

ORIENTATE TAKES COMMONWEALTH

Orientate (Mt. Livermore), winner of last year's Indian Derby, splashed to a front-running 1 1/4-length victory in yesterday's GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland. The four-year-old ended his 2001 campaign with a victory over the Santa Anita turf in the Sir Beaufort S. and returned to the main track for a runner-up finish in the Jan. 12 GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S. before tiring to sixth after setting the pace in the Feb. 2 GII Strub S. in his last trip to the post. A winner of his only other start on an off track, Orientate jumped out to the early lead and sped through fractions of :21 3/5, :44 2/5 and three quarters in 1:09 1/5. He responded when favored **Aldebaran** (Mr. Prospector) came to challenge in the stretch and kept that rival at bay to the wire. "He was on cruise control most of the way," said winning jockey Pat Day. "He's like a little Quarter horse leaving there. NOT JUST COMELY, BUT BELLA

Bella Bellucci (French Deputy) proved she was a force to be reckoned with in the already contentious three-year-old filly division with a commanding seven-length victory in yesterday's GIII Comely S. at Aqueduct. The gray filly, winner of the GII Astarita in only her second start last October, suffered her first defeat when third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, her only try over

a mile. She returned to take the Mar. 24 6 1/2-furlong Santa Paula at Santa Anita. Heavily favored against four rivals yesterday, Bella Bellucci came from just off the pace with a three-wide move approaching the stretch. She overtook pacesetter **Short Note** (Editor's Note) with a furlong to run and drew clear with ease. "It was a nice prep," commented winning

trainer Neil Drysdale. "I wanted to give her two comfortable races before the [May 3 GI] Kentucky Oaks. I have no distance concerns with her. She galloped out very well today and I don't think she'll have a problem with two turns." [Click here](#) for the brisnet.com chart.

SUPER SATURDAY WRAP-UP

The winners and losers from Saturday's big day of Kentucky Derby prep races began looking ahead yesterday. **Buddha** (Unbridled's Song) and **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}), first and second in the GI Wood Memorial, were both resting comfortably after their epic battle at Aqueduct. "He came out in great shape," Alvarado Cambray, assistant to trainer James Bond, said of Buddha yesterday. "He's a great horse." Should he start, Buddha will be Bond's first Derby starter. Of Medaglia d'Oro's second-place finish, trainer Bobby Frankel said, "Of course I would have liked to win it, but he needed a tough race and that's what he got. Hopefully he can take another step forward." **Sunday Break (Jpn)** (Forty Niner), third in the Wood, will ship to Kentucky Tuesday, according to trainer Neil Drysdale. "I thought he got a little tired the last part because he didn't get much out of the previous allowance race," Drysdale commented.

Harlan's Holiday (Harlan) exited his authoritative win in the GI Toyota Blue Grass in fine shape. "Everything went very smooth," confirmed trainer Ken McPeck. "He's feeling super this morning. All systems go."

Booklet (Notebook), runner-up in the race, was also doing well yesterday. "He came out of the race really, really good," said trainer John Ward. "He was bright cooling out afterwards and he ate up last night. I was happy with his effort."

GI Arkansas Derby winner **Private Emblem** (Our Emblem) arrived at Churchill Downs late Sunday morning to continue preparations for the Kentucky Derby. He was accompanied on the trip by stablemate **Windward Passage** (Captain Bodgit), third in Arkansas Saturday, who will also be aimed for the Derby.

Act One, rated France's best juvenile of 2001, returned with a smooth display to further enhance his reputation. He was handed a rating of 117 pounds in the International Classifications on the basis of his one-length success from Landseer (GB) in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in November on heavy ground. Previously he had won on very soft ground in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at that track in October, which had suggested he might not appreciate the considerably faster conditions here. He had won on good ground on his debut in a debutantes event at Chantilly in September, however, and he set aside any doubts with a convincing performance. Allowed to settle in second early as Caesarion and Duc d'Audiffret-Pasquier led, he was asked to quicken inside the final 1 1/2 furlongs. Hitting the front soon after, he merely had to be pushed out to win with ease. Winning trainer Jonathan Pease commented, "I always thought that he would develop into a nice horse, but I was quite surprised that he had done so well at two, as I have always thought of him as a top three-year-old. He may return in the G2 Prix Hocquart here May 8 or in the G1 Prix Lupin here May 12. I think that it will be the Lupin as it is a Group 1 race."

Bowman, out of the 1995 G1 Haydock Sprint Cup winner Cherokee Rose (Ire), was supplemented for this Classic trial earlier in the week and justified that decision with a game display. Fifth on his only two-year-old start in a debutantes event at Maisons-Laffitte in November, he returned to take a conditions event that had been transferred from Longchamp to Fontainebleau Apr. 1 with ease last time. Here he raced keenly in third early under Olivier Peslier as Greencus (Atticus) set a steady pace in front. Having settled before the turn into the final straight, he was asked to challenge Rashbag (Fr) (Reprimand {GB}) as that colt was committed and responded by battling to the lead with a furlong remaining. Jamie Spencer drove Landseer up the rail to his left and Olivier Doleuze closed fast to his right on Medecis, but the winner had enough to hold on and deny their attentions in a thrilling finish. The time was slower than the fillies' race an hour earlier, however. Medecis and Bowman should renew rivalry off a truer pace in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 2000 Guineas) at Chantilly May 12.

"Easy run," exclaimed Jamie Spencer after the \$3.4 million KEEJUL yearling Sophisticat dismissed her rivals in this trial for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas). The winner may now return to contest the mile Classic May 12. Held up in last place early as Urgele (Fr) (Zafonic) was sent to an uncontested lead, Sophisticat travelled with ease on the rail under a patient and confident ride from Spencer. Although she appeared short of room at the top of the straight and was still in last position with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, Spencer was content to wait until the leader had run out of steam and did not switch her until Thierry Jarnet sent Danseuse d'Etoile (Fr) (Highest Honor {Fr}) to the front with 100 yards remaining. Quickening impressively when in the clear, she hit the front soon after, before surging away from the fast-finishing Dublino. Incredibly, this was Sophisticat's first win in stakes company. She was runner-up to Queen's Logic in the G3 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot in June, the G2 Lowther S. at York in August and in the G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket in October, as well as finishing third behind Quarter Moon (Ire) in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh in September and runner-up in the Listed Silver Flash S. at Leopardstown in July. She was also fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' at Belmont Park at the end of October. "Sophisticat has trained on well from two to three and has a lot of class," Spencer continued. "The pace was not too strong, but she travelled smoothly and she quickened in style when asked. She loved the good ground and will improve more off that run."

SLEW'S RECOVERY CONTINUES Triple Crown winner **Seattle Slew** continues to improve after undergoing surgery six weeks ago to relieve spinal cord compression. A set of x-rays taken Friday show the bone graft is being incorporated into the surgery site, according to the stallion's owner and syndicate manager Mickey Taylor. Seattle Slew is being walked three times a day and is allowed to graze during those walks.

JIM AND TONIC, WITH ANTICIPATION, OUT OF QE II CUP American representative **With Anticipation** (Relaunch), a two-time Grade I winner, and France's **Jim and Tonic (Fr)** (Double Bed {Fr}), the runner-up in the race last year, have declined their invitations to the Apr. 21 G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II S. at Sha Tin. Taking their places in the lineup for the \$1.8-million event are **Precision (Fr)** (Anabaa), who finished second in the Hong Kong Derby in his latest start; and **Idol (NZ)** (Masterclass), the winner of last year's G1 Hong Kong Gold Cup. Named the reserve for the 2000-meter turf race was **Dashing Winner (NZ)** (Deputy Governor), who was third in the Hong Kong Derby after winning three in a row.

Handle Record Set at Keeneland:

The \$3,516,621 wagered at Keeneland during Toyota Blue Grass day on Saturday was an all-time single-day record at the Kentucky track. The previous record of \$3,127,294 was set on Blue Grass day last year. Saturday's on-track attendance was 28,270, fifth highest in the track's history.

UNBRIDLED TIME (c, 4, Unbridled's Song--Haveaheavenlytime, by Halo), second in the GIII Oklahoma Derby at Remington Park last August, had been unable to maintain that form in 2002, running sixth in both the GIII El Conejo H. at Santa Anita and GIII Aqueduct H. in January. Trying the turf for the first time since last April, the grey pressed the pace in second through a half mile, made the lead entering the turn, drew clear in the stretch and held his advantage to hit the wire 2 1/2 lengths in front. The 6-5 people's choice, Royal Romp (Lord Avie), sat off the pace early, loomed large as a contender entering the stretch, but never threatened the winner, finishing third. The 6-1 winner is a half to Enticed (Stage Door Johnny), MSW; and Heavenliness (Lord Avie), MSW & GSP, \$342,092. Lifetime Record: MSW & MGSP, 23-5-2-2, \$340,569. O-Robert B & Beverly J Lewis. MR. JOHN (c, 4, Golden Gear--Come On Texas {MSP}, by Apalachee), second in last year's GIII Gotham S., was disqualified from a runner-up finish in the GII Lexington and had not raced since finishing 11th in last year's Preakness. Sent off the 2-5 favorite in his return, the bay colt pressed the pace and forged clear in the stretch despite lugging in and out to win by 1 1/2 lengths. After missing the board in the G1 Phoenix S. at Leopardstown Aug. 12 and the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster in England Sept. 12, the chestnut was sidelined for the winter. He reappeared stateside to notch a third against allowance company at Gulfstream Mar. 16. Coming into this one as a 2-1 favorite, the colt shot out to an early 1 1/2-length lead, maintaining that margin between himself and the field before opening up in the stretch to score confidently by 5 1/2 lengths. 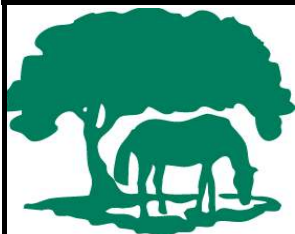
