STRONG HAND FOR O'BRIEN IN IRISH CLASSIC

Trainer Aidan O'Brien, a winner last year with Black Minnaloushe, saddles more than half the field in an attempt to win back-to-back runnings of the Irish 2000 Guineas Saturday at The Curragh. O'Brien, who has won three of the last five runnings of the Classic, has set himself a hard task to follow as he secured the trifecta last term with Mozart (Ire) and Minardi completing the sweep. It is the smallest Irish Guineas field since Rodrigo de Triano defeated five rivals in 1992, making the draw less significant. Jockey Michael Kinane takes over from Johnny Murtagh on G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas hero **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill), who is set to go to post as the hot favourite. Kinane is the only declared jockey for O'Brien's foursome with the riders of **Century City (Ire)** (Danzig), **Della Francesca** (Danzig) and **Nostradamus** (Gone West) yet to be announced. Trainer John Gosden's aptly named **Foreign Accent (GB)** (Machiavellian) is the only overseas contender for Ireland's first Classic of the season. Of the going, racecourse manager Paul Hensey told *Racing Post*:

"We had 3mm of rain overnight but it wasn't as bad as at Leopardstown--they got it bad and their meeting was called off. I walked the straight and the round course this morning and it is no worse than soft on either and I have no doubts about racing this weekend. On parts of the round course it is bordering on yielding, but if I were to call it now I would say it will be soft ground this weekend. The forecast is mixed, with heavy showers in places tonight which we may or may not get. But we should get a lot of wind tonight and tomorrow and the Curragh is a wide-open space, so 24 hours of wind can make a big difference."

MILLENNIUM WIND RETIRED Millennium Wind (Cryptoclearance--Bali Babe, by Drone), the winner of last year's Toyota Blue Grass S., has been retired from racing due to a re-occurring tendon injury. The half brother to 1999 Kentucky Derby winner and Horse of the Year Charismatic injured his tendon in last year's Derby, where he finished 11th, and took six months to make it back to the track. In what would be the final race of his career, the \$1.2 million Keeneland September purchase ran last of seven in the Skywalker H. at Santa Anita. Millennium Wind made seven starts over two seasons with three wins and a pair of placings for earnings of \$769,920. Stud plans for the four-year-old have not yet been determined.

Ransom's Pride won a pair of nine-furlong state-bred stakes last year, the Yaddo H. at Saratoga Aug. 27 and the Ticonderoga H. at Belmont two months later, before a troubled eighth in her most recent start, the GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill Downs Nov. 17. Modestly supported this time to score her first open-company win, the dark bay was a close-up second until the head of the stretch, where she darted to the rail and dug in gamely to nail second choice Laurie's Balada on the wire. Real Cozzy, winner of the GII Fair Grounds Oaks and second in the G1 Mother Goose S. as a sophomore, never got into the race and had to settle for the show spot in the small, six-horse field.

Kuntzweiller Injured:

Jockey Greta Kuntzweiller sustained a fractured vertebrae in a training mishap at Churchill Downs Tuesday and may be out for three months. Kuntzweiller, who won the riding title at the Winter/Spring meet at Turfway Park, was injured after a juvenile filly she had just worked stumbled near the seven-eighths pole. "I think I just hit the track--I saw her and she didn't hit me," said Kuntzweiller. "She felt like she was getting a little tired, but not wobble-legged. I guess she just crossed her legs and fell really hard. It kind of knocked the wind out of her, I think, because she took a while getting up--but she trotted off and was fine." Initial reports indicate that the 26-year-old fractured a vertebrae near her shoulder blades and that she could be out of the saddle for up to three months. "It's frustrating. I felt like some of those horses I rode just needed a race. I was really looking forward to a lot of these horses that I had coming up, and now I have to watch from the couch."
