

### JAPANESE DOMINATE QE II CUP

**Eishin Preston** (Green Dancer) outfinished **Agnes Digital** (Crafty Prospector) to give Japan a one-two finish in yesterday's G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin. The champion Japanese two-year-old of 1999, Eishin Preston was let go at odds of nearly 25-1 in the G1 Hong Kong Mile last December, but pulled off the upset with an impressive 3 1/2-length score. He had started just once since, finishing fifth in the G2 Nakayama Kinen Feb. 24. Trying 2000 meters for the first

time here, the bay was rated at the back of the pack early and was widest of all as they turned for home, but came flying down the stretch to take the lead in the final 200 meters, then held off 2001 G1 Hong Kong Cup hero **Agnes Digital** to take it by a half-length. "The early pace was slow, but it picked up in the second half," winning jockey **Yuichi Fukunaga** said. "I thought I would win it coming into the straight, but in the closing stages I was worried that **Agnes Digital** might pass me." In addition to the winner's share of the HK\$14 million purse, **Eishin Preston** also received a HK\$1 million bonus for adding the QE II Cup victory to his win in a Hong Kong International race. The runner-up, coming off a sixth-place showing in the Mar. 23 G1 Dubai World Cup, just missed. "He tried very hard, but I think, after the trip to Dubai, he was only at about 90 percent of his very best today," his trainer, **Toshiaki Shirai**, said. "We will give him a break now." **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), the 11-10 favorite, broke slowly, but moved up quickly. He went to the front at the top of the lane, but faded late to be fifth. "He came around the bend nice and steady and I said, 'let's go' and he hit the front, but he got tired and his head came up," jockey **Frankie Dettori** said. ### GRABBING THE BRASS RING

**Ringaskiddy** (Slewvescent) scaled his way from the claiming ranks to Grade I company and handled the climb, winning the G1 San Juan Capistrano H. by 3 1/2 lengths at Santa Anita yesterday. The six-year-old was claimed for \$50,000 in January of 2001 and went on to win the Apr. 28 Quicken Tree S. at Hollywood and to finish a close-up third in the Nov. 3 Cal Cup Mile at Santa Anita. He won facing optional claimers in his second start this season, then tried his luck in a graded stakes and finished fourth in the Feb. 16 GII San Luis Obispo H. The dark bay came back in the Mar. 16 GII San Luis Rey H. and was fourth again, this time beaten only a half-length for all the money. Sent off at 10-1 trying the marathon mile and three-quarters of the Capistrano, **Ringaskiddy** trailed for 10 furlongs, but drove between horses as they raced down the stretch, took control past the eighth pole and drew clear. "He had a little trouble in his last race, but this time he was really perfect," trainer **Juan Garcia** said. "There was a lot of speed in the race and he just sat and waited." **The Chairman's Sprint Prize cont.**

Trainer David Hayes walked away with the lion's share of the Chairman's Sprint purse, including an HK\$800,000 bonus for winning his second race of the Champion Sprint Series, following an impressive 1-2 finish by his runners Charming City and All Thrills Too. Charming City, the winner of the Hong Kong Classic as a sophomore, was a half-length winner in the Bauhinia Sprint Trophy Feb. 14, the first leg in the Champion series, before finishing third in the second leg, the 1000-meter Centenary Sprint Cup over this course Mar. 17. Looking for his third domestic Group 1 prize, Charming City settled just behind early pacesetter and stable companion Prime Witness (Aus) (Euclase {Aus}), took over from that one 300 meters out and drew off to an eye-catching victory. Hayes, who proclaimed the effort as the colt's "best performance of his career," said the two top finishers will target the G3 Singapore Airlines Krisflyer Sprint at Kranji May 11. Malabar Gold started an abbreviated 2001 campaign with two wins on the Santa Anita turf, but saw his season end after a fourth-place finish in last year's edition of this race. The dark bay returned to take a Santa Anita allowance test going 6 1/2 furlongs Jan. 17, then stretched out for the one-mile GII Frank E. Kilroe H. Mar. 2 and tired late to be fifth. Freshened after that effort, the lightly raced five-year-old came back as the second choice here. He tracked Astonished as that one dashed through a lightning half in :42 4/5 and six furlongs in 1:05 2/5, angled outside for the final drive and just got past the pacesetter to take the photo in a time just a tick off the course record. "I didn't think Astonished would be quick enough to be in front of me after a quarter mile, but he certainly was," jockey Chris McCarron said, adding, "I was almost outridden, but fortunately I was on the better horse." Jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., who got the jump on McCarron and nearly pulled off the upset, said, "My horse ran too good to lose. I thought I had it--I'll tell you, he never stopped. He never gave up." As for future plans for the winner, trainer Ron Ellis said, "We'll consider some longer races for him at Hollywood, but not on the grass. We're going to try and stretch him out on the dirt maybe, but I have nothing specific in mind right now."

Duckhorn, the front-running winner of the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup last May, ended his 2001 campaign with a third-place finish in the July 21 GII Washington Park H. at Arlington Park. He made his return as a 23-1 outsider in the Feb. 9 GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park and lived up to his odds, holding a brief lead before tiring badly to be 12th. The gray fared a lot better in his second start back, cutting out the early fractions and hanging on gamely to be second in the Mar. 9 GIII Stymie H. at Aqueduct. Odds-on to lead them every step this time, the five-year-old skipped right to the front over muddy surface, had nine lengths on the field after a half and was 10 1/2 in front after six furlongs. He cruised home under a hand ride to win impressively. "This is the easiest money I've made," jockey Jorge Chavez said. "I knew he would like the racetrack," added trainer Pat Byrne. "He just relished it." Parade Leader made a run at the winner in the stretch, but was second best. The bay fell about a quarter of a mile after the finish and had to be vanned off the track. GI Wood Memorial hero **Buddha** (Unbridled's Song) worked over the Belmont Park training track yesterday morning, going six furlongs in 1:14 2/5. The gray, breezing for the first time since his Grade I score, galloped out seven-eighths in 1:27 2/5. "He looked good," said trainer Jim Bond, who will saddle his first Kentucky Derby starter this year. The colt is tentatively scheduled to head to Churchill Downs a week from today. Asked if he thought Buddha might "bounce" off his big win at the Big A, Bond said, "He worked good, his coat looked good and all his blood work came back fine. I guess the 'bounce' theory is in the back of my mind, but there's nothing I can do about it. We're going to go into the race doing what we've always done. He can't read the papers or the figures."

Wayne Lukas said. "We're ready to go to the next step. Everything needs to fall into place, but we're excited." Lukas accomplished the Lexington-Derby double with Charismatic in 1999. Of his 2002 contender, the Hall of Fame horseman said, "I think we went from being a 200-1 shot to a horse they're going to watch a little bit now. I think we're going to get a little following."

**Mayakovsky Sharp for Trial:**

**Mayakovsky** (Matty G), fourth in the GI Santa Anita Derby last time out, worked five furlongs in a bullet :58.20 at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. After zipping through fractions of :22.20, :34.60 and :46, the colt galloped out the six furlongs in 1:12.20. "He seems to like the track," trainer Patrick Biancone said. "He worked good--but he works good all the time." The winner of the GIII Gotham S. in his 2002 debut, Mayakovsky goes next in Saturday's GIII Derby Trial. As for plans past the Trial, Biancone said, "We'll go slowly, see how he runs in the Derby Trial and after that we'll decide what to do. Everything is an option."

The 5-2 second choice for this start, the chestnut raced very wide through the first turn, angled back inside on the backstretch to save ground, made steady progress to earn a share of the lead entering the stretch and pulled clear while being kept to the task to hold off the 3-5 favorite Monnavonna to the wire.
