

### KRIS S. RETIRED

**Kris S.** (Roberto--Sharp Queen, by \*Princequillo), who was forced out of the breeding shed earlier this season by a neck injury, has been retired from stud, WinStar Farm announced yesterday. "Unfortunately, Kris S. has not responded to treatment for the neck injury he incurred in late February, and it is clear that his stud career must come to an end," WinStar President Doug Cauthen said. "We are trying to keep him comfortable, but going back into service is out of the question. He has been a real warrior, both as a stallion and now as a patient." The 25-year-old-stallion has sired more than 60 stakes winners to date, including Breeders' Cup winners Hollywood Wildcat, the champion three-year-old filly of 1993; Soaring Softly, the Eclipse Award-winning turf mare of 2000; Brocco and Prized. The stallion added yet another graded winner to the list Sunday, as his daughter Julie Jalouse came on in the final strides to win the GI Orchard H. at Gulfstream Park. The dark bay was represented by nine graded-stakes winners last season and had three yearlings of 2001 sell for at least \$1 million. Overall, his progeny from 17 crops to race have earned more than \$48 million. Kris S. has also sired You and I, winner of the GI Met Mile and himself the sire of MGISW You. Prior to his injury, Kris S. covered 10 mares, and six of the 10 have been pronounced in foal.

### CARRYING ON THE FAMILY TRADITION

**Shonan Kampf (Jpn)** (Sakura Bakushin O {Jpn}), the son of Japan's champion sprinter in 1994, looks set to follow in his father's footsteps. The four-year-old colt cruised to a front-running 3 1/2-length win in Sunday's Takamatsunomiya Kinen, the first Group 1 grass race on the Japanese calendar. It was the third victory in a row for the bay, who covered 1200 meters in 1:07.80 at Kyoto Feb. 17, then got the distance in 1:07.30 at Nakayama Mar. 2. Off at 6-1 after a step up to elite company, Shonan Kampf once again sped right to the front, ripped off a half in :44.40 and was never threatened. "What tremendous speed this horse has," jockey Shinji Fujita said. "He is very calm going into the gate, but as soon as it opens, he is already a half-length in front. At 1200 meters or shorter, I think he is unbeatable." Defending champ **Trot Star (Jpn)** (Damister) finished fifth, while **Stinger (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence), Japan's champion two-year-old filly of '98, was a solid third in what was her final appearance. The five-time stakes winner, now six, retires with seven wins from 21 starts and earnings of ¥402,506,000.

After Street Cry's dominant display in the Dubai World Cup, the Godolphin team must still be wondering how their colt would have fared against Monarchos, Invisible Ink, Congaree and company at Churchill Downs last May had he not been injured after his narrow defeat in the UAE Derby.

Fortunately for Godolphin, this year's UAE Derby--run over an extra eighth of a mile--has confirmed that they have another live contender for Kentucky Derby honors in the shape of Essence of Dubai. This high-priced son of Pulpit showed the requisite amount of stamina and determination in cutting back the lead established by the Chilean import Total Impact.

Just how big a threat Essence of Dubai represents to the American defenders is hard to know, though. Whereas Street Cry's juvenile form in the U.S. was good enough to earn him 122 pounds on the Experimental Free Handicap, just four pounds less than Macho Uno, Essence of Dubai ranked 11 pounds below Johannesburg and eight pounds below Repent following his disappointing effort in the Juvenile.

The clear inference is that Essence of Dubai needs to improve on his juvenile form to win the Kentucky Derby. While he can hardly be faulted after winning both the UAE 2000 Guineas and Derby in Dubai this winter, these wins were gained by margins of only a nose and half a length.

Perhaps he's a colt who does no more than necessary, but it's a fact that he administered pretty much the same beating to Ibn Al Haitham in the UAE Derby as he'd done when the pair finished first and second in the GII Norfolk S. last September.

"He has got stacks of ability," said Simon Crisford, Godolphin's racing manager, before adding, "He won't race before the Kentucky Derby--he's just had a hard race. He will go there fresh and well on the day."

It therefore looks as though everyone but Godolphin will have to remain somewhat in the dark about him right up to the main event--a situation with which British racegoers have become all too familiar in the approach to the 2000 Guineas.

What we do know about Essence of Dubai is that he is guaranteed to stay, unlike some of his Derby rivals, and that he can quicken at the end of a race. We also know that this very well-connected colt is a fine advertisement for his young sire, Pulpit.

In fact, he has been a fine advertisement for Pulpit ever since he caught John Ferguson's eye at the Keeneland September Sale in 2000. Ferguson had to go to \$2,300,000 to secure him, even though the colt was by an unproven stallion who had started his career in 1998 at a fee of \$35,000. Of course, Ferguson was by no means the only buyer willing to gamble that Pulpit would reach greater heights as a stallion than he had been able to as a racehorse. With other colts selling for such impressive prices as \$1,450,000, \$900,000 and \$700,000, Pulpit achieved a first-crop average of \$423,538 and a median of \$290,000.

Circumstances such as these sometimes place an unrealistic burden of expectation on a young stallion's shoulders, making him susceptible to criticism if he doesn't immediately make an impact. Fortunately, Pulpit has done a good enough job to avoid this backlash.

His second-crop yearlings also achieved an average and median many times his stud fee, prompting an increase in his advertised fee to \$60,000, from 2001's \$40,000. Pulpit ended 2001 with a tally of 10 winners from 23 runners (from a crop of 49 named foals), with Nokoma, Bema, Clergy and the talented Japanese colt Grandson also among them.

These figures have to be considered encouraging in view of the fact that Pulpit did not make it to the races until January of his three-year-old year. Frank Brothers then had to push the son of A.P. Indy to give him the type of Derby preparation considered essential by most Americans. The Kentucky Derby was Pulpit's sixth race in 113 days and he arrived at Churchill as a winner of four of them, including the GII Fountain of Youth S. and the GII Blue Grass S. The way he faded in the last quarter to finish fourth, nearly seven lengths behind Silver Charm, raised suspicions that he hadn't shown his true form in the Derby. These fears were confirmed a few days later when a displaced knee chip was discovered, and the Derby proved to be his last race, even though he was back in work by the Saratoga meeting.

With pedigree and performance on his side, plus the invaluable support of his owner-breeder, Claiborne Farm, Pulpit received a strong book of mares in his first season. Arguably the best of them was Essence of Dubai's dam Epitome, the champion juvenile filly of 1987. Although Epitome was at her best as a juvenile, when she won the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, she later found only one too good for her in the GIII Falls City H. over 1 1/8 miles. Her dam, Honest and True, a half-sister to the outstanding European miler Green Forest, had been one of the leading three-year-old fillies of 1980 when she won the Fair Grounds Oaks, so Essence of Dubai has every right to be a high-class performer.

He is the best of the three stakes winners out of Epitome, one of the others being Mr. Prospector's fast son Faltaat, who notched 13 wins in the UAE. No wonder the Maktoum family was keen to acquire Epitome's 2001 yearling colt by Swain, which went to Sheikh Hamdan for \$750,000.

**WOODMAN TO SHUTTLE TO BRAZIL** Woodman (Mr. Prospector--Playmate, by Buckpasser), who is standing the current breeding season at Ashford Stud in Kentucky for a fee of \$40,000, will shuttle to TNT Stud in Brazil for the Southern Hemisphere season, the *Thoroughbred Times* reports. The 19-year-old stallion has sired seven champions, including American Classic winners Hansel and Timber Country; Japanese champion sprinter and miler Hishi Akebono, who earned more than \$3.2 million; and European Classic winners Hector Protector and Bosra Sham. His progeny have earned nearly \$70,000,000.

A winner in a mile maiden event at Hanshin last December, Cheers Stark was runner-up in the G3 Shinzan Kinen in his 2002 debut before posting a solid win in the G3 Kyodo News Service Hai last month. Making short work of his competition here to win his final prep for the G1 Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas) Apr. 14, the hot favorite settled in midpack early, still had ground to make up at the top of the straight, but came flying in the final 100 meters to win going away.

### MRLS COSTS BREEDERS' CUP STAKES

**PROGRAM** The effects of last year's Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome continue to be felt in the Thoroughbred industry, with the Breeders' Cup reporting a deficit in the vicinity of \$1 million for its 2002 national stakes program. The dramatic drop in the number of foals because of MRLS, which has caused a sharp decrease in the number of foals nominated to the Breeders' Cup, is behind the shortfall. In an effort to make up the difference, Breeders' Cup has come up with a proposal to tracks which host supplemented races, asking for 1 percent of the simulcast revenue on the stakes in the program. "All we are asking for is a fair share of what is being generated in handle on those races," Pamela Blatz-Murff, Breeders' Cup's senior vice president for operations, told the *Daily Racing Form*. "We feel very strongly that the revenue that is being generated on these races is in large part because they are Breeders' Cup races." The Breeders' Cup is cutting the purse supplements to tracks which do not accept its proposal. The New York Racing Association has agreed to pay the percentage, but the Breeders' Cup take on the NYRA races involved has been capped at \$20,000 each. Breeders' Cup is in negotiations with a number of tracks, but one flaw in the proposal was revealed at Golden Gate Fields. The GIII Golden Gate Breeders' Cup H., held Mar. 16, drew only five runners, and only two of the five were Breeders' Cup eligible. The duo brought up the rear, and the purse supplements that Breeders' Cup paid out were smaller than the percentage of simulcast handle they would have collected from Golden Gate.

### Fasig-Tipton Texas Two-Year-Old Sale Set for Today:

The Fasig-Tipton Texas Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale will be held today at Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas. The public auction, with a catalog of 378 entries, includes prospects by top sires *Belong to Me*, *Carson City*, *Cherokee Run*, *French Deputy*, *Hennessy*, *Polish Numbers*, *Red Ransom*, *Saint Ballado*, *Silver Deputy*, *Wild Again* and *Woodman*. Freshman sires *Arch* and *Favorite Trick* will be represented, while the offspring of sophomore sires *Smoke Glacken*, *Tale of the Cat* and *Valid Expectations* will likely draw attention. Last year's sale, held over two days, saw 455 lots sold for \$10,371,700, an average of \$22,794. Today's bidding gets underway at 10 a.m.

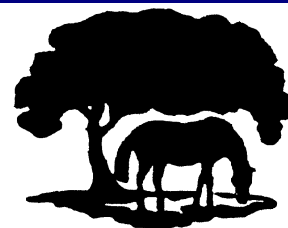

## GODOLPHIN WATCH

Godolphin's quest for a Kentucky Derby winner has been well documented, but the stable is also aiming a potent trio for the Kentucky Oaks: *Tempera*, *Imperial Gesture* (first and second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' last term) and *Infinite Spirit*. During the Al Quoz open morning last Wednesday, Simon Crisford, Godolphin's racing manager, outlined hopes for the three fillies and two of their male stablemates:

### INFINITE SPIRIT (USA)

*f, 3, Maria's Mon (USA)--Eternal Reve (USA), by Diesis (GB)*

O-Godolphin; B-Darley Stud Management Inc.

Having won a Redcar maiden in May, she was fourth in the hotly contested Listed Oh So Sharp S. at Newmarket and second to the very smart *Bandari (Ire)* in the Listed Silver Tankard S. at Pontefract in October. She returned to upset stable companion *Seba (GB)* in the Moonshell Mile Prep at Nad al Sheba Jan. 31 and then *Tempera (USA)* in the UAE 1000 Guineas back at the track Mar. 14. She could run in the UAE Oaks at Nad Al Sheba Apr. 13:

*"Infinite Spirit has already had a couple of runs and she is a very light-framed little filly. She is one of the three who is going to be considered for the Kentucky Oaks. Let us wait and see if she is good enough. She is a filly with a lot of quality and she may well be good enough. She doesn't want too much racing at this time of her career. She wasn't a real Classic contender last year but since we have put her on sand she has really stepped up."*

### TEMPERA (USA)

O-Godolphin; B-Darley Stud Management Inc.

Winner of last year's G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies from stable companion *Imperial Gesture (USA)* when under the care of Eoin Harty, she returned to suffer a beating by five lengths at the hands of *Infinite Spirit* in the UAE 1000 Guineas:

*"Tempera didn't run her race when beaten by Infinite Spirit last time out--there is no question of that--we didn't see the real Tempera the other night. She wasn't focused and she was a bit edgy beforehand. We took the view that she had an off-day. I remember seeing her run once like that in California last year. We will give her another chance in April and then reassess her."*

Naheef is by Marju but he is related to Lailani so he might stay. He has got the right attitude and he has won around Epsom. Naheef is a very laid-back colt and never turns a hair--that's how we like them."*

### MESHAHEER (USA)

Saeed bin Suroor explained that *Meshaheer* is the main current Godolphin hope for the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4:

*"Meshaheer is the horse so far for the Guineas. It will depend on how Dubai Destination is doing--if he stays sound and healthy, he will be ready by the end of April--today was the third piece of work for him. We have the trials on grass here at the beginning of April and we will know more about where we run our horses then."*
