlongs in 1:03.57 at Aqueduct Saturday, will be up against five rivals in Wednesday's sixth race going nine furlongs. Jockey Gary Stevens, fresh from his big day in Dubai, will ride.

GI Donn H. winner **Mongoose** (Broad Brush), expected to make his next start in Saturday's GI Gulfstream Park H., worked five furlongs at Payson Park on Sunday in 1:01 4/5. "He's definitely going in the Gulfstream Park H.," confirmed trainer Jim Bond. "This morning's work was a good one for him. He galloped out three-quarters in 1:15 and hopefully he'll give a good account of himself on Saturday."

Bravo Returns in Style:

Jockey Joe Bravo, sidelined since July, returned to the saddle Saturday at Gulfstream and made it to the winner's circle with his first mount. The 30-year-old Bravo won the 10th race aboard trainer Eddie Broome's Scagnelli. Bravo suffered a broken leg in a spill at Monmouth Park last summer. "It's great to be back," he said after the winning ride. "It was just like riding a bicycle. As soon as I got into the race, it was like I never was away. It was great just being back in the jockeys' room and to be back on a horse after being out so long. Winning is just the icing on the cake."

Jockeys Take on Media:

The Gulfstream Park jockeys will take on local members of the media in a charity softball game at O. B. Johnson Park in Hallandale at 6 p.m. Tuesday. No admission will be charged, but donations will be taken for the Yvonne Azeff Fund. Azeff, assistant trainer for John Ward, Jr., was in a coma for nearly a month after a training mishap at Gulfstream in January. She is currently receiving physical therapy and is making good progress, according to her doctors.

Bella Bellucci began her career with an impressive 5 3/4-length win at Belmont last September and earned a half-length victory in the Oct. 8 GII Astarita S. in just her second outing. She suffered her first defeat when third behind Tempera in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and had been off since that Oct. 27 effort. Heavily favored in the short field of five, Bella Bellucci was away slowly and settled into last place. She rallied gamely down the stretch and got up in the final strides for a half-length tally. "We haven't put any speed into her at all because her goal is the [GI May 3] Kentucky Oaks, which is nine furlongs," commented winning trainer Neil Drysdale. "This is just a tightener and we'll run her again in the [Apr. 14 GIII] Comely in New York, so that will be her second prep."

Aldebaran reeled off five straight second-place finishes before ending his European campaign with a third-place effort behind Group 1 winner Beckett (Ire) in the Oct. 4 Joel S. The bay made his U.S. debut in the Oct. 28 Nassau S. and came home a 3 1/4-length winner, then capped 2001 with a third in the Nov. 25 GI Hollywood Derby. Rested after that performance, the Flaxman homebred was off at 8-5 in his comeback and did not disappoint, rallying from seventh to win going away.
