HORSES FOR THE COURSE IN MET MILE

Both **Left Bank** (French Deputy) and **Affirmed Success** (Affirmed) have shown a fondness for the main track at Belmont Park in the past, each winning five of his seven starts over the course. The two will put their stellar Belmont records on the line in the G1 Met Mile this afternoon. Eight-year-old Affirmed Success bids for his third straight victory in the \$750,000 event. The ultra-consistent bay captured the Mar. 16 Toboggan H. and the Apr. 13 G1 Carter H. at Aqueduct in his last two starts, both

with jockey Richie Migliore in the irons. Migliore picked up the mount on Affirmed Success this year. "They've got chemistry between the two of them," trainer Rick Schosberg said. "He relaxes nicely for Richie, and when Richie pushes the button on him, he's ready to go." Left Bank is also looking for his third consecutive victory. The five-year-old ended 2001 with a win in the G1 Cigar Mile, then came back May 11 to take the six-furlong G11 Bold Ruler H. He tired to finish eighth in the Met Mile over a muddy track last year, but should give a much better account of himself this time. "He got the conditioning he needed out of the Bold Ruler and he has trained well since," trainer Todd Pletcher said.

A GUINEAS FOR GOSSAMER

Bouncing back from a below-par effort in the G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas, **Gossamer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) powered away with yesterday's G1 Entenmann's Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh. In the process, the filly led home a 1-2-3 finish for her exceptional sire, but denied trainer Aidan O'Brien, who saddled the second, third and fourth, another Classic win. Sent off the 4-1 favourite, Gossamer was held up at the back of a group of three on the far rail while travelling easily. The bay loomed alongside pacesetter **Alstemeria (Ire)** (Danehill) inside the final quarter mile, hit the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and quickened away from **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) to win by 4 1/2 lengths. "I knew she'd win as soon as the gates opened--I was cruising the whole way. She got inside [the final two furlongs] and started to stretch and I never had a moment's worry," said jockey Jamie Spencer.

When the Going Gets Soft, Gossamer Gets Going...

With her Irish 1000 Guineas victory, Gossamer proved once again that she is highly effective on soft ground. The filly also demonstrated that fact by winning on rain-softened conditions in the G3 Prestige S. and the G1 Fillies' Mile last season. But, sent off the 11-8 favourite at Newmarket, she finished eighth behind Kazzia (Ger) on the good-to-firm ground. Her rider, however, did not blame that effort on the footing. "Everything went wrong at Newmarket," Spencer said. "She missed the kick and they went slow, then I was on the rail so I had to come back and come around--I was trying to make ground when they were quickening and even Dancing Brave could barely do that." Gossamer is now Royal Ascot bound. "I have always maintained that she is as good on good ground as she is on soft because I've seen her do some very good bits of work on fast ground," trainer Luca Cumani said. "That's the next thing she has to prove, so she will go to Ascot for the G1 Coronation S. [June 21], all being well." As had been feared, French 1000 Guineas winner **Zenda (GB)** (Zamindar) did not handle the going and finished last.

Rebeline resumed her role as "giant killer," proving too strong for Nayef and overhauling Bach late to claim her first success at the highest level. The progressive filly is unbeaten so far this term, cutting down Johannesburg to win the G3 Gladness S. by a short head over this course Apr. 7 before returning to take the Listed Mooresbridge S. May 6. Last year, she took two Classic trials, including the G2 Pretty Polly S. here in June, before disappointing when failing to make the frame in the main events. She did finish third in the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp in October, but trailed Nayef in eighth in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket later in the month. Looking to turn the tables this time, she settled in sixth early as Bach cut out the running. The leader shrugged off the attentions of Tobougg (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) in the straight, but Rebeline moved to the inner as Nayef attacked on the outside. As the favourite faltered inside the final furlong, Rebeline quickened to grab the advantage from the game Bach before going away for a convincing score. "She's a hell of a filly--never underestimate her," jockey Declan McDonogh said. "I had no doubts today. She's been tricky to train in the week, but the boss has done a great job with her." Trainer Kevin Prendergast added, "She is very good in that ground--when it gets fast we have to send her to bed. She will have a break now and may come back for the G1 Irish Champion S. [Sept. 7] and possibly the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [Oct. 6]."

TDN "Dark Horse" Rakti became the first home-trained colt to win the Derby Italiano since Tisserand (Ity) in 1988 by denying the 8-5 favourite Ballingarry after a dramatic finish to this Classic. Registering the first success in the race for trainer Bruno Grizetti and jockey Mirco Demuro, he had to survive a stewards' enquiry into possible interference with the runner-up. Rakti, who was the 6-5 favourite, took command on the bridle with six furlongs remaining and was sent clear by Demuro. As Ballingarry came with his run, the tiring leader crossed his path, forcing jockey Kieren Fallon to change course and lose momentum. Rakti had enough left to hold on, and the stewards found no reason to reverse the order of finish. Purchased before the race by Gary Tanaka for an undisclosed sum that included a half-share of the prizemoney earned yesterday, the winner brought home nearly €1 million for his owners and almost €50,000 to his breeder. "It was great," said Tanaka, adding, "I really don't know where to go next with him. He hasn't got any big entries, bar the GI Secretariat S." Rakti was the impressive winner of the Listed Premio Botticelli in Rome May 1 last time, having scored in a conditions event there Mar. 10 on his seasonal return. At two, he won a Pisa maiden in his third start and progressed to take a hot conditions event in Rome in his final outing as a juvenile last November. He was bred by the Rome-based Giuseppe Colarieti, who runs Brinkley Stud in Newmarket.

Narrative turned this into a non-contest, making all and going clear before being eased to a facile first European stakes success. He had already won at Group level in Dubai, when beating stable companion and subsequent G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup winner Grandera (Ire) by 3 1/4 lengths in the G3 Dubai City of Gold Feb. 24. He was set a stiff task last time, finishing ninth behind Nayef in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic Mar. 23. Here, he was barely out of an exercise stroll under Ted Durcan. "He's always been a nice horse and proved that over the winter in Dubai," said Durcan. "He was brought over to win, but no one really expected him to win as easy as he has done." Godolphin's Diana Cooper commented, "It was an extremely encouraging and exciting performance. His next target will be decided in a week or two."

Touch Down showed promise at three, finishing second in the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) at Cologne in May before running second in the G3 Darley Oettingen-Rennen at this track in August and third in the G3 Premio Chiusura in Milan in November. He returned to take the Listed Premio Bereguardo at that track Apr. 28 in his most recent effort. Looking for his first group win, Touch Down was held up towards the rear early as Inglenook went to the front, but came with a powerful late run to pass the long-time leader with 50 yards remaining. The winner becomes the third individual group/graded stakes scorer for his sire Dashing Blade (GB), following Flying Dash (Ger) and Peu A Peu (Ger) in the United States. "No miler in Germany can beat this one," jockey Jimmy Quinn said. "He is definitely one to follow. He travels easy and has a lot of natural speed." He may now head for the G3 Criterion S. at Newmarket June 29.

She appeared poised to win in a romp, but she lost her action in the final strides and was all out to hold off the late charge of Dusek. The winner is likely to make her next start in the 10-furlong G1 Estrellas Classic June 29.

Proud Citizen Preps for Belmont:

Proud Citizen (Gone West), second in the GI Kentucky Derby and third in the GI Preakness, had his first work since the second leg of the Triple Crown at Churchill Downs yesterday morning, going a half-mile in :50.80. "It was just a maintenance work," trainer D. Wayne Lukas said. "That was all I wanted to do. We'll come back the first part of the week and do something more serious." The colt will make his next start in the GI Belmont S. June 8, but stablemate **Table Limit** (Conquistador Cielo), 11th in the Preakness, will not. "He had a quarter crack coming out of the Preakness," Lukas said. "We patched it, but I don't want to push the envelope with him."

Request for Parole Sharp at Churchill:

Request for Parole (Judge TC), who was fifth in the GI Kentucky Derby last time out, worked six furlongs in 1:11.80 at Churchill Downs yesterday morning with jockey Robby Albarado in the saddle. Albarado will be aboard the colt in the Belmont S. The colt will have his final prep for the "Test of the Champion" June 4 and will ship to Belmont the following day.

The connections of **Redattore** had intended to send the Brazilian-bred to Belmont Park for the GI Met Mile this afternoon, but had to switch to Plan B when his flight to New York was canceled. Still, the seven-year-old has won half of his eight starts going a mile on the grass, including a Group 1 event in his native country and the GII San Francisco H. at Bay Meadows in April of 2001. The bay also captured the GI Eddie Read H. last season, but went to the bench after a fifth-place showing in the Oct. 7 GII Oak Tree Breeders' Cup S. He came back to take the Feb. 3 GII San Antonio H. on the Santa Anita main track and, in his only other outing this year, finished second in the May 5 GIII Inglewood H. on the Hollywood turf. **Touch of the Blues** was second by a neck behind **Irish Prize** in this race last year. A Group 2 winner in France, the five-year-old was off the board in his first two appearances of this campaign, but earned his first American score with a rallying success in the Apr. 12 GII Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland last time out. **Irish Prize**, a six-time graded-stakes winner, just missed number seven in his most recent start. The six-year-old had the lead late, but was caught on the line to finish second by a half-length in the Apr. 6 GII Arcadia H. Trainer Julio Canani, who has been first or second with nine of the 16 horses he has saddled at the meet, sends out **Ladies Din**. The seven-year-old has been the runner-up in this event twice, finishing a nose behind Silic (Fr) in 1999 and a half-length behind that rival in 2000. 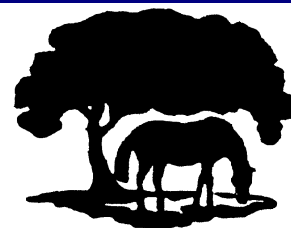
