

TOUGH ACT TO FOLLOW

All of France are ready to welcome the grey **Act One (GB)** (In the Wings {GB}) into their hearts. He heads to post a warm favourite for today's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly and he certainly deserves to be. His record is faultless; he is unbeaten, was a top-class two-year-old and has won all the right trials in the right manner. Act One was rated the best French juvenile on

117 pounds in the 2001 International Classifications after he sprinted away from the talented Landseer (GB) in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in November. He returned with a

smooth success in the G2 Prix Greffulhe at Longchamp Apr. 14, a trial which Montjeu (Ire) in 1999, Peintre Celebre in 1997 and Ragmar (Fr) in 1996 won before striking here. On the same afternoon that Landseer took the G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Poulains, Act One strode nearer his goal with a powerful display in the G1 Prix Lupin, beating Secret Singer (Fr) by a comfortable two-length margin. Although no winner of that contest has followed up here since Celtic Arms (Fr) in 1994, both Montjeu and Anabaa Blue (GB) last year went close there before winning this event. Act One will bid to become owner/breeder Gerald Leigh's second Classic winner in a week, following Gossamer (GB)'s success last week in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas. Aidan O'Brien has a strong hand with which to challenge Act One's dominance. **Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West), **Black Sam Bellamy (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Diaghilev (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) will attempt to take the French Classic back to Ballydoyle for the first time since Caerleon's success in 1983. Alain de Royer-Dupre, who took this three times between 1984 and 1987, will be hoping the compact **Khalkevi (Ire)** (Kahyasi {Ire}) can end a long dry spell for His Highness the Aga Khan.

MACHO MAN

Showing an impressive turn of foot, **Macho Uno** (Holy Bull) extricated himself from behind a wall of horses to win the GII Massachusetts H. yesterday at Suffolk. The 2000 champion two-year-old colt won the GIII Pennsylvania Derby on Labor Day and concluded his three-year-old season with a solid fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. A sharp winner of a Gulfstream allowance Mar. 23 in his only previous start this season, the Stronach homebred was sent off as the 2-1 second choice. Gary Stevens settled the grey colt on the rail in fourth through a solid pace and turned for home with a horse full of run, but no place to go. He wheeled to the outside, nearly impeding **Evening Attire** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}), but straightened himself out, quickly took charge and was geared down in the final strides. "This was a powerful performance," said Stevens. "He is a much more professional horse than earlier in his career. I don't want to say he will be Horse of the Year, but I hope he stays the way he is." Defending champ **Include** (Broad Brush) ran third.

Tweedside took the lead early in the stretch and withstood a three-pronged challenge to win Saturday's Belmont feature. The bay filly proved her ability to get a distance of ground last year in winning the 12-furlong GI Coaching Club American Oaks on the dirt last July, but could do no better than sixth in the GI Alabama S. Aug. 18 and was eased in the GI Flower Bowl Sept. 29 on the turf at Belmont. She returned victoriously Mar. 11 at Gulfstream, defeating Peanut Gallery (Mister Baileys {GB}) in a 1 1/16-miles optional claimer, but weakened to fourth behind Sweetest Thing in the GIII Bewitch H. Apr. 25 at Keeneland. Tucked into a ground-saving position by John Velazquez as Refugee (Unaccounted For) showed the way, Tweedside came through along the inside turning for home and quickly opened a clear advantage. She looked to have things sewn up at the eighth pole, but Sweetest Thing came flying at her on the outside, with Golden Corona and Owsley (Harlan) in between the pair. A photo showed Tweedside a nose in front. "She might have made the lead a little bit sooner than we wanted her to," commented winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "We'll take a look at the New York H. [GII, 10fT, July 4]."

Pisces and Classic Par broke side by side from the gate and wound up in the winner's circle together following the disqualification of 67-1 Two Point Two Mill (Known Fact). Winner of the GII Appleton H. at Gulfstream Jan. 5, Pisces was coming off a fifth in the GI Woodford Reserve H. Classic Par captured a Keeneland allowance Apr. 6 before running sixth to Kim Loves Bucky (Green Dancer) in the GIII Elkhorn H. Apr. 24. Both runners were well-placed early and made their moves concurrently, reaching the wire together. "This isn't the first time that I've moved up to win a stakes," quipped jockey Donnie Meche, who rode Classic Par. "But it is the first time to be moved up and be in a dead-heat also." Longshot Two Point Two Mill, making a sweeping six-wide bid, drifted in and impeded Rochester (Green Dancer), who clipped heels and nearly went down. "I think that I was going to win it, I really do," said Rochester's rider Pat Day. "I hadn't called on my horse at that point. He was moving nice and I know he's got a pretty good turn of foot. As easy as he had gotten to that point I felt like he was certainly going to make his presence felt at the end of it."

Dance Routine disappointed on her debut when sixth in a conditions event at Saint-Cloud Apr. 10, but made no mistake next time in a similar event at Longchamp May 12. She held Mer de Corail and Drama Payout (GB) (Kendor {Fr}) on that form and confirmed placings this time with a smooth display. Breaking smartly, she was coaxed upsides Birdie (GB) (Alhaarth {Ire}) in the early stages by jockey Olivier Peslier before being taken to the front by the halfway. Travelling easily there, she had the race in control as Dominique Boeuf brought Mer de Corail from the rear to challenge in the straight. Pushed out with hands and heels inside the final quarter of a mile, she had a considerable amount in hand on the runner-up at the line to register a comfortable first stakes success. Dance Routine may now head to Saint-Cloud for the G2 Prix de Malleret June 30.

The high point of Doc Holiday's six-race English campaign last year came when the chestnut colt ran third to Johannesburg in the G1 Middle Park S. Oct. 4 at Newmarket. He made one additional start on the Continent, finishing seventh in the G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte Oct. 25, and made his U.S. bow Feb. 24. Sixth in the GIII Baldwin S. contested down the hill at Santa Anita, Doc Holiday followed that up with a second to GSW Mountain Rage in the La Puente S. going a flat mile at Santa Anita Apr. 14. He then chased Van Rouge all the way round when second in the GIII Ascot H. going 1 1/16-miles at Bay Meadows May 12 and was the third choice in this short field. Breaking alertly from his rail post, the Irish-bred went straight to the front and rationed his speed through fractions of :47.21 and 1:10.82 Johar came to his hip turning for home, but Doc Holiday fought off that challenge the length of the stretch to earn his first stakes victory. "He ran a good second up North in the Ascot H. in his last race, and I really like him," said winning rider David Flores. "I was very comfortable the first half-mile. At the 3/8-pole, I just kind of tapped him a little bit, and he was really ready to go. I waited as long as I could, and when Alex [Solis, aboard Johar] showed up alongside in the stretch, I just asked him and he responded." The 8-5 favorite in his first U.S. start, True Phenomenon (Afternoon Deelites) lacked a late punch, finishing fourth. [Click here for the brisnet.com chart.](#)
