

### SULAMANI SPRINGS SURPRISE AT CHANTILLY

**Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}), sent off at nearly 20-1, swooped late under Thierry Thulliez to end the unbeaten record of the 9-10 favourite **Act One (GB)** (In The Wings {GB}) in yesterday's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly. In doing so, he emulated his sire, who won this in 1993, and his half-brother Dream Well (Fr), who followed up in 1998 as the third of Pascal Bary's Jockey-Club winners. As Sulamani

and Act One quickened impressively inside the final furlong, they pulled five lengths clear of the **Simeon (GB)** (Lammtarra), who stayed on well under Frankie Dettori to be third. Seventh in his debut, a Longchamp conditions race Apr. 7, Sulamani took a similar event at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 30 on soft ground. He followed with a score in the Listed Prix de l'Avre over this course May 15, beating Agog (Ire) by 1 1/2 lengths and showing that he handled the firm conditions by displaying a fine turn of foot. Here he was held up in the rear early as **Temple of Artemis (GB)** (Spinning World) led the pack along at a fast clip, with Simeon and the free-running **Louveteau** (Bahri) chasing the leader. Confidently ridden from there, the bay had only two behind as they swung into the straight, but had clear passage on the outside of the field. Act One hit the front under Thierry Gillet approaching the furlong marker, but Sulamani was mounting his winning charge. He quickened dramatically to join battle with the grey inside the final 150 yards and, asserting soon after, sprinted away under considerate handling to win by 1 1/2 lengths and record a time only 9/10 of a second outside of the record set by Bering (GB) in 1986. "I intended to ride him closer to the pace, but they went very fast and there was a lot of bumping in front of me early, so I took no chances and let him settle at the back," Thulliez explained. "When I moved on him, he was really smooth...I was never worried from that point on as I knew he would accelerate like he did last time."

### Bary Celebrates Fourth French Derby Score

Winning trainer Pascal Bary, celebrating his fourth victory in this Classic, said, "Today he was some kind of horse and showed fantastic acceleration." As for the future, he added, "I went to Ireland with [1998 French Derby hero] Dream Well, but this horse is not as mature as him. We will wait and see how he comes back, as he has run three times in five weeks--the horse will decide, and he might need a break." The G1 Irish Derby is set for June 30 at The Curragh, but Sulamani would have to be supplemented to the race. Alan Cooper, racing manager to the owner/breeder, the Niarchos family, said, "He's a horse who has had quite a lot of racing in a short period of time and he's a horse who is going to better with time." Act One's trainer, Jonathan Pease, had no excuses. "We were beaten by a better horse on the day," he said with a smile. Aidan O'Brien's **Black Sam Bellamy (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), **Castle Gandolfo** (Gone West) and **Diaghilev (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) finished in fifth, sixth and seventh, respectively, with the latter particularly unlucky in running.

Rouvres and Olivier Doleuze denied Frankie Dettori and Imtiyaz and Olivier Peslier and Shaanmer in a thrilling finish. In doing so, he provided trainer Criquette Head-Maarek with her second success in this. Rouvres was beaten three lengths by Act One (GB) in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon at Saint-Cloud in October, but returned to take a conditions race at this course Apr. 4 before beating Rashbag (GB) by a short neck in the G3 Prix de Guiche at Longchamp May 16. Keen in fourth on the rail in the early stages here while rating off the inadequate pace set by Nostradamus (Gone West), he had to be ridden to close alongside Shaanmer, who was staying on well on the outside up front. Dettori sent Imtiyaz to the fore approaching the turn into the straight and the colt was giving everything on the rail as Rouvres and Shaanmer challenged inside the final 100 yards. It was only in the final strides that the winner overcame his rivals. Head-Maarek said, "He's a really nice, gifted horse who is very tough, but he does not show a lot in the mornings. He is a different horse on the racetrack--he can't be faulted. The G1 Grand Prix de Paris [at Longchamp June 23] is a possibility, but it looks as if he might have had a hard race here so we may wait for the G1 Secretariat S. at Arlington in August." Imtiyaz may now head to the Grand Prix de Paris, according to Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford. Aramram (Danzig) unseated Steve Drowne when diving to the left in the home straight.

Admire Cozzene, the champion juvenile colt in Japan in 1998, went two years without a victory, finally breaking the streak with a win in the G3 Tokyo Shimbun Hai in January, then came right back to take the G3 Hankyu Hai the following month. Coming off a second-place finish in the G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen, the gray was sent off at long odds this time. He settled just off the pace, kicked it into gear as they came out of the final turn and took the lead late in the lane, then had to hold off the final charge of Dantsu Flame to post the narrow score. "It didn't feel like we were going to win until the very end, but the horse ran really well in the stretch," jockey Hiroki Goto, picking up his first Group 1 victory, said. "Today is my son's birthday, so this will be a great present for him." Favored Eishin Preston (Green Dancer) was well back early and finished well, but could get no closer than fifth, beaten two lengths.

A Listed stakes winner in Ireland at three, Siringas was off the board facing Group company in her final three starts across the Atlantic. The bay was shipped to the U.S. last fall, making her American debut in the Oct. 26 Gill Athenia S. at Belmont Park, where she missed by a nose behind Verruma (Brz). Given a winter vacation, the Irish-bred came back to take a Gulfstream allowance race Mar. 13, then was second as the 7-5 chalk in a Keeneland allowance last time out Apr. 11. The filly was sent off the odds-on choice after a return to graded-stakes company and lived up to her backing, closing from fourth to catch the speedy Rosthern in deep stretch before drawing clear despite lugging in badly during the drive. "I got a little worried about the half-mile pole when everybody was starting to get away from me," winning jockey Jose Santos said. "So I started asking my filly. She was not picking it up, but when she switched leads at the top of the stretch, she really started running. We had a little bit of a problem with her because she was lugging in real bad and I couldn't ride her the way I wanted to. But the main thing is she got the job done, she went pretty easy and finished very well, so I'm very happy with her." Added Nicholas Bachalard, assistant to trainer Christophe Clement, "We took the blinkers off today. I thought she might have been a bit too far back, but she ran a great race. I'm thrilled. I just told [Santos] to stalk the pace, not to be too far out of it and just wait as long as he could." For the brisnet.com chart, click [here](#).

Spring Star proved the best of the unexposed fillies lined up for this contest in outbattling the front-running Clerical Error. Having finished second to Chanteline (Ire) in a debutantes event at Saint-Cloud Mar. 26, she was a short head and a neck third behind Little Treasure (Fr) and Polygreen (Fr) in a conditions race on this course Apr. 16. Last time she reversed with Chanteline (Ire) in a similar contest May 7, showing her determination there in a tussle to the line. Here she displayed the same qualities in the finish, tracking in second before overcoming the long-time leader and Christophe-Patrice Lemaire in the final strides. Carlos Laffon-Parias commented, "She is a talented filly. I have won this race in the past with fillies who have later progressed to Group 1 level and I think she could be the same."

Porlezza and Maybe Forever met for the fifth time here and this time it was the former who proved the strongest. Last time, Porlezza failed by a neck to defy a two-pound penalty as Maybe Forever took the win in the G3 Prix de Saint-Georges at Longchamp May 12. That leveled the score between the two, as Porlezza had twice finished ahead of her rival as a juvenile, beating her by a length in the Listed Prix de la Vallee d'Auge at Deauville in August and again when sharing second the next month in the G3 Prix d'Arenberg at Chantilly, with Maybe Forever back in fourth. Maybe Forever was beaten a nose by Swedish Shave (Fr) first time this season in the Listed Prix Servanne at Chantilly Apr. 23, where Porlezza was seventh, again under a penalty. Breaking in fifth here under Christophe Soumillon as the even-money shot Swiss Lake (Indian Ridge {Ire}) and Sa Premiere (Fr) (Nombre Premier {GB}) cut out the running, Porlezza stayed on well as the favourite veered left past halfway. Finishing with a flourish, she caught Maybe Forever with 50 yards remaining and was firmly on top at the line. Winning trainer Yves de Nicolay said, "I'm not surprised by that as she is a very nice filly and very fast. I didn't dare enter her at Royal Ascot after she was seventh on her first run, but I found out she had knocked her head on the gate there. Her last two runs have been excellent and, as there is nothing left in France for her at present, she will most probably travel to England for the top sprints at York [G1 Nunthorpe S. Aug. 22] and Haydock [G1 Sprint Cup Sept. 7]."

Simoun took the Listed Kolner Grand Prix Aufgalopp 2002 at Cologne Mar. 17 before finishing second to Well Made in the G3 Grosser Preis der Bremer Wirtschaft at Cologne Apr. 7. Returning to that track, he failed to make an impact against that rival when fourth in the G2 Gerling-Preis on heavy ground May 5. Here he was settled in second by Andreas Suborics as Limerick Boy (Ger) (Alwuhush) assumed the early lead. Swinging into the straight, he had to be ridden to close on the long-time leader, who had most of the field on the stretch at that point. Samum was angled out wide by Terence Hellier, but, with considerable ground to make up on the leaders, he struggled to get on terms as the winner hit the front with 250 yards remaining. Pushed out from there, Simoun's advantage proved decisive over the staying-on Samum; Well Made never threatened. Simoun and Samum will renew rivalry in the G2 Hansa Preis at Hamburg June 30.

Kona Gold, the champion sprinter of 2000, capped a seven-race winning streak with a 3/4-length score in the Gil Bing Crosby Breeders' Cup H. at Del Mar last July, but was held winless in his last three starts of the campaign, including a seventh-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and a fourth-place effort in his seasonal finale, the Nov. 17 GI DeFrancis Dash. The odds-on choice in his first appearance of 2002, the veteran tracked fast fractions and turned it up a notch in the stretch, taking the lead at the eighth pole and pulling away to prove he still belongs at this level. "It's a lot of fun when you have a horse like this," trainer Bruce Headley said. "He could be back...maybe he's on his way to his fifth [start in the] Breeders' Cup. Maybe he'll win again." Added jockey Alex Solis, "I thought he would run a race like this, the way he has been training. He's eight now, but I'll tell you, he looks like a four-year-old. The freshening really helped him. He's ready to do it again." As for what's next, Headley said, "It could be the [GI Triple Bend Breeders' Cup at Hollywood July 6], hopefully, if he's in good shape, then on to Del Mar." With **Persian Punch** and **Solo Mio** in the line-up here, the winners of five of the last six runnings are present. **Persian Punch**, now nine, won the event in 1997, 1998 and 2000, and it is less than six months since he ran arguably his best race when third behind **Ethereal** (NZ) in the G1 Melbourne Cup at Flemington. His voracious appetite for a battle will see him engage with his more youthful rivals here once again, but the scattering of progressive types may prove too much for him to handle. Chief among them is Mark Johnston's **And Beyond**, one of four stable representatives and, judging by jockey bookings, the most highly regarded. He battled to success in the competitive G3 Queen's Vase at Royal Ascot last June before being freshened for his only subsequent run, the G1 St Leger at Doncaster in September, where he was soundly beaten in seventh behind **Milan** (GB). He should find this longer trip and less exalted company in his favour. **Beekeeper** represents the Godolphin team and he also scored at Royal Ascot last year when trained by Sir Michael Stoute. His performance when winning the King George V H. there led his trainer to run him in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York in August and he was far from disgraced in fourth, beaten only three lengths by **Milan**.
