Repent Injured, Out of Derby:

Two days after suffering his first loss of the season, **Repent** (Louis Quatorze) has been taken off the Kentucky Derby trail due to a chip in his left front ankle. He will undergo surgery Apr. 15. "We want to bring the horse back at 100 percent," said trainer Ken McPeek.

"It's a very minor injury. But in the long-term best interest of the horse, it's better to get it out. If all goes well, he'll be back in training in 60 to 90 days." Second to Johannesburg in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, Repent closed out his two-year-old campaign with a win in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. and established himself as a top Derby contender with 2002 victories in the GII Louisiana Derby and GIII Risen Star S. "He has never taken a lame step--he is not in any way uncomfortable," said McPeek. "It's part of the game and we're big boys. We'll rest him up and turn him into a top handicap

horse." McPeek still has a live candidate in **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan), the GI Florida Derby hero who runs next in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 13. Another McPeek trainee, **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere) was a late nominee to the Triple Crown. She rolled to her third consecutive victory in Saturday's GI Ashland S., but seems more likely to head to the GI Kentucky Oaks May 3. "She'll be favored in the Oaks, and we've still got Harlan's Holiday," McPeek explained. "Based on how the race shapes up, she would have to have a heck of a chance to win the Derby for us to consider going that route. But I'll have to have a lengthy conversation with Jerry and Faye Bach [owners of both Repent and Take Charge Lady] and see what their take is on it."

Wood Hopefuls Work:

Saarland (Unbridled), second in the GIII Gotham S., worked four furlongs at Belmont yesterday in :48. "That was what I was looking for," commented trainer Shug McGaughey. "He'll just gallop into the Wood." Also working at Belmont Monday, **Nokoma** (Pulpit) went the same distance in :48.21. The Todd Pletcher-trained colt is coming off a disappointing finish in the GI Florida Derby. "He's a better horse than what he showed [in the Florida Derby]," Pletcher said yesterday. "He's shipped in here well and I was happy with what I saw this morning. He's proven in the past he can run with these horses. He ran his biggest race on that track last November. He deserves another shot." **Sunday Break (Jpn)** (Forty Niner) went six furlongs in company at Aqueduct yesterday in 1:15 3/5. Clockers caught the colt in fractions of :13 1/5, :26, :38 3/5, :51 and 1:03 1/5 and he galloped out in 1:29 2/5. "The work went perfectly according to instructions," trainer Neil Drysdale said afterwards. "This was exactly what I wanted today. Now he's all set for the [GI] Wood Memorial."

Arrow Carry defied a large field and double-digit odds to capture her first Group 1 victory in Sunday's Japanese 1000 Guineas. Second behind 2001 two-year-old filly champion Tamuro Cherry (Secreto) in the G1 Hanshin Juvenile Fillies Dec. 2, Arrow Carry ended the season with a fourth-place finish in the G3 Fairy S. Beaten only a nose in her 2002 debut, the Elfin S. in February, the sophomore couldn't maintain her forward progress and finished eighth last month in the Anemone S. Looking for her first JRA victory, Arrow Carry was a close-up third early and finished up strongly in the stretch for the win. According to trainer Kenji Yamauchi, no plans have been made as to the filly's next race. Favored Shinin' Ruby managed to finish third, but Tamuro Cherry was a disappointing 12th.

He won the G2 Aramburu at La Plata in July and came back 13 days later to win the G1 2000 Guineas over the San Isidro turf. It was another four months before he resurfaced to win the G1 Nacional (Argentine Derby) and he had been off five months since that victory. Dr. Ciro track pacesetter Bat Ruizero (Arg) (Bat Atico {Arg}) and swept passed that rival in the stretch for a handy victory.

Considering that **Gone West** contested the Belmont S. and has sired a Belmont winner, it is perhaps surprising that this high-class stallion hasn't had more representatives in the Kentucky Derby. His first 10 crops produced only two Derby runners--**West by West**, eleventh in 1992, and **Commendable**, the future Belmont winner who was 17th two years ago--but his latest batch of three-year-olds promises to make up for missed opportunities. Two of his sons won their trials in encouraging style on Saturday, with **Came Home** proving he stays at least 1 1/8 miles with his victory in the Santa Anita Derby, while the Irish-trained **Castle Gandolfo** confirmed that he is very much at home on a dirt track when he collected the International Trial S. in England.

So why has **Gone West** had so few Derby contenders? One explanation is that a sizeable number of his better sons--such as **Castle Gandolfo**--have left the U.S. for Europe ever since **Zafonic** became Europe's champion juvenile in 1992.

The other explanation is that **Gone West** isn't a particularly strong influence for stamina. His presence in the Belmont field owed more to **Woody Stephens'** quest for a sixth successive victory in this classic than to any real hopes that this son of **Mr Prospector** would stay the mile and a half. **Gone West** was described in *Principal American Racehorses of 1987* as "a natural miler," with his runaway win in the **Dwyer S.** over 1 1/8 miles being dismissed as "largely a fluke, a result of powerful rail-favoring bias at Belmont Park that day." It's worth adding that **Gone West** had five full-brothers or -sisters. Four of them won, but none of them scored beyond 1 1/16 miles and the best of them was **Lion Cavern**, winner of the **GII True North H.** over six furlongs.

Although **Gone West** has showed himself capable of getting some high-class stock which stay better than he did, the truth is that his graded winners beyond 1 1/8 miles have been in fairly short supply. Among them are **Commendable** and **Lassigny**, both G1 winners over 1 1/2 miles; **Aboline**, a G2 winner over 1 9/16 miles; **Gontcharova** and **Tamayaz**, two European G3 winners at around 1 1/4 miles; and **Zafolia**, a G3 scorer over 1 1/4 miles in Japan. Not surprisingly, most of these have at least one major mile-and-a-half winner close up on the dam's side of their pedigree, so do **Came Home** and **Castle Gandolfo** meet this criterion?

There won't be any stamina doubts about **Castle Gandolfo** should he make the trip to Churchill Downs. Not only did he finish second of 10 on heavy ground in a G1 race over 1 1/4 miles as a juvenile, but he also has a sister to the Irish Derby winner **El Gran Senor** as his dam. He's a three-parts brother to **Devonwood**, a Woodman colt who was twice graded-placed over 1 1/2 miles.

Unfortunately, there is no such encouragement in the bottom half of Came Home's pedigree. His dam Nice Assay (who was rated as high as 117 on the Blood-Horse Free Handicap for three-year-old fillies) did all her stakes winning from six furlongs to 1 1/16 miles. It's hard to ignore the fact that her mating with the Belmont S. winner A.P. Indy resulted in that fast filly A.P. Assay, who equalled Hollywood Park's seven-furlong track record in the GII A Gleam H. as a three-year-old before winning the six-furlong Desert Stormer H. at four.

The source of this speed was no doubt Came Home's broodmare sire Clever Trick. Only one of Clever Trick's eight stakes victories was gained over a distance as long as a mile and he later passed on his speed to his son Phone Trick. It's a similar story with both of Nice Assay's grandsires, Icecapade and Full Out. Although Icecapade did manage to win a GII over 1 1/16 miles, Full Out did all his stakes winning at up to seven furlongs.

I will therefore be surprised if the Kentucky Derby provides Came Home with his seventh win from eight starts, but stranger things have happened, such as Commendable's win in the Belmont. I should point out, too, that another Clever Trick mare was responsible for the runner-up in Saturday's AJC Australian Oaks over 1 1/2 miles.

NEWMARKET TO CHANGE GRANDSTAND

Newmarket racecourse yesterday unveiled some major changes to the new Millennium Grandstand from next year. Officials outlined a £3.5 million program of improvements to the facilities, including increased access for annual and day members to previously restricted parts of the grandstand, a new area for owners and trainers, installation of escalators and the disbanding of the Millennium Club. Lisa Hancock, managing director of Newmarket Racecourses, said: "It was quickly apparent when I joined Newmarket Racecourses 18-months ago that the Millennium Grandstand would have to be modified if the Rowley Mile was to prosper. It's a tremendous building, but at the same time it suffers on racedays from poor crowd circulation in key areas and we are not getting the best use out of its facilities. Last season saw a 12-percent drop in the number of Annual Members--an unprecedented decline for Newmarket--and a loss of many previously loyal Day Members. Action was most definitely needed. It was a very difficult decision to close the Millennium Club, but under the circumstances it became clear that it was the only sensible option." Newmarket also announced substantial increases in prizemoney, with an extra £350,000 currently planned for 2003. The July Meeting will see increased total prizemoney of 22 percent, while all Group 2 races for three-year-olds and up guaranteed to be worth a minimum of £80,000. The Darley sponsored G1 July Cup and G1 Dewhurst S. are also set to increase by 10 percent as Darley announced the extension of their sponsorship deal for a further three years, ending with the 2004 season. "We've made prize money increases right across the board, but I'm most excited about the July Meeting," said Clerk of the Course Michael Prosser. "The overall boost to its prize money, allied to improvements to its race program, should help make a big difference to this key summer festival meeting. I will be aiming to make further increases to it over the coming years."

Trainer Luca Cumani yesterday reported that **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) will head for the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 5 without a prep run. Gerald Leigh's unbeaten filly cantered on Newmarket Heath alongside stablemates Kuster (GB) and All In All (GB) in front of a press crowd invited to a Bedford Lodge open morning. Cumani said of the G1 Fillies' Mile winner: "At the moment the plan is to go straight to Newmarket. It's do-able, it's easier and she just doesn't need the run. If you run two-and-a-half weeks before the Guineas, you run the risk of picking up a problem. In the Guineas you are competing with fillies that haven't run this season or have run only once. It is a level playing field for everybody. She hasn't grown very much, but she is a very straight forward and uncomplicated lady. Last year, she did most of her training on fast ground and if it stayed dry that wouldn't worry me. She shows all the speed. We could try further later in the season, but the plan at the moment would be Guineas, Irish Guineas and Coronation S."
