

TOP CAT

Having split their last two decisions, **Cat Cay** (Pleasant Colony), 119 pounds, and **Raging Fever** (Storm Cat), 120 pounds, face off in a rubber match in the GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. going seven furlongs at Aqueduct this afternoon. The former turned in one of the top performances by a female sprinter in winning the GIII Thoroughbred Club of America S. at Keeneland last Oct. 21 and closed the season with a head success in the GII Top Flight H. Nov. 23. The bay could not catch

Raging Fever in the six-furlong GIII First Lady H. at Gulfstream in their respective seasonal bows Jan. 11, but turned the tables on her younger rival in their most recent meeting, winning the seven-furlong GIII Shirley Jones H. by a neck

Feb. 15. Still, Cat Cay's trainer, Shug McGaughey does not credit the extra distance with the Shirley Jones victory. "I can't say that seven furlongs in a better distance for her than six," he said. "It all depends on what kind of pace is in there." The presence of four-year-old Raging Fever ensures quick fractions. The dark bay zipped a pressured half in :44 flat and six furlongs in 1:08 4/5 en route to her runner-up finish last time. "The pace was suicidal and it was a huge effort for her even to be around at the finish," trainer Mark Hennig said. "She fought on gamely." Still, Cat Cay is three-for-six at seven furlongs, while Raging Fever, on the board in all three tries, has yet to win at the distance.

NEXT MOVE IS WITH ABILITY'S

Edward P. Evans' homebred **With Ability** (A.P. Indy) broke like a shot from the inside post and made every pole a winning one en route to an easy victory in yesterday's GIII Next Move H. at Aqueduct. Winner of the Fashion S. at two, the bay managed just one allowance score last spring before going to the shelf following a seventh in the GI Acorn S. June 8. Returned to action with a second-place allowance effort late last fall, the four-year-old was a well-beaten sixth behind Xtra Heat in the Interborough H. New Year's Day. She came back to win her two-turn debut by 9 1/2 lengths Feb. 8 and most recently finished a game second to **Zonk** (Farma Way) in a local allowance heat Mar. 10. Well handled through moderate fractions of :48 and 1:11 4/5, With Ability drew clear when roused in upper stretch and maintained a daylight advantage to the line to win easily. "My filly is so quick from the gate. I wasn't going to try to take her back and rate," rider Javier Castellano commented. "As it turned out, we were alone on the lead. I really appreciate Mark Hennig giving me the opportunity to ride this filly back. I guaranteed him this filly would win if he kept me on."

Sir Bear defends his Gulfstream Park H. title at the ripe old age of nine. The veteran gelding, who captured last year's edition of this Grade I test by a half-length, was held winless in six subsequent starts, but got back on top in his most recent outing, beating **Red Bullet** and **Hal's Hope** with a game effort in the Jan. 12 GIII Skip Away S. The dark bay had been off for two months prior to winning this last year. **Red Bullet** has been tested beyond nine furlongs only once before, posting a 3 3/4-length score over Fusaichi Pegasus in the 2000 GI Preakness S. The chestnut has suffered through a pair of rough trips this year and just missed in both outings, finishing second by a half-length in the Skip Away and second by a neck to **Mongoose** in the Feb. 9 GI Donn H. Trainer Joe Orseno, confident of turning things around this time, said, "The only thing I'm worried about is the small field. I wish it was a full field--then my horse could run the kind of race he likes to run. With a short field, you have to worry about the early pace and whether it is fast enough. [Jockey Jerry Bailey] will have to see how the race sets up and go from there." **Hal's Hope** can keep **Mongoose** honest on the front end. The five-year-old, front-running winner of the 2000 GI Florida Derby, changed tactics to try coming from off the pace for four starts, but after going winless over that span, reverted to his old form last time out and went gate to wire to win the Mar. 10 GIII Creme Fraiche H. by a decisive 2 1/4 lengths.

Six-year-old mare **Kalookan Queen** is the starting highweight in the field at 116 pounds despite facing males for the first time in her distinguished career. The dark bay mare scored the first Grade I victory of her career in the GI Santa Monica H. Jan. 30, but will be trying to rebound off a runner-up finish to Cal-bred speedball Above Perfection in the GIII Las Flores H. Feb. 23. Lightly raced **Romanzo** (113 pounds), fourth by a neck to champion Kona Gold in this event a year ago, returned from a 6 1/2-month layoff to register a one-length victory sprinting down the hill Feb. 13 and overcame trouble in his last to dead heat in a similar test Mar. 8. The gelding makes his return to the main track this afternoon.

STRIKE POSTPONES FRENCH GROUP RACE

The strike by France Galop employees which led to the cancellation of Longchamp's meeting on Thursday, also forced the cancellation of today's meeting at Saint-Cloud. The G3 Prix Edmond Blanc, which was due to be staged at Saint-Cloud today, will now take place at that track's Wednesday meeting. Sunday's racing will take place at Longchamp, as will Monday's jumps meeting at Auteuil, after France Galop and its employees reached an agreement to meet on Wednesday for new talks. Tomorrow's card at Longchamp, featuring the G2 Prix d'Harcourt, will now stage 10 races including the Listed Prix de Courcelles and Listed Prix Lord Seymour, which were originally scheduled for last Thursday. The Prix Lord Seymour will be run as the 10th race on the card, without betting. Yesterday's meeting at Maisons-Laffitte was allowed to take place as the card did not feature a Quinte+ race, the national bet, which is France Galop's main source of income.

Request For Parole to Keeneland:

Jeri and Sam Knighton's **Request For Parole** (Judge T C), third by a neck to Perfect Drift and Azillion (Ire) in last Saturday's GII Lane's End Spiral S., will make his next start in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland, trainer Stephen Margolis confirmed yesterday. "The Spiral was a tough race and he ran hard, but he has bounced back well," the conditioner said. Connections contemplated simply training up to the Kentucky Derby, but changed course earlier this week. "The owners and I talked it over and we decided that if we are going to make the Derby, we wanted to see how he stacks up against top competition," Margolis explained. Request For Parole will need a new pilot for the Blue Grass as Pat Day, who rode the colt at Turfway, has been enlisted to ride **Buddha** (Unbridled's Song) for trainer James Bond in the GI Wood Memorial the same afternoon.

Mayakovsky Likely to Stay Home:

The GIII Gotham S. winner **Mayakovsky** (Matty G) is almost certain to remain in Southern California for the Apr. 6 GI Santa Anita Derby, rather than ship back to New York for the Apr. 13 GI Wood Memorial. "I will tell you that he is 99.9 percent [certain to run in the Santa Anita Derby]," trainer Patrick Biancone said yesterday. Biancone added a rider for the colt will be named Saturday. New York-based Edgar Prado has been aboard in all three of the Florida-bred's career starts.

Thunder Blitz Returns:

Shortly after trainer Joe Orseno saddles favored Red Bullet in the GI Gulfstream Park H., he will return to the paddock to tighten the girth on last year's GIII Flamingo S. winner **Thunder Blitz** (Holy Bull). A late-running fourth in the GI Kentucky Derby and sixth in the GI Belmont, the Stronach Stables homebred was last seen under silks when third in the West Virginia Derby Aug. 11. "He suffered a quarter crack after the Belmont," the conditioner explained. "We put a patch on it and he ran with the patch in the West Virginia Derby. But he lost the patch and came back bleeding around the foot, so we decided to give him some time off." The four-year-old fired a bullet six furlongs in 1:12 1/5 Mar. 22 and gets Jerry Bailey in the saddle for the mile-and-70-yard event carded as the 10th race.
