FULL FIELD FOR DERBY 128

For the first time since 1984, a full field of 20 runners has been entered for the GI Kentucky Derby Saturday at Churchill Downs. Headlined by the 9-2 morning-line favorite **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan), it includes a trio of runners who had their Derby preps overseas--**Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West), **Essence of Dubai** (Pulpit) and **Johannesburg** (Hennessy)--and an 11th-hour entry from the barn of trainer Bob Baffert. Trainer Ken McPeck selected the last spot in the main gate, post 14, for Harlan's Holiday, winner of the GI Florida Derby and the

GI Toyota Blue Grass in his last two starts. Last year's two-year-old champion, Johannesburg has drawn the rail. He is 6-1 on the morning line, as is **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}), the GII San Felipe S. winner who will break from the nine hole. The Bobby Frankel-trained colt lost a squeaker last out to **Buddha** (Unbridled's Song) in the GI Wood Memorial. Buddha's connections had the first pick and chose post 10 for their grey three-year-old, who at 5-1 is the co-second choice with **Came Home** (Gone West) (post 15).

Three runners have been tabbed at 15-1: **Essence of Dubai**, post 8; **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer), post three; and **Saarland** (Unbridled), has drawn the 16th slot. **Full Field with Odds, p2**

Irish Eyes are Smiling

The two Ballydoyle runners, **Castle Gandolfo** and **Johannesburg**--arrived safely from Ireland Tuesday evening in Lexington, Kentucky and will be stabled at Keeneland for the quarantine period. "Both horses travelled well and seem in good form after their flight," said trainer Aidan O'Brien. "Hopefully they will clear quarantine on Thursday and we hope to do a canter on the Keeneland track on Friday morning." Castle Gandolfo got a boost in the form lines when Dupont (GB), third to the blaze-faced chestnut at Lingfield Apr. 6, came back to take yesterday's G2 Premio Parioli (*see p3*).

Baffert Thinks 'Dan' Could Be the Man

While no one was surprised when **Mayakovsky** (Matty G) was officially withdrawn from Derby consideration yesterday morning, plenty of eyebrows were raised when trainer Bob Baffert entered **Danthebluegrassman** (Pioneering) for the Run of the Roses. "The plan was to take him to Kentucky," Baffert explained. "I said to Mike [owner Pegram], 'Let me get him back here and see how he handles the track before we decide anything.'" Winner of the GIII Golden Gate Derby Jan. 12, the chestnut colt tired to eighth behind Came Home in the Apr. 6 GI Santa Anita Derby. He breezed three-quarters in 1:11 4/5 Wednesday morning.

BELLA BELLUCCI OUT OF OAKS

Bella Bellucci (French Deputy) will be forced to miss the GI Kentucky Oaks after blood tests showed the filly was less than 100 percent. The graded stakes winner was the 3-1 second choice on the morning line for Friday's race. Trainer Neil Drysdale, in consultation with Demi O'Byrne, advisor to owner Michael Tabor, reached the decision to scratch the filly Wednesday morning. "Neil called me last night [Tuesday]," O'Byrne explained, "and said he wasn't happy with the way the filly was acting. They did blood work and when the results came back this morning, we decided that Bella Bellucci should not run in the Oaks. It's a disappointment." Drysdale added, "As part of the routine, we took blood tests on all the horses and her's came back poor, so she can't run."

Leading home a one-two finish for the *TDN* "Dark Horses," Sadowa was well supported in the market before this Classic and she justified that confidence with a convincing success. Although she had never won a stakes event previous to this contest, she had rattled up a sequence last year in conditions events before scoring in Milan last month. Looking to make it two in a row, Sadowa was held up under jockey Mirco Demuro early as favourite Kootenay (Ire) (Selkirk) took up the running after two furlongs. Travelling well off the strong pace, Sadowa got her gap up the rail in deep stretch and quickened to the front with 1 ½ furlongs remaining as Torrigiana challenged the long-time leader. As Kootenay could give no more, Sadowa mastered Torrigiana inside the final furlong before going away to hold off the fast-finishing Sweetsoutherngirl. The first two home will renew their rivalry in the G1 Oaks d'Italia in Milan May 19. "I wanted her fresh and found a nice little race for her at Milan," said winning trainer Bruno Grizzetti. "I knew she was spot on for the day and Demuro arrived just in time. She'll go for the Oaks now."

Dupont, with jockey Darryl Holland aboard, arrived late to deny a home win for Fisich in a thrilling climax to the first European Classic of 2002. Having finished 3 ½ lengths back in third behind GI Kentucky Derby hopeful Castle Gandolfo in the Fosters International S. on Lingfield's polytrack Apr. 6, he came here with strong claims, particularly as the runner-up that day, Aramram, had subsequently scored in stakes company. Last year, he took a Doncaster maiden in June before following up in a conditions event at Lingfield in August. He was seventh in the G3 Prix La Rochette at Longchamp the following month before finishing sixth behind Sir George Turner (GB) in the valuable Houghton Sales S. at Newmarket in early October. Here, he was rushed into mid-division early from his wide draw and travelled well behind early leader Danubio Blue (Tactical Advantage). Dupont took a while to pick up in the straight, but Holland was determined and encouraged his mount to fight inside the closing stages, pushing his head in front Fisich in the final strides. "His full brother Pacino won the German Guineas," a jubilant Maureen Haggas said, "and we thought he would go there, but the ground was firm here in Rome. He has won well today and we'll see how he has come out of the race before we make a decision about what to do next. He had improved so much since his start last time at Lingfield and we were quite hopeful."

Keltos arrived late with his customary rattle under jockey Olivier Peslier to record his most important career success. In doing so, he showed no ill-effects from his excursion to Dubai where he finished eighth behind Street Cry (Ire) in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 23. Always highly regarded, he posted a success in the Listed Prix de Pontarme at Chantilly last May before finishing sixth in the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot the following month. He rounded off a fine season by taking the G3 Prix Perth over this track in November by a short head from Cornelius and extended his superiority over that horse with an impressive show of acceleration this time. Held up in rear early with only one behind as Mahfooth led, he threaded through the pack at the top of the straight, but still had a lot to do as the long-time leader dueled with Cornelius. Picking up well for pressure inside the final quarter-mile, he quickened impressively when in the clear to grab the lead with 100 yards remaining and rushed away to score comfortably. "Keltos proved today that he could quicken on good ground," said winning trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias. "We gave him a good break after the Dubai World Cup and he has come back to his best. Having now won a Group 2 it would make sense to go for a Group 1, so we will seriously consider supplementing him for the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S. [at Newbury May 18]--if not, the G1 Prix d'Ispahan [at Longchamp May 19] or the G2 Queen Anne S. [at Royal Ascot June 18] are other opportunities."

Give Notice defeated the old guard of the staying division here to mark his arrival on the scene. In response, Coral Eurobet cut his odds from 25-1 to 14-1 for the track's flagship marathon event, the G1 Ascot Gold Cup at the Royal meeting June 20. Having plied his trade in staying handicaps, he capped off his 2001 season with a half-length success from L'Evangile (GB) (Danehill) in the Listed Stubbs S. at Newmarket over two miles before dropping back in trip to be third to Crillon (Fr) in the Listed Prix Denisy at Saint-Cloud in November. Here, he was held up in fifth as Persian Punch was sent into a clear advantage by jockey Richard Quinn. Making steady progress to challenge wide at the top of the straight, Give Notice had to battle to eventually pass the game front-runner, but got on top with 200 yards remaining before lengthening away to win comfortably.

Trainer Aidan O'Brien yesterday revealed the rising arrangements for Saturday's G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. O'Brien announced that Jamie Spencer would ride **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) and Johnny Murtagh would partner **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill). George Duffield will ride **Tendulkar** (Spinning World), while Paul Scallan will be required for **Sholokhov (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Formerly known as the Cork and Orrery S., the six-furlong contest also includes **Johannesburg** (Hennessy). **Sakhee** (Bahri) heads the 46 entries for the G1 Prince of Wales' S., which has attracted two American possibles in Richard Mandella's **Cagney (Brz)** (Roy) and Jim Chapman's **Western Pride** (Way West {Fr}). "The response to the elevation of the Golden Jubilee S. has been tremendous," said Ascot Clerk of the Course Nick Cheyne. 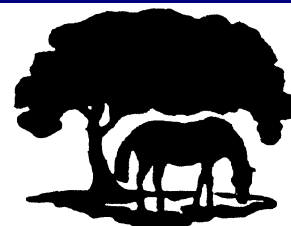

LUIS BARRERA DIES Trainer Luis Sosa Barrera died yesterday morning of an apparent heart attack while working at his barn at Belmont Park. Barrera, brother of Hall of Fame conditioner Laz Barrera, trained 1981 Belmont S. winner Summing. He was 80 years old. Barrera, a native of Havana, Cuba, began training as an assistant to his brother Angel. In 1952, he began working for trainer Arnold Winick. He was an assistant to Laz Barrera for a number of years and was instrumental in the conditioning of Kentucky Derby and Belmont S. winner Bold Forbes in 1976. "What Laz and he did with Bold Forbes is one of the greatest training jobs I ever saw," Hall of Fame rider Angel Cordero, Jr. said yesterday. "Bold Forbes was a sprinter and they got him to win the Belmont S." On his own, Luis Barrera trained stakes winners One Sum, First One Up, Give Me Strength, Its Acedemic and Prismatical. Summing's 1981 win in the Belmont S. ruined the Triple Crown hopes of Derby and Preakness winner Pleasant Colony. "Luis Barrera was a very, very good businessman," said Summing's jockey George Martens. "He was well composed and he knew his racehorses. He was a good person, too." Visitation will be held May 2 and 3 at Krauss Funeral Home in Franklin Square, NY. A funeral mass will be held May 4 at 9:30 a.m. at St. Thomas the Apostle Catholic Church in West Hempstead, NY.

PUNTERS HAVE IT ALL FOR A DAY British punters witnessed the launch of the new attheraces digital television channel and received a respite as betting shops continued to show live pictures. After negotiations between the Racecourse Association and Britain's bookmakers resumed at the 11th hour yesterday, the RCA extended the licence by one day for SIS to deliver pictures to over 8,000 betting shops. However, the RCA voted unanimously at their annual general meeting against accepting the bookmakers' latest offer, with Chief Executive Steven Atkin optimistic that the bookmakers would review their offer. Meanwhile, attheraces enjoyed its first day of broadcasting, with Brad Higgins, director of programming, commenting: "The attheraces digital channel aims to bring fresh impetus into the sport, breaking down traditional barriers and demystifying betting. Our schedule will provide live racing coverage from all 49 racecourses, reviews, previews, features and news from Britain and overseas. Our objective is to meet the demands of existing racing enthusiasts as well as engaging the non-traditional racing audience through innovative, informative and compelling features fronted by our team of 10 presenters who combine youth and experience, and new and established faces."

ROBERTS RETIRES FROM THE SADDLE Michael Roberts has been forced to retire due to ongoing injury sustained in a fall at Wolverhampton last September. Having crushed crushed vertebrae in his neck in that incident, the 47-year-old former champion jockey in Britain and 11-times champion in his native South Africa, was warned by his physician that another such fall could leave him paralysed. Roberts was famed for his many big-race successes in Britain, including the 1991 G1 2000 Guineas on Mystiko (USA), and 1993 G1 Epsom Oaks on Intrepidity (GB), as well as winning the G1 King George VI And Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. on Mtoto (GB) in 1988 and Opera House (GB) in 1993. Roberts, who clinched the jockeys' championship in 1992 with 206 winners, thanks largely to his retainer with Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, finished his career on 3,964 worldwide winners. Roberts told the *Racing Post*. "If I had a fall or got a bang from a horse I could be paralysed. I really have had a fantastic career and ridden for top owners like The Queen and Sheikh Mohammed. Mtoto was by far the best I sat on-his acceleration was incredible."
