### BEST OF THE REST AT LONGCHAMP

**Best of the Bests (Ire)** (Machiavellian), sent off at odds of 9-2, made all to land the spoils under an enterprising ride from Frankie Dettori in yesterday's G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp. While the 3-5 favourite **Banks Hill (GB)** (Danehill) failed to land a blow and could stay on at only the one pace at the finish, it was the outsider **Poussin (Ire)**

(Alzao) who loomed as the greatest threat in the closing stages. Best of the Bests had done enough, however, and kept up the gallop all the way to the line for his first score at the highest level. "The horse was going really well at home, however, he was a little bit excited and worried, perhaps, and I was worried he'd left the

race in the paddock," said Dettori. "Banks Hill hadn't run this year and I knew Best of the Bests was in great form. He stays 2000 metres, so I wanted to make sure if they were going to sprint I'd be in the front end--my horse has been in front before, so I didn't see any problems." Seventh behind Nayef in the G1 Champion S. last October, Best of the Bests returned to win the Feb. 7 G3 Second Round of the Maktoum Challenge before running seventh in the Mar. 23 G1 Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba. Godolphin racing manager Simon Crisford commented: "We will have to discuss his future, but he is in every major race, including the G1 Prince of Wales' S. [at Royal Ascot June 19]." That may also be the aim of Banks Hill. Teddy Beckett, racing manager to Prince Khaled Abdullah, explained: "She blew up and needed the race, but she's fine. In principle, she could go to the Prince of Wales' now."

#### START SPREADING THE NEWS...

Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) left Pimlico yesterday and returned to Churchill Downs. The colt is expected to travel to New York the week of the June 8 Belmont S. in his attempt to become racing's 12th Triple Crown winner. "You've all been waiting for that super horse--well you got him," a confident trainer Bob Baffert told a group of reporters at Pimlico yesterday morning. "Everything is going smooth, so hopefully we won't let you guys down. He came back great from the Preakness and the 1 1/2-miles Belmont should be a piece of cake. He's just a tough horse. He just keeps going and going and getting better and better."

**Magic Weisner** (Ameri Valay) came out of his surprising runner-up finish Saturday in fine shape. "I expected him to run big," said owner, breeder and trainer Nancy Alberts. "He's not a big strapping horse. He's just a medium-sized horse with a big heart." Alberts added that the Belmont remained a possibility.

**Proud Citizen Ready for Round Three:**

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas said yesterday he expected Derby runner-up and Preakness third-place finisher **Proud Citizen** (Gone West) to run in the Belmont. Lukas's other Preakness runner **Table Limit** (Conquistador Cielo) grabbed a quarter during his 11th-place effort Saturday.

**Holiday for Harlan:**

Trainer Ken McPeck said that Preakness fourth-place finisher **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan) will get a break after racing in five straight Grade I races in three months. "I think we're going to back off Harlan's Holiday for a while," he commented. McPeck could have a Belmont starter in Sir Barton S. winner **Sarava** (Wild Again). "The way he ran here yesterday, I might consider him for the Belmont," the trainer added.

Also earning a vacation is **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}). The colt, eighth in the Preakness, shipped back to Belmont Saturday evening. Trainer Bobby Frankel said Medaglia d'Oro would get a month or two of rest and could resurface on the turf at Saratoga.

**Preakness Numbers:**

A crowd of 101,138, short of the record 104,454 set last year, attended the races at Pimlico Saturday. The Preakness race handle was a record \$42,301,515 and total handle on the entire card was a record \$64,546,504.

Marotta sprang a surprise here, showing brilliant acceleration to deny another late flourish from the consistent Bright Sky. Richard Gibson's attractive grey entered this competitive contest a relative unknown, having only a Chantilly conditions score Apr. 29 to her name after finishing seventh in a similar event on her debut over this track Apr. 7. She settled in sixth along the rail under cover by jockey Thierry Jarnet off the fast early pace set by Grey Pearl (GB) (Ali-Royal {Ire}). Travelling easily throughout, she moved off the fence at the quarter-mile marker and quickened emphatically to hit the front with 300 yards remaining. Stretching out well under pressure, she was chased by the determined runner-up. Despite the late headway made by that filly, Marotta's earlier speed had won the day and this Group 1 contest. "This was a filly that was sold as a yearling at Deauville and was bought for FF450,000 by John David Martin," said Gibson. "When the horse went through his dispersal at Goffs, Antoinette Oppenheimer picked the filly herself as she really liked her. She won her maiden quite well at Chantilly and has improved since, so we thought it worth her taking her chance here. I must say it's a pleasant surprise that she won, but she got a serious pace which she needs and also a beautiful ride from Thierry Jarnet. I will have to discuss plans with the owner, but all being well I should imagine the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes [French Oaks at Chantilly June 9] is on the agenda."

Guadalupe arrived with a late surge to beat Bright and Clear and provide Germany with its second success in this contest after Nagoya (Ger) in 1999. Jockey Kieren Fallon was at his strongest on the filly as they arrived late to rob the favourite of Classic glory in the closing stages. Settled in seventh early as Nashwan Rose (GB) (Nashwan) went to the front, Guadalupe was taken wide for her challenge entering the straight as Bright and Clear moved into the lead. As that filly gamely warded off all challenges from the front, Guadalupe was finding more for Fallon's urgings and got on top in the final 50 yards. The filly, whose previous wins included success in the Brandenburger Stutenmeile, a conditions event at Berlin, is a half sister to the top-class stayer Royal Rebel (GB), from the family of Riviere d'Or, Gold River (Fr) and Gold Splash. "They went a good pace," Fallon said, "and my horse loved that. She stays well and finished strongly." Trainer Peter Schiergen will now aim her at the G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks at Mulheim June 9). There were no excuses for Sadowa (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}), winner of the G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas in Rome May 1), who finished well to fare best of the Italian team in fourth.

Wareed is Royal Ascot-bound after this towering performance against the best stayers in Europe. By beating the track record set by Sunshack (GB) in the 1995 G1 Prix Royal-Oak (French St Leger) by :40, he proved a different horse from the three-year-old that finished unplaced in that Classic last October. Earlier in the month, he won the G2 Prix Hubert de Chaudenay over this course by four lengths from the extremely tough Capal Garmon (Ire) in testing conditions. On much livelier ground here, he was able to display his versatility and book his place in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup June 20. Held up in fifth early by jockey Frankie Dettori as Balthazar assumed his customary position at the head of affairs, he always travelled well and was in prime position at the top of the final straight. Striking the front with quarter of a mile remaining, Wareed was driven out to go clear before being eased near the line for an authoritative score. "We did think the ground was too quick for him and we had our doubts whether he was going to enjoy it, but he was a group winner last year and he could be a nice Cup horse," said Dettori. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented of the three-time course winner: "After the last race we took him back to Dubai to give him more time. Last year, when he won here, he showed that he was a horse for the future so we saved him for this year and he looks a different horse. He has trained very well in Dubai and looks stronger and bigger than before and this is the best distance for him."

Cornelius upheld the form of Saturday's G1 Juddmonte Lockinge winner **Keltos (Fr)** by taking this contest. For Paul Cole's five-year-old, it was a deserved first stakes success, having finished runner-up to **Keltos** in both the G3 Prix Perth at Saint-Cloud in November and in the G2 Prix du Muguet at that track May 1. Previously, Cornelius finished third behind **Bedawin (Fr)** in the G3 Prix Edmond Blanc there Apr. 3 and used his experience to maximum effect as the 1-2 favourite. Taken along by **Overspect (GB)** (**Spectrum {Ire}**) in second early, he was asked to lengthen in the straight and was soon clear for a convincing success. "This horse has been unlucky not to win a group race--we twice met **Keltos** and today we were scared only about the fast ground, but he handled it well," said Cole. "I think I'll rest him now and wait for the autumn and the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua here Oct. 13 could be a race to look at with him."

Trainer Ivan Allan walked away with the lion's share of the final leg in Hong Kong's Triple Crown for the fifth straight time after a solid performance by **Cheers Hong Kong** in the ING HK Champion's & Chater Cup yesterday. The five-year-old, who placed in the HKG1 Centenary Vase and the HKG1 Hong Kong Gold Cup earlier this season, made short work of 10 others, including Hong Kong Horse of the Year Indigenous (Ire) (**Marju {Ire}**) and 1999 G1 New Zealand Derby winner **Helene Vitality**, who was an impressive second in the Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23. Coming off a sixth-place finish last time in the G1 Queen Elizabeth Cup Apr. 21, **Cheers Hong Kong** ran back to earlier French form, a pair of Listed-race victories over the soft going for trainer Andre Fabre, this time. Looking for his first Group 1 score, the gelding was content to settle in fifth early as **Snowstorm (GB)** (**Environment Friend {GB}**) and **Idol (NZ)** (**Masterclass**) cut out solid fractions. Rounding the final bend, **Cheers Hong Kong** passed fading race favorite **Rainbow And Gold (Gulch)**, who was found to have bled after the race, and **Indigenous**, and went on to score with ease over a hard-running **Helene Vitality**. "Stepping up in today's distance made the difference," said Allan. "He was staying on at the end of the QEII Cup last month, and although he was entered in the race at Singapore [International Airlines Cup, May 11] last week, I felt he had a better chance here." Allan will target the G1 Hong Kong Vase for his prized pupil next season.

**Dupont**, winner of the G2 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas) at Rome May 1, bids to emulate his full brother Pacino (GB) by taking this Classic. Having finished 3 ½ lengths third behind GI Kentucky Derby hope Castle Gandolfo in the Fosters International S. on Lingfield's Polytrack Apr. 6, he denied Fisich (GB) by a short head in a thrilling climax to the Italian Classic. He attempts to complete the European Guineas double at the expense of a strong domestic team. Heading that assembly is the unbeaten **Next Desert**. Last time, he was impressive in his four-length defeat of **Orfisio** in the G3 Preis des Gestuts Wiesenhof-Dr Busch-Memorial at Krefeld Apr. 21, where **Whisperer** was a further half length back in third. **Stolzinger** beat **Peppershot** by 2 ½ lengths in the Listed Preis der Dreijahrigigen der Merck Finck & Co Privatbankiers at Dusseldorf Apr. 28, where **Chan Chan** was a further half length back in third. **Peppershot** may be capable of reversing those placings if he reproduces his two-year-old form, highlighted by his success in the G2 Preis der Winterfavoriten at this track in October.

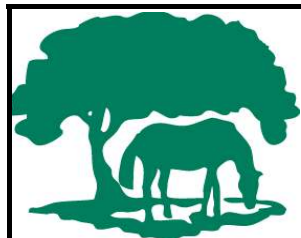

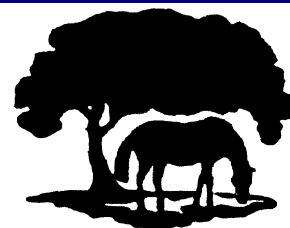
