

OUR EMBLEM SOLD

Our Emblem (Mr. Prospector--Personal Ensign, Private Account), sire of dual Classic winner War Emblem, has been purchased by WinStar Farm in partnership with Taylor Made Farm. "We feel the horse represents great value," said Doug Cauthen, president of WinStar. "He not only sired a [GI] Kentucky Derby and [GI] Preakness winner [War Emblem] in his second crop, but he also sired this year's [GII] Arkansas Derby winner [Private Emblem] and the winner of the [GIII] Railbird S. [September Secret]." Currently this year's leading sire in the United States with \$3,558,618 in earnings, the 11-year-old stallion has three crops of racing age. With only 35 foals to his credit in his first crop, Cauthen extolled the virtues of the purchase, adding, "In fact, only Broad Brush and Kingmambo have more graded stakes winners [both have four] this year than Our Emblem. He's done this with limited opportunity." Second in the GI Carter H. and third in the GI Metropolitan H. and the GI Vosburgh S. in 1995, the dark bay, who retired with \$366,013 in earnings, stood his initial season at stud at Claiborne Farm in 1997 for a fee of \$10,000. Prior to the 2002 breeding season, he was moved to Murmur Farm in Maryland where he initially stood for \$4,000, but that was later raised to \$7,500. Said Audrey Murray, co-owner Murmur Farm: "We had an offer we couldn't refuse. I wish them the best and hope the horse wins the Belmont for them."

CROWN HOPEFUL WAR EMBLEM WORKS

On the worktab for the first time since his Preakness victory, Triple Crown hopeful **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) breezed at Churchill Downs yesterday morning, going five furlongs in 1:00.60 under exercise rider Dana Barnes. The dark bay galloped out six furlongs in 1:13.60 as he gets ready for the final jewel in the

Crown, the June 8 \$1 million GI Belmont S. "He has put on some weight and he looks great," trainer Bob Baffert said. "I'm pretty excited about the way he's coming back. He galloped out really strong today. He didn't want to pull up. He didn't get tired, never broke a sweat and didn't take a deep breath. He's just a really fit horse right now, but he does it so effortlessly." Baffert, who has won eight Triple Crown races over the last six years, is making his third Triple Crown bid. His two previous attempts, with Silver Charm in 1997 and Real Quiet in 1998, were tripped up in the

Belmont. But he is optimistic that the third time will be the charm. "[Silver Charm and Real Quiet] needed certain racing luck because they came from off the pace, but this horse really just needs to get out of the gate and he's gone," Baffert said. "The main thing is to keep him healthy, and the way he looks right now, he looks pretty awesome."

REQUEST FOR PAROLE OUT OF BELMONT

Request For Parole (Judge T C), winner of the John Battaglia Memorial, will miss the GI Belmont S. June 8 due to an injury to his left front leg. Fifth in his most recent start, the GI Kentucky Derby May 4, the colt worked Sunday in preparation for the final leg of the Triple Crown. In what trainer Steve Margolis described as the beginnings of a stress fracture, he commented, "He came back good, but on the second day there was a little spot on his shin." The sophomore will be sent to Dr. Larry Bramlage in Lexington, Kentucky, to perform surgery, which may require the insertion of a screw to stabilize the bone. The dark brown colt, who has made 11 starts with four wins and earnings of \$343,812 to date, will be aimed toward a fall campaign, including the GII Clark H.

Essence of Dubai Breezes:

Essence of Dubai (Pulpit), winner of the GII Norfolk S.as a juvenile and most recently ninth in the Kentucky Derby May 4, breezed five furlongs in 1:01 over the Belmont main track yesterday. Exercise rider Lee Roebuck was in the irons. "The clockers caught him galloping out six furlongs in 1:13 and change," said Tom Albertrani, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "I wanted him to do a little bit more than he had in his last couple of works. It was a nice move."

Fresh Horse Sarava Works Toward Belmont:

Belmont S. contender **Sarava** (Wild Again) worked a half-mile in :49 1/5 yesterday at Churchill Downs with jockey Patricia Cooksey in the irons. "It was a solid half-mile," said trainer Ken McPeck. "He finished the last quarter in :23 and change." The winner of the Sir Barton S. at Pimlico May 18 was scheduled to arrive at Belmont Park late yesterday afternoon. "He's got a good shot in the Belmont, but needs some of the favorites to run poorly," added McPeck. "He's definitely a horse on the improve."

Opposition to Act One Dwindles:

Act One (GB) (In The Wings {GB}) continued to scare off the opposition in Sunday's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly, with 15 rivals remaining at yesterday's second forfeit stage. Notably, Aidan O'Brien withdrew **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), leaving four Ballydoyle runners in the mile-and-a-half Classic. **Simeon (GB)** (Lammtarra) could be added at a cost of €60,000 at today's supplementary stage, while Andre Fabre's **Shaanmer (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), fourth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas), is expected to miss the race in favour of the G1 Prix Jean Prat over a mile and an eighth on the same card. Owner/breeder Baron Edouard de Rothschild told the *Racing Post* yesterday, "Shaanmer will be left in the Jockey-Club and could even be declared for the race, just in case something happens to Act One." Alain de Royer-Dupre also spoke of **Khalkevi (Ire)** (Kahyasi {Ire}), who beat O'Brien's **Black Sam Bellamy (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the G2 Prix Hocquart at Longchamp May 8. He told the *Post*, "Khalkevi won his gallop very easily and it was a pleasure to see him going so well," but added, "The rain won't be an advantage for us if it continues." The ground is currently described as good-to-soft at Chantilly with more rain forecast.

PRESTON HEADLINES YASUDA KINEN

Eishin Preston (Green Dancer), a two-time Group 1 winner in Hong Kong in recent months, leads the home-team charge in Sunday's G1 Yasuda Kinen at Tokyo Racecourse. The five-year-old, winner of the G1 Hong Kong Mile at Sha Tin in December, is coming into this off a 1/2-length score in the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup in Hong Kong Apr. 21. "After he arrived back from Hong Kong last month he seemed a little tired," exercise rider Kazuo Fujisawa said following a 1200-meter breeze over the Tokyo all-weather surface. "However he is in really good condition now and he must keep it up until Sunday." Others expected to attract their fair share of attention include **God of Chance (Jpn)** (Cozzene) and **Grass World** (Cozzene), first and second, respectively, in the G2 Keio Hai Spring Cup May 12, and **Zenno El Cid (Ire)** (Caerleon), who scored a 3/4-length win over Eishin Preston in the G1 Mile Championship last November.

SIRE STATISTICS GALORE

It's amazing the chaos you can create--well, I can create--by asking a simple question about sire statistics. We were already planning to run the same four tables which we ran four weeks ago--European and North American second- and third-crop sires. These statistics come to us courtesy of TJCIS.

Then I got the proverbial bee in my bonnet, which turns out to be a hornet's nest. I say to myself, Self, it looks to me like this 16-year-old overnight success Danehill, is having such a good year, I wonder if he's challenging perennial champ Sadler's Wells as King of Europe. This I asked the folks at Hyperion Promotions. I always want to leave out the money from Japan, because it's five times even what the money in the States is, so including Japanese earnings distorts 'money' (progeny earnings) statistics past the point of credibility. Eventually John Quinlan at Hyperion and I decide we'll chop Japan, but include everything else.

As it turns out, 'everything else' (Northern Hemisphere only, I hasten to add) includes something I think we can call 'Asia', which consists primarily of Hong Kong, Singapore, the UAE (Dubai plus), and Turkey--where the money happens to be quite good. I know Turkey's trying to join the European Union, and that Dubai's pretty fringe in terms of Asia, but, anyway, that's what we did. But when *TDN* and I designed the tables from TJCIS, we basically asked for North America, Europe, and the UAE--we did not ask them to include Hong Kong, Singapore, or Turkey.

This is probably more than you wanted to know about designing sire statistics, but it does explain a few discrepancies and other quirks which you may find within the tables in this issue. So, through no fault of their own, the TJCIS tables do not include Hong Kong, Singapore, and Turkey, whereas the Hyperion table does. Neither includes Japan.

EUROPEAN SIRES: THE MONEY'S IN ASIA

Let's look first at the Table of Leading European Sires 2002 compiled by Hyperion, which does include 'Asia' (less Japan). We see first that neither Sadler's Wells nor Danehill is leading European sire so far this year: the winner is Machiavellian, whose Street Cry became his second winner of the Dubai World Cup. Also represented by English 1000 Guineas second and Oaks contender Snowfire in Britain, and Group 1 winner Best of the Bests in France, Machiavellian tops the chart--as long as you include Asia. If there were such a thing as an 'official' European sire list, it would probably only include European earnings. Today, on our list, which includes Asia, Machiavellian is Europe's number one sire.

Significantly, five of the top seven European sires this year have a big earner in Asia; the exceptions are Sadler's Wells and Danehill. The latter has plenty of runners in Asia, especially from his Southern Hemisphere crops, but hasn't had a real star in Asia this year.

Bishop of Cashel ranks fourth in Europe including Asia, but barely makes the top 20 European third-crop sires on the TJCIS list (those lists are cumulative, beginning when they first had runners; third-crop means first foals 1998, first two-year-olds 2000). The big difference is a colt from his first crop, who was called Ecclesiastical when he raced in Britain last year. He won the valuable Silver Bowl H. at Haydock, and ran second in the prestigious Britannia H. at Royal Ascot. Then he went to Hong Kong, where he metamorphosed into Olympic Express. He's won over £1-million in Hong Kong this year.

Similarly, Grand Lodge has Grandera, who, like Ecclesiastical/Olympic Express was trained by James Fanshawe last season. Grandera went to Godolphin, and won the G1 Singapore Airlines Cup earlier this month; this accounts for more than half Grand Lodge's 2002 Northern earnings. Marju sired the evergreen nine-year-old Indigenous, who's ran third in 10-furlong Group 1 races in Hong Kong and Singapore this year--he is also the sire of Godolphin Epsom Derby hope Naheef. And Kaldounevees is the sire of Terre a Terre, winner of last year's G1 Prix de l'Opera on Arc day, and winner of the G1 Dubai Duty Free this year.

But the answer to the original question is yes. Leaving out Asia, Danehill is challenging perennial champion and stablemate Sadler's Wells for supremacy in Europe. Sadler's Wells has 41 winners and the earners of £1,410,214 this year, including 12 SW already and the 1-2-3 in last weekend's Irish 1000 Guineas. Danehill, however, sired the winners of all three major European 2000 Guineas, courtesy of Rock of Gibraltar in England and Ireland, and Landseer in France. He also had French 1000 second Firth of Lorne, and English 1000 fourth Dolores (subsequently a new SW in her next start) for good measure. He has 42 winners, one more than Sadler's Wells, and the earners of £1,403,488, just £6,000 and a bit less than his Coolmore stablemate.

N.A. 3RD-CROP SIRES: OUR EMBLEM SURGES

Never, ever will we have a better example of why not to write a sire off until his second crop of 3-year-olds have raced than Our Emblem. Two months ago he was in the lower thirties among North American third-crop sires (first 4-year-olds 2002). Four weeks ago, his two Derby prep winners had propelled him to 21st. Now, a Derby and a Preakness later, he is up to fifth, edging out 2000 leading freshman sire Honour and Glory by \$4,000 in cumulative progeny earnings to date. Maria's Mon is back in front of Unbridled's Song for top spot among this group; he now leads him by \$130,000. Interestingly, Maria's Mon has 43 percent winners from foals now in his first two crops (66/155); Unbridled's Song, in true Unbridled fashion, has 28 percent (41/145). Hennessy is still \$65,000 ahead of Forest Wildcat--both Storm Cats, of course--for third. I'd say it's a testimony of the strength of this group of sires that Our Emblem is only fifth, and that just barely.

EUROPEAN 3RD-CROP SIRES

Spectrum, who had 237 foals to represent him in his first two Northern Hemisphere crops, is the money leader among this group, with \$156,000 more in progeny earnings than second-placed Pivotal, who had 93 foals. Each of the top five sires in this group now has three or more GSW, but Pivotal is group leader and also group surprise package, with six GSW. Three other very promising sires--Anabaa, Halling, and Mark of Esteem--round out the top five. It's all change, though, if we were to add in Hong Kong: Anabaa and Bishop of Cashel would be 1-2.

NORTH AMERICAN 2ND-CROP SIRES

Very little change here this month; in fact, Pulpit didn't have a winner in the last four weeks, and his progeny earnings increased by only around \$43,000. This enabled Valid Expectations to close the gap between them to \$110,000, whereas it had been \$270,000 four weeks ago. Open Forum edged back ahead of Smoke Glacken for third by only about \$3,000, followed still by Louis Quatorze, Langfuhr, and Siphon--all of whom have had Classic contenders who have fallen by the wayside. The biggest forward move came from Tejano Run, who advanced from 15th to 11th.

EUROPEAN 2ND-CROP SIRES

This is beginning to look like a pretty salty group. Royal Applause continues in first, but Spinning World (from his American crop) has now taken second spot off new stablemate Danehill Dancer. Zenda's French 1000 Guineas win takes Zamindar into fourth, while Singspiel has moved up from 10th to seventh, just ahead of Alhaarth. All of these look decidedly useful. Ex-Coolmore Ali-Royal (dead) and Desert King (Japan this year) are fifth and sixth. Desert King is definitely looking a middle-distance sire. Bahamian Bounty and Anabaa's three-quarter brother Key of Luck round out the top ten. Revoque is in 12th without his good Turkish filly Ribella, if she were added in, he'd be in the second five.

 A federal judge has ordered the California Horse Racing Board to repay trainer Bob Baffert a sum in excess of \$100,000 for expenses he incurred during a recent legal fight with the board, according to *Thoroughbred Times*. The case involved an alleged morphine positive from one of Baffert's horses in May 2000. After a second urine sample also tested positive, the trainer and his attorney requested that a blood sample be drawn, but were advised that the laboratory conducting the testing had lost the sample. A judge in Los Angeles found this to be in violation of due process and overturned a 60-day suspension handed down by the CHRB.

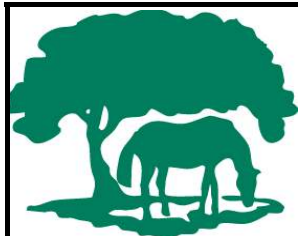
