### GUINEAS FAVE IS LOGICAL

"It's a relief", sighed trainer Mick Channon after his unbeaten filly **Queen's Logic (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) came through the G3 Dubai Duty Free S. with relative ease to remain undefeated. She will now bid to emulate the efforts of Bosra Sham, who won this in 1996 before going on to win the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. "I was very confident as she was in good form and she has come out of the winter well", the trainer said. "She's just been an exceptional filly ever since I've had her and she's making the job easy for me." A winner at the first time of asking 11 months ago, Queen's Logic went on to take the G2 Lowther S. at York in August and G1 Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket in October. Here, she raced keenly early under jockey Steve Drowne as **Lady Dominatrix (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) assumed the pole position. As that filly wound up the pace from the front, Queen's Logic settled in Drowne's hands so that she was travelling easily when taking over from the tiring leader with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. Asked to quicken from there, she settled the outcome in a few strides before being pushed out for a convincing score. Coral Eurobet made the winner their 9-4 favourite for the mile Classic in two weeks' time.

Returned to training in early March, Proud Citizen recorded a series of solid drills, but was thrown to the wolves for his seasonal debut against Came Home and company in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 6. After showing some early speed, the \$425,000 Keeneland September yearling faded back through the pack to finish next to last. Still, Lukas remained undeterred. "I'm probably the only guy that would use the Santa Anita Derby as a prep," he explained. "I know that when we ran there, I told [owners] Bill [Mack], Bob [Baker] and Dave [Cornstein] that we were making a quantum leap, but we'd protect him and point him here." It wouldn't be the first time that Lukas brought a horse into this race off a sound defeat in California. Could lightning strike twice?

**Doing His Trainer Proud**

A bit restless in the gate, Proud Citizen broke open his stall prior to the start, but was kept from getting loose by the assistant starters. Settled back down, he was a bit slow into stride, but sprinted up from between horses to assume command entering the first turn. He continued to make the pace beneath jockey Mike Smith, but was joined entering the far turn by **American Style** (Quiet American) with second choice **Easyfromthegitgo** (Dehere) in close attendance from third and **Crimson Hero** (Capote) making good ground up the inside. But the Lukas pupil was just too strong in the stretch, turning back the bid of American Style and drawing clear to hold Crimson Hero at bay. Easyfromthegitgo, checked a couple of times around the first turn, earned the show spot in a photo. "We needed this one under our belts and he responded," Lukas said. "It's easy to be optimistic after a win like this." Perhaps that optimism is fueled by the fact that the winner's third dam is a full sister to 1964 Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Northern Dancer.

**Beaten Fave Didn't Handle Track**

**Ethan Man** (Glitterman), the 3-2 favorite off his easy win in the GIII Swale S. at Gulfstream Park Mar. 16, was wide into the first turn, last down the backstretch and struggled home a well-beaten fifth. "I am not making excuses, but he wasn't taking to the track," said trainer Pat Byrne. "When he left the gate, he was wide because he was not taking to the track. Our horse is a complete toss out in this race. The track was not bad, it was just deep."

The three-length winner of this event a year ago, Astra stamped herself the leading turf distaffer in this country with a four-length success in the GI Beverly Hills H. at Hollywood Park June 24. Sent to Chicago for the GI Beverly D. S. in August, the Allen Paulson-bred mare could not handle the yielding going and finished seventh in what would be her final start of the year. Kept in the barn until last month, the bay made her six-year-old debut in the Mar. 23 GII Santa Ana H., falling victim to a powerful late run from Golden Apples to finish third. Stretching out to her preferred distance for this, Astra was tucked in behind front-running Polaire (Ire), who set dawdling fractions of :50 and 1:15 and still held the call turning for home. That's when jockey Kent Desormeaux asked his mount for her best and she responded, shifting off the rail and exploding through the final quarter mile in :22 flat before holding off Golden Apples for the win. "As a jockey, it's scary when the pace is so slow as it was today," Desormeaux said. "I had confidence in her turn of foot and she does have a nasty turn of foot. She's just a pleasure to ride." A fixture on the British handicap circuit at places like Wolverhampton, Folkestone and Salisbury, Hail the Chief has taken nicely to the American variety of racing and scored a powerhouse front-running victory in yesterday's GIII National Jockey Club H. Sent to the U.S. late last year, the bay was a good fourth to eventual GII New Orleans H. winner Parade Leader in Fair Grounds allowance company Dec. 23 before finishing fifth in the Col. E.R. Bradley H. over a sloppy track Jan. 5. Sent to Florida for his next pair, the five-year-old accounted for stakes quality Dancing Guy and American Halo in a Feb. 16 allowance at Gulfstream and ran Macho Uno to 1/2 length in his last start Mar. 23. Allowed to coast along through easy fractions of :23 2/5, :47 3/5 and 1:12 3/5, Hail the Chief turned for home with a commanding lead and was ridden out to win by double digits. "The horse was so good on the all-weather track in the United Kingdom that we were running out of races for him," said Paul Lacy, representing owner Peter Crane. "The United States was a land of opportunity for him. We knew he was great on dirt. We knew he'd stay a mile and an eighth. He's done everything we always expected of him." Arguably the best two-year-old of her generation with six wins from seven starts, including a pair of Grade Is, Raging Fever is proving her mettle against older foes with her fourth win from her last five starts. Third behind Xtra Heat in the GII Beaumont S. last April, the Edward Evans homebred was sidelined, but returned in style to take the Garland of Roses H. over the inner Dec. 8. Sent south for the winter, she added a two-length win in the Jan. 18 GIII First Lady H. before finishing a neck second in the GIII Shirley Jones H. Feb. 15. The dark bay was sent off the prohibitive favorite off her 3 3/4-length tally in the GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 30. Raging Fever broke alertly, but relaxed kindly to get her first quarter in a slow :23 4/5 chased along the inside by Atelier. The latter came under a ride rounding the far turn as her younger rival extended her advantage and was gaining late but could not get to the winner. "I was glad to see her relax and settle as well as she did," winning trainer Mark Hennig commented. "She's really matured a lot. If someone wanted to blast off and go, I think she'd have no problem sitting second or third." The GII Shuvee H. at this trip at Belmont May 18 could be next for Raging Fever. Redback added another big race success to his portfolio with a dominating display in the closing stages here. Last year, he proved a consistent and talented colt, winning the Listed Superlative S. at Newmarket in July and G2 Solario S. at Sandown in September before finishing third to High Chaparral (Ire) in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster the following month. Having finished third in the Listed Easter S. at Kempton Mar. 30, he arrived here with a fitness edge and showed that with a smart break from the stalls. Taken over to the stands' side by jockey Darryll Holland, he sat second overall as Royal Quarters (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}) took them along in the centre of the track. Assuming command at the halfway marker, Redback was shaken up to go clear inside the final furlong as Guys and Dolls stayed on in the centre. The winner is now on target for the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4, for which he is quoted at odds of 33-1 by Coral Eurobet. "Today I thought he was very impressive and he did it the hard way, although he's much better when he does it like that," said Richard Hannon Jr. "He hasn't done fantastically physically, but he's got a wonderful temperament and he's obviously very talented--he's as tough as boots. He's fully entitled to be in the Guineas and he'll take a lot of whacking if he gets to the front at any stage."

Zindabad is a stable stalwart for trainer Mark Johnston, who has a particular niche for improving older horses. Last year, the French bred was beaten a head when second to Sandmason (GB) in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot in June and ran with great credit to finish third before being disqualified and placed sixth behind Mutamam (GB) in the G1 Canadian International at Woodbine in September. Here, he raced in third tracking the early lead shared by both St Expedit and Fair Question (Ire) (Rainbow Quest). St Expedit, who shook off Fair Question after half a mile, had his rivals on the stretch in the straight as jockey Kevin Darley was asking Zindabad to close. Lengthening well to join the game front-runner inside the final 1 1/2 furlongs, he wore down his rival in the final strides. "He's been fantastic for us," said Johnston. "Last year, he was wonderful at Ascot and then in Canada he was very unlucky and did not really get the credit he deserved after being demoted, as he would have been at least second with a clear run. He got a bit stale with the travelling last year and it just took its toll on him--he was too light and needed a rest. It's worked well--probably the G2 Yorkshire Cup [at York May 16] is next where the mile and six will probably suit him even better."

The Japanese ruled the roost during the Hong Kong International Races Program Dec. 16, with **Agnes Digital** taking home top honors in the G1 Hong Kong Cup over today's trip and **Eishin Preston** in the G1 Hong Kong Mile. The former, named the Japan Racing Association's Horse of the Year in 2001, got the new year off on a high note with a one-length success in the G1 February S. over the Tokyo dirt surface. He disappointed in his last when a distant sixth in the G1 Dubai World Cup, but was reported to have not handled the journey from Japan very well, which could have contributed to his performance. Eishin Preston finished fourth in his seasonal bow in the G2 Nakayama Kinen Feb. 24, carrying high weight of 132 pounds and is a threat, though he tries 2000 meters for the first time. The 2001 G1 AJC Derby hero, **Universal Prince** has kept top company down under, with a third to Tie The Knot in the G2 Chipping Norton S. three back prior to a win in the G1 Ranvet S. over 2000 meters Mar. 9. He comes into this off a head defeat at the hands of Ethereal in the G1 BMW S. at Rosehill Mar. 23.

Frankie Dettori will ride **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4, it was announced yesterday. Dettori had been expected to ride **Essence of Dubai** (Pulpit) in the G1 Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs that afternoon, but he will instead return to Newmarket after partnering **Imperial Gesture** (Langfuhr) in the G1 Kentucky Oaks May 3. That leaves the ride on Godolphin's UAE Derby winner to David Flores. Naheef, who took the G3 Champagne Lanson Vintage S. at Goodwood in August before finishing runner-up to Hawk Wing in the G1 National S. at The Curragh the following month, was the winner of the private trial held at Nad al Sheba last month.

**Albarado to Ride Request for Parole:**

Jockey Robby Albarado has accepted the mount aboard **Request For Parole** (Judge T C) in the G1 Kentucky Derby May 4. Owned by Sam and Jeri Knighton, the dark bay colt had been ridden by Pat Day when third in a blanket finish in the GII Lane's End Spiral S. Mar. 23. "The other rider we were considering was Mike Smith, but we felt that by getting Robby, he would be able to work the horse before the race and he certainly knows Churchill Downs as good as any of them," trainer Steve Margolis said yesterday. "The fact that he won on the owners' horse [Friday] kind of put the icing on the cake," Margolis added, referencing Albarado's ride aboard Saints Cup.

**Dash Flies Into Derby Trial:**

Fusao Sekiguchi, who capaigned 2000 Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus, could be represented in this year's race, should **Flying Dash (Ger)** (Dashing Blade {GB}) run well in his next start, the GIII Derby Trial on Saturday. Winner of the G2 Maurice La Croix Trophy at Baden Baden last year, the bay came from off the pace to score the Transylvania S. over the Keeneland turf course Apr. 5. The colt may need some luck to draw into the Derby field in the first place, as he has only \$57,370 in graded-stakes earnings. "If it happens, it happens," trainer Neil Drysdale said. "There seems to always be some horses drop out as the race draws near."

**Bella Bellucci Works:**

Michael Tabor's **Bella Bellucci** (French Deputy), winner of the GIII Comely S. at Aqueduct a week ago today, breezed a solid half mile beneath the Twin Spires in :47 3/5, the third fastest of 33 at the distance. Expected to vie for Oaks favoritism with Take Charge Lady, the \$925,000 two-year-old in training purchase galloped out five furlongs in 1:00 shortly after the track opened for training and before rains rendered the main track sloppy.

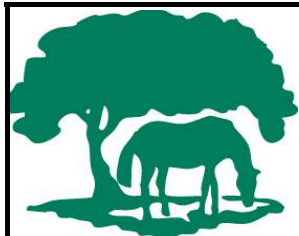
