

GRANDERA LANDS SINGAPORE CUP

Sent off the 8-5 favorite, Godolphin's **Grandera (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) flew from the back of the pack to catch

Paolini (Ger) (Lando {Ger}), then pulled away to win yesterday's G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji by two lengths. The race lost some of its luster when G1 Dubai Duty Free H. winner **Terre a Terre (Fr)** (Kaldounevees {Fr}) was scratched due to an unsatisfactory blood

count. Still, Simon Crisford, racing manager for Godolphin, was pleased with the colt, who improved sharply off a fifth-place finish in the G1 Audemars Piguet QE II Cup at Sha Tin Apr. 21. "He's come on since Hong Kong and will be a very nice international horse for us," Crisford said. "I'm not sure of his next run, but he could be aimed at the Arlington Million." Grandera came into the race with two wins to his credit, including the Listed Dubai Arc Trial at Newbury last September. The four-year-old was also a close-up second in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. and finished the runner-up again, seven lengths behind Sakhee, in the G1 Juddmonte International S. last season. He started his 2002 campaign with a second-place finish in the Mar. 24 G3 Dubai City of Gold S. at Nad al Sheba prior to his Hong Kong run. Settled off the pace as **Western Pride** (Way West {Fr}) cut out genuine fractions here, the chestnut kicked it into gear as they turned for home. Paolini burst clear with 300 meters to go, but Grandera ran him down and won going away. "The race set up very well for him," jockey Frankie Dettori said. "When I asked him, he delivered." The race was marred by a spill at the top of the lane. It appeared that **Universal Prince (Aus)** (Scenic {Ire}) clipped heels with Western Pride and took a crashing fall. Fortunately, both the horse and his rider, jockey Justin Sheehan, appeared uninjured in the incident. For a replay of the race, choose modem speed: [56K](#) or [Broadband](#).

VIVA LA FRANCE

Despite fielding only four runners here, the French will bid to extend their historical domination of the G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) at Longchamp this afternoon. Only four overseas horses have won this race since 1970. This year, Team France is headed by **Shaanmer (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), who makes his seasonal return. His trainer Andre Fabre has won this three times, but only once since 1987, with last year's promoted Vahorimix (Fr) and his unbeaten colt lacks a vital prep. He was a progressive two-year-old, ending his campaign with a smooth success in the G3 Prix des Chenes over this course in September, but is considered more of a middle-distance prospect. Fabre also saddles **Bowman** (Irish River {Fr}), winner of the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau Apr. 14, where he got the better of **Medecis (GB)** (Machiavellian) and **Landseer (GB)** (Danehill) by a neck and a short neck, respectively. Three winners of that trial in the last decade followed up with a victory here.

Landseer Leads Foreign Raiders...

Landseer is one of three colts bidding to give Ballydoyle its first French 2000 score. Second behind G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas winner Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the G1 Dewhurst S. last year, he also boasts Group 1 form at two in France, running second in the Criterium International in his final start of the season. Godolphin sends out two in its continued offensive on French superiority in this event--the stable won with Vettori (Ire) in 1995 and with Bachir (Ire) in 2000. Were it not for the disqualification of Noverre in 2001, **Firebreak (GB)** (Charnwood Forest {Ire}) would be bidding to make it three in a row for the Dubai-based outfit. Like his predecessors, he was a Group-class juvenile who started off his three-year-old career in the UAE 2000 Guineas at Nad al Sheba. Bachir took that race when it was called the Khor Derby in 2000; like Noverre, Firebreak finished runner-up to Godolphin's main Kentucky Derby hope there. Subsequently 10th in the G2 UAE Derby Mar. 23, Firebreak will appreciate this drop back to a mile. **Redback (GB)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}), third to Rock of Gibraltar last Saturday, faces a tough task returning to top-flight action so soon. DEDICATION CEREMONY?

This afternoon's G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp has been as inhospitable for foreign raiders as the colt's version, with only four successful overseas forays since 1970. No trainer warrants more respect than Criquette Head-Maarek, whose particular skill with fillies has seen her garner six renewals of this event since 1979. This year, she is represented by **Dedication (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}). Having taken a Fontainebleau conditions event Mar. 22, she was beaten a neck by **Glia** (A. P. Indy) as the pair dominated the Listed Prix Imprudence at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 8. Whether she can reverse that form depends on the relative progress of the pair. Trainer Pascal Bary was successful with **Bluemamba** in 2000, who had finished third in the Imprudence, and there is every reason to believe that Bary's 2002 contender **Glia** is a classier animal.

Taking the Traditional Track...

Longchamp's G3 Prix de la Grotte is considered the preeminent prep for this Classic. **Sophisticat** (Storm Cat) took this year's renewal Apr. 14, where she beat **Firth of Lorne (Ire)** (Danehill), **Danseuse d'Etoile (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}) and **Loupy Glitters (Fr)** (Loup Solitaire). She is from the stable of Aidan O'Brien, who scored with **Rose Gypsy (GB)** in this race last season. Like **Rose Gypsy**, **Rum Charger (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}), trained by Dermot Weld, contested the Listed Athasi S. at The Curragh as her final prep, going one better than O'Brien's filly by winning. Andre Fabre has one success to his credit here, with **Houseproud** in 1990. This year, he runs **Heat Haze (GB)** (Green Desert) for the same connections and she will bid to go one better than her half-sister **Banks Hill (GB)**, runner-up last year. By the sire of **Rose Gypsy**, who had the head call over her stable companion in that contest, she showed she had inherited his speed when second in a conditions event over this course Apr. 28 following a win against debutantes at Chantilly Apr. 12. John Gosden, who saddled **Valentine Waltz (Ire)** to win this in 1999, is double-handed this year with **Zenda (GB)** (Zamindar) and **Camaret (GB)** (Danehill). Both maiden winners, **Camaret** may prove the better, having won a competitive event at Newmarket Apr. 17, beating the smart **Monturani (GB)** by two lengths. She bids to emulate **Ta Rib**, who took this after winning a similar event at Newmarket in 1996. (1000 Guineas field, p3)

Irgun's Angel, 2nd Santa Ysabel-G3 in 2001, returned to the track for a win at Hollywood Park May 2.

Nonsuch Bay came through gamely between horses to get her nose down on the line, earning her first career stakes victory. The chestnut won at first asking Jan. 20 at Gulfstream and added an allowance victory Feb. 8 before stretching out for the first time in the GII Bonnie Miss S. Mar. 15. She gave a good account of herself that day, finishing second to Dust Me Off (With Approval), and came back to run a distant third to Bella Bellucci in the GIII Comely S. over Aqueduct's one-turn mile Apr. 14. Cutting back to seven panels, Nonsuch Bay was content to race in seventh as previously unbeaten Wilzada led along the rail through an uncontested half in :46.53. Wopping came up to challenge on the outside in the stretch, forcing jockey Javier Castellano to send Nonsuch Bay through a narrowing hole. She complied and got the bob at the wire over Wopping, with Wilzada a half-length back on her inside. "I love this filly," exclaimed winning trainer Frank Alexander. "She's a gutsy SOB. She really tries hard. We were originally thinking about running her in the Black-Eyed Susan [May 17], but since we decided to run here instead, we'll probably take a look at the Acorn [GI, 8f, June 7]." The 9-5 favorite, Godolphin's Infinite Spirit (Maria's Mon), was hustled along early, but flattened out to finish a distant fifth.

A handicap winner at Caulfield in February, North Boy came back to be second in the Mar. 9 G1 Newmarket H. and third in the Mar. 23 G1 Australia S. But, coming off a 10th-place effort in the G2 T.J. Smith S. Apr. 13, and as the only three-year-old in this field, the bay gelding was let go at 14-1 here. Rated off the pace of Superb Effect, North Boy closed stoutly to catch the front-runner in the stretch before drawing off to a decisive score in course-record time. "This was a bit of a gamble coming here," winning trainer Tony McEvoy said. "We had a high opinion of him back home, but to come and perform beating such a high-class field was fantastic." The disappointment of the race was G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen hero Caller One (Phone Trick), who pressed the pace, but tired badly to be 12th in the 12-horse field. "He travelled OK for the first two furlongs, but he didn't handle the track, which is very sandy on the inside," jockey Gary Stevens said. "He was really struggling on it from the word go." Added trainer James Chapman, "He loved training on the outside of the turf in the mornings--I can't understand why he didn't handle it in the race. But this doesn't change anything, we are still going to England [G1 Golden Jubilee S., June 22]."

Doing his best impression of War Emblem in last week's Kentucky Derby, Wiseman's Ferry made every pole a winning one in collecting his first stakes victory. His final start overseas was a fourth to Dubai Destination in the G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster Sept. 14. Making his U.S. bow at Gulfstream, Wiseman's Ferry finished third in a seven-furlong allowance Mar. 16, but caught a sloppy track at Keeneland Apr. 14 and romped by 5 1/2 lengths going 1 1/16 miles. Breaking from the far outside in post 14, he cleared the field and took charge with an honest pace, clipping off fractions of :46.22 and 1:10.08. Tracemark made a run at him in the stretch from far back, but couldn't make much of a dent in the pacesetter's advantage.

It takes a special colt to win a Derby trial by 13 lengths and that is just what Bandari appears to be following this impressive romp. Trainer Mark Johnston, who has now taken three of the four major trials for the June 8 G1 Epsom Derby, ironically only has the vanquished Sir George Turner (GB) entered, but he is contemplating the possibility of supplementing this colt. "I will not be talking Mr. Al-Rostamani out of paying £90,000 to enter Bandari for the Derby, but we shouldn't forget that there are plenty of other races--he could go for the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. [July 27] and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [Oct. 6]," Johnston said. The three-year-old handled the undulations, which are similar to those of Epsom, in spectacular fashion here, settling in second on the outside of Mamool (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) early before sweeping past that colt with three furlongs remaining. Pushed out with hands and heels late, he galloped powerfully clear, establishing a record winning distance for this event. Bandari ended his 2001 campaign with an impressive nine-length success in the Listed Silver Tankard S. in October, but he had been overlooked by some as Johnston's Simeon (GB) and Fight Your Corner (GB) stole the limelight in their trials. "Bandari has been the one that has been working weakest of the four in some ways, probably because he just hadn't wintered as well and has taken more time to come to himself," explained Johnston. "I think Timeform said at the end of last year he was certainly the most impressive horse they'd seen in the North and hopefully, they'll now think he's one of the most impressive, full stop."

This year's Prix Lupin acts as the stage for the match that Paris wants to see; **Act One** versus **Ballingarry**. Both have done little wrong in their short careers so far; each appears championship class and will bid to stake their claim for the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 2. As far as history goes, the French have had little to sweat over in this event, but in the last two editions trainer Aidan O'Brien has shaken things up with **Ciro** and **Milan** (GB). Unbeaten in four starts, **Jonathan Pease's** grey was the highest-rated French juvenile of 2001 on 117 pounds in the International Classifications. He earned that mark by scoring impressively in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at Saint-Cloud in October before beating **Landseer** (GB) by a half-length in the G1 Criterium International at that track the following month. He returned with a fluent score in Longchamp's G2 Prix Greffulhe Apr. 14, where **Without Connexion** was four lengths back in third. **Ballingarry's** stable-companion **Temple of Artemis**, who did a fine job of pacemaking in Monday's G3 Prix La Force, may be the key to this and he will be employed to draw the sting from **Act One**.

Godolphin will bid for their third renewal in this event with **Ekraar** and this five-year-old has outstanding claims. Having blossomed as a three-year-old under trainer **Marcus Tregoning**, he was taken to the G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba last March, but disappointed on the dirt there. Subsequently, he was third in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp in May, fourth in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom the following month and fifth in the G2 Princess of Wales' S. at Newmarket in July. Back to basics afterwards, he duly won the Listed Troy S. at Doncaster in September before running **Agnes Digital** to a head in the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December. His fair run when fifth behind **Nayef** in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23 will have sharpened him up and he must take all the beating here. Italy, a winner in this contest only twice since 1990, field a strong team for this edition, headed by **Falbrav**. 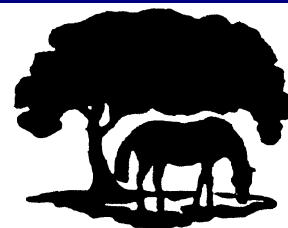

JOHNSTON SLAMS DERBY ENTRY SYSTEM

Mark Johnston yesterday opened fire at the entry system for the G1 Vodafone Derby June 8. **Bandari (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) put up a highly impressive performance when winning yesterday's G3 Lingfield Derby Trial by 13 lengths, but does not hold an entry for the Classic. Johnston is also responsible for **Simeon (GB)** (Lammtarra {USA}), winner of the G3 Sandown Classic Trial Apr. 26, and **Fight Your Corner (GB)** (Muhtarram {USA}), successful in Tuesday's G3 Chester Vase, also without entries in the mile-and-a-half contest. Johnston believes the £90,000 supplementary fee payable by the owners of his three colts to enter at this stage to be excessive: "We shouldn't escape from the crux of the matter which is that the Derby entry fees are structured to boost the prizemoney. Owners are putting up more than 50 percent of the total pool and it's just not justified. Hopefully, with the new funding for racing, we will see a change." Johnston is convinced that a reduction in the supplementary fee for Derby trial winners will end the detrimental effect on the recognized trials: "I am sure that is one answer and that's certainly something that a lot of people have been suggesting--not only would that improve the Derby, it would greatly lift the status of these Classic trials and make them more competitive--that would be a great move forward. "Epsom should be structuring to attract the horse, not to give us a dozen reasons why not to go. They should be trying to draw the best possible horses and clearly today, he has shown that he is a candidate that the public would like to see at Epsom. I'm not just having a go--the idea that I could have a team of horses where I have four potential Derby candidates and only one entered is heart-breaking. It is a sad fact, but let's face it, this horse cost 44,000 guineas, and obviously he's worth many times that, but we're talking about twice his purchase price to supplement him for a race that he doesn't need to run in." Epsom Executive Director Stephen Wallis responded: "Mark's achievements in the last four weeks have been amazing and it is very sad that some of his horses are not already entered. I really hope he does supplement Bandari as that horse must be in with a shout. We know that this is the race that the majority of owners, trainers and breeders want to win. But we will continue to review the entry system and there may be a way in the future to make sure that the winners of Derby trials take their chances."
