IT'S LADIES' DAY IN LOUISVILLE

Sophomore fillies take center stage this afternoon beneath the Twin Spires for the 128th renewal of the GI Kentucky Oaks. Trainer Kenny McPeck, who will saddle morning-line favorite Harlan's Holiday in tomorrow's Kentucky Derby, will hobble into the paddock to tighten the girth about Select Stables' **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere). Winner of six of her eight career starts

and a perfect three-for-three this season, she is coming in off a convincing win over **Take The Cake** (Fly So Free) in the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 6. Second to the declared Belterra in the GI Golden Rod S. last season, the bay has sparkled in a pair of local

drills since her Ashland success. "She is eating and training now better than ever," assistant trainer Helen Pitts told *Daily Racing Form*. "She's too good to be true." **Imperial Gesture** (Langfuhr) may represent Team Godolphin's best chance at success on the weekend. Second to the late Tempera in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last October, the dark bay has been ultra-impressive in two starts in Dubai this winter, with a nine-length win in the Feb. 24 Moonshell Mile and a 3 1/4-length decision over Tempera in the UAE Oaks Apr. 13. Regular rider Frankie Dettori is in for the ride. **You** (You and I) and **Habibti** (Tabasco Cat) clash for the fifth consecutive time today, with the former leading the head-to-head battle by a count of three to one. Fourth and seventh, respectively, in the Juvenile Fillies, Habibti got the better of her rival by a head in the GI Hollywood Starlet S., but You turned the tables in their last two, winning the GI Las Virgenes S. by a length Feb. 9 and the GI Santa Anita Oaks by 1/2 length Mar. 10.

Contention Runs Deep

The field for the Kentucky Oaks is so deep that **Ms Brookski** (Montbrook), winner of the GI Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream Park in February, rates just a longshot. Recently purchased by Gary Tanaka, the dark bay has trained fast over the Churchill main. **Farda Amiga** (Broad Brush) may be the best closer in the field. Campaigned exclusively on the turf in her first four starts, the bay filly came from 11 lengths back in the Santa Anita Oaks to finish fourth by two lengths, beaten a nose for third by **Ile de France** (Storm Cat) in her main-track debut. The field is completed by **Art Fair** (Air Forbes Won), 1 1/2-length winner of the Cincinnati Trophy at Turfway Park in January, but a well-beaten fifth in the Bourbonette Breeders' Cup in Florence Mar. 23.

☆ 2000 GUINEAS ☆

O'BRIEN LOW, MIDDLE AND HIGH IN GUINEAS

With **Tendulkar** (Spinning World) in the one stall, **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) in 10 and **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill) the widest of all the declared runners for tomorrow's G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, trainer Aidan O'Brien seems to have the classic field surrounded. Hawk Wing, the 6-4 favourite with Coral Eurobet, will start from the same position as Zafonic, the last market leader to win the English 2000 Guineas in 1993, while the "Rock" will have to emulate last year's winner Golan (Ire) in overcoming the widest draw. Nevertheless, Rock of Gibraltar, with Johnny Murtagh scheduled to ride, was backed into 8-1 from 10-1 on Wednesday with Coral Eurobet and now holds the position as third favourite behind Hawk Wing and **King of Happiness** (Spinning World). Sir Michael Stoute's unbeaten King of Happiness will be bidding to follow in the steps of the stable's Entrepreneur (GB), who also exited from the four hole in 1997 to win the Classic. Among the seven withdrawals yesterday were Godolphin's **Waldenburg** (Miswaki) and O'Brien's **Century City (Ire)** (Danzig). Good ground seems likely after more rainfall yesterday afternoon, with drying conditions forecast for today and over the weekend.

She has picked up this season right where she left off with a solid runner-up finish behind loose-on-the-lead Miss Linda in Gulfstream's GIII Sabin H. Feb. 8 and a three-length score last up in the GII Ram-part H. in South Florida. In a race which figures chock full of speed, **Red n'Gold** will take back and come with one run. An impressive five-length winner of the Pippin S. at Oaklawn Park in her seasonal debut Feb. 16, she comes in off back-to-back runner-up finishes in the GIII Oaklawn Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 16 and the Apr. 5 Bayakoa S. in Hot Springs. **Spain** is still looking to overtake Serena's Song as the top career earner in the distaff ranks. She has not won a race in 14 months and was most recently fourth in the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Apr. 6.

O'BRIEN BOOKS FALLON Meanwhile, O'Brien also outlined his plans for Sunday's G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, with Kieren Fallon likely to ride **Maryinsky (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Michael Kinane, who is due to return from the suspension that ruled him out of tomorrow's GI Kentucky Derby, is set to partner **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the mile contest. O'Brien told *PA Sport* yesterday, "Michael Kinane and Kieren Fallon between them will ride Quarter Moon and Maryinsky. I haven't spoken to Michael yet as to which one, though I'd imagine he'd be on Quarter Moon." Ballydoyle will also be represented by **Pietra Dura (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) and **Lahinch (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the Classic, with O'Brien adding, "George Duffield will ride Pietra Dura and Paul Scallan will be on Lahinch. The four fillies had a canter and are all on target for Newmarket."

Kutub has to give weight to all his rivals here on the basis of his prosperous international campaign from mid-summer onwards last year. Taking advantage of the testing conditions in Germany and Italy, he rattled off successes in the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich in August, G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne the following month and G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club in Milan in October. He proved he was not just a soft ground performer, however, when accounting for a select international field in the Singapore Gold Cup on faster conditions at Kranji in November. **Storming Home**, the top-rated British-trained three-year-old on 124 pounds in the 2001 International Classifications, is also penalised for his success in last year's G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot. There was no disgrace in his failure to concede three pounds to Milan (GB) when second in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York in August and will be a danger if he has progressed throughout the winter.

Millenary captured this race last year before finishing third in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom the following month and fifth in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot in July. He appears held by Storming Home on that running and may need further. **Zindabad** is as tough as they come and showed his mettle when beating St Expedit (GB) by a neck in the G3 John Porter S. at Newbury Apr. 20 last time.

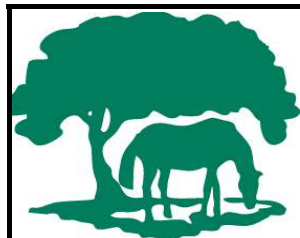
