

### TEMPERA EUTHANIZED

Last year's champion two-year-old filly **Tempera** (A.P. Indy) was humanely euthanized Sunday evening at the Hagyard-Davidson-McGee Veterinary Clinic in Lexington after developing colitis and laminitis. The Godolphin

colorbearer, who was being prepared for the GI Kentucky Oaks, came down with a fever Friday and was sent to the clinic Saturday. "It is hard to believe, but her condition went so bad in 24 hours they couldn't do anything to help her," Tom Albertrani, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor, said. The winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and GII Sorrento S. at two, **Tempera** had started twice this season, finishing second in both the UAE 1000 Guineas and the UAE

Oaks. In all, the dark bay had three wins, two seconds and two thirds from her seven career starts for earnings of \$770,240. Trainer Eoin Harty, who guided the filly through her juvenile campaign, said, "I am devastated. One minute I thought she had a temperature and would miss the Oaks and here it is 48 hours later and she's dead. It's all very sudden. She was the horse that put the [Godolphin] two-year-old program on the map and showed the world what Sheikh Mohammed's goals are with his two-year-olds. She's the one that did it for us; she was a very special filly." Simon Crisford, racing manager for Godolphin, added, "It's a tragic loss, it's so sad that her life was so short. What a brilliant filly she was when she won the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies...it was one of the greatest moments for Godolphin with the 1-2 in that race. She was a very sweet-natured filly and she's going to be a great loss to the stud and Sheikh Mohammed's broodmare band."

#### Top Contenders Get Their Finals Works:

GI Santa Anita Derby winner **Came Home** (Gone

West) had his final Kentucky Derby prep yesterday morning, going five furlongs in 1:00.60 under jockey Chris McCarron.

The once-beaten colt galloped out six furlongs in 1:13.20. "He went very well," McCarron said. "He felt good going across the ground. He showed us good signs. This is a determined colt with a lot of try in him."

Also stretching his legs under the Twin Spires yesterday, **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) went six furlongs in 1:13.80 after cruising through splits of :24, :36, :48.60 and 1:01.60. The dark bay galloped out seven-eighths in 1:28.20. Jockey Marco Ramirez, aboard the Bobby Frankel trainee for the move, said, "He felt good-he likes this track."

Trainer Steve Asmussen sent his Derby duo, GII Arkansas Derby hero **Private Emblem** (Our Emblem) and **Windward Passage** (Captain Bodgit), who dead-heated for third in the race, out for workouts yesterday. **Windward Passage** went a half in :48.60, galloping out five-eighths in 1:02.40. A half hour later, his stablemate went the same distance in :48.80, but galloped out in a sprightly 1:01.80. "I'm pleased with the way they are getting over the track," Asmussen said. "Both horses are handling their surrpondings. In his last work, **Private Emblem** was noticing things in the infield and not really paying attention. Since then, he's acted like he knows where he's going."

**Saarland** (Unbridled), fully recovered from minor throat surgery, worked five furlongs in 1:02, dashing through the final eighth in :11 and change before galloping out six furlongs in 1:15.60. He will be the first Derby starter for trainer Shug McGaughey since Easy Goer finished second in 1989.

**Proud Citizen** (Gone West), winner of the GII Coolmore Lexington S. last time out, zipped five furlongs in :58.80 when the Churchill strip first opened yesterday morning. "He looked fine and everything went smooth," trainer D. Wayne Lukas said...Santa Anita Derby runner-up **Easy Grades** (Honor Grades), working after the break, went five-eighths in 1:01.40. Jockey Jorge Chavez, who rode Monarchos to victory in Derby 127, was in the irons...**Lusty Latin** (El Prado {Ire}) also went five panels, going the distance in 1:01. "I let him do his own thing early and then, turning for home, I kind of clucked to him and let him stretch on out down the lane and he finished up real well," jockey Glenn Corbett said...**Blue Burner** (French Deputy) clicked off his five furlongs in a shap :59 flat. "I wanted to put a decent work into him and I got what I wanted," trainer Bill Mott said...**Sunday Break (Jpn)** (Forty Niner), third in the GI Wood Memorial last time and still hoping for a Derby berth, went six furlongs in 1:14.40. "He was spot on," trainer Neil Drysdale said.

**Take the Cake Drills for Oaks:**

**Take the Cake** (Fly So Free), third in the GI Ashland S. last time out, worked five furlongs in 1:01.60 yesterday at Churchill Downs as her final prep for Friday's GI Kentucky Oaks. "She's ready," trainer Carl Nafzger said. "She came off the track looking great, just the way she's supposed to." Nafzger is still undecided as to whether to run **Belterra** (Unbridled) in the Oaks. The filly underwent throat surgery Apr. 8. "The question I keep asking myself is if she's 110-percent fit, which you have to be to run in the Oaks," he said. "If she's not completely ready, a race like that could set her back six or eight weeks. I'd love to go, but I don't know right now."

**Equality Breezes at Delaware Park:**

He won't be running in the Kentucky Derby, but **Equality** (Mt. Livermore), a possible for the May 18 GI Preakness S., worked five furlongs in 1:00.80 at Delaware Park yesterday morning. The three-year-old, winner of the GIII Tampa Bay Derby, comes off a second-place finish in the Apr. 6 Aventura S. at Gulfstream Park. "I thought his work went super," trainer Graham Motion said. Explaining why he is waiting for the second leg of the Triple Crown, Motion said, "The Derby is probably the toughest race in the world to win. We also felt he might not be quite ready at this time. The Preakness will give him a little more time and it is not quite such a mad house."

**Ballydoyle Duo Fly Out:**

**Johannesburg** (Hennessy) and **Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West) fly out to Keeneland today to begin their quarantine ahead of their GI Kentucky Derby bids at Churchill Downs on Saturday. Jockey arrangements have yet to be announced for the pair, although Jerry Bailey and Gary Stevens were named by O'Brien yesterday, as he told the *Racing Post*, "Jerry Bailey will ride one and Gary Stevens is a possible for the other, but we haven't yet decided who will ride which."

**Comfy Withdrawn from Guineas:**

Sir Michael Stoute's **Comfy** (Lear Fan) was the most notable withdrawal from Saturday's G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas S. at Newmarket at the five-day entry stage yesterday. The absence of Listed Acomb S. winner Comfy, quoted at 20-1 by Coral Eurobet before being taken out of the mile Classic, as well as the Henry Cecil-trained **Western Verse** (Gone West)--also withdrawn yesterday--means that Khalid Abdullah will be without a runner in either of the two Classics. Also pulled out at yesterday's confirmation stage was Roger Charlton's **Tikkun (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), leaving a list of 29 colts still engaged in the £300,000 contest. Aidan O'Brien is responsible for nine of those, including the 6-4 ante-post favourite **Hawk Wing** (Woodman), and he is likely to confirm jockey arrangements mid-week. Godolphin have left in four colts, headed by **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}), but have withdrawn long-time doubtful **Dubai Destination** (Kingmambo). In the fillies' equivalent 23 remain, but Richard Gibson has taken out **Danseuse d'Etoile (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}), while Pascal Bary has left in **Glia** (A.P. Indy), although she is more likely to stay at home for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 12.

**VAL ROYAL TO SOUTH AFRICA** GI Breeders' Cup Mile hero **Val Royal (Fr)** (Royal Academy--Vadlava {Fr}, by Bikala {Ire}), retired after his fifth-place finish in the Mar. 23 G1 Dubai Duty Free H., will stand at Odessa Farm in South Africa, the *Thoroughbred Times* reports. The six-year-old was recently jointly purchased by Maine Chance Farm and Odessa Farm. A winner of seven of his 12 career starts, he goes to the breeding shed with earnings of \$1,186,687. In addition to his Breeders' Cup score, the bay also captured the GII Del Mar Derby, GII Oak Tree Breeders' Cup Mile, G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano, G3 Prix de Guiche and the Listed Prix Matchem. A stud fee has not yet been set.

## PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

During the first two years of the 'noughties,' there were plenty of Grade I winners in the U.S. and Europe which were inbred within the first four generations to Northern Dancer. There were also several inbred to Hail to Reason, among others, and even two with two lines of Caro.

Bearing in mind how deeply Raise a Native's blood permeates the American stud book, one might also have expected his name to be duplicated in the pedigrees of a significant number of this period's major winners. Surprisingly, though, there were only two inbred to this tremendous stallion, who founded a dynasty through the likes of Alydar, Exclusive Native, Majestic Prince and Mr. Prospector. Maybe it is the unsoundness which is almost synonymous with Raise a Native's name--or the fear of this unsoundness--which has limited the number of major winners bred this way.

I should quickly add that one of the two recent Grade I winners inbred to Raise a Native was none other than the outstanding Point Given, and that the previous Grade I winners inbred to him include champions Real Quiet and Anees. This type of mating can clearly pay enormous dividends, an excellent recent example being Proper Gamble, who improved her record to five wins and a second from seven starts when she narrowly landed the GII Stonerside Beaumont S. This daughter of Prospectors Gamble is inbred 4x3 to Raise a Native.

What is especially noteworthy about Proper Gamble's pedigree is that it also contains 4x3 inbreeding to In Reality. In Reality also appears in the pedigrees of Real Quiet (through Believe It), Point Given (through Relaunch) and Anees. Could it be that the toughness of In Reality--a horse who reached the first two in 23 of his 27 starts--helps stabilize the brilliance of Raise a Native, who burnt out after only four starts?

Of course, the Raise a Native male line has long enjoyed a fruitful relationship with mares with In Reality blood. Good examples are that admirable stallion Crafty Prospector and the Belmont S. hero Commendable, both sons of In Reality mares, while Unbridled and Chester House both have In Reality mares as their second dam.

Winning a Grade II has to be considered a considerable achievement for Proper Gamble, who appeared in Book 7 as Hip 4605 of the sale's 4650 yearlings, at Keeneland's September Sale in 2000. Proper Gamble must have done well after being bought for \$20,000 as a weanling because her price rose to \$80,000--more than three times the next-best price of \$25,000 paid for a Prospectors Gamble yearling that year.

The incentive to send her dam Bare It Properly to Crafty Prospector's son Prospectors Gamble in 1998 possibly owed something to the success enjoyed in 1997 by Crafty Prospector's son Crafty Friend. This accomplished miler is inbred 3x3 to Raise a Native.

Prospectors Gamble is now a resident of Wafare Farm in Kentucky, but he began his stallion career in 1991 in Florida, where he quickly established his ability to sire plenty of juvenile winners. He earned promotion to the Kentucky league by the summer of 1995, moving first to Pin Oak Stud. Whether he has justified the move to Kentucky is open to question. His only American graded winner prior to Proper Gamble was Bevo, one of the top juveniles of 1999, but his record has to be considered respectable for a Grade II winner whose best figure on the Blood-Horse Free Handicaps was the 113 he received at three and five years.

A \$6,000 yearling, Bare It Properly won only four small races, but she has some notable relatives. Tribal Hill, a half-sister to Bare It Properly, produced that good filly Aztec Hill, and Proper Gamble's second dam, Cypress Bearer, was a half-sister to the high-class Pine Circle. As her fourth dam is Classicist, Proper Gamble comes from the same family as Danzig Connection.

### TOP OF THE CLASS

by Bill Oppenheim

What's the ultimate class measurement of sire success? The commercial marketplace tells us which stallions command six-figure stud fees and seven-figure yearlings, but there has never been a defining statistic--one number--which we can look at and say, this is how good a sire is, and here is where he ranks among the top sires.

Progeny earnings in a year, or season, has always been the most popular standard, and topping one of those lists makes a horse the Champion Sire in that country, in that year--so, Bold Ruler was Champion Sire eight times in North America, Sadler's Wells has been 11 times champion sire in Britain and Ireland, etc. The cumulative average-earnings index has its adherents, too, and Marketwatch newsletter introduced an interesting variation on that statistic in its February 28 edition which does succeed in refining that rating.

This *TDN* Special Edition sees the introduction of a new sire rating statistic: an index of 'real-world' Gr. 1 and Gr. 2 winners/foals, based on racing of 1983-2001. Let's abbreviate that as G1/2 Index, and I need to just explain a couple of things about the statistic, and how it was derived, before revealing all.

The statistic was generated under the direction of Stew Winstandley of The Jockey Club Information Systems. I almost said "the long-suffering Stew Winstandley," because for about 15 years now, every time I call up with a new brainstorm, Stew threatens to retire. TJCIS performs an invaluable service, at least in my opinion, because their database and expertise at managing it enables people like me to ask questions that couldn't have been answered 20 years ago. So their information provided the starting point.

To make a long story shorter, they generated a list of

Gr. 1 and Gr. 2 winners since 1983, according to the cataloguing standards accepted by the industry. Those who have followed my work in stallion statistics over the years will be familiar with my contention that achieving accuracy for the objective of practical application usually means limiting the population in some way. Again I have done this, by throwing out about 20% of the Gr. 1 and Gr. 2 winners recognized by the industry. Over the years various countries--Peru and Panama are two examples--have had races recognized as being of the highest possible standard, when they patently are not. My revision of TJCIS' list comprises 4,080 individual horses who won Gr. 1 or Gr. 2 races from 1983-2001 in North America, Great Britain, Ireland, France, Germany, Italy, and, very recently, Hong Kong and the UAE. Japan is unfortunately not included, and all I can say is don't blame me, talk to the cataloguing standards committee.

Some might argue that an 'ultimate class measurement' should be based only on Gr. 1 winners. After much deliberation, I think not, and that's why Gr. 2 winners (in the right places) are included in this index statistic. Three reasons: one, the sample of Gr. 1 winners is too small for sire statistics based on them to be really meaningful; two, because some Gr. 2 races should be Gr. 1, and vice versa; and three, my analysis suggests Gr. 2 winners are markedly better than either Gr. 3 winners, or Gr. 1-placed horses. My argument is that, both statistically and practically, measuring Gr. 1 and Gr. 2 winners is the best available pointer to high-class sires.

Finally, why have we indexed the measurement rather than simply list sires' 1983-2001 percentage of G1/2 winners to foals? The answer again has to do with practical application, in two ways. To relate the statistic to currently active sires, I found that the per-

centage for 1,150 sires who had APEX ratings (as long as the majority of their foals aren't in Japan, as noted above) is 0.82% G1/2 winners to foals (covering racing 1983-2001). In other words, for the 1,150 sires selected as a representative sample group, about 1 of every 122 foals is a G1/2 winner. There are 403 of the 1,150 who have sired a G1/2 winner: for those sires, the G1/2 Index is their percentage of G1/2 winners, divided by 0.82. This enables us to truly assess the sire relative to his contemporaries, and has the added benefit of enabling comparisons with the APEX indices, which also involve class gradations, though based on earnings, and covering the period 1995-2001 rather than 1983-2001.

**DANZIG TOPS THE CHARTS**

That's the theory; then what do we learn in practice? The tables on the following pages list the top 50 sires on G1/2 Index, then all 403 sires who had both APEX ratings 1995-2001, and had sired a G 1/2 winner since 1983. Danzig tops the charts with an 8.20 G1/2 Index, which is 6.72% of his foals. He is one of eight sires with a G1/2 Index of 5.00+ . The top 10, as you can see from the accompanying table, are:

I would just add that, for each sire, you will see six columns of index figures. The four indices to the left represent class gradations, while the two right-hand columns are percentages of the two highest class gradations, A Runners and G1/2 winners. The G1/2 Index, and those two right-hand percentage figures, are based on racing from 1983-2001. The three left-hand indices--C, B, and A indices--are based on racing 1995-2001. Nonetheless, indexing the scales does give us some idea about a sire's performance as you go up the class ladder.
