

THE SPOILS OF WAR

Proving that the Kentucky Derby was no fluke, **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) stormed down the stretch at Pimlico yesterday afternoon to win the GI Preakness S. by 3/4 lengths, moving one step closer to Triple Crown glory. "We found out today that this horse is for real," trainer Bob Baffert said.

The colt has come a long way. Sent off an unconsidered 38-1 in the Feb. 17 Gill Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds, he lived up to his odds, finishing sixth behind Repent. But something happened over the next month. War Emblem came back to take a Sportsman's allowance race by 10 3/4 lengths

Mar. 17 and cruised to a 6 1/4-length score over Repent in the Apr. 6 Gill Illinois Derby. Everyone expected the ebony three-year-old to flash his speed on Derby Day--very few believed he could carry it 1 1/4 miles. But carry it he did, leading through moderate fractions and finishing full of run to win by four lengths. The effort was enough to make him the favorite in the second leg of the Triple Crown. Sent off at 5-2, the \$20,000 Keeneland September yearling broke well and settled in second as **Menacing Dennis** (Star de Naskra) zipped to the front. Jockey Victor Espinoza had his feet on the dashboard down the backstretch, holding War Emblem at the pacesetter's flank, but he let out a notch as they hit the far turn and the Derby winner was in front for good. As he had at Churchill Downs, **Proud Citizen** (Gone West) went after the leader at the top of the stretch, but it was almost instant replay. The Team Lukas runner could not get by, and it was only the surprising late charge of 45-1 shot **Magic Weisner** (Ameri Valay) that prevented a repeat of the one-two Derby finish. "He so professional," Espinoza said. "He was the best of the field and he's always going to be the best." Added Baffert, "We've been trying to get this horse to relax. We knew somebody might get stupid today and we had to be prepared. He still wants to get up on the bit, but he learned a lot today."

Third Time's the Charm?

Bob Baffert has been down this road before, guiding both Silver Charm (1997) and Real Quiet (1998) to victory in two-thirds of the Triple Crown, only to see both colts shot down at Belmont Park. But he is optimistic about his chances at the Belmont S. this time. "I think the experience is going to help," he said. "We've gone through this before. The main thing is to keep the horse healthy and keep Victor [Espinoza] healthy--he has this horse figured out. The pressure is on now, and I'm sure there will be new shooter and new rabbits, but we'll be ready for them." The third leg of the Triple Crown will be run June 8.

The Magic Touch...

Adding a touch of excitement to the finish of the Preakness, **Magic Weisner** (Ameri Valay) came flying in the final 100 yards and just fell short. First or second in eight of his 10 career starts, the bay was making his graded-stakes debut after finishing second in the Apr. 20 Federico Tesio S. for owner/breeder/trainer Nancy Alberts. "[Nancy Alberts] told me he was game, that he didn't know the meaning of the word quit," jockey Richie Migliore said. "It's just a shame we ran out of racetrack. He was getting to War Emblem pretty quick. My horse was really putting in a pretty good run and they were weakening up front. I can't say enough nice things about this little horse." Added Alberts, "I'm not planning on going to the Belmont, because there could be some better spots here."

Tough Trip for Proud Citizen...

Kentucky Derby runner-up **Proud Citizen** (Gone West) did not have the best of trips at Pimlico. Bumped at the break, the powerful bay was caught very wide on the first turn and raced on the outside while tracking the leaders down the backstretch. The colt began his bid as they raced out of the final bend and gave it all he had down the lane, but had to settle for third. "Two things cost me," jockey Mike Smith said. "The break cost me about a half-length and then we ended up about seven-wide on the first turn. That's hard to make up. I really believe he had a legitimate excuse today. He got to War Emblem's hip, but it was just too much to overcome." **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) raced wide most of the way as well, but lacked a late kick and finished fourth. "He ran a solid race," trainer Ken McPeck said. "He only got beat two lengths. It's too early to tell where we are going next. We just have to see how he comes out of the race." Second choice **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) pressed the pace, but faded to finish eighth. "We were in the perfect spot early, the horse just backed up," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "The horse is going to New York tonight. I will give him a month or so off, then try the turf." **Straight Gin** (Go for Gin), well back early, came six wide into the stretch but couldn't mount a rally and was pulled up in distress after the race. The early diagnosis was a bowed tendon. "He's fine, but obviously his racing career is over," trainer Nick Zito said.

Keltos, a £12,000 supplement, was held up with only one behind early as Atavus (GB) (Distant Relative {Ire}) led, but was allowed to creep closer passing the half-way, tracking Noverre. As that colt hit the front in the final quarter, Keltos was hampered to his left by Olden Times, but he shrugged off that attention and drew alongside with 250 yards remaining. Noverre hung into his challenger slightly while attempting to bite him but, undeterred, Keltos ran away from that rival to win by daylight. Gary Tanaka purchased the colt from Leonidas Marinopoulos before last year's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas), where he finished sixth, but was promoted to fifth when winner Noverre was subsequently disqualified. The colt captured the Listed Prix Pontarme at Chantilly later in the month, but finished sixth in the St. James S. at Ascot in July and was given a lengthy break. Keltos came back to take the G3 Prix Perth at Saint-Cloud Nov. 3. This season, he was eighth in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 23 before winning the G2 Prix du Muguet May 1. "We were looking at the G2 Queen Anne S. [June 18], but he will get a penalty for winning a Group 1, so we could have a re-think," Tanaka said. "Ultimately, we will be looking at the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Arlington and the GI Atto Mile at Woodbine." Noverre will now step up in trip for the G1 Prince of Wales' S. June 19.

Jockey Jorge Chavez lost the mount on Preakness also-ran Booklet, but made up for that "loss" with a front-running score here. A steady performer over the all-weather during his European stint, the five-year-old blossomed this past winter and recorded his first U.S. win at Gulfstream Feb. 16. Second to Macho Uno in a Mar. 23 allowance in South Florida, the bay used that race as a springboard to an 11-length success in the GIII National Jockey Club H. Apr. 20. Content to let fellow speedball Duckhorn (Not for Love) dole out the pace for the opening three-quarters, Chavez sent Hail The Chief up after that rival on the final turn, took a clear lead turning for home and was never seriously threatened. Strut The Stage, who is out of a half-sister to champion Chief Bearhart, is making a mark of his own. The chestnut went three-for-five last season, numbering the GIII Toronto Cup among his wins. He was second by a nose in the GI Secretariat S., but lost all chance in his 2001 finale when he was checked on the first turn in the Sept. 30 GI Canadian S. and crossed the line sixth, only to be moved up to fourth by the stewards. The four-year-old came back in a Keeneland allowance race Apr. 20, rallying for a 1 1/2-length score, and was the choice in his first try at Old Hilltop. Sent right to the front by jockey Robby Albarado, Strut The Stage was tracked by Del Mar Show through easy fractions and lost the lead to that rival in the stretch, but battled back for the victory. Shiny Band was the rank outsider in this five-horse field, but cruised up the rail to post the upset. The gray capped a three-race winning streak over allowance company with a five-length victory going seven furlongs at Belmont Park last October, but had not fared as well facing graded-stakes foes in her last four outings. A well-beaten third in the GIII Honey Bee H. going a mile and a sixteenth at the Meadowlands Nov. 2, the Maryland-bred was off the board in the Nov. 23 GII Top Flight S. and, after a break, the Mar. 30 GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. Last time out, she was a non-threatening third behind Distaff winner Raging Fever in the Apr. 20 GIII Bed o'Roses Breeders' Cup H. in the slop at Aqueduct. Not expected to turn the tables this time, the Allen Jerkens trainee tracked favorites Raging Fever and Victory Ride to the stretch, then slipped up the inside in the final drive to win going away. "The 'Giant Killer' strikes again," said jockey Robbie Davis. "He told me to try my hardest to pick up a check. Coming to the eighth pole, my filly just jumped on Raging Fever and I wanted to get up the rail as quickly as possible so I wouldn't get shut off. She ran a huge race today." Snow Ridge, disqualified from a win in the GII Churchill Downs H. two weeks ago, atoned for that tough loss with a much-the-best victory. The chestnut, winner of the GII Kentucky Cup Sprint last year, climbed to the head of the California sprint division with consecutive dominating wins in the GIII El Conejo H. Jan. 1, the Jan. 27 GII Palos Verdes H. (where he beat champion Squirtle Squirt) and the GI San Carlos H. Sent to the East Coast, the colt pressed suicidal fractions in the GI Carter H. at Aqueduct Apr. 13 and tired to be ninth. He came home first on the Derby Day undercard, but jockey Mike Smith inadvertently struck D'Wildcat with his whip during the stretch drive, resulting in a disqualification to second. Sent up to contest the pace three abreast in his Maryland debut, Snow Ridge disposed of Bop (Rahy) in upper stretch and proved much the best under mild encouragement. In 1989, the mare Indian Skimmer proved she was every bit as good as a five-year-old by winning this race. Campaigned at the top level the previous year, she had finished third in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Churchill Downs. Indian Skimmer was the last of her sex to win this event, but **Banks Hill (GB)** is likely to start a short-priced favourite to emulate the grey here. Like Indian Skimmer and Miesque before her, Banks Hill is a filly of the highest class, as she showed when taking the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf at Churchill Downs last October. That day, she showed marked improvement for the step-up from a mile to beat Spook Express (SAf) by 5 1/2 lengths. She also laid claims to being the best of her sex at a mile, having taken the G1 Coronation S. by 1 1/2 lengths from Crystal Music at Royal Ascot last June. Softer conditions proved her undoing when a promoted second behind Vahorimix (Fr) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville in August and when a three-length runner-up to Slickly (Fr) in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp the following month. This extended nine-furlong trip should be ideal and she should take her trainer's winning record in this to five. Godolphin, who won this with Halling in 1996, send out **Best of the Bests** for this edition. Like Halling, the Irish-bred was unplaced in his most recent start, the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 23. He has raced only once in Europe since September 2000, when third behind last year's winner Observatory in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. He may need the run here and has it all to do. **Execute** was beaten a half-length by Aquarelliste (Fr) in the G1 Prix Ganay at this track Apr. 28 last time. He bids to follow in the steps of Croco Rouge (Ire), who was placed in the Ganay before winning this in 1999.

Traditionally, the G3 Prix Penelope at Saint-Cloud and G3 Prix Vanteaux over this course are the only places to look for the future winner of this contest. Each of the last seven winners of this had prepped in one of those two events; this year, half of the field took part in one of those trials. **Sweet Oona**, whose trainer has won this twice, is the only representative of the Penelope form, in which she was fourth. The other five all took in the Vanteaux last time. It was **Ana Marie** who came out on top in that trial Apr. 28, getting the better of **Bright Sky** by a short head, with 2 1/2 lengths back to the fast-finishing **Mariensky** in third. Ana Marie had previously finished behind Bright Sky when fourth to Turtle Bow (Fr) in the Listed Prix Finlande at this track Apr. 7. While 2 1/2 lengths separated the pair that day, Bright Sky was receiving five pounds from Ana Marie and, at level weights, they proved almost inseparable last time. While Mariensky will appreciate the extra distance here, **Summertime Legacy**, who was fifth in that race, may have improved beyond them all. She represents the Andre Fabre stable, which has proved omnipresent in this race's history, having won five renewals, including four between 1992 and 1996. Summertime Legacy had Ana Marie back in third when winning the G3 Prix des Reservoirs at Deauville in August and must be feared.

Sadowa and **Sweetsouthern** led home a domestic route in the G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) at Rome May 1 and renew their rivalry here. Over the Capanelle's mile, only a half-length separated the pair, and it will be fascinating to see whether this testing mile-and-a-half trip exposes their stamina. Both fillies have won over further than a mile, but **Sadowa** may prove to have greater scope of the two for this trip. Stamina is not an issue for **Bright and Clear**, who chased home **Shadow Dancing** (GB) when 1 1/4 lengths second in the Listed Cheshire Oaks over an extended 11 furlongs at Chester May 8. 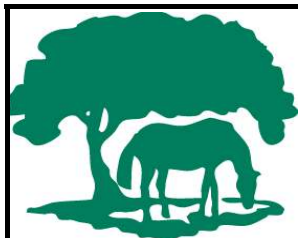
