ANOTHER GRADE I FOR AZERI?

Azeri (Jade Hunter) bids for her third consecutive Grade I victory in the \$200,000 Milady Breeders' Cup H. at Hollywood Park this afternoon. A perfect two-for-two last season, the chestnut filly started 2002 with a victory in an optional-claiming event at Santa Anita Jan. 12. The four-year-old suffered her first and only defeat in her next outing, finishing second behind Summer Colony in the GII La Canada S., but rebounded to take the Mar. 10 GI Santa Margarita H. and the Apr. 6 GI Apple Blossom H. back-to-back. She faces five rivals in her attempt at three in a row at the highest level, including **Affluent** (Affirmed), who is herself a Grade I winner on both turf and dirt. The Janis Whitham homebred ended her 2001 campaign with wins in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup on the Keeneland turf and the GI La Brea S. on the Santa Anita dirt. She made it three straight with a victory in the Jan. 20 GII El Encino S., but failed as the odds-on favorite in the La Canada, running fourth. She faced Azeri again in the Apple Blossom last time out and finished a solid second. Trainer Ron McAnally hopes Affluent can reverse that order of finish with San Luis Rey Downs-based Azeri this time. "Training over the deeper track here [at Hollywood] could be an advantage," said McAnally, adding, "She's been doing well since the Apple Blossom."

PROBLEMS FOR SUNDAY SILENCE

Sunday Silence (Halo--Wishing Well, by Understanding), who has been the leading sire in Japan since his first crop turned three in 1995, is suffering from a bacterial infection in his right front leg. According to a Japanese source, the 16-year-old stallion is undergoing treatment for the ailment and "His veterinarian will make a decision on June 10 [whether] the stallion will cover more mares during the 2002 breeding season or not." First or second in all 14 career starts, Sunday Silence won two-thirds of the Triple Crown in 1989, only to be tripped up by arch rival Easy Goer in the Belmont S. He turned the tables on Easy Goer in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at the end of '89, then started just twice more, winning the GI Californian S. and finishing second in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup. He retired with earnings of \$4,968,554. The dark bay, who has stood his entire career at the Shadai Stallion Station, topped the Japanese sire standings for the seventh straight year in 2001, when his progeny accounted for 333 wins and ¥6,745,789,000 in earnings.

AMERICAN INVADERS ARRIVE IN ENGLAND

Top American sprinter **Caller One** (Phone Trick) and stablemate **Western Pride** (Way West {Fr}) have arrived in England to prepare for the Royal Ascot meeting in June. The two-time winner of the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen and third in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, Caller One, who finished last in the May 11 G3 Singapore Airlines Krisflyer Sprint on the turf in his most recent start, goes next in the G1 Golden Jubilee S. June 22. His stablemate, a multiple graded-stakes winner on the dirt in the U.S., has not fared well in two starts on the international scene, finishing ninth in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 23 and 11th in the G1 Singapore Airlines Cup May 11. He is scheduled to start in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. June 19. Under the care of trainer Jim Chapman's father, Jim Chapman Sr., both are stabled at Geoff Wragg's yard in Newmarket.

ROCK OF AGES

Few ever expected to see Giant's Causeway's achievement of five consecutive Group 1 successes matched or surpassed in as little as two years, but trainer Aidan O'Brien, who conditioned the "Iron Horse," has a chance to guide **Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)** (Danehill) to another crack at the historical feat. The three-year-old goes for his fourth straight Group 1 victory in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh this afternoon. Giant's Causeway was actually beaten in this event two years ago, then went on his incredible run that ended in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. In the "Rock," the Ballydoyle handler has a live contender in chasing the record of six consecutive Group 1 wins set by Mill Reef from 1971 to 1972. He is already halfway there, having added the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas S. at Newmarket May 4 to his two juvenile scores in the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp and G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket in the span of 13 days last October. He appears to have a straightforward task here, facing only three rivals outside of his own stable. Should he succeed, he will become the first favourite to win this since Spinning World in 1996. Significantly, he is the first to try the English-Irish Guineas double since Rodrigo de Triano, who beat just five opponents at odds of 8-11 in 1992. Tirol (Ire) did it in 1990, following in the steps of Don't Forget Me (Ire) in 1987. Soft ground should not prove a disadvantage for his bid, as he put up arguably his best performance of last year in extremely testing conditions on Arc day. Many did not expect the "Rock" to beat stable companion Hawk Wing at Newmarket last time, but he had the neck call over that colt at the line, having done enough in the final furlong to ensure victory as Hawk Wing lunged late in the centre of the track. The colt meets nothing of that calibre this time. **Century City (Ire)** (Danzig), winner of the G3 Tetrarch S. at the track May 6, appears the best of the others in the line-up and can fill the runner-up spot. John Oxx drops **Ahsanabad (Ire)** (Muhtarram) drops back in trip following his third behind High Chaparral (Ire) in the G3 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial at Leopardstown May 12 and, if he handles the conditions, he should also fill the frame.

A GOING CONCERN FOR ZENDA

Jockey Richard Hughes, who is set to partner **Zenda (GB)** (Zamindar) in tomorrow's G1 Entenmann's Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh, has issued a note of caution regarding the state of the ground. John Gosden's filly, who scored in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 12, is one of 15 fillies left in the mile Classic. "It was quite dead in France when she won," Hughes said Thursday. "She wouldn't like it heavy, but hopefully there will be good drying days on Friday and Saturday, as The Curragh dries out well." Aidan O'Brien has five fillies entered, headed by **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who was fifth in the G1 1000 Guineas behind Kazzia (Ger) at Newmarket May 5 last time. But it is **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), eighth at Newmarket in her most recent effort, who is the current market leader at odds of 3-1 with Coral Eurobet, with Zenda quoted at 4-1. "The Newmarket race didn't pan out for her and didn't go according to plan," trainer Luca Cumani told *PA Sport*. "She was a bit too far back in a slowly run race--it was a big ask for her and then she stumbled." The winner of the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot in September, Gossamer was making her seasonal debut in the G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas.

A decade ago, trainer Neil Drysdale was forced to miss the Kentucky Derby with A.P. Indy, but later saddled that colt to wins in the Peter Pan S. and Belmont S. on his way to being named Horse of the Year. This year, Drysdale's **Sunday Break** failed to draw into the Kentucky Derby field with a lack of graded-stakes earnings, but will be the heavy favorite in this prep for the third jewel of the Triple Crown. "If you're not running in the Kentucky Derby, why is it necessary to run in the Preakness?" Drysdale commented. "I think not running him in the Derby or Preakness will help him because he's a late developer." The Japanese-bred bay broke his maiden in January at Santa Anita and followed with a pair of allowance scores, one at Santa Anita in February and then at Aqueduct in March. He gave a good account of himself in his stakes debut, finishing third by a half-length to Buddha and Medaglia d'Oro in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 13. "The horse has been training well and I'm pleased with him," Drysdale added. "We'll see how he does in the Peter Pan, then decide on the Belmont."
