

HORSE FOR THE COURSE

Now five for eight lifetime at Gulfstream Park, **Hal's Hope** (Jolie's Halo) successfully turned back the clock and **Mongoose** (Broad Brush) yesterday, putting up a gutsy performance on the front end to win the GI Gulfstream Park H. as 1-2 **Red Bullet** (Unbridled) ran off the board. The dark bay gave owner/breeder/trainer Harold Rose the thrill of a lifetime in winning the GI Florida Derby and the GIII Holy Bull S. as a three-year-old, but had only posted three victories in the two years since. Seventh to Mongoose in the GI Donn H. Feb. 9, Hal's Hope returned to wire the field in the GIII Creme Fraiche H. Mar. 10 over this surface. Breaking alertly, he set out in front under a rating hold,

clicking off fractions of :49 and 1:13 3/5 with Mongoose at his tail. The latter drew even on the far turn, but Hal's Hope dug in deep to inch away while becoming a millionaire. "Edgar's horse [Mongoose, with jockey Prado] evened up with us in the stretch, but Hal got a second wind and took off again," said winning rider Roger Velez. "He's such a nice horse and he loves Gulfstream Park." Harold Rose maintained his faith in his homebred. "I wouldn't have run him if I didn't think he could win," said Rose. "Anytime he goes ahead of everybody and slows it down, he's going to have plenty left at the end." Asked about the drought between Grade I victories, Rose answered, "It's a big lift. I knew he was a good horse, but there were times he just didn't show it." It was Preakness winner Red Bullet's turn to have a bad day. The chestnut raced in third down the backstretch, but packed it in through the lane to finish last of five. "He felt horrible," said rider Jerry Bailey. "He was hitting the ground really bad. QUEEN FOR A DAY

Trying the boys for the first time in her career, six-year-old **Kalookan Queen** (Lost Code) pinned her ears back and denied all challenges to win the GII Potrero Grande H. Saturday afternoon at Santa Anita. The dark bay earned a Grade I victory in the Santa Monica H. going seven furlongs Jan. 26, but had some trouble at the start in the GII Las Flores H. Jan. 26 and was never able to get by Above Perfection in a 3/4-length loss. Part of the favored 3-5 entry, Kalookan Queen worked her way up to track **Alyzig** (Danzig) through a :21 3/5 quarter and grabbed the lead after a half in :44 3/5. **Elaborate** (Gilded Time) came to head the mare in the stretch, but he could not get by and she held on resolutely over the late-closing **Ceeband** (Chimes Band). "They gave her a real test today, and she answered back," commented winning rider Alex Solis. "She was really game today. When she got to the 5/16-pole, she started waiting a bit, and I said, 'Mama, don't do that,' but the last part I really got down on



her, and she responded nicely." The first distaffer to win the Potrero Grande, Kalookan Queen followed in the footsteps of full brother Sir Hutch, who won

this event in

1994. She also continued trainer Bruce Headley's remarkable run, giving him his third straight Potrero Grande victory and four out of the last five renewals. He saddled Kona Gold to victory in 2000 and 2001 as well as Son of a Pistol in 1998. "I expected her to win today and she did her work," said Headley. San Miguel brewing company chairman Eduardo Cojuangco when he realized his dream of leading Don Eduardo back to the scales after the colt won the G1 AJC Derby yesterday. Ready for a top effort following a good second to Carnegie Express last time in the G1 Rosehill Guineas, Don Eduardo settled in fifth early while Valedict (Danehill) shot to a two-length lead, with Carnegie Express about four lengths behind him. At the 700-meter marker, jockey Jim Cassidy made a brave and ultimately costly decision to come off the fence and take off aboard favored Carnegie Express, scooting away to a 2 1/2-length lead in the lightning move. Don Eduardo challenged in the straight and made up five lengths to hit the lead a stride before the post. "It was a fantastic staying performance, I thought he had no hope when Jimmy put five lengths on him, but in the end Don Eduardo outstayed Carnegie Express," commented winning trainer Lee Freedman. A NZ\$3.6 million yearling, Don Eduardo is a three-parts brother to champion Octagonal (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) and Mouawad (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}).

Sunline took her earnings past the A\$10-million mark and recorded Group 1 win number 12, when she became the first mare to win two Doncasters since the AJC's flagship race began at Randwick in 1866. Establishing a modern-day weight carrying record along the way, Sunline's supreme effort also signaled that retirement is not on the rising seven-year-old's immediate agenda. Sent out the favorite as black clouds gave way to a burst of autumn sunshine on a blustery day, Sunline went straight to the lead ahead of Ha Ha (Danehill) while Shogun Lodge settled about 11 lengths back in 10th. Shogun Lodge flew down the outside and confusion reigned as jockey Glen Boss punched the air in triumph, but Shogun Lodge had to settle for his 11th Group 1 second after a photo showed Sunline had prevailed. "I've never seen a bloke so excited to run second," quipped jockey Darren Beadman of Boss' antics in the saddle. Winning jockey Greg Childs said, "I thought we'd just held on, right on the line, but when Glen jumped up, I wasn't so sure. It was a spectacular effort in handicap conditions, and she was out there to be beaten. She is a champion." Beaten three-quarters of a length by Northerly (Aus) in the G1 Cox Plate last spring, Sunline resumed from a 15-week break to win the G1 Waikato Sprint at Te Rapa before scoring the G1 Coolmore a month later at Rosehill Mar. 9. Sunline may make her next start in the G1 A\$400,000 All-Ages S. at Randwick Saturday.

Trainer Lee Curtis said, "He is a serious racehorse, and he never knows when to give up." Mistegic sat just off early leader Donna Natalia (Anabaa) and held off a determined challenge from Century Kid, with the Gai Waterhouse-trained Excellerator third at his first start since spring. Curtis is yet to decide whether Mistegic will back up in the TJ Smith S. in a fortnight.

Raging Fever capped off a memorable weekend for her connections with a convincing front-running display in the GII Distaff Breeders' Cup, following the success of With Ability in Friday's GIII Next Move H. Five-for-five to begin her career, with wins in the GI Matron S. and GI Frizette S., the dark bay faltered to be sixth as the favorite in the 2000 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Runner-up in the Dame Mystereuse S. last Mar. 16, she was sidelined off a third to Xtra Heat in the GII Stonerside Beaumont S. in April, but has excelled since the return, with victories in this track's Garland of Roses H. Dec. 8, a two-length success over Cat Cay (Pleasant Colony) in the GIII First Lady H. at Gulfstream Jan. 18 and a neck loss to that foe in the GII Shirley Jones H. Feb. 15. Allowed to dictate a moderate early pace from La Galerie, Raging Fever kicked it into gear rounding the far turn and was hand ridden to an easy win. Cat Cay, the 19-10 second choice, lingered towards the back of the pack and rallied mildly to be fourth.

"They weren't going that fast in front," commented winning trainer Mark Hennig. "She settled great today and really kicked nicely in the stretch." The GIII Bed o' Roses Breeders' Cup H. over a flat mile at Aqueduct Apr. 20 could be next for the winner. "A lot of people don't think she can stay a route of ground, but I never believed that," Hennig added.

Winner of the GIII Longacres Mile H. at Emerald Downs last August, Irisheyesareflying ended the year on a high note by taking the rich California Cup Classic by 2 1/2 lengths Nov. 3. The bay has had his work cut out for him in his three previous tries this campaign, but acquitted himself well, with a close fifth in the GII San Pasqual H. Jan. 5, third in the GII San Antonio H. Feb. 3 and most recently sixth in the Mar. 2 GI Santa Anita H. Heavily favored on the class drop and cutting back to a more comfortable distance, Irisheyesareflying was forced to race four wide around the clubhouse turn before getting up alongside pacesetter Bring the Heat (In Excess {Ire}) approaching the far turn. SANTA ANITA DERBY-GI, \$1,000,000, 3yo, 1 1/8m

The field for the Apr. 6 Santa Anita Derby is beginning to shape up, with trainer Patrick Biancone confirming that Gotham winner **Mayakovsky** (Matty G) will indeed take on **Came Home** (Gone West). "We're going to run," said Biancone. "He'll work a half mile here on Tuesday, weather permitting, and we hope to decide on a rider today." 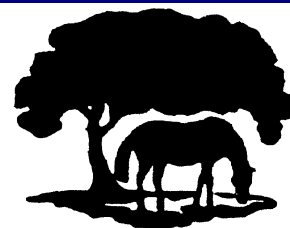

PILLAGING TAKES INGLIS CLASSIC

Trainer Lee Freedman's decision to skip the G1 Golden Slipper with **Pillaging (Aus)** (Canny Lad {Aus}) reaped a A\$621,400 reward when the gelding, a A\$45,000 2001 Inglis Classic sale purchase, scored in the A\$1m Inglis Heroic Championship at Randwick yesterday, after surviving a protest from the connections of **Half Hennessy (Aus)** (Hennessy {USA}). Pillaging, boxed in midpack near the rails 250 meters from home, was steered wide for the final drive by jockey Damien Oliver, bumping the late charging Half Hennessy in the process. The latter colt's jockey was quick to fire a protest, "I stopped riding and straightened, but still copped a bump--my horse is a little bit timid and I could feel him suck back in underneath me and if definitely cost us the race." Oliver told stewards the shift 20 meters from the post was minimal and came from both horses. Claiming that the two horses were never on equal terms, Oliver argued, "In fact my horse waited for him [Half Hennessy], then kicked again. It happened too close to the line to have any effect on the result." Even the most experienced protest judges were reluctant to predict the result, but stewards ruled that they could not be satisfied that Half Hennessy would have beaten Pillaging had not the bump occurred. Oliver said, "He was doing the spolits when we jumped, but we probably would have settled right back anyway and he traveled lovely. In the straight, he stargazed and waited for them. He's a pretty foolproof horse." Pillaging, the 9-10 favorite, now has earnings of A\$1,068,900 with four wins and two placings from six starts, including a three-length win last time in the G1 VRC Sires' Produce S. at Flemington Mar. 16.
