

### DEEP IN THE HEART OF TEXAS

When the connections of Mayakovsky opted out of last week's Kentucky Derby, it seemed all but assured that Team Valor's **Windward Passage** (Captain Bodgit) would draw into the field of 20. All of that changed in the blink of an eye for trainer Steve Asmussen, but he gets his chance at redemption in this afternoon's GIII Lone Star Derby. A maiden winner in three tries at two,

Windward Passage was second in his February comebacker in New Orleans before finishing a good third in the Southwest S. at Oaklawn Mar. 2. The bay improved off that effort to be a one-length victor of the GIII Rebel S. in Hot Springs three weeks hence and most recently dead-heated with **Bay**

**Monster** (Meadow Monster) for the show spot in the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 13. **Smoked Em** (Smoke Glacken) is a sophomore on the rise for trainer Todd Pletcher. Stakes placed over the winter at Aqueduct, the bay colt was impressive in a front-running, two-length victory in Pimlico's Federico Tesio S. Apr. 20. Jockey Chris McCarron is in for the ride.

### SINGAPORE HOSTS THE WORLD

An accomplished field of 14 international runners gathers this evening for the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup under the lights at Kranji Racecourse. **Terre A Terre (Fr)** (Kaldounevees {Fr}), winner of the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp last October, ventured beyond the French border for the first time in December to run third to Agnes Digital in the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin. Rested off that effort, the grey mare returned to action with a 3/4-length victory in the G2 Dubai Duty Free S. at Nad al Sheba. The five-year-old caused her connections some concern when she appeared to tie up following a Wednesday work, but appears to have completely recovered. A distant second to subsequent Arc de Triomphe winner Sakhee in the G1 Juddmonte International S. over this trip last Aug. 21, **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) dropped in class to score a 1 1/2-length victory in the Listed Dubai Arc Trial S. at Newbury in September. A disappointing runner-up in the G3 Dubai City of Gold S. Feb. 24, the chestnut added blinkers and raced keenly when fifth in the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin Apr. 21. The shades come off for tonight's race. **Palace Line (Aus)** (Palace Music) represents the best chance of the locally based contingent. The champion two-year-old in South Africa in 2000, the chestnut was dominant in his first two starts in Singapore, with victories in the G3-Sin Singapore Guineas Jan. 11 and the G1-Sin Singapore Classic Mar. 1. The gelding was most recently seen running sixth to Essence of Dubai in the G2 UAE Derby, a race open to Southern Hemisphere-bred three-year-olds. (*Field p3*)

### PERFECT DRIFT TO SKIP PREAKNESS

Stonecrest Farm's **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer), third in last Saturday's GI Kentucky Derby, will skip next week-end's second leg of the Triple Crown. "We've decided to skip the Preakness," trainer Murray Johnson explained yesterday. "If all goes well between now and then, we'll take a good look at the Belmont." Johnson also said that the gelding will continue to train at the Trackside Training Center for now.

**SHAANMER HEADS BAKER'S DOZEN FOR POULAINS**

Andre Fabre's **Shaanmer (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) heads a home defence of four in Sunday's G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) Sunday at Longchamp. Olivier Peslier will partner the unbeaten colt, who features prominently in ante-post lists for the G1 Epsom Derby June 8. "You've got to remember this is very much an educational race for him considering his main objective lies over 12 furlongs," owner Baron Edouard de Rothschild told *PA Sport*. "All in all, we're hoping for a good run--we'd be pleased if he ran a good third. We chose to run him here because we wanted him to experience a fast run race with plenty of runners--up to now he's only faced small fields." Of the three Aidan O'Brien runners, Michael Kinane has chosen **Landseer (GB)** (Danehill), while Kieren Fallon will partner **Della Francesca** (Danzig) and Paul Scallan will ride **Sahara Desert (GB)** (Green Desert). In the fillies' equivalent, 17 runners will make up the largest field since 1986, with **Glia** (A.P. Indy) and **Dedication (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}), first and second respectively in the Listed Prix Imprudence at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 8, heading the list. Michael Kinane has chosen **Sophisticat** (Storm Cat), winner of the G3 Prix de la Grotte over this course Apr. 14, over stable companion **Pietra Dura (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), due to be ridden by Jamie Spencer. The going at Longchamp yesterday morning was reported as good, with a penetrometer reading of 3.1.

Godolphin's **Infinite Spirit**, stakes placed in England last year, returned to take the Jan. 31 Moonshell Mile Prep at Nad al Sheba before defeating champion Tempera by five lengths in the Mar. 14 UAE Guineas. In preparation for her U.S. bow, the chestnut filly worked six furlongs at Belmont May 6 in 1:16. **Dust Me Off**, whose lone loss in four starts came over the Gulfstream turf, has been off since a front-running victory in the Mar. 15 GII Bonnie Miss. In that 1 1/8-mile contest, the gray filly bested **Nonsuch Bay** and the highly regarded Belterra. **Carson Hollow** bested a field of state-bred maidens by 18 3/4 lengths in her Mar. 22 debut at Aqueduct and returned to defeat open company in an Apr. 21 allowance. Both efforts came at today's seven-furlong distance.

**Derby Trial S. cont.**

Except for High-Rise (Ire) who took this in 1998, this trial has had little impact on the Epsom Derby in recent years. Trainer Mark Johnston, who has already won two Derby trials and finished a short-head second in another, saddles **Bandari**. That colt was an impressive nine-length winner from Infinite Spirit in the Listed Silver Tankard S. at Pontefract last October and will relish this stamina test. **Wahchi** had to do the dirty work last time from the front in the Listed Fielden S. at Newmarket Apr. 18 and was only caught in the closing stages by the smart Playapart. His three-parts sister Ranin (GB) stayed in excess of this trip and he may prove hard to peg back if allowed an uncontested lead.

**JOCKEY CONSCIOUS AFTER FALL**

Jockey Paul Fessey regained consciousness last night after a fall in the second race at Carlisle yesterday. Fessey fell from his mount exiting the stalls and, after being examined by the racecourse doctor, was taken to the local hospital by ambulance. John Norton, trainer of his mount Red River Rebel (GB), had alerted the racecourse officials as to the jockey's well-being before the start, but they passed him fit to ride. Norton said yesterday: "I fully expected the doctor would take him out at the start because in my opinion I thought that for whatever reason--dehydration, concussion, I wouldn't wish to speculate--I thought it was in the interest of the jockey and the jockeys of the other horses that he didn't ride. I was somewhat flabbergasted when the doctor came back and said he was fit to ride. It's not an ideal situation, but nobody would have been hurt. Paul could have come back and had a cup of tea and a rest and he could have been OK in an hour or so, but it shouldn't really have happened." Stewards held an inquiry into the incident and are expected to forward a confidential report to the Jockey Club.
