

PICTURE PERFECT IN PRIX GANAY

Aquarelliste (Fr) (Danehill) followed the script in Europe's first Group 1 event of the 2002 calendar, denying the fast-finishing **Execute (Fr)** (Suave Dancer) by a half-length as the 4-5 favourite in yesterday's G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp. Drama unfolded at the start of the Prix Ganay as **Sagacity (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}) lurched violently left out of the stalls before refusing to race. Aquarelliste was settled in second early. Always travelling well behind front-running **Anabaa Blue (GB)** (Anabaa), she swept to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and gave more inside the final 100 yards to hold off Execute. "At first, watching the race, I was quite disappointed about how things were going as I wanted Dominique Boeuf to wait with her," trainer Elie Lellouche said, "However, they were going slow and that's the way it went. Anyway, she showed that she had lost none of her quality and fighting spirit and showed she had improved since last year." (*Prix Ganay, cont. p2*)

WITH ABILITY SETS SAIL AT SPORTSMAN'S

Fresh off an impressive front-running victory in the GIII Next Move H. at Aqueduct Mar. 29, **With Ability** (A.P. Indy) shipped to Chicago and made it two graded stakes in a row with a handy score in yesterday's GIII Sixty Sails H. at Sportsman's Park. The speedy four-year-old went right to the lead once again and was never headed, pulling away in the final furlong as the 2-1 second choice. "I went to the lead so easily," winning jockey Javier Castellano said. "But this is my first time riding [at Sportsman's] and I was surprised [by the length of the stretch].



When I turned for home, I said, 'oh my God, I don't see the finish line.' But I asked my filly in the last part and she responded. I have a lot of confidence in her." Even-money **Pompeii** (Broad Brush), winner of the GI Personal Ensign H. last summer, showed little in her first start since an 11th-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff and ended up fourth. "I don't think she cared for the track," jockey Pat Day said. (*Chart, p2*)

HOPE FOR SHARP PERFORMANCE

Four-year-old **Sharp Performance** (Kris S.), injured during his seventh-place finish in Saturday's GIII Fort Marcy H. at Aqueduct, was resting comfortably in his stall at Belmont Park yesterday morning, but the colt is not out of the woods yet. "He has severe soft tissue damage in both front legs," trainer Dave Donk said. "We X-rayed him and there was no damage to his sesamoids. His class is starting to come out. He's been a good patient. I'm hoping we'll be able to fit him with braces. We've got a long way to go. This is definitely life-threatening. Hopefully we can save him as a stallion." The Kentucky-bred has won four of his seven career starts, including the GIII Lexington S. and GIII Lawrence Realization H. at three. He was also third, beaten only a half-length, in last year's GI Secretariat S. His career earnings stand at \$279,780.

Buddha Sharp in Belmont Slop:

GI Wood Memorial winner **Buddha** (Unbridled's Song) worked six furlongs in 1:13.42 around the "dogs" on a sloppy Belmont Park training track yesterday morning. In his final workout before the May 4 GI Kentucky Derby, the three-year-old galloped out the seven furlongs in 1:29. "It started raining at 10 to 2 this morning and I was out of bed by 2," trainer Jim Bond said. "He went out at about 5:30. It was a superb work. He couldn't have done it any better. He looks good and is feeling good." The colt will fly to Kentucky today.

Tempera to Miss Oaks:

Last year's champion two-year-old filly **Tempera** (A.P. Indy) will miss the May 3 GI Kentucky Oaks after contracting a fever Saturday. The Godolphin colorbearer spent Saturday night at a veterinary clinic in Lexington, but was expected to be back at her barn at Churchill Downs late yesterday. Tom Albertrani, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor, said. "Hopefully we will have her back at Belmont this spring and summer and go from there."

It's all in the chase, Wild Horses Work at Churchill:

While several trainers postponed planned pre-Derby works yesterday, Wilson Brown decided to move up the final prep for his Triple Crown hopeful. **It's all in the chase** (Take Me Out) drilled five furlongs in 1:01.60 after cutting out fractions of :12.60, :24.80, :37 and :49; he galloped out six furlongs in 1:14 over a Churchill Downs strip labeled "muddy." "The track was nice and tight and he handled it real well," jockey Eddie Martin Jr., who was aboard for the breeze, said. He added, "I know this colt has stamina, I know he's feeling good and I know he likes this track. It's a wide-open race and I think we've got a shot." The bay, third in the GII Louisiana Derby, comes off a ninth-place finish in the Apr. 13 GII Arkansas Derby.

Wild Horses (Saint Ballado) didn't head out for his workout until after the 8 a.m. renovation break. With the track labeled "good," the Arkansas Derby runner-up went his five-eighths in 1:01.20, with a final half in :48. "I think the track was probably a bit faster before the break," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "They ran the harrows over it and deepened it a bit. But he handled it fine and we're very pleased with how he's coming up to the race."

ANOTHER TILT AT THE ARC? Aquarelliste

(Danehill) has been beaten only once, finishing second to the mighty Sakhee in last October's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and earned a rating of 120 pounds as champion European middle-distance filly in the 2001 International Classifications. After starting her career in a conditions event on this card last April, she made light work of the Listed Prix Melisande the following month, a display that took her to the head of the market for the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes three weeks later. She did not disappoint her supporters, outpointing the tough Nadia (GB) by 1 1/2 lengths. The filly followed with a win in the G1 Prix Vermeille, filling the late Daniel Wildenstein with ambition that she could carry his colours to yet another Arc success. Tragically, her owner did not live to witness her top-class performance in that event. Six lengths separated her and the world's 2001 heavyweight Sakhee there, but she established herself as a force for the future and was kept in training with an Arc win as her ultimate aim. As for her path to the 2002 Arc, trainer Elie Lellouche said, "She will now be rested until the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud [June 30], as we want to campaign her lightly in the first part of the season. We want to bring her back here fresh for the G2 Prix Foy [Sept. 15] and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [Oct. 6], and then we'll see about the major international races later in the year."

She may have been dismissed at odds of over 12-1, but Ana Marie had what it took to win this trial for the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes at Chantilly June 9 after a thrilling tussle with Bright Sky. Although she is a consistent filly, she had failed to get her head in front before this competitive contest, her best effort coming when third behind Summertime Legacy (GB) (Darshaan {GB}) in the G3 Prix des Reservoirs at Deauville last October. Fourth in the slowly run Listed Prix Finlande here Apr. 7, the bay had plenty of catching up to do with Bright Sky, the runner-up there. However, she was helped by that filly's pacemaker Atlantique (Ire) (Alzao) in this true test of stamina, traveling strongly in the early stages off the honest tempo carved out by that rabbit. Full of run at the top of the straight, Ana Marie took a while to reach top gear when asked by jockey Davy Bonilla, but eventually stretched out to grab the lead at the furlong marker. She looked as if she would be caught by the fast-finishing Bright Sky under a drive from Dominique Boeuf, but found more in a gutsy display to hold on. Mariensky was another eyecatcher in third, quickening impressively from behind despite the contest being already won up front. Philippe Demercastel said, "I have always thought this filly was nice and that's why although she's still a maiden I have kept running her in this class. Last time out she ran on the middle course here and was caught for speed all the way. Today the pacemaker ensured a truly-run race and she was able to show her true colours. She will now head straight to the Prix de Diane."

Balthazar was heavily campaigned in the spring of his three-year-old career and was a creditable third behind Maille Pistol (Fr) in the G2 Prix Hocquart here last May. Given time to fulfill his potential afterwards, he showed the benefit of that patience by taking the Listed Prix Right Royal at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 8 with a dominating display of front-running. "He was a nice horse last year but he was not mature and this year he has really come around and got much stronger," trainer Alain Lyon explained. Taken to the front again here by Davy Bonilla, he always had the measure of his pursuers and kicked away to an insurmountable lead turning into the final straight. Despite the late headway made by the heavily-penalised Generic and Raphael Marchelli, he was always in control and maintained his advantage all the way to the line. "He has continued to rise up the scale, from Listed success to Group 3, so his next step will be the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier here May 19," the winning conditioner added.

Maranilla is bound for the G1 Derby Italiano in Rome May 26 following this impressive performance. Although he beat some of the best German three-year-olds here, his fate does not lie in the Deutsches Derby. Trainer Eoghan O'Neill explained, "I didn't have the horse early on as a two-year-old so I never had the chance to enter him for the German Derby, so the Italian was the only one I could have entered him in." Having raced in France at the tail end of last year, Maranilla captured the Listed Prix du Languedoc at Toulouse in December and showed here that he has improved since then with a fluent display in the drying conditions. Settled in third on the rail early as Sergeant Pepper was taken to the front by Lennart Hammer-Hansen, the bay colt quickened impressively off the turn into the straight before grabbing the lead with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. Ridden out from there, he was never in danger despite a late run from Whispered Secret. O'Neill continued, "We knew we could sit where we wanted and the plan was to kick before the bend which was the making and breaking of the race. Everything fell in his favour here and he's a very very good horse who will be competitive in the Derby. I might run him in the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial (May 11) before he goes to Rome, but I'll see how he comes back. He even ran a bit green today and he's just getting better and better. He's out of the top drawer."

Mount Intrepid hadn't won since a late-closing allowance score over this strip back on Dec. 13. Following that triumph, the chestnut recorded a second and two fourth-place finishes in three route trips, the most recent coming Apr. 6 when he closed well, but finished just out of the money. Gaining only mild support at 5-1 for this try, he raced close to the pace through the first half-mile, gathered momentum exiting the backstretch, came four-wide with a strong bid to engage 3-5 favorite Gander at the quarter pole and battled that foe to the wire to score by a nose. Gander, winner of the GII Meadowlands Cup H. and ninth in the GI Breeder's Cup Classic last fall, was game on the rail and had a nose in front in the final yards, but settled for the place. Winning trainer Howie Teshler remarked, "Is he a great horse? No. Is he a good New York-bred? Definitely. I thought we had Gander, but that horse fought back. I think we won the tougher division." Jockey Norberto Arroyo Jr. said of his winning ride, "I didn't even hit my horse the last sixteenth. I didn't realize how close it was till I watched the replay." John Terranova, trainer of the beaten favorite Gander said, "Johnny [Velazquez] said he lost some of his action when he went over the tire tracks in the stretch. I don't think he likes Aqueduct as much as Belmont."

He's gone from claimer to stakes winner in only three starts, though the amount of time it took Compelling World to make the transformation was almost a year and a half. Claimed for \$75,000 in the fall of 2000 after a maiden-breaking performance at Belmont, the colt was then sidelined for seven months before winning against statebred allowance rivals in early April of 2001. It was nearly a year before the colt made it three in a row with another restricted allowance score at six furlongs Mar. 30. Going two turns for the first time, the dark bay got away slowly and sat in last place through three-quarters before unleashing a furious run in the stretch that propelled him to an impressive victory over a sloppy track.
