

ISLINGTON A "PERFECT" CHOICE IN OAKS

Her owner Lord Weinstock believes her to be the "perfect" filly, an opinion which may be justified if **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) goes on to win today's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom. Sir Michael Stoute's filly was prominent in the Oaks betting before she showed the requisite speed and determination to win the G3 Musidora S. at York May 14 by a length from **Spinnette (Ire)** (Spinning World). On pedigree, she is tailor-made for this, being by Sadler's Wells, sire of four Epsom Oaks winners, out of her owner's G1 Yorkshire Oaks winner **Hellenic (GB)**. Lord Weinstock's colors were last successful here in 1983 when **Sun Princess (GB)** recorded a record winning distance. That filly was handled by the late Major Dick Hern, whose presence is very strong in the two representatives of his former assistant Marcus Tregoning. Not only did he part-breed and own **Shadow Dancing (GB)** (Unfuwain), winner of the Listed Cheshire Oaks at Chester May 8, he also trained **Roseate Tern (GB)**, the dam of **Esloob (Diesis {GB})**, to be a promoted second in this in 1989. **Esloob**, who took the Listed **Pretty Polly S.** at Newmarket May 5, may be the best chance for Tregoning to open his Classic account. Her sire is second only to Sadler's Wells in producing winners of this, his three successful daughters being **Diminuendo** in 1988, **Ramruma** in 1999 and **Love Divine (GB)** in 2000. **Love Divine** remains the only winner of the Listed **Lupe S.** to follow up here, but this year's 11-length winner **Mellow Park (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}) may extend that record. Highly impressive in the rain-softened ground at Goodwood May 22, she has a similar profile as she broke her maiden in that trial. **Godolphin's Kazzia (Ger)** (Zinaad {GB}) bids to become the first filly since **Salsabil (GB)** to complete the 1000 Guineas-Oaks double. Connections are convinced that a mile and a half will suit her to much greater effect and she will be helped by the recent rain. Aidan O'Brien's **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) was fifth in the Guineas before finishing runner-up to **Gossamer (GB)** in the Irish equivalent May 26, won last year by **Imagine (Ire)**, who went on to success here. WHICH SQUIRREL GETS THIS ACORN?

Three-year-old fillies occupy center stage this afternoon as Belmont Park hosts the first leg of the filly Triple Tiara, the G1 Acorn S. A small, but accomplished field of six has been assembled, including five graded-stakes winners, headed by the top-class duo of **Bella Bellucci (French Deputy)** and **You (You and I)**. The former, owned by Michael Tabor, suffered her only defeat to date when third in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies last October. Unbeaten in two starts in 2002, the full sister to Japanese champion **Kurofune** was an easy seven-length winner of the GIII **Comely S.** at Aqueduct Apr. 14. Scheduled to run in the May 3 G1 Kentucky Oaks, the \$925,000

FTFFEB juvenile purchase was withdrawn a few days ahead of the race with a low blood count. "She's back on track," trainer Neil Drysdale commented. "We were disappointed that we didn't make the Oaks with her. I've been pleased with her progress over the last few weeks." Edmund Gann's **You**, winner of the G1 **Frizette S.** at Belmont last September, proved best among California's sophomore fillies this winter, with wins over **Habibti** in the G1 **Las Virgenes S.** and G1 **Santa Anita Oaks**. The reformed claimer was last seen when fourth, beaten three lengths, in the **Kentucky Oaks**. "She ran her race in the Oaks. I think nine furlongs is a little too far," explained trainer Bobby Frankel. "She's as sharp as ever. I've been real happy with her training. The turnback (to a mile) helps. She's going to run big."

KINANE CHOOSES HAWK WING Michael Kinane ended weeks of speculation yesterday by siding with **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) for tomorrow's G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom. Although the jockey had warned that a significant weather change could result in a switch to the other Aidan O'Brien-trained colt, **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), he has decided to partner the favourite. Kinane will be renewing his link with Hawk Wing for the first time since he won the G1 National S. at The Curragh last September. Kinane missed the ride on the colt in the G1 2000 Guineas May 4, where he finished a neck runner-up to Rock of Gibraltar, due to suspension. Further rain yesterday morning has turned the ground to soft, good to soft in places for today's meeting at the Surrey track but clerk of the course Andrew Cooper is hoping for a dry spell before tomorrow's race. He said yesterday, "We had 37 millimetres of rain, which amounts to about an inch and a half, between 11 a.m. yesterday morning and 3 a.m. today. There has been only light drizzle since the rain stopped and the forecast is that it will remain cloudy and overcast with the possibility of the odd shower for today and for the two days of racing. The temporary rail will be removed for racing on Saturday so that the runners in the Vodafone Derby will have brand new ground to race on." Hawk Wing was handed the outside post in 12 yesterday, but connections will be unconcerned as Sinn dar (Ire) won from the widest draw two years ago. The sole defection, as expected, was Godolphin's **Dubai Destination** (Kingmambo).

Godolphin hold a stong hand here with **Kutub** and **Marienbard**. Last time, the latter had Kutub 2 1/2 lengths back in fifth when winning the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 3. In receipt of five pounds on that occasion, the bay had the benefit of a previous run when fourth, 2 1/4 lengths behind Nayef in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23. He appears to have progressed throughout the winter and may be capable of holding his stable companion again here, but the rain seems to have come in time for Kutub. That one proved his efficiency on an easy surface last year with success in the G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich in August, the G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne in September and the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club in Milan the following month. He adapted to a faster surface when winning the G1 Singapore Gold Cup in Kranji in November but he is arguably superior with cut underfoot. That will also suit the German raider **Boreal**, who eclipsed his peers in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg in July before finding only Morshdi (GB) 1 1/4 lengths too strong in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden in September. His performance when third behind Nayef in the Dubai Sheema Classic last time was highly creditable considering the fast ground and he may prove a tough nut to crack here.

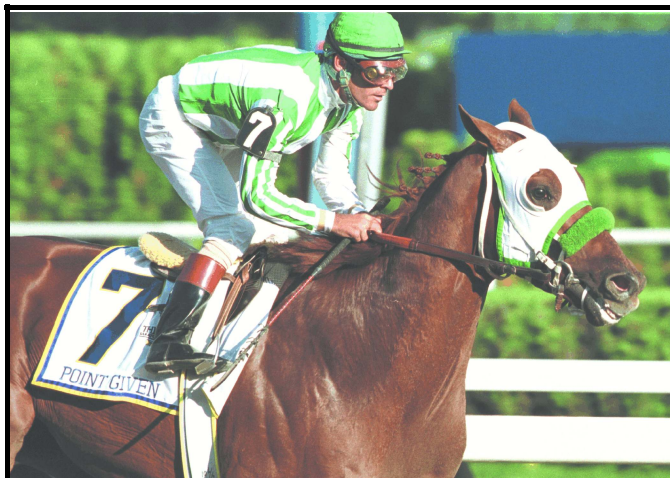

Puzzlement Out of Belmont:

Joseph V. Shields' **Puzzlement** (Pine Bluff) was yesterday declared from tomorrow's GI Belmont S. due to an abscess caused by a bruised right front hoof. "He's sore right now but after it breaks from tubbing in hot water, it should be fine," his trainer Allen Jerkens said yesterday. "Even if it came out by the time the race was run, we wouldn't have any confidence in him in a race like that." The injury was discovered yesterday morning just before the Gil Peter Pan S. runner-up was to train. The conditioner indicated that the colt would likely be put away for the rest of the Belmont meeting which ends July 21. "We might as well give him a rest and have him ready for Saratoga," Jerkens said.

Baffert Chats With the I-Man:

Bob Baffert, trainer of Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner **War Emblem** (Our Emblem), was a guest on the nationally syndicated "Imus In the Morning" radio program, which is based at New York station WFAN-AM. Imus will wager \$20,000 on the Belmont, the proceeds of which will benefit the Imus Ranch, a working ranch for adolescent cancer patients in New Mexico. Imus referred to Baffert as his "homey" during their conversation as both are originally from Arizona. With the assistance of WFAN personality Mike Francesa, a total of \$72,000 was collected on winning bets on Point Given in last year's Preakness and Belmont. Imus told his listeners that this year they would be backing Baffert again "if nothing else than to annoy people." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who sends out Proud Citizen (Gone West) in the Belmont, is a guest on this morning's program. His appearance is set for 7:37 a.m. EDT.

A winner at first asking in April at Keeneland, Holiday Runner earned her first stakes victory against colts in the Three Chimneys Juvenile S. on Derby Day at Churchill, impressively defeating the promising pair of Zavata and Posse. She was odds-on to maintain her unbeaten record in New York, but had to work hard for the win. The bay filly contested the pace with La Violette (Coronado's Quest) through a :21.46 opening quarter, but shook free of that rival after a half in :45.14 and held a five-length lead at the eighth pole. Miss Mary Apples put in a strong run on the outside, but the favorite dug in to prevail narrowly. "I think she got a lot out of this race," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who was winning the Fashion for the first time. "She was real impressive today. [Jerry] Bailey said that she was going through the motions in the stretch, and that sometimes gets you beat. But she had enough left." Holiday Runner's next appearance will likely come at the Spa. "I haven't talked to the ownership, but I would say that we'll probably wait until opening day at Saratoga [Gil Schuylerville S., 6f, July 24]," Lukas added.

Louisiana-based stallion **Believe It** (In Reality--Breakfast Bell, by Buckpasser) died Wednesday at Clear Creek Stud in Folsom, La. He was 27 years old. One of the top three-year-olds of his generation, the Virginia-bred won the GI Wood Memorial in 1978 before finishing third to Affirmed and Alydar in the Kentucky Derby and Preakness. Since entering stud in 1979, Believe It was the sire of 19 graded-stakes winners, the best in Louisiana. His progeny earned in excess of \$22 million, headed by his Panamanian champion Creemelo, GI John Henry H. winner Al Mamoon and GI Met Mile hero Garthorn. As a broodmare sire, he was represented by champion Real Quiet, winner of the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. as well as second in the GI Belmont S. Believe It was standing at Clear Creek for the first time in 2002.

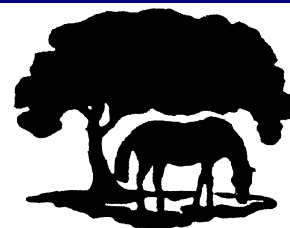
