

### OGDEN PHIPPS DEAD AT 93

Ogden Phipps, the well-known philanthropist and Thoroughbred owner and breeder, died early yesterday at the Good Samaritan Medical Center in West Palm Beach after a short illness. The 93-year-old resident of Palm Beach is survived by three children Robert L.

Phipps, Ogden Mills Phipps and Cynthia Phipps, and several grandchildren and great-grandchildren. "Racing has lost one of the truly great men of the 20th century," said Barry K.

Schwartz, New York Racing Association Chairman and CEO.

"When one speaks of 'improvers of the breed,' no one epitomized it more than Mr. Phipps. Our heartfelt sympathies go out to the entire Phipps family. He will be sorely missed by all of us at the New York Racing Association." An avid sportsman and

athlete, Phipps won numerous U.S. Court Tennis championships during the '30s and '40s and was inducted into the international Court Tennis Hall of Fame in 2001. The Chairman of Bessemer Securities Corporation from 1958 through 1978, Phipps was elected to the Jockey Club at age 30 and held the post of Chairman from 1964-74. Awarded the prestigious Mr. Fitz Award from the National Turf Writers Association in 1989 and the C.V. Whitney Achievement Award from the New York Turf Writers in 1998, Phipps also earned an Eclipse Award as the outstanding owner and breeder in 1988 and ruled again as leading owner in 1989. "It was an honor for me to be chosen to have worked for the Phipps stable and all of the people that have worked with me the last 16 years feel the same way," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "There are not many people like him left in the world. He was a great man." Funeral arrangements will be private and the family requests that, in lieu of flowers, donations be made to the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation.

### WEATHER ADVISORY RELATED TO MRLS

The University of Kentucky issued a statement yesterday advising horse farm owners and managers to restrict early and late pregnant mares from pastures until noon today because of similarities in weather patterns to 2001, which is believed to be related to Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome. The advisory was prompted by yesterday's forecast for the Kentucky area that called for freezing temperatures last night and this morning. "The weather pattern leading up to [last night] has many similarities to 2001, including a warm period followed by near-freezing temperatures," stated a release issued by the University of Kentucky.

### Kinane To Appeal:

Michael Kinane will appeal the seven-day ban that currently denies him the ride on **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) in the Kentucky Derby, it was announced yesterday. Kinane, who was found guilty of "irresponsible riding of a major nature" at Newmarket Thursday, will attend a hearing at the Jockey Club headquarters at Portman Square later in the week. The suspension, which would keep him out of action from Apr. 27 to May 4, inclusive, was handed out as a result of his ride on the subsequently disqualified winner Sahara Desert (GB) in a conditions event at the track. John Maxse, the Jockey Club's press officer, said yesterday, "Michael Kinane has declared his intention to lodge an appeal. We are working on arranging a date. It will be heard this week, probably Thursday or Friday."

**Private Emblem Leads Worktab at Churchill:**

A slew of Derby-bound horses were out for a preparatory work yesterday over Churchill Downs main track. Leading the charge, GII Arkansas Derby winner **Private Emblem** (Our Emblem) worked four furlongs in :51 2/5. "I thought Private Emblem was little flat," said trainer Steve Asmussen. "He's usually a little more aggressive a work horse than that. [Jockey] Donnie [Meche] said he traveled really well. He seemed to have quite a bit in the infield to take a look at--it is his first time to ever work at Churchill. Hopefully, he'll be a little stronger and sharper through the week leading up to the Derby." According to the trainer, stablemate **Windward Passage** (Captain Bodgit), who dead-heated for third in the Arkansas Derby, fared better with a :50 2/5 move over the same distance. "I think Windward Passage worked not necessarily visually any better, but did cover the ground a little quicker," Asmussen told the *Blood-Horse*. Among other Derby hopefuls who were out yesterday, **Easy Grades** (Honor Grades) covered seven furlongs in 1:29 2/5. "He went nice and easy," said trainer Ted H. West. "I will probably give him a little more serious work in six days or a week. So far, so good. He acted like he handled the track really good, which is always a concern, but he has been looking really good in his gallops, so we thought he would probably handle the track well." Jorge Chavez was aboard for the breeze. **Lusty Latin** (El Prado {Ire}) went four furlongs in :49 1/5 for trainer Jeff Mullins. "I loved the way he worked," said regular jockey Glenn Corbett, who was in the saddle. "He seemed to me like he handled the track real well." The grey colt most recently ran third behind Came Home in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 6.

**Saarland and Blue Burner Work at Belmont:**

**Saarland** (Unbridled) worked a half-mile in :47.21 at Belmont yesterday morning. The colt, who recently underwent minor throat surgery following a fourth-place finish in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 13, bested 39 others at the distance while preparing for the GI Kentucky Derby May. 4. Also out for a spin over the Belmont main track, **Blue Burner** (French Deputy), fifth in the Wood, breezed five furlongs in 1:02.97. "He worked very well and I was pleased with the way he finished up," said trainer Bill Mott, who indicated the colt would ship to Churchill Downs Thursday.

**Lake Lady Breezes at Churchill:**

Trainer Steve Asmussen sent out GI Kentucky Oaks contender **Lake Lady** (Salt Lake) at Churchill Downs yesterday and the filly turned in a sharp :49 2/5 clocking for four furlongs over the fast main strip. "She's a very nice filly that I don't think has necessarily shown her best this year," said Asmussen. "I'm very anxious to run her at Churchill Downs. I'm not under the illusion that the Oaks isn't extremely deep and talented this year, but Lake Lady at Churchill Downs has been nothing short of brilliant." The filly, who scored in her only two starts to date at Churchill, started off the year with a pair of stakes win at the Fair Grounds in January before placing behind Take Charge Lady in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 9 and finding the runner-up spot again in the GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Park Apr. 12.

## PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

Only a few weeks ago I mentioned that commercial breeders rarely enjoy the luxury of enough time to make a fair assessment of a young stallion. With snap decisions having to be made, yesterday's hot new stallion can quickly find himself struggling to maintain his initial popularity.

Although the Coolmore/Ashford stallions are usually immune to such fluctuations, Spinning World appears to have fallen into this trap. Demand for his services was predictably strong when he made his debut at a fee of \$50,000 in 1998. This very well-bred horse had, after all, won three of the previous year's top mile races, the Prix Jacques le Marois, the Prix du Moulin and the Breeders' Cup Mile, and Spinning World's impressive career totals stood at eight wins, three seconds and a third from 14 starts.

But then what happened? With his fee increased to \$55,000 in 1999, his book fell from 148 mares in his first year to 99 in his second. Coolmore quickly took evasive action, sending the son of Nureyev to Japan for his third Northern Hemisphere season. Although they then took the precaution of lowering his fee to \$35,000 when Spinning World returned to Ashford for the 2001 season, demand fell again, this time to 84 mares. Consequently, Spinning World was transferred to Coolmore in Ireland after several members of his first crop had shown distinct promise in Europe. The move has had the desired effect and the nine-year-old is expected to cover around 130 mares by the end of the season.

It's interesting to speculate about the possible causes of Spinning World's dwindling popularity. Could it be that breeders were concerned about Nureyev's record as a sire of sires, which would appear ordinary without Theatrical. Or was Spinning World's light-framed physique to blame, or more likely the fact that he is a turf horse with a turf pedigree?

Another possible contributory factor could be his fertility. Because this son of Nureyev is inbred 2x4 to Northern Dancer, I always wondered how fertile Spinning World would be. The answer seems to be that his fertility is reasonable rather than exceptional: his 148 mares in his first season produced 105 live foals, followed by 62 live foals from 99 mares in his second season. Apparently, there were at least 36 barren mares from the 109 mares he covered in New Zealand in 2000. Of course, figures of this sort will not represent a problem if Spinning World proves capable of getting high-class performers, which he is now doing.

Last year saw him sire 13 winners from 23 juvenile runners in Europe and there was a pleasing number of stakes performers among the 23. They were led by Tendulkar, who very nearly won the G1 Dewhurst S.; Quad's Melody, winner of the G3 Prix d'Aumale in France; Chan Chan, a German Listed winner; and several nice prospects, such as Temple of Artemis, Aglow, Flat Spin, Kepler, Spinnette and King of Happiness. Flat Spin and King of Happiness have both gone on to become stakes winners on their first start at three.

King of Happiness, who, like his sire, was bred by the Niarchos Family's Flaxman Holdings, looked well worth the 220,000 guineas he had cost at the Houghton Sales when he made a winning debut last summer. The colt didn't race again until the G3 Craven S. last week, when his decisive victory established him as Britain's leading contender for the 2000 Guineas. Spinning World, a horse with excellent finishing speed, would have been proud of the way his son quickened.

King of Happiness' success will reassure the many European breeders who are finding it quite hard to avoid producing horses with three lines of Northern Dancer. Because his dam is Mystery Rays, a dual Group 3 winner by Nijinsky II, King of Happiness is inbred 3x5x3 to Northern Dancer. His breeders were no doubt encouraged to try Mystery Rays with a son of Nureyev because she is a half-sister to two of Nureyev's notable sons. One, Robin des Pins, was an accomplished sprinter in Europe, while the other, Robin des Bois, is now best known as the sire of Gentlemen.

King of Happiness' third dam, Another Treat, was a half-sister to What A Treat, the champion racemare who produced the champion sire Be My Guest to Northern Dancer, so he has a pedigree worthy of a classic winner. All he has to do now is defeat the awesome Hawk Wing on May 4 to become a very valuable stallion prospect.

**HIGH OBS BID FOR FORTUNATE PROSPECT**

**FILLY Hope for Love** (Fortunate Prospect) attracted the top bid at yesterday's opening session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Spring Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training in Ocala, Florida. **THAT'S ITALIAN**

The picture for the G2 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas) and G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) at Rome May 1 is clearing after a series of trials run in Italy in the last fortnight. The Regina Elena looks wide open, with the locals waiting to hear if John Dunlop will route **Kootenay (Ire)** (Selkirk {USA}) to the Classic. In her absence, it may be worth looking at **Dayara (Ger)** (Kornado {GB}), the impressive winner of the Listed Premio Zanoletti di Rozzano at Milan Apr. 13. The nine-furlong contest is usually used as a trial for the G1 Oaks d'Italia, and trainer Maurizio Guarnieri will drop the filly back in trip in the hope of a strong pace. Dayara had previously finished fourth in the Listed Premio Seregno in Milan Apr. 7; **Rosa Delle Alpi (USA)** (Royal Applause {GB}), easy winner of that event, is currently the best Italian-trained filly for the Elena. *TDN* "Dark Horse" **La Risposta (GB)** (Halling {USA}) was a length second there and is improving. **Meanya (Ire)** (Revoque {Ire}) took the traditional Elena trial, the Listed Premio Torricola at Rome's Cappanelle Apr. 14.

Looking at the colts for the Parioli, **Fisich (GB)** (Halling {USA}) was an impressive winner of the Listed Premio Gardone in Milan Apr. 7. Having won the G2 Premio Berardelli last year, Fisich showed that he had trained well over the winter by beating the Paul Cole-trained **Welenska (GB)** (Danzig Connection {USA}). Fisich and G3 Premio Chiusura winner **Salselon (GB)** (Salse {USA}) look by far the best home prospects for the Parioli. The latter took the Listed Premio Pisa Mar. 24 in fine style on his return. In the Listed Premio Daumier in Rome Apr. 14, **Crespucolo (GB)** (Efisio {GB}) came out on top in a three-way photo finish, but this trial, run on very testing ground, did not look too strong. John Dunlop may send over Listed Easter S. winner **Flat Spin (GB)** (Spinning World {USA}), fifth in Thursday's G3 Craven S. at Newmarket; the Mark Johnston-trained **Mister Cosmi (GB)** (Royal Applause {GB}) may also run.

**ITALIAN DERBY DOINGS**

Pointing for the G1 Derby Italiano in Rome May 26, the smart **Candrin (GB)** (Zamindar {USA}) won a vital Derby trial at Rome Sunday, taking the Premio Secretariat over 10 furlongs from the promising **Muk Muka (Ire)** (Mukaddamah {USA}). **Einstein (Ity)** (Lando {Ger}) doubled up for the Grizzetti stable in a mile-and-a-half event in Milan, while the maiden winner on the card, **Ablauf (Ger)** (Mtoto {GB}), also holds an entry in the Derby. Lorenzo Brogi's *TDN* "Dark Horse" **Bianca Maria (Ity)** (Acatenango {Ger}) took the Premio Azzurrina over 10 furlongs in Rome and booked her place in the line-up for the G1 Oaks d'Italia in Milan May 19.
