

ROCK ON

Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) (Danehill), sent off the 4-7 favourite, produced a spectacular display to win yesterday's G1 Entenmann's Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh, beating stable companion **Century City (Ire)** (Danzig) by 1 1/2 lengths. In doing so, the sensational three-year-old maintained Aidan O'Brien's sweep of the 2002 European colts' Classics and provided his trainer with a repeat one-two-three in this race. The manner of victory had to be witnessed to be believed--the "Rock" never came out of second gear and treated his rivals as mere exercise partners to become one of the easiest-ever winners of a Classic. "He is a very high class colt and I could have waited longer on him," jockey Michael Kinane said. "He is going to be a very hard horse to lower this year if he sticks to a mile."

Guineas double since Rodrigo de Triano in 1992. Reserved early as **Nostradamus** (Gone West) set the pace, he made his bid approaching the final furlong under a motionless Kinane. The partnership eased to the front and cruised to an untroubled success.

A Model of Consistency...

The "Rock" has proven adaptable and versatile throughout his career, scoring on soft ground in his debut, a maiden test at The Curragh last April, and when winning the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp in October. He is possibly more effective on good-to-firm ground, as his success in the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas S. at Newmarket May 4 would suggest. That day he beat stable companion Hawk Wing by a neck under controversial circumstances--he was drawn high on an apparently faster strip of ground--but his victory was well earned. He will now head to the G1 St James' Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 18 to continue his bid to equal the achievement of O'Brien's "Iron Horse," Giant's Causeway, attempting five consecutive Group 1 successes. That race formed the first pillar of Giant's Causeway's record bid in 2000. (Chart p2)

OUT FOR A SUNDAY STROLL

The last horse to complete the Peter Pan--Belmont double was A.P. Indy, trained by Neil Drysdale, in 1992. The California-based conditioner may have the goods to duplicate that effort should **Sunday Break (Jpn)** (Forty Niner) go on to the final leg of the Triple Crown off his victory in yesterday's GII Peter Pan S. at Belmont Park. A 4 1/2-length maiden winner going seven-eighths at Santa Anita Jan. 21, the Japanese-bred colt successfully negotiated the jump to winners and two turns with a handy two-length allowance score Feb. 22. Shipped to New York, the bay raced very erratically in his Mar. 27 prep for the GI Wood Memorial, but managed to hold on for a one-length win, earning a spot in the Wood. Sent off at odds of 7-1 for that Apr. 13 event, he was always a factor, but could not get to Buddha and Medaglia d'Oro late and had to settle for third. The odds-on choice off that effort, **Sunday Break** raced well within himself in fourth as **Essayons** (Deputy Minister) set a fast pace from longshot **Deputy Dash** (Always a Classic) and second choice **Fast Decision** (Gulch). Allowed to cruise up to the front-runner under a long hold from jockey Gary Stevens, he edged to the front when shaken up at the midstretch marker and held off **Puzzlement** (Pine Bluff) while just being shown the whip. "He was running the last eighth," the winning rider commented. "He was much stronger today than he had been in the past. The time in between races has really helped him. If we make it to the Belmont, I hope I'm the spoiler." Stevens foiled the Triple Crown bid of Real Quiet aboard Victory Gallop in the 1998 Belmont. Added Drysdale, "If he is going to come back and run in the Belmont, he needed to settle well here. He is a very tractable horse. I think he got what he needed out of this race; the next few days will tell." Allen Jerkens, trainer of the runner-up, indicated that his charge is also probable for the Belmont. Topweighted Azeri, spotting her rivals anywhere from three to 11 pounds, made light work of yet another Grade I field to win yesterday's GI Milady Breeders' Cup H. with consummate ease. The race was unfortunately marred by the death of Cashmina (Cherokee Run), who fractured her right front ankle and was euthanized. The winner of her first three career starts, including her two-turn bow at Santa Anita by three lengths Jan. 12, the chestnut filly suffered her only defeat to date when a rallying second behind Summer Colony in the GII La Cañada S. in Arcadia Feb. 9. Stepped up in class for the GI Santa Margarita H. Mar. 10, Azeri accounted for an excellent field, including second-place Spain, by a convincing three lengths and was in search of her third consecutive win at the highest level following her 1 3/4-length defeat of Affluent in the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Park Apr. 6. Given poetic license, so to speak, by trainer Laura de Seroux, jockey Mike Smith elected to put his mount on the front end to dictate the pace from Collect Call. Confidently ridden all the way around, Azeri began to pull clear around the far turn and won under a hand ride. "She got right out there and really relaxed well," Smith commented. "She is really something special. She simply floats over the top of the ground." The winning conditioner added that the winner's next start is likely to come in the GI Vanity H. at Hollywood June 22, with possibly one additional start prior to the Breeders' Cup in October.

Canada's Horse of the Year and champion turf horse in 2000, Quiet Resolve managed just one victory last season in the GII King Edward Breeders' Cup in June and was third, beaten just a head in the GI Atto Mile in September. Tenth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf to close his six-year-old campaign, the Sam-Son homebred returned to action with a fourth-place finish in the GII Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland Apr. 12 and was coming into this effort off a seventh in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic on the Derby undercard May 4. Sent off the odds-on favorite in his return to his home turf, the gelding broke sharply from the outside to force the pace while racing three wide. The bay accelerated impressively on the far turn to draw on even terms in upper stretch and kicked clear late for an easy win.

Take Charge Lady atoned for her runner-up finish in the GI Kentucky Oaks with a much-the-best success over six overmatched rivals. Untouchable over the winter in New Orleans, the attractive bay filly ran the table with an 8 1/2-length tally in the GIII Silverbulletday S. Feb. 16 and a five-length win in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 9. The Kenny McPeek pupil added Grade I black type with an easy 4 1/2-length victory in Keeneland's Ashland S. Apr. 6, but found the final sixteenth of a mile a touch too much and had to settle for second behind Farda Amiga on Derby eve in Louisville. She worked well following the Oaks, covering three furlongs in a bullet :35 and was slated to run in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico May 17, but scoped dirty following the work and was forced to miss the race. Recovered from that bump in the road, she was cutting back to a more suitable distance for this and was hammered down to prohibitive favoritism. Content to race in second down the backstretch, Take Charge Lady pulled jockey Tony D'Amico to the front leaving the half-mile pole and was on cruise control from there, leading by three at the eighth pole before winning under a stranglehold. The final time broke the six-year-old stakes record by 0.49 seconds. "She's fun to ride, a Cadillac," the winning rider commented. "She just been awesome the whole winter long. This filly is just doing everything so easily." The winning trainer is focused on long-term goals for his charge. "Ultimately we want to be the champion three-year-old filly," McPeek said. "If we win the [GI] Mother Goose S. [at Belmont June 29], you can probably put a ring around it. We've got every reason to believe we can win the Breeders' Cup Distaff with her. She carries weight, she's big, she's got speed--she'll love Arlington," he added.

Jockey Harry Vega had hit the ground three times in the last two days, but he shook off his stretch of misfortune to guide Key Lory to victory here. Vega suffered through two spills at Pimlico Friday and also went down when his mount in the third race at Monmouth yesterday clipped heels. His trip with Key Lory was a lot smoother. Vega gunned his mount to the lead soon after the start, cut out moderate fractions, shook off a challenge on the far turn and had enough left in the tank to hold off Sardaukar for the victory. Key Lory is now a perfect four-for-four on the grass, but it wasn't until last year that he was even tried on the surface. A 1/2-length winner of the GIII Oceanport H. at Monmouth in his turf bow, he made it two in a row in the Sussex H. at Delaware Park last Sept. 1 and ended the season with a score in the Da Hoss S. at Pimlico Sept. 29. The eight-year-old was making his first start of 2002 in the Red Bank. Key Lory will defend his title in this year's edition of the Oceanport, set for June 15.  the bridle at that point, was eased to the front ap-
 proaching the final furlong and was ridden clear of his
 rivals thereafter to secure a comprehensive success.
 Tendulkar ran on strongly inside the final furlong to
 finish a clear second, but couldn't get close enough to
 trouble the winner.

ZENDA RATES THE MARQUEE With champion two-year-old filly Queen's Logic (Ire) again missing from the line-up for this afternoon's G1 Entenmann's Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh, this Classic has as open a feel as the G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 5. Godolphin's Kazzia (Ger), who won that Classic, is also absent, but the presence of John Gosden's **Zenda (GB)** (Zamindar) is considerable compensation. She exploded on to the scene with a fine front-running performance in winning the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp May 12. That day, **Wrong Key (Ire)** (Key of Luck) was a fast-finishing fourth and **Heat Haze (GB)** (Green Desert) was fifth. The latter, an improving type in the mould of her half brother Dansili (GB) and half sister Banks Hill (GB), could be anything. All three were supplemented on Tuesday and it will be fascinating to see how they fare in these much softer conditions. They should suit **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who would be a worthy favourite on the form of her 2 1/2-length success from **Maryinsky (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot on similar ground in September. However, she was disappointing when eighth behind Kazzia at Newmarket last time and has to re-assert her juvenile superiority here. Dermot Weld has saddled two winners of this since 1970 and **Saranac Lake** (Smart Strike) could prove a major threat here. She beat **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) by a head in the G3 Debutante S. over this course last August and has not been seen since. Quarter Moon went on to take the G1 Moyglare Stud S. here the following month and showed promise when a staying-on fifth in the 1000 Guineas behind Kazzia last time. **Alasha (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}) did not appear to handle the undulations in the closing stages of the 1000 Guineas when third behind Kazzia. Nevertheless, Sir Michael Stoute's filly was eventually only beaten two necks and should be better suited by this track. She bids to provide her trainer with his second renewal after Sonic Lady won back in 1986.

Marcus Tregoning's four-year-old had the latter 3/4 of a length back in second in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket in October before comprehensively confirming that authority in winning the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23 last time, where Tobougg was a disappointing last of 15. Nayef has come a long way since disappointing last spring when beaten in both the G3 Craven S. and G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. Given time to strengthen throughout the summer, he developed into a smart performer, taking the G3 Rose of Lancaster S. at Haydock, G3 Select S. at Goodwood and G3 Cumberland Lodge S. at Ascot in the space of seven weeks. His Champion S. success crowned a highly creditable feat of training by Marcus Tregoning and he appears to have improved again judged on his spring form in Dubai. The home defense is headed by Kevin Prendergast's **Rebelline (Ire)** (Robellino) and Aidan O'Brien's **Bach (Ire)** (Caerleon), both of whom have solid form. The former may hold stronger claims here, having shown a fine turn of foot when beating Johannesburg in the G3 Gladness S. at this track Apr. 7, before returning to the track to win the Listed Mooresbridge S. With another strong overseas team assembled here, the 14-year drought of Italian-trained winners looks likely to be extended. Trainer Aidan O'Brien sends **Ballingarry** into battle and that colt sets the standard after his success in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud in November. That day, he had the smart stable-companion Castle Gandolfo a length back in second and reproduction of that form would see him an easy winner of this. He returned this year to take the G2 Prix Noailles at Longchamp Apr. 7, but finished distressed when fifth behind Act One (GB) in the G1 Prix Lupin there May 12 last time. If he fails to run his race again, John Gosden's unbeaten **Proven** may be the one to capitalize. He showed considerable potential in winning a competitive conditions event at Newbury Apr. 17 last time, and on a strict line through that form holds Michael Jarvis' **Kayseri**. His trainer took this 12 months ago with the similarly unexposed Morshdi (GB) and he shaped well when third behind Fight Your Corner (GB) in the G3 Chester Vase May 7. **Fisich** looks the best chance of a first domestic success since Tisserand (Ity) in 1988 on his fine nose second to Dupont (GB) in the G2 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas) here May 1. He is bred to be suited to distance's over a mile, and the winner's subsequent smooth success in the German equivalent has boosted the form. **Rakti** is another home contender and is on a winning run, powering away with the Listed Premio Botticelli over this course May 1 last time. He looks guaranteed to stay, as does **Maranilla**, the impressive winner of the G3 Frühjahrspreis des Bankhauses Metzler at Frankfurt Apr. 28. He beat the smart Whispered Secret (Ger) by a length there and is an improving type.
