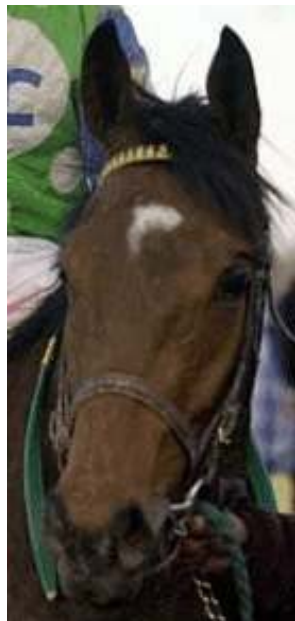

#### DERBY DOINGS

Likely Kentucky Derby favorite **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) continued his preparation for next Saturday by earning a bullet for his five-furlong breeze in :59.20 yesterday morning under the Twin Spires. "I didn't want him to go that fast," acknowledged trainer Ken McPeck, "but he's a nice horse and he works fast. In think the track was a little quick today. He's very sharp right now. He was a little aggressive leaving the pole...I wanted to go in around a minute, but he went a little quicker." McPeck indicated that the dual Grade I winner would come back to work a half-mile Tuesday.



**Perfect Drift** Horsephotos

Off since his victory in the GII Lane's End Spiral S. Mar. 23, **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) sailed through a half-mile in :49 at the Trackside Louisville Training Center Wednesday morning. The three-year-old covered his last eighth in :11.20. "I couldn't be more pleased," commented trainer Murray Johnson. "One more work to go and we're in good shape."

GII Illinois Derby hero **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) had his second work since switching barns after his Apr. 6 victory at Sportsman's Park. The nearly black colt stopped the clock in 1:12.40 for his six-furlong breeze, galloping out in 1:26. "I thought he went nice, very good," said new trainer Bob Baffert. "We're just happy to be in the show. He will probably work again next Tuesday, something real easy, depending on the weather." Jockey Victor Espinoza will have the Derby mount aboard The Thoroughbred Corp.'s colorbearer.

#### FEEL THE LOVE

Jockey Jorge Chavez had a simple plan when he rode **Kim Loves Bucky** (Green Dancer) to a two-length victory in yesterday's 1 1/2-miles GIII Elkhorn S. at Keeneland. "He was rating nicely a few lengths behind," Chavez said of the five-year-old gelding, "and when I couldn't hold him any more, I let go." Chavez "let go" around the final turn and **Kim Loves Bucky** responded, first overtaking longtime leader **Craigsteel (GB)** (Suave Dancer) and then drawing clear down the lane for the first graded stakes victory of his career. **Kim Loves Bucky** won a 1 1/2-miles allowance at Keeneland in October 2000, but in his only start this year, the bay gelding was fifth over the track and distance Apr. 6. "He's all heart," said trainer John Glenney, also earning his first graded stakes victory. "Nothing tops this." Favored **Cetewayo** (His Majesty) rallied three wide into the stretch and made only modest gains late to finish third.

## OAKS OUTLOOK

Preparing for next Friday's GI Kentucky Oaks, **Habitbi** (Tabasco Cat) breezed three-quarters in 1:13.40 accompanied by stablemate Danthebluegrassman (Pioneering). "It was all right," said trainer Bob Baffert. "This track, you need to catch it early or right after the break, and today it was a little chewed up by the time she got out there."

Triple Grade I-winning **You** (You and I) breezed the same distance in a bullet 1:13.20. "From what I saw, she looked pretty good," said trainer Bobby Frankel, who won last year's renewal with Flute. "She doesn't take much. She has been away six weeks, so I think she's right on right now."

Heroine of the GI Bonnie Miss. S., **Ms Brookski** (Montbrook) breezed five-eighths in 1:00.60 yesterday morning in advance of the Kentucky Oaks. "Two horses broke off seven lengths in front of her and that wasn't expected," explained trainer Niall O'Callaghan. "Then another horse hooked up with her at the half, so it was four horses. She was four wide and she did it all very nicely. She doesn't seem to get upset about anything and I couldn't have planned it any better."

## GUINEAS FIELDS HAVE SOLID LOOK

Officials at Newmarket racecourse were yesterday anticipating a strong line-up for their mile Classics that take centre stage next weekend. With 40 horses standing their ground for the £300,000 G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas on Saturday, including Aidan O'Brien's **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) and **Hawk Wing** (Woodman), the colt's Classic has the appearance of a vintage renewal. O'Brien has left 12 of his original 20 entries in the mile contest, including **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill). Sir Michael Stoute, who trains G3 Craven S. winner **King of Happiness** (Spinning World), also has **Comfy** (Lear Fan) and Bragadino (GB) (Zilzal) engaged, while Saeed bin Suroor has left six in the race, including **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}), **Meshaheer** (Nureyev) and **Dubai Destination** (Kingmambo). Andre Fabre is set to be represented by the unbeaten **Massalani (Fr)** (Ashkalani {Ire}), who beat fellow entry **Ziping (Ire)** (Zafonic) in the Listed Prix Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 8. **Love Regardless** (Storm Bird), from the Mark Johnston stable, and Richard Hannon's G3 Greenham S. winner **Redback (GB)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) are other notable entries remaining after the latest forfeit stage. Mick Channon's **Queen's Logic (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) heads the list of 31 fillies left in the £300,000 Sagitta 1000 Guineas the following day, alongside Luca Cumani's **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). Henry Cecil, who has won the race six times, has left in **Half Glance (GB)** (Danehill) and **Protectress (GB)** (Hector Protector). Marcus Tregoning's G3 Nell Gwyn S. winner **Misterah (GB)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) and fourth Alasha (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) are other notables, as is Aidan O'Brien's **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Saeed bin Suroor has two remaining entries in **Silent Honor (Ire)** (Sunday Silence) and **Kazzia (Ger)** (Zinaad {GB}). France may be represented by **Danseuse d'Etoile (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}) and Listed Prix Imprudence winner **Glia** (A.P. Indy).

### LOVE PLEASES JOHNSTON

Mark Johnston, trainer of G1 2000 Guineas winner Mister Baileys (GB) in 1994, has declared **Love Regardless** (Storm Bird) on target for this year's Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4. The Newcastle maiden winner, who is as low as 8-1 for the mile Classic, galloped with three stable companions at Ripon on Sunday. "I was delighted with the gallop--Mister Baileys went to Thirsk two weeks before the race and Ripon a week before the race and this time, I think we have much better horses," said Johnston. "It was a very, very good gallop and I would probably have been happy to call it a day at that and go straight to the Guineas, but [jockey] Kevin [Darley] felt he was still just a bit green. The colt didn't know what to do when he got to the front, so we are going to repeat it again this weekend. It is a big gamble to take a horse from a maiden race to the Guineas and I don't for a moment underestimate the odds against winning the Guineas, but we've made this decision and there's no doubt he's a very, very good horse. If he runs well, then he's in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas [at The Curragh May 25] and G1 St James' Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 18] and there'll be another day for him."

**APPEALING DAY THREE AT OBS** A colt by Appealing Skier attracted an offer of \$155,000 from Yusuf Mongroo to top the third session at the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Spring Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training. The Florida-bred bay, consigned by Halcyon Hammock Farm as agent, had breezed a quarter in :21 2/5 last week, the co-fastest time of the day. In all, 161 head sold for \$3,916,200, compared to 165 selling for \$4,480,400 in 2001. The average and median were also down slightly, but the buy-back percentage improved, checking in at 28.4 percent this year, compared to 33.1 percent in 2001. **JOSTLE RETIRED** Jostle (Brocco)'s return to the races has ended; the five-year-old has been retired and bred to Storm Cat. A dual Grade I winner at three, the dark bay had been purchased for \$1.7 million at Keeneland November by Pete Whitman for WinStar Farm. She made one start this season for trainer Elliott Walden, finishing third in the Banshee Breeze H. at Gulfstream Apr. 5. "She came out of the race fine, and we were pleased with the way she ran," WinStar president Doug Cauthen told *The Blood Horse*. "We had planned to run her one more time before breeding her, but she was cycling, and we had a season open to Storm Cat." Jostle earned \$1,389,932 while capturing eight of 20 career starts, including the GI Coaching Club American Oaks and the GI Alabama S.

**EXTENDED MEET ENDS AT GULFSTREAM** The 90-day meeting at Gulfstream Park concluded yesterday, with track president and general manager Scott Savin remaining optimistic amid opinions that this year's meet was not as high-profile as in the past. "Gulfstream's 2002 season was successful considering the prevalence of severe negative external factors including a weak tourist season in South Florida, a national recession and a shortage of Thoroughbreds," Savin said in a statement released yesterday. "Magna Entertainment Corp. [owner of Gulfstream] is dedicated to quality live racing and is making a substantial investment to further that goal by building the Palm Meadows Training Center at Boynton Beach. We are looking forward to the opening of Palm Meadows later this year." Total attendance for the 90-day meeting was 842,319, for a daily average of 9,359; total on-track handle was \$149,946,481 for a daily average of \$1,666,072. Gulfstream did not release comparative statistics for 2001, when the track held a 63-day meeting.

**FUTURE BET FOR BREEDERS' CUP** The National Thoroughbred Racing Association has announced that Breeders' Cup Future Bet wagering will be offered on the eight races that make up the Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships, which will take place Oct. 26 at Arlington Park. The wagering will be conducted during four weekends in 2002, with up to three Breeders' Cup races open for betting each weekend. Each race will offer pari-mutuel pools of 23 runners, plus one field entry consisting of all horses not in the body of 23 for each respective pool. Two separate pools will be offered for the Breeders' Cup Classic, Distaff and Sprint, while one pool each will be offered for the other five races. All bets will be win only with a minimum wager of \$2.00

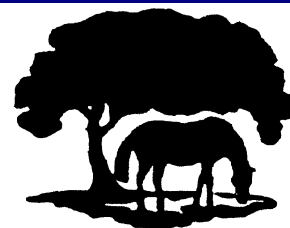
