

GODOLPHIN LEVEL THE SCORE

Kazzia (Ger) (Zinaad {GB}), sent off at 14-1, beat **Snowfire (GB)** (Machiavellian) by a neck to provide Godolphin with their first Classic of 2002. Out of luck with the colts in the G1 2000 Guineas dominated by Ballydoyle on Saturday, Sheikh Mohammed's operation replied with Kazzia's game success to level the scores. "I had suggested to Sheikh Mohammed that we run her in the G2 Premio Regina Elena [Italian 1000 Guineas], but he wanted a runner here," said Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford. "She's a really hard, tough and resolute filly and she's very honest. This has made up for a pretty moderate weekend so far." Kazzia capitalized on the withdrawal of **Queen's Logic (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) on the eve of the race, and the disappointing showing by **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) in the race itself. Jockey Frankie Dettori was keen to lay up with the easy early pace set by **Lahinch (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in second until moving up to dispute the lead at the halfway marker and that proved a decisive move.

Kazzia Takes the Lead...

When the front-runner faded entering the dip, Kazzia was ready to take over before being driven out to assert over the determined Snowfire. **Alasha (Ire)** (Baratheia {Ire}) and **Dolores (GB)** (Danehill) closed fast, but it was too late as Dettori had stolen the race up front. "I just wanted to find a nice, even stride and she was going really nicely," said Dettori. "Pat [Eddery]

came along and helped me and took me all the way to the line--she was very brave."

Kazzia started her career under the care of trainer Andreas Wohler, taking a Hoppegarten maiden before winning the G3 Premio Dormello in Milan in October, beating Kootenay (Ire) by 2 1/4 lengths in the process. Purchased by Sheikh Mohammed shortly after, she wintered in Dubai where she ran a fine trial, beaten a short head by stable companion Si-

lent Honor (Ire). When that filly met with a setback and was ruled out of this Classic, Kazzia took centre stage and did not let her connections down. "She will go for the [Epsom] Oaks [June 9] now--over a mile and a half on soft ground she'll just gallop them into the ground--when she gets her toe in a bit I'm sure you'll see something more effective," said Crisford. Coral Eurobet responded by making her the 8-1 joint-favourite for that Classic, with Snowfire quoted at 12-1, behind Alasha on 10-1.

Logic Misses the Gig...

Trainer Mick Channon was forced to withdraw **Queen's Logic (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) from yesterday's 1000 Guineas on the morning of the race as the filly's bruised foot failed to heal in time. Channon will now aim the champion two-year-old filly of 2001 at the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh May 26 before the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 21. "For a race like this you need her to be 110 percent and we just couldn't risk her," said jockey Steve Drowne.

DERBY WINNER EYES PREAKNESS

War Emblem (Our Emblem) came out of his surprising Kentucky Derby win in fine shape and is expected to make his next start in the May 18 Preakness S. "You can tell he ran hard," trainer Bob Baffert said of his third Derby winner yesterday. "He's a little tired today. Yesterday he was pretty wound up after the race, but today's he finally mellowed out a little bit. He can be tough, this son of a gun." As for War Emblem's preparation for the Preakness, Baffert will follow the formula which worked for his previous Derby and Preakness winners Silver Charm and Real Quiet. "I'll train him here [at Churchill]--this track is so good this year," Baffert explained. "I'm just going to train him, take him up there [to Pimlico] and what happens happens. That's the approach I'm taking."

War Emblem will be joined in the Preakness by Derby runner-up **Proud Citizen** (Gone West). "He is doing well and I think he should move forward off this race and I think he will run well in the Preakness," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. Trainer Murray Johnson said Derby third-place finisher **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) was "doubtful," for the Preakness.

Derby favorite **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) exited his seventh-place effort in fine shape and is "possible" for the Preakness, according to trainer Ken McPeck. "I think physically he's ready [for the Preakness]," McPeck said. "He's capable of going, but no decision has been made yet." Of Saturday's race, McPeck added, "I just think we kind of got caught with our drawers down the first half-mile--like everybody else. This horse is capable of going :47 or :46 and change for the half mile and keep going. In hindsight, I should have just told [jockey Edgar Prado] to send the horse. That's my fault and that's horse racing."

Ballydoyle runners **Johannesburg** (Hennessy) and **Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West) left Churchill Downs early Sunday morning for the eight-hour flight back to Ireland. Also heading home is **Came Home** (Gone West). Sixth Saturday, the colt will ship to California today for some R & R. "I will not run him again until he tells us he is really eager," commented trainer Paco Gonzalez.

SAARLAND INJURED **Saarland** (Unbridled) came out of his 10th-place Derby finish with a chip in his left front ankle. The colt was expected to ship to the Rood and Riddle Clinic in Lexington yesterday. Trainer Shug McGaughey indicated a fall return for the well-bred colt was possible.

NAHEEF STILL ON COURSE FOR EPSOM

Naheef (Ire) (Marju {Ire}), 14th in Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, was reported on course for the G1 Epsom Derby June 8. "We still have a lot of faith in Naheef and he will go to the Derby," said Godolphin's racing manager Simon Crisford. "Everything that could have gone wrong did go wrong." Naheef is quoted at odds of 10-1 for the Classic by Coral Eurobet.

Miss Terrible made a good showing in only her second lifetime start, a close-up second to Beau Fete (Arg) (Beau Sultan {Fr}) in the G1 Premio Unzue at Palermo Mar. 3, but was able to reverse that order next time out in the G1 Premio Eliseo Ramirez at San Isidro Apr. 13. Poised for the rubber match this time, the fillies would be denied the chance to gain the advantage. An early morning defection by Beau Fete left the remaining five challengers at the mercy of Miss Terrible. In control from the start, the Miguel Garcia-trained pupil assumed an uncontested lead early and was never in any danger as she romped home unchallenged. The filly will likely make her next start in the G1 Estrellas Juvenile Fillies at Palermo June 29.

Well Made took this competitive contest with ease, showing a fine turn of acceleration in the closing stages. Last time, he had handed a two-length beating to Simoun (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}) in the G3 Grosser Preis der Bremer Wirtschaft over this course Apr. 7. Extending that superiority with a dazzling display this time, Well Made was held up in fourth early as Yavana's Pace took his customary position at the head of affairs. He was asked to quicken in the straight and surged between the long-time leader and Simoun, before changing gear and powering away for an impressive score. Last year, he was second to Noel (Ger) in the Listed Mulheim Stehercup in April before finishing sixth in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano in June. He showed in winning the G3 Premio Federico Tesio in Milan in October that he had progressed and has underlined that with fine performances this year.

Voodoo Dancer, on the board in five of seven starts last year, won the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont last September before a seventh-place effort behind Affluent in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Keeneland. Off since that Oct. 13 effort, the bay filly was never far from the front end yesterday. She angled out for the stretch drive and gamely battled Golden Corona down the lane before drawing clear in the closing stages. "For her first time back this year, I thought she ran very well," commented winning trainer Christophe Clement. "I had some concerns about the ground being soft because she likes it firm. It couldn't have been too soft because they went the half-mile in :48 1/5. When she's right she closes with a strong kick like she did today. We'll either run her in the [May 27 GI] Gamely in California or the [June 8 GIII] Just a Game at Belmont." Winning rider Jerry Bailey added, "She was a little keen today with the soft pace and all. There were some anxious moments at the top of the stretch, but that was about it. Once I got her in the clear, she accelerated."

Night Patrol earned his last trip to the winner's circle after a narrow score in the Oct. 28 Pacifica H. at Bay Meadows. In his most recent trips to the post, the bay gelding ran eighth in the Mar. 2 GII Kilroe H. and fourth in the Apr. 6 GII Arcadia H. Jockey Victor Espinoza, fresh off Saturday's front-running score in the Kentucky Derby, sent Night Patrol right to the lead. Favored Redattore pressed the pace and the two stayed that way around the track through fractions of :24.06, 47.20 and 1:10.18. Redattore looked set to go by in the stretch, but Night Patrol fought back to earn a half-length victory. "When I rode him last time [in the Arcadia], I think I waited a little too much," Espinoza said. "He was dragging me all the way around. I fought him too much trying to take him back. It was a little bit of a mistake. So today I decided just to let him go. When he took the lead, he was very relaxed and really slowed down. He finished pretty good." Trainer Nick Canani added, "These races, sometimes when you don't really know who's going to the lead, sometimes you get an easy pace and sometimes three horses end up ding-donging it out there. This turned out really well for us. He's two-for-two on this turf course. He loves this grass course."

DERBY 128 SETS HANDLE RECORD The final figures have not yet been totaled, but Saturday's Kentucky Derby card eclipsed the North American record for single-day handle, with \$123,315,302 bet on the 11-race program. The previous mark, set on the 2000 Breeders' Cup card at Churchill, was \$108,603,040. Total handle for the 2002 card was up 14.5 percent over the 2001 "Run for the Roses." Overall wagering on the 128th running of the Derby was a record \$79,094,806, up 11.11 percent from the standard of \$71,189,142 set last year. On-track handle at the Louisville oval, where a record 145,033 fans were in attendance, was also a new mark, hitting \$19,400,818 on the 11 races. The figure was up 9.73 percent from 2001, when there were 10 races on the card.

Spill Hospitalizes Philly Jocks:

Marring an otherwise picturesque day of racing at Philadelphia Saturday, an ugly spill in the eighth race hospitalized two of the track's top jockeys, Nick Santagata and Roberto Alvarado. The accident happened leaving the far turn when **Forest Ridge** (Manastash Ridge), with Santagata aboard, began backing up into traffic after tiring as a pacesetter. The horse then broke down with an injury to the right front, sending Santagata over his head. Alvarado's **Stop the Bus** (Forest Wildcat), unable to maneuver around, toppled over the fallen Forest Ridge. Both jockeys were stretchered off the track and taken to local hospitals. The extent of the injuries to both men seemed to be just serious bruising after X-Rays came up negative. Santagata hoped to return by next weekend, while Alvarado thought he'd be okay for the opening of Monmouth Park May 11th. Stop The Bus evidently was unharmed by the fall. Forest Ridge was humanely destroyed.

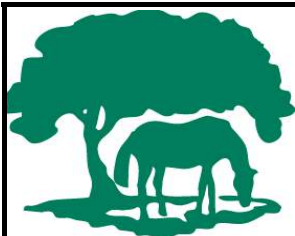

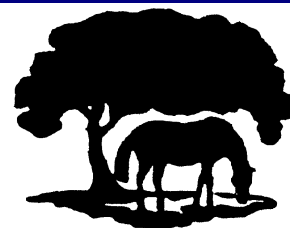

NEWMARKET REACTS TO CONTROVERSY Officials at Newmarket racecourse yesterday were quick to address the controversy caused by the running of the G1 2000 Guineas on Saturday. That Classic saw a marked advantage for horses running against the far-side rail, on ground which had been used at the previous Craven meeting. The strip of ground in question, which had dried faster than the remainder of the course in the past fortnight, was dolled off by course officials ahead of yesterday's G1 1000 Guineas, with the track narrowed as a result. "We can't do a lot unless we reduce the safety factor, or alternatively run the three days of the Craven meeting on one side," said Newmarket official Michael Prosser. "That is unsatisfactory as you've got top class horses running in the Craven and they're not getting the best of the ground." Excessive fields in preceding handicaps have been blamed for the widening of the track ahead of the Classic, leading horses on the far side to run on the faster strip. "I think the answer is to reduce the safety factor at the Craven meeting. If we reduce it to 24 or 25, that would leave enough ground to have the full safety factor at the Guineas meeting. This is something we'll have to discuss with the National Trainers' Federation--I think they're pretty keen. We'll have a look at it and it's something I really do want to avoid in the future."

BANS ALL ROUND AT HQ Jockey Pat Eddery will miss the whole of the Dante meeting at York and Newbury's weekend meeting, featuring the G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S., after picking up a five-day suspension. The ban was handed out for excessive frequency of the whip aboard G1 1000 Guineas runner-up **Snowfire (GB)** (Machiavellian {USA}). Eddery will not appeal against the ban, which rules him out from May 15-18 and May 20, inclusive. Johnny Murtagh also picked up a one-day ban for careless riding on **Alasha (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}), while Richard Hills also picked up a one-day suspension.
