### IT'S WAR AGAINST ELEVEN RIVALS

For the fourth time in the last six years, just the GI Belmont S. stands between horse and racing immortality. An alert and curious **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) ambled down the ramp upon his arrival at Farmingdale Airport yesterday morning, his ebony coat glistening on a warm and humid day in the Big Apple. A short time later, the Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner drew post position number 10 for Saturday's final leg of the Triple Crown and was installed the even-money favorite on the morning line. "The horse is doing great," trainer Bob Baffert told track announcer Tom Durkin during

yesterday's traditional post position pull. "I am very happy with the draw. I wanted an outside post. He is a fast horse. He can leave there and dictate the pace he wants." Baffert later added, "You can't take his game away from him. I don't want to see [jockey] Victor Espinoza pulling hard because that weakens him." Certainly, Prince Ahmed Salman's colt has shown that he is quick enough to gain the front end if he wants it, but there appears to be plenty of potential speed horses to his inside. **Proud Citizen** (Gone West) could revert to the front-running style which

helped him win the GII Coolmore Lexington S. in April. An excellent runner-up in the Derby, the D. Wayne Lukas pupil comes into the "Test of a Champion" off a solid third in the Preakness, despite enduring a tough, wide trip at Old Hilltop. "He has had four races in eight weeks, but he doesn't give me any indication that he is backing up," said Lukas. "I think he has moved forward. I like his muscle tone, his weight is exceptional, he seems to be handling the stress of the campaign. But you can't be sure until they're turning for home." The bay is the second choice on the morning line at 5-1. *(Belmont S. field p2)*

### More Speed To Lead

Additionally, **Wiseman's Ferry** (Hennessy), who wired the GIII Lone Star Derby from the 14-hole May 11, is likely to be sent from post position three by jockey Jorge Chavez, while **Sunday Break (Jpn)** (Forty Niner) has displayed versatility enough to adapt to the shape of the race. The Japanese-bred colt raced with the pace of the GI Wood Memorial Apr. 13 before finishing a game third and came from just off the pace to score the GII Peter Pan S. at Belmont May 25.



### The Few, The Proud, The Forgotten...

On Derby Day, jockey Eddie Delahoussaye quickly determined that the slow pace would hinder **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) and decided to race with the leaders. A come-from-behind winner of the Mar. 23 GII Lane's End Spiral S., he lacked a late punch, but finished a creditable third. Looking to become only the second gelding to win the Belmont, he figures to get a reasonable pace to run at this time around. "He'll run over it," trainer Murray Johnson said of the Belmont Park surface. "He loves running on turns. The Belmont track suits his style." **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}), a troubled fourth following a slow pace in the Derby, was a disappointing eighth in the Preakness after racing too close to the fast pace. A generous 10-1 chance on the early line, the attractive dark bay has every right to rebound with a better trip. Trainer Bobby Frankel has tabbed jockey Kent Desormeaux to ride.

**HARLAN'S HOLIDAY TO PLETCHER**

**Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan), the Kentucky Derby favorite off his wins in the GI Florida Derby and GI Toyota Blue Grass S., has been transferred from trainer Ken McPeek to Todd Pletcher's barn. Seventh in the Derby, the Ohio-bred was most recently fourth, beaten three lengths, in the Preakness S. May 18. Co-owner Jack Wolf explained that he wants to consolidate his racing operation in New York, where Pletcher is based. "My wife and I recently bought a house in Saratoga Springs and we currently have some horses with Todd, who we've enjoyed working with," Wolf said. "I have no complaints about anything Ken McPeek did with Harlan's Holiday. He did a good job with the horse. But we wanted to get all our horses together in New York." While disappointed, McPeek said he harbors no hard feelings toward Wolf. "It's a part of this business," he said. "I'm very proud of the job we did with this horse. The fact that my wife Sue was sick last year has given me a different perspective on these things. I'd much rather lose Harlan's Holiday than her or my daughter." Wolf added that Harlan's Holiday was tired after the Preakness and needed a rest, but he was hopeful the three-year-old could return in time for the GI Jim Dandy S. or the GI Haskell H., both Aug. 4.

**FOURTEEN SET FOR FRIDAY**

A field of 14 fillies have been entered for Friday's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom, headed by Lord Weinstock's **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), heroine of the G3 Musidora S.; and Godolphin's **Kazzia (Ger)** (Zinaad {GB}), who will have to overcome a wide draw in 13 if she is to follow up her surprise success in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4. "Whoever goes by me wins--Kazzia will not go down without a fight as you saw in the Guineas," said a bullish Frankie Dettori, who rode the filly at Newmarket. "She can fight and she will stay. There is no hole in her armour." Michael Kinane will take the ride on **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who like last year's winner Imagine (Ire) will start from stall 10. She heads a team of four from Aidan O'Brien's Ballydoyle stable, successful with both Imagine as well as Shahtoush (Ire) in 1998. Marcus Tregoning yesterday expressed himself as satisfied with the draws for his two fillies **Esloob** (Diesis {GB}) and **Shadow Dancing (GB)** (Unfuwain). Esloob has drawn 12, while Shadow Dancing will race from three. "They are in very good form, I am very happy with them and they probably couldn't be much better, so we're hopeful that they will both run very well," Tregoning told *PA Sport*. "The draw won't make that much difference. It's an average size field so it should be fine." Of the four withdrawals yesterday, Barry Hills' **Fragrant View** (Distant View), second to Islington in a Newbury maiden Apr. 19, was the most notable. Epsom racecourse yesterday announced that 8 millimetres of rain fell after 11am and that the going now reads as good, good to soft in places.

**HOLLAND KEEN ON MELLOW**

Jockey Darryll Holland yesterday spoke of his hopes for **Mellow Park (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}) in tomorrow's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom. With rain falling on the Surrey track all day yesterday, Holland believes the conditions will help the winner of the Listed Lupe S. at Goodwood May 22. He said yesterday, "She relished the ground at Goodwood and Jeremy [Noseda] said she would probably be better with better ground, so I'm happy if it goes soft and if it was good I'd be even happier. She's done nothing wrong and she's very laid-back at home but there's no prizemoney at home and hopefully we can pick the big one up on Friday."

Claimed for \$45,000 out of a fifth-place finish at Aqueduct last Dec. 12, New York-bred Bella Rouge returned to score a 3/4-length victory against open company over the inner track at the Big A Feb. 7. Second at the next level at Aqueduct Mar. 28, the chestnut remained undefeated at this trip with a 3 1/2-length success at Aqueduct Apr. 27. In hand early towards the back of the back, Bella Rouge took advantage of an opening along the inside turning for home and pulled impressively clear. Even-money Shooting Party (Sky Classic) set a good pace, but gave way and finished last of five.

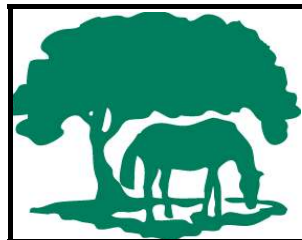

### BIG TRAINERS TARGETED IN DOPE CHECKS

Trainers **Bruno Grizetti**, **Alduino** and **Giuseppe Botti**, **Maurizio Guarnieri** and **Valfredo Valiani** were yesterday waiting on the results of the investigation by the Italian authorities into possible doping. Saturday's raids by the **Nucleo Anti Sofisticazione (NAS)** in **Milan**, **Pisa**, **Merano**, **Florence**, **Turin** and **Varese** were organised to uncover any instances of outlawed drugs such as **clenbuterol**, a bronchial dilator. **Grizzetti** and **Valiani**, president of the **Italian Trainers' Association**, welcomed the investigation, which also included two major veterinarians. Among the evidence taken are blood samples of horses declared to run in **Milan** on **Sunday**, as well as unlabelled boxes and bottles of medicine. **Giudige di Prete** of **Milan's** court of justice is investigating the illegal importing of the medicinal products from **Germany** and **Switzerland**.
