### GOING FOR GOLD

The 5-2 morning-line favorite for Saturday's GI Preakness S., **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) blew out three furlongs in :35 flat yesterday at Belmont Park. The big colt broke awkwardly and had a troubled trip when fourth in the GI Kentucky Derby two weeks ago. "He's shipping tomorrow [Friday night] and I didn't want to breeze him the day before the race," said

trainer Bobby Frankel. "I didn't think he even needed a breeze, but I decided to do a little with him. Hopefully, he'll break a little sharper this time.

He's a little on the lazy side and hopefully it will perk him up a little bit." Medaglia d'Oro will also have a new pilot in Jerry Bailey, who replaces Laffit Pincay, Jr. "Jerry and I have been lucky together over the past three years," Frankel explained. "We've won a lot of Grade 1s. The horse will be on the East Coast and he's the go-to rider there. Laffit didn't do anything wrong in the Derby. But we're on the East Coast now, so I'll use my East Coast rider." Medaglia d'Oro will ship out of Belmont Park at midnight Friday night and is expected to get into Pimlico at 4 a.m. Frankel is not concerned about the colt's late arrival. "I've been winning 75 to 80 percent of the races doing it that way, so I figure I'll do the same thing," he said. "The Europeans do it that way all the time. It's no big deal."

He tried hard, as always, but Persian Punch (Ire) (Persian Heights {GB}) just could not draw the sting from his faster rivals over this trip, which is short of his best. The marathon stayer set out to draw clear of his rivals from the front, but Zindabad and Kevin Darley cut him down at the quarter-mile pole before lengthening away to hold Boreas as the old warrior faded into fourth. Zindabad, as tough as they come over middle distances, was having his third run in less than a month--the six-year-old beat St Expedit (GB) by a short head in the G3 John Porter S. at Newbury Apr. 20 and was fourth in the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 3. Last year he was a model of consistency, his best efforts coming when second in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot in June and when third, before being disqualified into sixth, in the G1 Canadian International at Woodbine in September. Here he tracked the game leader before being pulled wide to challenge in the straight. Once in front, he kept up the gallop all the way to the line and never looked likely to be caught. Zindabad will once again point for the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 22, where he will re-oppose Boreas, before another crack at the G1 Canadian International in September.

Vesta ran her skein to three with this wire-to-wire victory. The dark bay, a winner at first asking in October at Belmont, finished fourth to MGSW Proper Gamble in Aqueduct's Dearly Precious S. Feb. 16, but bounced back to wire allowance foes over the same track Mar. 7. She added a six-length victory in the Smart Halo S. over this trip at Pimlico Apr. 27 and was sent off as the third choice against these five rivals. Breaking alertly under leading Pimlico reinsman Mario Pino, Vesta quickly went to the front and rattled off fractions of :22.26 and :44.83. She kicked clear turning for home and held sway over the late-charging Willa On the Move. "It wasn't the plan to go to the front, but our whole strategy went out the window when she broke on top," said Pino. "She was gone, made an easy lead." The 7-5 favorite, A New Twist (Storm Cat) got off to a slow start and never picked it up, finishing fifth.

Invincible Spirit defied a four-pound penalty here to reward the faith of Michael Kinane, who paid a flying visit to the Knavesmire for the ride. Beaten two lengths by Reel Buddy (Mr. Greeley) when conceding six pounds to that rival last time in the Listed Abernant S. at Newmarket Apr. 16, he reversed that form under a lighter burden in decisive style. Last year, the colt won the Listed Hackwood S. at Newbury in July and finished second to Do the Honours (Ire) in the G3 Prix de Meautry at Deauville in August, then went on to break the course record at The Curragh when winning the six-furlong G3 Boland S. in September. Here he was settled in sixth early as Lady Dominatrix blazed the trail under Paul Doe. Asked to close on the leader inside the distance, he wore her down with 100 yards remaining before battling to the line to hold Mugharreb's wide challenge. Robert Hamilton, the travelling head lad for winning trainer John Dunlop, commented, "When he ran at Newmarket, he didn't get the best of runs and got bumped a little when it mattered. He's a hold-up horse with a quick finish and he's done it very nicely--he's got very quick acceleration and six furlongs is spot on for him. The G1 Golden Jubilee S. [at Royal Ascot June 22] is a race we would definitely be looking at and he loves top of the ground."

Rouvres provided trainer Criquette Head-Maarek with her second consecutive renewal of this, following in the hoofsteps of last year's hero Mizzen Mast. Having been beaten three lengths by Act One (GB) in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at Saint-Cloud in October, Rouvres returned to take a conditions race over this course Apr. 4. Keen to establish an even pace here, his trainer sent out Moissac (Fr) (Anabaa) and jockey Ronan Thomas and the two carried out their task with aplomb, setting reasonable fractions as his stable companion settled well in third on the rail under Olivier Doleuze. Rouvres, travelling on the bridle in the straight, quickened to lead with 175 yards remaining. Pushed out with hands and heels from there, he had enough to hold the late thrust of Rashbag and Dominique Boeuf in the closing stages. Winning owner Alec Head said, "Rouvres is a quite a nice horse. When he ran second in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon last year he was beaten by Act One, but at the time nobody knew how good Act One was, so it was not a disgrace to be beaten that day. The plan before today was to take him to the G1 Prix Jean Prat [at Chantilly June 2], so we will go ahead with that now. After that he may go for the G1 Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris here [June 23] because I don't think he'll have a problem staying 10 furlongs."

The unbeaten graded-stakes winner **Summer Note** (Notebook) returns to the racetrack for the first time in over two years in today's eighth race at Belmont Park. In his last start, the five-year-old dead-heated with **More Than Ready** in the 2000 renewal of the **Gil Hutcheson S.** The eighth race, a six-furlong allowance contest, has attracted a field of eight, including graded-stakes placed **American Century** (Pioneering).

He used up a lot of energy between the four and the three pole and that's why he was tying up a little bit at the finish but 1 1/2 miles is definitely a big question mark for him."
