

KRIS S. EUTHANIZED

WinStar Farm LLC announced yesterday that **Kris S.** (Roberto--Sharp Queen, by *Princequillo) has been euthanized due to complications from a neck injury sustained earlier this year. The 25-year-old stallion was pensioned in March after impregnating six of 10 mares covered. "Kris S. has been a real warrior since his injury and recovered enough to graze comfortably for the last month," said Doug Cauthen, the farm's president. "However, he had a setback this weekend and it was time to let him rest forever. His presence will be missed." A winner of three of five starts including the Bradbury S., the Florida-bred dark bay entered stud in Florida in 1982. After siring 1989 GI Breeders' Cup Turf hero Prized, Kris S. had a pair of winners at the 1993 Breeders' Cup meeting, Brocco (Juvenile) and Hollywood Wildcat (Distaff), and moved to Kentucky's Prestonwood Farm for the 1994 season. Soaring Softly became the fourth Breeders' Cup winner for her sire when she captured the F/M Turf in 1999. Over his stud career, Kris S. sired five millionaires, two Eclipse Award winners--Hollywood Wildcat and Soaring Softly--and 28 graded-stakes winners. In 2002, he has been represented by GI Oaklawn H. winner Kudos and GII Orchid H. heroine Julie Jalouse as well as Japanese stakes winner Symboli Kris S. His daughter Hollywood Wildcat produced GI Breeders' Cup mile winner War Chant; Kris S. is also the broodmare sire of Grade I winner Ladies Din and of Relish the Thought, a stakes winner in England who finished third in the G1 Vodafone Oaks in 2001.

KHALKEVI TAKES PRIX HOCQUART

The unbeaten **Khalkevi (Ire)** (Kahyasi {Ire}) delivered an impressive turn of acceleration in a pulsating finish to take yesterday's G2 Prix Hocquart at Longchamp. The winner of a debutantes event at Fontainebleau in November, Khalkevi added a conditions race here Apr. 19. Jockey Christophe Soumillon used the colt's strong late kick to take this trial for the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 2. Held up in last early, the Aga Khan homebred was patiently ridden as Michael Kinane set **Black Sam Bellamy** (Sadler's Wells) alight at the top of the straight. As that colt seized the advantage, Dominique Boeuf sent **Louveteau** (Bahri) up the rail to challenge while Soumillon asked Khalkevi to quicken on the outside. Hitting the front at the furlong marker, he needed only a few waves of the whip to seal the result. Louveteau was subsequently disqualified and placed behind Morozov in fifth, after being judged to have hampered that colt in the closing stages. His Highness the Aga Khan said afterwards: "He is a very small horse--the same as his sire, and has the ability to quicken on good ground. He proved today he can handle the distance and I will speak to the trainer but I think he will go for the Jockey Club now."

Free of Love, second in last year's GI Jim Dandy, opened the year with a 3 1/4-length win in a Jan. 21 optional claimer at Gulfstream, but failed to make an impact when sixth in the Feb. 9 GI Donn H. and seventh in the Mar. 10 GIII Creme Fraiche H. Off since then and with blinkers on, the bay colt was never far back, moved up with a three-wide move turning for home and forged clear in the closing stages. "It looked like there was legitimate speed in there," explained winning rider Jerry Bailey. "My horse's best races have come when he was up close to the pace and that's where I wanted to be today. We were wide, but that's where I wanted to be because the inside was a little cuppier." Trainer Richard Violette added, "The blinkers helped him today. Jerry put him on the bridle five-eighths out and he stayed on the bridle the whole way. He made a long, sustained run today. I was losing sleep over not having a stakes win with this horse; all of the horses he's been running with have been getting a stakes win. We're going to nominate to the [May 27 GI] Met Mile, but I'm not sure if he would run in it."

Returning sound to the barn area, she was reported fine by owner Antonia Devin, who said, "Something like this happened to her in Hong Kong and again in Dubai, so our fingers are crossed that this will not be a problem." Also on show was Michael Jarvis' Hawkeye (Ire) (Danehill), due to be ridden by Gary Stevens, and the four-year-old did two steady canters, with his final piece of work today. Godolphin's Grandera (Ire) (Grand Lodge) and Atlantis Prince (GB) (Tagula {Ire}) worked together over five furlongs on the turf track at Kranji yesterday morning, with Grandera, ridden by John Phelan, shading his work companion, who was partnered by Tony Garth, in a hand-held time of 1:00.10. Yutaka Take has been booked to partner Atlantis Prince on Saturday, with Frankie Dettori choosing Grandera.

MRLS LOSSES DOWN The Kentucky Thoroughbred Association reports that foal deaths caused by Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome are significantly down from last year. "During the period of Sunday, April 28 through Tuesday, May 7 we had 125 equine fetuses submitted to our diagnostic center," said Lenn Harrison, director of the University of Kentucky Livestock Disease Diagnostic Center. "This compares to 318 submissions during the same period last year and that represents a 61-percent decrease. This is very encouraging news." Harrison added that, although examinations have not been completed on all the foals, it was evident that not all the deaths can be blamed on MRLS. "Although we would prefer to not have any losses, we're encouraged by this early submissions data," commented Rusty Ford, equine programs manager for the Kentucky Department of Agriculture. "We're continuing our monitoring activities, and based on preliminary research data from UK we continue to recommend that farm managers take the necessary steps to protect pregnant mares from exposure to eastern tent caterpillars."

BIG GUNS ENTERED FOR ECLIPSE Officials at Sandown racecourse were yesterday contemplating a fascinating renewal of the G1 Coral Eurobet Eclipse S. July 6 which attracted 87 entries, the highest entry in seven years. With Aidan O'Brien accounting for 33 of those, G1 2000 Guineas winner **Rock Of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill {USA}) and runner-up **Hawk Wing (USA)** (Woodman {USA}) may bid to follow in the steps of the "Iron Horse" Giant's Causeway (USA), who took this for the stable in 2000 having contested the Newmarket Classic. Godolphin, whose Daylami (Ire) led home a one-two-three in 1998, is responsible for 18 entries, including **Sakhee (USA)** (Bahri {USA}), winner of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp and runner-up to Tiznow (USA) in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic in October. Sir Michael Stoute, who has won this three times, is responsible for five entries, headed by last year's 2000 Guineas winner **Golan (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}). **Nayef (USA)** (Gulch {USA}), winner of the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad Al Sheba Mar. 23, is another notable, while **Banks Hill (GB)** (Danehill {USA}), winner of the G1 Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf last October, is a significant overseas entry. Andrew Cooper, Group Racing Director at United Racecourses, said yesterday: "We could scarcely have asked for a better set of entries for this year's Coral Eurobet Eclipse S. at Sandown on Saturday, July 6."

If ever there was a racehorse made for this unique track, it is Shadow Dancing. Her dam, Salchow (GB) was trained by Major Dick Hern to take this event in 1986, while her sire, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's Unfuwain (USA), also made "the Roodee" his own when winning the G3 Chester Vase two years later. Dick Hern and Willie Carson, who combined for those two success stories, also bred and jointly own Shadow Dancing, under the care of Marcus Tregoning at Kingwood House Stables, where Hern ended his training career. "It's a hell of a story--Salchow died two days after giving birth--[Shadow Dancing] was fostered on a Beamish Cleveland Bay mare," Carson explained afterwards. Her tale started at Goodwood last August, where she ran with credit to finish third behind Kootenay (Ire) and Bright and Clear in her maiden. After getting off the mark in style at Sandown later in the month, she took on Half Glance (GB) in the G3 May Hill S. at Doncaster in September and finished third there, staying on well. Here Martin Dwyer used that inherent stamina to great effect, prompting William Hill to cut her to 12-1 for the G1 Epsom Oaks June 7. Held up while travelling well in fourth early, she was kept wide as Bright and Clear and Richard Hughes held the rail position tracking the leader Spinney (GB) (Unfuwain {USA}). Asked to lengthen with three furlongs remaining, she grabbed the lead soon after before asserting under hands and heels to win comfortably in the end. Marcus Tregoning said: "I think she is a nice filly and all the signs are that she will continue to progress as she has a big frame to fill out. I'm very pleased with the way she has been going at home and she handles any ground, but top of the ground is very suitable for her. I thought she came round those bends especially well--her sire Unfuwain won the Chester Vase impressively here and went on to Epsom and won the Warren S. after that by 12 lengths, and her mother won round here, so the pointers are fairly reasonable that she will handle more turning and handle Epsom."
