

PORTRAIT OF A LADY

Europe kicks off the Group 1 season with the G1 Prix Ganay this afternoon at Longchamp, featuring the return of last year's French Classic winners **Aquarelliste (Fr)** (Danehill), who made her career debut last year on the Ganay undercard; and **Anabaa Blue (GB)** (Anabaa). Just a week after the latter had battled to success in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby), Aquarelliste stormed to success in the fillies' equivalent (G1 Prix de Diane Hermes) at Chantilly. In terms of what followed, trainer Elie Lellouche's filly exceeded Anabaa Blue as she maintained a high level of form in her final two starts. Those came in the G1 Prix Vermeille in September and the 12-furlong G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe over this track. In the former, she beat Diamilina (Fr) by a short neck, then met her match when six lengths back in second to Sakhee in the Arc itself. Nevertheless, she had **Sagacity (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}), Golan (Ire), Milan (GB), Hightori (Fr), Egyptband and Anabaa Blue behind her that afternoon, underlining her class. She must contend with a drop back to the Diane trip here, but showed she did not lack for speed when taking that Classic and the Listed Prix Melisande at Chantilly over 10 furlongs last May. Anabaa Blue was subsequently disappointing when seventh in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot the following month. He found Golan too strong when second in the G2 Prix Niel here in September before his poor ninth in the Arc. He needs to improve, as does Sagacity, who was disappointing when 13th behind Nayef in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23. The chief danger to Aquarelliste may be **Execute (Fr)** (Suave Dancer), who is finally fulfilling his considerable promise this year. He was a smooth 3/4-length winner from Sunstrach (Ire) in the G2 Prix d'Hocquart here last time Mar. 31 and is highly effective at this trip. *Ganay field, p6*

SUANCES BY THE BAY

Continuing his remarkable comeback, **Suances (GB)** (Most Welcome {GB}) seized command soon after the start on his way to winning the GII San Francisco Breeders' Cup at Bay Meadows yesterday afternoon. The British-bred bay had started his career in Spain, winning four of five starts, and successfully carried that form to France, where he captured the G1 Prix Jean Prat by six lengths from Bach (Ire) as a three-year-old in 2000. Purchased by U.S.

interests, Suances was set to run in the GII American Derby at Arlington Park, but sliced his leg on a steel door in the quarantine barn and was forced to the sidelines. "It's been a long time, baby," trainer Darrell Vienna told *Daily Racing Form* in March. "He sliced some ligaments in his leg. It was in an area that would bend, and it would break open again. He missed maybe a year." He was off nearly two years and returned in the GII Explosive Bid H. Mar. 24 at Fair Grounds, finishing 10th, just 4 3/4 lengths behind **Sarafan** (Lear Fan). With that effort under his belt, the 7-2 shot went up to set the pace, rating kindly under jockey David Flores through a half in :48.31 over the firm turf course. His three challengers--even-money **Decarchy** (Distant View), **The Tin Man** (Affirmed) and Sarafan--came after him turning for home, but Suances had plenty left in the tank and came home one length clear of the blanket finish for second. "I was surprised nobody pushed me early," Flores said. "He relaxed much better today than he did in New Orleans. I hit him a couple of times left-handed, but we could have gone another eighth of a mile and they would not catch me. He looks like he could be a good mile horse or maybe even go a little further." As for Decarchy, who got the photo for second, jockey Kent Desormeaux said, "The last quarter we all set it down and were motoring. But I couldn't even get to the tail of the winner. That horse ran wild." *Chart, p2*

With the defection of both **Tough Speed (Miswaki)** and **Olden Times (GB) (Darshaan {GB})** due to the overnight rain, this contest lost much of its luster. It was left to **Swallow Flight** to take advantage of their absence with a game display for his fourth career stakes success. **Geoff Wragg's** six-year-old is very much a spring and early summer horse, with his performances when third in the G1 **Lockinge S.** at **Newbury** last May and second in the G2 **Queen Anne S.** at **Royal Ascot** in June--he was third in the 2000 renewal--easily his best. He was unlucky last time when hemmed in on the rail in the Listed **Doncaster Mile Mar. 21**, and with that in mind jockey **Darryll Holland** kept him to the outer in second early as **Priors Lodge (Ire) (Grand Lodge)** took them along. Taking command passing the quarter-mile marker, he had to battle to ward off the attentions of **Cape Town**, who was keen in the early stages, but pulled out more for his jockey's urging to secure his most important success to date. "He's much better this year than he has ever been," said **Geoff Wragg**. Both winner and runner-up will meet again in the G1 **Juddmonte Lockinge S.** at **Newbury** May 18 before a possible crack at the G2 **Queen Anne S.** at **Royal Ascot** June 18.

Sky Terrace won his first two career starts, then stepped into the graded-stakes ranks and was a solid fourth behind Repent in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. in the Churchill slop last November. The bay made his sophomore debut in the Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds Jan. 26 and finished second, just a nose behind Easyfromthegitgo. But the colt had not fared as well in his two most recent outings, running eighth to Repent in the Feb. 17 GIII Risen Star S. and third, but beaten 6 1/2 lengths by Cashel Castle in the Apr. 7 GIII Lafayette S. at Keeneland. Looking to turn the tables with an additional furlong here, Sky Terrace went right to the front and showed his mud-tied tail to his rivals all the way to the wire, edging clear late for a decisive score. "This winter at the Fair Grounds, we thought this colt was best suited for a one-turn mile," winning jockey Craig Parret said, but added, "Down the road, he might be able to handle two turns." That chance could come in the second leg of the Triple Crown. Trainer Vickie Foley said the Kentucky Derby is not in the cards, but the May 18 GI Preakness is a possibility. Cashel Castle, who came into the race with a perfect five-for-five record, was tucked in along the rail early and failed to threaten when wheeled out for the stretch drive, settling for second. "He just wouldn't give all that he is capable of," jockey Pat Day said. "I don't think he had any confidence in the track. He felt fine and pulled up fine, he just couldn't handle that track."

Pyrus led nearly every step in winning his first stakes as favorite Sharp Performance (Kris S.) broke down inside the final sixteenth (*see p8*). Originally trained by Aidan O'Brien in Ireland, the dark bay colt debuted victoriously in the Listed Marble Hill S. at The Curragh as a two-year-old and followed that up with a second in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood. He concluded his Irish campaign with a fifth in Deauville's G1 Prix Morny in August 2000. He made his U.S. bow on the dirt at Gulfstream last March, finishing eighth, and didn't make another racecourse appearance until Jan. 31, where he led every step in winning a turf allowance at the Hallandale oval. He duplicated that effort over the same course Mar. 10 going nine furlongs and was well regarded as the third choice in this stakes appearance. Away alertly, Pyrus went straight to the front under a tight hold by Edgar Prado. He turned for home with a narrow advantage and dug in gamely as he was headed by Sharp Performance passing the eighth pole. Pyrus maintained his momentum when that colt was pulled up and secured his third straight victory. "I thought it would be a good race; unfortunately, that horse got hurt," said Prado. "It takes the flavor out of the win." Trainer Elliott Walden indicated that Pyrus would now head to Kentucky and would have a campaign mapped out for him later. Chancellor led from pillar-to-post to clinch his second stakes success under an enterprising ride from Michael Hills. It was in May last year that he outbattled Asian Heights (GB) in the G3 Classic Trial over this track on heavy ground before finishing 10th in the G1 Epsom Derby in June on much livelier going. He returned to finish a length second to Masterful in the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville in August before finishing fifth in the Listed Dubai Arc Trial in September. He was beaten a head by Albarahin in the G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp in desperate conditions before disappointing when 11th in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket in October. Here, he was taken to the front early by jockey Michael Hills, quickened turning into the straight and stayed won well to deny the game Border Arrow.

 Following stablemate Suances (GB)'s victory at Bay Meadows, Queen of Wilshire gave trainer Darrell Vienna his second graded stakes win of the afternoon with her game front-running performance in the GIII Hawthorne H. The chestnut mare had been running on the turf in her last six starts and was entered in Friday's GIII Wilshire H. on grass, but was scratched out of that race in favor of this spot. She had been beaten a neck in the GII Buena Vista H. Feb. 18 and was most recently second in the Miss America H. at Bay Meadows Apr. 7. Breaking alertly from her rail post, the six-year-old assumed her customary place on the front end and opened up by three lengths through a half in :47.31. She drifted out a bit in the stretch, allowing Alexine to challenge her from the inside, but hung in tenaciously for a narrow victory. "I was able to dictate the pace," said winning rider Patrick Valenzuela. "She responded very well when Gary Stevens' horse [Alexine] came to her. She tried again, because I think Gary had the momentum to pass me at the wire. But my mare picked it up when Gary got there, and she held her spot." Jockey Chris McCarron, who had ridden the last five winners of the Hawthorne, lost a chance to establish a North American record when his mount, morning-line favorite Ask Me No Secrets (Seattle Slew), was scratched yesterday morning with an unspecified physical ailment.

Warningford got the overnight rain he needed and duly took this contest with a last-to-first flourish. Now eight, James Fanshawe's pupil shows little sign of stopping over this specialist distance. Last year, he took this event in similar fashion when it was run at Newmarket before finishing a neck runner-up to Medicean (GB) in the G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury 15 days later. Fourth in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp in September, he held his form with a fine third in both the G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket and G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp in October. Looking for the repeat in this year's edition, Warningford swept to the front with a furlong remaining as the early leader Red Carpet faltered and the weight concession found out the game Atavus, before comfortably holding off the former's rally in the closing stages. "He was well suited by the conditions here and we wanted to run him as we want to go for the Lockinge again," said Fanshawe. "He's an eight-year-old, but he hasn't got any slower--we are looking for a horse that can go past him at home." The 11-10 favorite, Tamburlaine (Ire) (Royal Academy) was almost pulled up in the closing stages and was found to have broken a blood vessel.

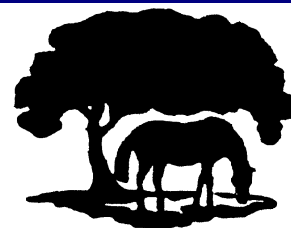

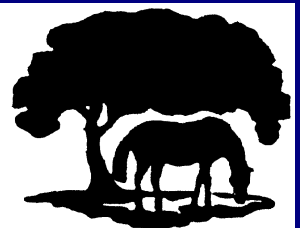

BETTING SHOPS FACE BLACK-OUT Britain's betting shops will be without pictures and sound beginning Wednesday after negotiations between the Racecourse and Confederation of Bookmaker Associations broke down Friday. With no agreement reached over licenses for the transmission of live pictures from the majority of British tracks to betting shops, bookmakers will only be able to show racing televised on terrestrial networks. "I'm afraid unless they buy the rights alongside the pictures, they will not have audio feed other than from terrestrial races," said RCA Chief Executive Stephen Atkin. "It was very disappointing when the meeting broke up. We'd have liked to have carried on and we are certainly willing to talk to the bookmakers again before next Wednesday, but unless we can resolve that problem, there will be no pictures in the shops."
