### KING FOR A DAY

Sir Michael Stoute was guarded in his optimism after **King of Happiness** (Spinning World) had booked his place in the line-up for the G1 2000 Guineas May 4 with the trainer's seventh success in the G3 Craven at Newmarket yesterday. "You had to be pleased with that, as it was a nice, smooth performance," said Stoute. "However, there will be a few tougher nuts to crack on Guineas day. He loves this ground and he wouldn't want it any softer than good as that would count against him." **Della Francesca** (Danzig) was sent to the front in the early stages, but as that colt was passed by **Silence and Rage (GB)** (Green Desert), the tempo quickened considerably. Kieren Fallon was able to stalk the pace astride King of Happiness before asking him to close on the outside inside the final three furlongs. The 220,000gns Houghton yearling struck the front with a quarter mile remaining and was pushed out a comfortable winner. "He's a very good horse--he's shown that in his work at home and we just hope now that we can get him in the same condition on the day and keep him right," the winning rider commented. Coral Eurobet responded by cutting the winner to 5-1 as second favourite for the mile Classic behind Della Francesca's stable companion Hawk Wing at 6-4.

### MINARDI SET TO SHUTTLE

Champion **Minardi** (Boundary--Yarn, by Mr. Prospector) will stand the Southern Hemisphere season at New Zealand's Glenmorgan Farm for a fee of NZ\$15,000. He entered stud this spring at Walmac Farm near Lexington. A \$1.65 Keeneland September yearling purchase, Minardi went on to capture the G1 Heinz 57 Phoenix S. and the G1 Middle Park S. and was named champion at two in both England and Ireland. "We are over the moon to have been able to secure Minardi for New Zealand breeders," said Brett Jenkins of Glenmorgan Farm. "Not only was he the champion European two-year-old, but he is also a half brother to rising sire star Tale of the Cat (Storm Cat) and his half sister is the dam of superstar Johannesburg (Hennessy)."

### KINANE SUSPENDED, COULD MISS DERBY

Michael Kinane was yesterday hit with a seven-day suspension at Newmarket which could rule him off of Breeders' Cup Juvenile and Eclipse Award winner Johannesburg in the G1 Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs May 4. Having being judged guilty of irresponsible riding of a major nature on the disqualified winner **Sahara Desert (GB)** (Green Desert) in the final race on yesterday's card, Kinane was banned from Apr. 27 to May 4 inclusive. Stipendiary steward Jeremy Ker said, "The jockey made a maneuver where it ought to have been obvious to him that by doing so he would cause interference. Sahara Desert was placed fifth, directly behind Tumbleweed Charm and Western Verse as they were the horses he interfered with. He can appeal if he wishes, just as any jockey can against a punishment from the racecourse stewards." Kinane has until Monday evening to formally launch an appeal.

**NEW HEIGHTS AT TATTS** An amazing two days of the Tattersalls Breeze-Up Sales finished last night with a record turnover, despite the smallest catalogue since 1993, beating the 2000 record by two percent. The median of 20,000gns equalled that year's record, but the average bettered the previous high by 35.6 percent. The individual record price was shattered on Wednesday by a 180,000gns Selkirk colt, which easily eclipsed the previous best of 125,000gns. Yesterday's session was headed by Michael Bell, who trains just a few hundred yards from Tattersalls. On behalf of a six-person partnership, Bell paid 100,000gns for a Desert King (Ire) colt consigned by Fiona Marner's Kingwood Stud, on her first breeze-up venture. Amanda Skiffington was underbidder on the grey, who had breezed well under conditional Dean Corby in the morning. "He was the only horse I bid for," said Bell. "He was the one we wanted and will race for an existing owner." Berkshire-based Swede Mikael Magnusson, paid 92,000gns for a son of Hector Protector sold by Mark Dwyer's Oaks Farm Stables. The colt will be trained at Magnusson's stable by David Arbutnot, who also conditions last year's top lot Manorson (Ire). Edmond Mahony, chairman of Tattersalls, reflected on the results of the two-day sale. "There seems little point in understanding the success of the last two days here at Park Paddocks--we have just had a remarkable sale," he said. "We were confident that we had a catalogue with real international appeal, but could not have predicted the level of trade we have experienced. The obvious feature of the sale has been the huge impact of the strong Japanese contingent. Our Japanese representative Naohiro Goda has worked tirelessly to promote the Breeze-Up in Japan and the steady flow of Japanese buyers at this sale in recent years have all bought well and returned in greater numbers than ever. The Japanese buyers have without doubt dominated the top end of the market, but equally encouraging for the long term has been the domestic and European demand, again often fuelled by the race course successes of previous Breeze-Up purchases, as well as significant interest from the Gulf region and Southeast Asia."

A consistent performer in stakes company last year, Califet's best win came when he was a short head victor of the Listed Prix du Grand Camp at Lyon-Parilly last November. The son of Freedom Cry (GB) put up his best career effort to date here with a solid display to garner a first group race win. Jockey Davy Bonilla employed patient tactics in sixth place as Sagittarius (GB) (Sadler's Wells) led from Ange Gabriel. The eventual winner moved sweetly into third as the field entered the home straight and made his bid at the quarter-mile marker. The race was settled as a contest in a matter of strides when Califet quickened into a clear lead approaching the final furlong and was merely kept up to his work thereafter to record an impressive victory. "This horse has always been very consistent and has never run a bad race in his life," said winning trainer Guy Cherel. "He has never stopped improving, but needs a truly run race to show his best and that is what he got today. If everything goes to plan he will return in the G2 Prix Jean de Chaudenay at Saint-Cloud May 20." Ange Gabriel proved game in the latter stages and just held on for second as Sangreal rallied to good effect.

**Baffert Goes To War:**

GII Illinois Derby victor **War Emblem** (Our Emblem), acquired privately last week by Prince Ahmed Salman's The Thoroughbred Corporation, had an impressive first workout for new trainer Bob Baffert yesterday morning, covering five furlongs in a snappy :59 3/5 at Churchill beneath exercise rider Dana Barnes. The colt was caught in fractions of :24 for the first quarter, :47 4/5 for the half and out six furlongs in 1:12 3/5. "What I saw today I really liked," the trainer commented. "I feel a little bit excited about (the Derby) now. Today he showed me, just comparing him with other horses that I've brought here, that he has what it takes to go on to the Derby. He handled the surface really well. He's been galloping really strong in the morning--he's one of those horses that gets out there and really strokes it." Also from the Baffert barn, GIII Golden Gate Derby winner **Danthebluegrassman** (Pioneering) worked five panels in :59 4/5 while Kentucky Oaks starter **Habibti** (Tabasco Cat) drilled her five-eighths in 1:00.

**Came Home Due Today:**

**Came Home** (Gone West), winner of the G1 Santa Anita Derby in his most recent effort Apr. 6, is scheduled to depart Southern California early this morning for Churchill Downs. "He's doing very good," trainer Paco Gonzalez said yesterday morning. "He had his regular gallop today then came back and cleaned up all his feed." The conditioner said that the bay would just walk during his first three days in the Bluegrass, with a work tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, though that could change. "Depending on the weather, we might want to work Tuesday. I can go either way. This is an important work coming up," Gonzalez said.

**SAINTS CUP RETURNS** *Saints Cup* (Saint Ballado), unraced since a 9 3/4-length debut victory at Saratoga Aug. 28, 1999, makes a remarkable return to the races in this afternoon's sixth race at Keeneland. The dark bay colt became the subject of a bitter lawsuit after selling for \$850,000 as part of the Robert and Bea Roberts dispersal at the Keeneland November Sale in November 1999. Purchased by trainer Billy Badgett on behalf of Peter Callahan and Barry Golden, the colt was later discovered to have a tear in a tendon of his left fore and was subsequently returned to his consignor. Callahan and Golden sued the Robertses and trainer Stanley Hough, who acted as the agent for the dispersal, for fraud and breach of contract. At the time, veterinarians indicated that there was a "50-percent chance he could return to the races and less than 20 percent that he could be as competitive" as he was in his maiden win. Following two days of litigation in October 2000, an out-of-court settlement was reached which mandated the return of *Saints Cup* to the Robertses and payment of \$250,000 from Callahan and Golden to the couple for legal costs. Now trained by Steve Margolis, a former assistant to Hough, and owned by Jeri and Sam Knighton, who also campaign Derby hopeful *Request For Parole*, *Saints Cup* returned to training last spring, but was sidelined after a recurrence of the tendon problem. Now five years old, the horse has been training well for the return and breaks from the outside post under jockey Robby Albarado.

"Those two in front were setting it up for us and I thought I could get by them whenever I wanted. She's a quality filly." Winning trainer Mark Frostad added, "She's a lovely filly. She's got great tactical speed. There's a good race [May 17 GIII Pimlico Breeders' Cup Distaff] for her at Pimlico on Preakness [weekend] if everything comes out o.k."
