BIG FIELD LOOKS TO SPOIL TC SWEEP

Despite the presence of a potential Triple Crown winner, the June 8 GI Belmont S. may have a surprisingly large field, which could include **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}). He is among a list of 15 horses still eyeing the third leg of the Triple Crown. Following Medaglia d'Oro's eighth-place finish in the Preakness as the 3-1 second choice, trainer Bobby Frankel said his colt would be freshened for a grass campaign. But Frankel has had a change of heart and is now considering the final leg of the Triple Crown. "I'll just train him and see how he acts," he said. "If he doesn't run in the Belmont, I'll freshen him up for the grass races in Chicago." The list of confirmed Belmont starters consists only of **War Emblem** (Our Emblem), **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer), **Essence of Dubai** (Pulpit) and **Proud Citizen** (Gone West). The latter was third in the Preakness for trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who is convinced Proud Citizen would have won the Preakness with a better trip. "I feel comfortable that we could have beaten War Emblem Saturday if we had a decent trip," Lukas said. "He got pushed out on the first turn and we lost all chance. He spent a mile of the race trying to work out a decent trip, which left him without any punch at the end." Lukas said he is also leaning toward running **Table Limit** (Conquistador Cielo) in the Belmont, despite an 11th-place finish in the Preakness. Other possibles include: **Azillion** (Ire) (Alzao), **Magic Weisner** (Ameri Valay), **Puzzlement** (Pine Bluff), **Request For Parole** (Judge T C), **Sarava** (Wild Again), **Sunday Break** (Jpn) (Forty Niner), **Tracemark** (Conquistador Cielo), **Like A Hero** (Pleasant Colony) and **Wiseman's Ferry** (Hennessy). The status of both Azillion and Like A Hero will be clarified after they start in Thursday's \$75,000 Alydar S. at Hollywood Park. Sunday Break and Puzzlement are scheduled to run in Saturday's GI Peter Pan at Belmont.

Dupont followed up his success in the G2 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas) at Rome May 1 with a convincing victory in this German equivalent. In doing so, he emulated his full brother Pacino (GB), who took this for Godolphin in 2000. Jockey Darryll Holland was confident here, keeping Dupont in third as Dimaro (Ger) (Platini {Ger}) led. Quickening a quarter of a mile out, he held off the late challenge of the 3-5 favorite Next Desert. Dupont was beaten 3 1/2 lengths when third behind Castle Gandolfo in the Fosters International S. on Lingfield's Polytrack Apr. 6 before beating Fisich (GB) by a short head in the Italian Classic last time. Trainer William Haggas may step him up in class now: "He's an improving horse, so I will be pretty keen to persuade the owners to supplement him for the G1 St Jame's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 18]." The race was marred by the death of Stolzing (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), who unseated his rider and broke through the rails, sustaining a fatal injury to his hind leg.

PEDIGREE INSIGHTS

'SPIRIT' OF GREY SOVEREIGN

As War Emblem has been reminding us so vividly in recent weeks, the ingredients which go to make an exceptional horse often include a burning desire to dominate. This inner fire can sometimes make things difficult for the people associated with the horse, as the life of that great stallion Nasrullah demonstrated, and the same applied to Nasrullah's son Grey Sovereign.

Grey Sovereign's obituary in the Bloodstock Breeders' Annual Review of 1976 recorded that:

"His highly strung temperament caused concern throughout his lifetime. Even as a two-year-old, he was frequently ridden in the paddock preliminaries and was often accompanied to the start by the trainer's assistant, whose unenviable task was to help the horse relax by 'pulling his tongue;' however, Grey Sovereign was never inclined to do anything against his will. His stubbornness persisted into old age, when he would sometimes defy all attempts to bring him in from his paddock. If rearing up and striking out failed to have the desired effect, he would charge with teeth bared."

Grey Sovereign's temperament often proved a hindrance on the track. Racing long before starting stalls were introduced in Britain, he twice refused to race as a four-year-old and he also ruined his chance on two other occasions that year. However, his high nervous energy proved more of a help than a hindrance as a stallion. He became champion sire of juveniles in 1958 and 1961 and once finished as high as second on the general sires' list, even though his progeny were mainly best at up to a mile.

By the time of his death, Grey Sovereign had established a flourishing male line, founded principally on his sons Sovereign Path, Fortino II (sire of Caro) and Zeddaan (sire of the truly remarkable Kalamoun).

Oddly enough, the Grey Sovereign-male line has virtually disappeared in Britain and Ireland, swept away in the onslaught by Northern Dancer's descendants. Fortunately for everyone, it continues to flourish in many other parts of the world. In the U.S. it depends on Caro's descendants, such as Cozzene, sire this year of Mizzen Mast, the good Japanese colts Admire Cozzene and God of Chance, and In Excess.

Caro has also helped sustain the Grey Sovereign line in France, mainly through his very effective son Kaldoun, but the line's mainstay in France has been Kalamoun. Although most of Kalamoun's best sons proved very disappointing as stallions in Europe, the high-class miler Kenmare proved a notable exception, and another son, Kampala, was destined to make a lasting impact on Japanese bloodstock through his Arc-winning son, Tony Bin.

Kenmare had already been sold to Australia by the time he completed his first French championship in 1988, but two of his Group 1-winning sons, Highest Honor and Kendor, were ready to step into his shoes. Kendor is now responsible for Keltos, who staked his claim to being the best older miler in Europe when he sprinted away with Saturday's G1 Juddmonte Lockinge S., and Highest Honor completed a Group 1 double for his male line when his daughter Marotta took the following day's G1 Prix Saint-Alary.

I mentioned earlier that one possible reason for the decline of the Grey Sovereign line in Britain and Ireland was the arrival of the Northern Dancer line. However, the two have worked together to produce Keltos, whose dam, Loxandra, is inbred 3x3 to Northern Dancer. It's well worth pointing out that last year's dual Group 1 winner Chichicastenango is by another Grey Sovereign line stallion out of a mare inbred 2x3 to Northern Dancer. Could this be the answer for breeders looking for outcross stallions for mares closely inbred to Northern Dancer?

Keltos' dam Loxandra was only a minor mile winner in England, but she was bred along similar lines to Waajib, a high-class miler best known nowadays as the sire of Royal Applause, last year's leading freshman sire in Britain and Ireland. Waajib was by Try My Best, the grandsire of Loxandra, and he was out of Coryana, the second dam of Loxandra.

The idea of sending Loxandra to a stallion from the Grey Sovereign line probably owes something to Keltos' fifth dam, Corbalton. When Corbalton was sent to Grey Sovereign's son Fortino II in 1967, she produced a son, Knockroe, which embodied all the pluses and the minuses of this volatile male line. This temperamental gelding so disliked racing in the company of other horses that his trainer resorted to using his 3.5 litre Rover car as Knockroe's galloping companion on the training grounds. In his races, Knockroe usually strolled along well behind the others, while he decided whether or not to give chase in the second half of the race. When in the mood, he was capable of producing a breathtaking finishing kick and he won several important races at up to 1 3/4 miles.

That finishing kick is also now apparent in Keltos, a very progressive individual whose long-term target is the Breeders' Cup Mile.

See How She Runs didn't make her debut until January, but she has made patience pay for her connections. The gray filly started her career with a maiden victory at Oaklawn, then posted back-to-back allowance scores over that track, winning at six furlongs Feb. 17 and at a mile Mar. 22. The Pin Oak homebred tried stakes company for the first time in her latest outing and, sent off at 7-2, led every step before outgaming Lake Lady for a 3/4-length success in the 1 1/16-mile GII Fantasy S. Racing outside of Arkansas and stepping up to the highest level for the first time, See How She Runs was bet down to 6-5 and lived up to her odds. The crowd's choice changed tactics this time, settling off an honest pace. She was caught behind horses at the quarter pole, but moved to the outside for running room and finished well to win handily. "[Trainer Donnie Von Hemel] suggested that if we could get her to settle, to settle and teach her that," said winning jockey Don Pettinger, who has ridden the filly in all her races. "She settled really nice. I was waiting there behind [Ginger Gold], and I figured she'd have the best kick. When I got room, she just took off. She's a legitimate filly." Added Von Hemel, "We were a little concerned whether she was going to rate today. It did look like there was going to be plenty of pace and he got her to settle three or four lengths off it. Califet stormed to an impressive success here, cutting down the disappointing Sensible (Fr) (Sadler's Wells) before settling the issue in a few strides. Last year, the colt won the Listed Prix du Grand Camp at Lyon Parilly at the end of November before finishing third behind Mont Rocher (Fr), who was receiving two pounds, in the Listed Prix Max Sicard at Toulouse the following month. He returned this season to be beaten a head by Ange Gabriel in the Listed Prix Lord Seymour at Longchamp Mar. 31 under a five-pound penalty, but put that rival in his place next time when handing a three-lengths beating to him and Sangreal in the G3 Prix d'Hedouville at that track Apr. 18. Yesterday, he rewarded punters' faith, settling in fourth early under jockey Davy Bonilla as Yavana's Pace (Ire) (Accordion {Ire}) cut out the running. Moved up to challenge on the bridle as Sensible was committed, Califet struck the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining before quickening away under a hand ride. Winning trainer Guy Cherel said: "This horse is really amazing and doesn't stop improving. Between races he is jumping out of his skin at home and really needs to run every three weeks. Now, after he has won a Listed, a Group 3 and a Group 2, he must go a step higher, so we will try him in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud [June 30]."

Godolphin used the Predominate as a stepping stone for the late Dubai Millennium (GB) in 1999 but the last winner to go on to Epsom Derby glory was Troy (GB) in 1979. Fillies hoping to earn a spot in the June 7 G1 Epsom Oaks take centre stage on Wednesday in the Listed £35,000 Victor Chandler Lupe S. over 10 furlongs. Love Divine (GB) was the last winner of this trial to take the Epsom Classic two years ago. Thursday's action centres around the two Listed contests, the EBF Conqueror S. over a mile and the Festival S. over 10 furlongs. The latter event, which was first run in 1975, has been won by King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. winner Ile De Bourbon (GB) in 1979, and by Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Rainbow Quest (USA) in 1985. With complete coverage from the BBC for the first time, Goodwood is set for its highest-profile meeting yet. Rod Fabricius, general manager and clerk of the course, commented: "The May Meeting begins the exciting 2002 season at Goodwood, celebrating 200 years of racing at the course, and will, as usual, attract runners from the top trainers and owners, with leading jockeys riding."
