LAST LAUGH FOR WAR EMBLEM

He was given little chance by the 145,033 fans at Churchill Downs yesterday afternoon, but GII Illinois Derby winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) stole the show, leading nearly every step en route to a four-length victory in the 128th running of the GI Kentucky Derby. "That horse had his way the whole way and he just kept on going," jockey Eddie Delahoussaye, third aboard **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer), said. Completely underestimated by the connections of his 17 rivals, the 20-1 shot was allowed to set an uncontested pace, with GII Coolmore Lexington S. hero **Proud Citizen** (Gone West) sitting second and Perfect Drift an unexpectedly close third. That was the order as they raced around the first turn, travelled the backstretch and came out of the final bend. Proud Citizen and Perfect Drift tried to make a race of it, but War Emblem simply opened it up in the final furlong.

Give and Take...

War Emblem's victory was a measure of consolation for owner Prince Ahmed Salman and trainer Bob Baffert, who came in with favored Point Given last year, only to see the 2001 Horse of the Year suffer his only loss of the campaign, finishing fifth. "I told the Prince that, after last year, I owed him a Derby," Baffert said. The two went looking for a Triple Crown contender when it became clear that last year's star juvenile Officer would not fill the bill, and found one in War Emblem. The speedy colt had finished up the track behind Repent in the GIII Risen Star S. in February, but turned it around to win an allowance race at Sportsman's Park a month later and completely dominated the field in the Apr. 6 Illinois Derby, handing Repent a 6 1/4-length defeat. Owner Russell Reineman announced after that race that he would not be heading to Churchill Downs, but the Prince made him an offer he couldn't refuse (reportedly in the neighborhood of \$1 million) and The Thoroughbred Corporation had its Derby horse. "I'm just grateful that we were able to purchase this horse," Baffert said. "We are always looking for horses, and we loved his race in the Illinois Derby. When they said after the race that he wasn't going to run in the Derby, the Prince told me, 'if you can get him, get him.'" Added the Prince, "I've been dreaming of this race for 25 years or more--maybe 30. It is such a thrill." It was also the first Kentucky Derby score for jockey Victor Espinoza. "Turning for home, I knew I had much the best horse," Espinoza said. "He was going very easily." Click [here](#) for the brisnet.com chart.

ONE-TWO FOR ROCK SOLID CREW

Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) (Danehill) was sent off a generous 9-1 shot, but outlasted stablemate and 6-4 favourite **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) to give Team Ballydoyle the one-two finish in the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas at Newmarket yesterday afternoon.

Separated by almost the width of the track as the field split into two groups, the duo asserted their dominance over their rivals on both sides of the course, with the far side draw, which put him on the better ground, favouring the

“Rock.” Jockey Johnny Murtagh, who had taken up the running from **Redback (GB)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) at the furlong pole, was on top at the finish after a few anxious glances across the track. “He was pulling up a bit in front and [Jamie Spencer, aboard Hawk Wing], was flying, but I think he won a bit smug in the end,” Murtagh said. Rock Of Gibraltar was held up on the rail in mid-division of the far side group early as Redback took them along. He found running room between horses inside the final quarter of a mile and, quickening through, he took over with a furlong remaining before being driven out to claim the victory. “I had plenty of cover and I kicked a bit early because the gap was closing, but when I kicked he really accelerated,” Murtagh said.

No Shame for the Favourite...

Hawk Wing, settled towards the rear of the stands' side clan that was headed by **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}), quickened brilliantly entering the dip and accelerated clear, but it was all too late. Trainer Aidan O'Brien, while pleased with his one-two result, expects even more from his Classic colts in the future. “It was their first run so they will improve,” he said. “I thought it was a serious run from the two of them and they are both obviously top-class colts. It was very difficult to know what was going to happen, but it worked out great--there was always a danger that they would go head-to-head and end up mentally scarred. By racing apart it was great for them--they both thought they'd won and mentally they'll be super after it.”

Fulfilling His Promise...

The “Rock,” as honest and consistent a performer as has won this Classic, started his career in a maiden at The Curragh last April and, in his third appearance, beat Hawk Wing in the G3 Railway S. in July. That success meant he was burdened with a penalty in both the G2 Gimcrack S. at York in August and G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster the following month, but it hardly stopped him as he took the former impressively before finishing a length runner-up to Dubai Destination in the latter. Testing ground caused him no problem in the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp on Arc day, where he burst clear for a facile success, and he used all his customary toughness to take a three-way photo in the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket 13 days later. As for the future, O'Brien said, “Rock of Gibraltar could go to Royal Ascot now [for the G1 St James' Palace S. June 18] and Hawk Wing was always a possible for the Epsom Derby [June 8]; we'll see how he is. Hawk Wing is a beautifully balanced horse, so I'd say he'll act on the track.” Coral Eurobet reacted by cutting him from 5-1 to 2-1 as favourite for that Classic.

QUEEN'S LOGIC LAME

Queen's Logic (Ire) (Grand Lodge) was yesterday found to be lame in her near foreleg and could miss today's G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Mick Channon's filly had been quoted as the 7-4 favourite for the Classic. "We found out [that she was lame] at 5:30 this morning," Channon said. "We've got a little bit of pus out of her foot and she's a bit better. We're just hoping that poulticing it and hot-tubbing it will do the trick. It's just time really. She's never had a lame day in her life. I just want everyone to know so that they can suspend the betting. We've just got to hold our nerve. She's got to be sound today. We know what it is, it's nothing serious but it's very annoying." In response, bookmakers William Hill cut Gossamer (GB) (Sadler's Wells) into 15-8 from 9-4.

Logic Doubt Leaves Guineas Wide Open...

Before the news of the setback, most believed this year's 1000 Guineas to be a straight match between Queen's Logic and Gossamer (GB) (Sadler's Wells). However, with the doubt over Queen's Logic, the race is taking on a different look. If her setback is overcome, Mick Channon's champion two-year-old filly of 2001 still holds great claims. She achieved a rating of 122 pounds in the 2001 International Classifications, the highest allotted to a filly since Ravinella in 1987, and like Ravinella, she bids to enhance her reputation by becoming the fourth champion juvenile filly to go on to success here. She warmed up for this with a win in the G3 Fred Darling S. Apr. 20, a prep contested by six of the last 14 1000 Guineas winners. But she is vulnerable. Gossamer, rated eight pounds below the champ at the end of last year, makes her 2002 debut, but five fillies having won without a prep in the last 14 years. A very impressive winner of the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot in September, a race won by 1996 heroine Bosra Sham and contested by 1997 winner Sleepytime (Ire), she is guaranteed to stay the distance. Aidan O'Brien is represented by four fillies, headed by Quarter Moon (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and Maryinsky (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). They bid to become the first Irish-trained fillies to win this since Tommy Stack's Las Meninas (Ire) in 1994. While the latter was runner-up to Gossamer in the Fillies' Mile, Quarter Moon has already scored at this level, when finishing with a flourish to capture the Moyglare Stud S. in September. Both are touted to be Oaks fillies, and it is worth remembering that O'Brien saddled Shahtoush (Ire) to finish runner-up here in 1998 before she took the Epsom Classic.

Mum's The Word...

A low profile...that was the strategy in the War Emblem camp before the Kentucky Derby. "I kept saying to Bob before the race, 'please shut up, don't say anything, because if they let this colt go to the lead, he won't be beaten,'" the Prince said. Baffert heeded the advice. "I liked the way this horse was training, and he worked as good as any horse I've had here," he said. "But if you brag on your horse, you get a lot of attention, so I just stayed quiet." The trainer did talk it over with jockey Victor Espinoza, however. "We had a conversation this morning in the barn and he told me, 'make sure you come out of the gate good and clean,'" Espinoza said. "He said, 'don't move on him until the last minute.' He must have told me that 100 times, and I was thinking about what he told me when we hit the far turn. But it was not that hard to sit still--turning for home, I knew I had a lot of horse." With the win, War Emblem earned a \$1 million bonus for notching the Illinois-Kentucky Derby double, but it is his previous connections, owner Russell Reineman and trainer Frank Springer, who reap that reward.

Where Have All The Closers Gone...

The early leaders came home virtually unmolested, with only **Came Home** (Gone West) launching any kind of attack, and he had been sitting fourth most of the way. The GI Santa Anita Derby winner loomed boldly at the quarter pole, but couldn't keep it up and ended up sixth. "He gave me a little run around the turn and I got excited, but he wasn't able to sustain it," jockey Chris McCarron said. **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) was bumped around at the break and again at the three-sixteenths pole, but still managed to make up ground, finishing fourth. "He didn't break that great and we got squeezed back," jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. said. "So instead of being close to the pace like I wanted, I found myself behind a lot of horses. I couldn't get him out of the jam in time."

No Playing Favorites...

Harlan's Holiday (Harlan), the slight 6-1 choice, was in touch with the leaders down the backstretch, but showed little down the lane, finishing seventh. "He broke OK, but he didn't pull like he usually does," the favorite's jockey, Edgar Prado, said. "When we hit the backstretch, he didn't give me any confidence. He wasn't responding like he has been." **Saarland** (Unbridled), the crowd's second pick, was never in the hunt. "He really didn't want to run today," jockey John Velazquez said. "He had no push whatsoever." There wasn't much luck among the foreign contingent either, with two-year-old champion **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) finishing a lackluster eighth, **Essence Of Dubai** (Pulpit) mounting only a mild bid before fading to ninth and **Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West) managing only 12th. Jockey Gary Stevens, aboard Johannesburg, said, "They asked an awful lot for him to come all this way and to try and pull this off. But he wasn't disgraced."

Danthebluegrassman Misses Derby...

A last-minute entry into the GI Kentucky Derby, **Danthebluegrassman** (Pioneering) was also a last-minute scratch. The Bob Baffert trainee tied up after a morning jog yesterday and was forced to miss the race. "We noticed when he came back and was cooling out after his bath he was stepping a little short in behind," Baffert said. "We had to treat him...we had to give him some muscle relaxers, and you can't run a horse after you give them all that."

Buddha on the Improve...

GI Wood Memorial hero **Buddha** (Unbridled's Song), resting in his stall while 18 of his classmates contested the Kentucky Derby, was showing improvement yesterday. "With no medication, he's almost 90 percent right now," trainer Jim Bond said. Added the colt's veterinarian, Dr. Larry Bramlage, "We X-rayed his left knee, ankle and shin today. The results are back and they're fine." Buddha will ship to Rood and Riddle equine clinic in Lexington Monday to undergo a nuclear bone scan. "We want to see exactly what it is," Bond said. "Hopefully we can get him back on the right road for the fall."

Winner of a Yarmouth maiden in September 1999, Beat Hollow kicked off his sophomore season with a victory in the Listed Newmarket S. in May. Beaten into third, six lengths behind subsequent G1 Arc de Triomphe hero Sinndar (Ire) in the G1 Epsom Derby, the blaze-faced bay was sidelined following his success in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris in June 2000. The homebred resurfaced in the barn of Juddmonte's main U.S. trainer Bobby Frankel, who sent the five-year-old out to register a one-length allowance victory at Santa Anita Jan. 31. Shipped east for his first stakes try in this country, Beat Hollow was the 13-10 favorite in a tough renewal of the GII Explosive Bid H. at the Fair Grounds and led late, only to be caught on the line by Sarafan. Favored at 8-5 to go one better here, he tracked pacesetting Climate (Cahill Road) early before being eased out four wide onto the backstretch while racing well in hand. Sent up after the leader approaching the stretch, he assumed command outside the eighth pole and was under an energetic ride to hold sway over With Anticipation. "We always knew he was a great horse," commented winning rider Alex Solis. "He's so easy to ride and versatile. The runner-up in her last two starts, Celtic Melody picked an opportune time to have victory awarded to her by the stewards, getting her first stakes success in a Grade I. The bay filly put up back-to-back daylight allowance victories last summer before running third in the GII Cotillion H. Oct. 6 going a mile and a sixteenth. Kept to sprint distances after that effort, she ran Gold Mover to a length when second in the Hurricane Bertie H. on St. Patrick's Day and followed that up with an excellent second to GISW Victory Ride in Keeneland's Madison S. Apr. 10. She settled into second through a half in :45 1/5 and maintained her position through three-quarters in 1:09 4/5. Bumped by favored Gold Mover inside the final furlong, she recovered to finish just a head back in second. "Sure, it's a tough way to win a Grade I," acknowledged winning trainer Jimmy Jerkens, "but she deserved it. [John Velazquez on Gold Mover] was crowding her and she was getting jostled pretty good." The \$600,000 OBSMAR purchase had drilled his rivals by 10 1/2 lengths in the 2001 GIII Swale S. at Gulfstream, but found himself on the sidelines shortly thereafter. He returned to action Mar. 2 at Santa Anita, finishing second to Crafty C.T. in an \$80,000 optional claimer, and followed that up with a fourth over a sloppy track in the GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup H. at Keeneland Apr. 14. The chestnut settled into third as favored Snow Ridge dueled for the lead with Accelerant (Candy Stripes). The favorite shrugged off that rival turning for home and was 3 1/2 lengths clear passing the eighth pole, but D'wildcat began to cut into that advantage. Smith, aboard Snow Ridge, went to a right-handed whip and inadvertently struck the challenger across the face in the final strides, crossing the wire a neck in front.
