TABOR: JOHANNESBURG STILL DERBY BOUND

Despite a stunning upset in Sunday's G3 Gladness S. at The Curragh in Ireland, **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) could still be on course for the May 4 Kentucky Derby, owner Michael Tabor said yesterday. "I have not even spoken to [trainer] Aidan [O'Brien] yet," Tabor said. "I have spoken to my partner, John Magnier, and we're not in any hurry to make a decision. But no one has decided that he is not going to go to the Kentucky Derby. Therefore, as for now, he's still going. It's better than 50-50 that he goes. Unless something comes out of the woodwork that we're not happy with, that's our position." When asked to comment about Johannesburg's performance in the Gladness, which resulted in his first career defeat, Tabor replied, "I haven't managed to see the race, so it would be difficult for me to comment." Tabor also confirmed that GIII Gotham S. winner **Mayakovsky** (Matty G), who was a tiring fourth in the Santa Anita Derby, will not start in the Kentucky Derby. "He's more of a seven-furlong or mile horse," he said. "At the end of the day, I don't think he'll get a mile and a quarter."

TEMPERA AND GESTURE GO HEAD-TO-HEAD

Godolphin will pitch GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' winner **Tempera** (A.P. Indy) and runner-up **Imperial Gesture** (Langfuhr) into battle again in Saturday's UAE Oaks at Nad al Sheba. While Tempera disappointed in her sophomore return when five lengths second to Invincible Spirit in the UAE 1000 Guineas at the track Mar. 14, Imperial Gesture beat **Seba** (GB) (Alzao) by nine lengths in the Moonshell Mile Feb. 24. Seba re-opposes in the nine-furlong event on dirt and will be partnered by John Carroll, while Frankie Dettori rides Imperial Gesture and American jockey David Flores renews his association with Tempera.

Buddha Breezes:

Looking to make his stakes debut in the GI Wood Memorial on Saturday, **Buddha** (Unbridled's Song) breezed five-eighths in 1:01 1/5 at Payson Park Tuesday morning, the best time of the day. The grey colt galloped a mile and a half over the training track at Belmont yesterday. "He's got to win a stakes to show he belongs with the top three-year-olds," said trainer H. James Bond. As for Saturday's strategy, Bond will leave that up to new pilot Pat Day, but said, "It seems like he's a little bit better running at horses. That's what we do with him in the mornings." been ridden to to impressive victories at Gulfstream by Edgar Prado, who will ride Harlan's Holiday in the Blue Grass on Saturday. The last two Kentucky Derby winners,

Fusaichi Pegasus in 2000 and Monarchos in 2001, each prepped in the Wood Memorial, which has been upgraded to Grade I this year. In addition to Buddha, the 78th renewal of the Wood Memorial is likely to draw **Blue Burner** (French Deputy), **Heir d'Twine** (Twining), **Iwin** (Victory Speech), **Laissezaller** (End Sweep), **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}), **Nokoma** (Pulpit), **Saarland** (Unbridled) and **Sunday Break** (Jpn) (Forty Niner).

Straight to the Blue Grass?

Trainer Nick Zito may have a runner in the GI Toyota Blue Grass. **Straight Gin** (Go for Gin), fifth in the GII Lane's End Spiral S. Mar. 23, worked five panels in 1:01 2/5 at Keeneland Monday morning. The bay broke his maiden Groundhog Day and returned Mar. 2 to take a Gulfstream allowance over Marasca, subsequent winner of the Aventura S.

Having secured minor placings on her first two starts, Ombre Legere entered winter quarters still a maiden. She put matters to rights on her sophomore debut with a win in a conditions event over course and distance Mar. 14 and secured her first stakes success here with a determined late rally to deny her rivals. Jockey Stephane Pasquier settled the eventual winner in fifth as first Sweet Oona (Fr) (Kendor {Fr}) then Historian (Ire) (Pennekamp) led, but began a forward move at the quarter-mile marker. Ridden to challenge approaching the final furlong, she led with 150 yards to go and ran on strongly in the closing stages to hold the late rallies of the close-up Dzinigane and Kapria. Although she started at odds over 11-1, trainer Elie Lellouche was not unduly surprised with the win. "She had won well on this course on her return, had trained well since and I had no doubt she would stay the trip," he said. "The question mark was to know if she would handle firmer ground. There is not much choice now and she should return in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary [at Longchamp May 19]."

Victory Ride jumped into national prominence with a game runner-up finish in the GI Acorn last June in just her third start and solidified her position as a runner to watch with a victory over Xtra Heat in the July 28 GI Test. But the filly had been sidelined since that effort by a condylar fracture. She bobbled at the start and bumped City Fair (Carson City) before settling off the dueling Collect Call (Meadowlake) and Nasty Storm (Gulch). The bay advanced four wide nearing the stretch and forged to the front for a one-length victory. "She broke a step slow, but I didn't rush her because horses are winning from off the pace today," said winning rider Edgar Prado. "When I asked her in the lane, she responded. She's a lot more mature than she was last summer. She ran super."

Texas Glitter Returns Saturday:

Multiple graded stakes winner **Texas Glitter** (Glitterman) returns to the races in Saturday's Yankee Affair S. at Gulfstream. The speedy six-year-old won the GIII Spectacular Bid in 1999 and the GIII Laurel Dash in 2000, but has been off since running second in the Dayjur H. over the Hollywood turf last December. "He's training exceptionally well," said Cindy Hutter, assistant to trainer Todd Pletcher. "He's got just as much speed now as he's ever had. After Saturday's race he'll be shipped to Kentucky."
