PUTTING A STOP TO WAR

War Emblem (Our Emblem) is out to add his name to the history books as racing's 12th Triple Crown winner. Ten rivals are out to stop him. Kentucky Derby and Preakness hero War Emblem is the even-money favorite on the morning line for the GI Belmont S. this afternoon, but he is far from a certainty. Australian-born trainer Murray Johnson, who saddles Derby third **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer), would be happy to slam the door on trainer Bob Baffert's third attempt at a Triple Crown. "Aussies love playing the spoiler," said Johnson, whose great-great grandfather was W.S. Cox of G1 Cox Plate fame. Perfect Drift fits the role of spoiler to a T. On the board in all seven starts, the bright bay gelding is bred for a mile and a half--his sire, Dynaformer, is by G1 Epsom Derby winner Roberto; his dam, Nice Gal, is by Naskra, who was third, beaten only a length in the 1970 Belmont. He also has the right rider for the job: Eddie Delahoussaye has ridden the Belmont three times; second with Gato del Sol in 1982, he came back to win it with Risen Star in 1988 and with A.P. Indy in 1992. The biggest knock on Perfect Drift--other than the fact he would be only the second gelding to win the Belmont--is that he has had just one race in the past 11 weeks. "I'm not worried about his fitness at all," Johnson insisted. "He ran a really strong mile and a quarter [in the Derby] and has worked well and had good strong gallops since. The schedule we had mapped out for him went pretty much perfect. I have no complaints there--and no excuses."

The sires of three Belmont runners have already produced Belmont winners: **Like a Hero** is by Pleasant Colony, sire of Colonial Affair (1993); **Sunday Break (Jpn)** is by Forty Niner, sire of Editor's Note (1996); and **Proud Citizen** is by Gone West, sire of Commendable (2000)...Trainer Wayne Lukas goes for his fifth Belmont win with Proud Citizen...trainer Neil Drysdale goes for his second with Sunday Break...trainer Bob Baffert and owner The Thoroughbred Corporation go for their second with **War Emblem** after winning with Point Given last year... Jockeys Pat Day and Gary Stevens have three Belmont wins each to their credit...The last odds-on favorite to win the Belmont was Affirmed in 1978.

KAZZIA STAYS THE COURSE

Godolphin's super tough, unbeaten **Kazzia (Ger)** (Zinaad {GB}) held off the strong late challenge from Aidan O'Brien's **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) by a half length to complete the 1000 Guineas-Oaks double, leading virtually from gate to wire in yesterday's G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom. On a memorable afternoon for German-bred horses, the 100-30 favorite gave her all under Frankie Dettori to deny Michael Kinane's mount as the pair pulled an astounding 14 lengths clear of **Shadow Dancing (GB)** (Unfuwain). Kazzia showed similar raw determination to deny **Snowfire (GB)** (Machiavellian) by a neck in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 5. That effort surprised her connections, who were in doubt as to whether to run based on her staying pedigree and sharp juvenile form, including a win over soft ground in the G3 Premio Dormello in Milan in October.

How the Race was Won Kazzia broke well from the gate and travelled smoothly into the lead, tracked closely by **Esloob** (Diesis {GB}) and **Starbourne (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Always moving easily on the unique undulations, she was joined by **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) on the run downhill to Tattenham Corner, but had that filly's measure as she tracked over to the stands' rail. Left clear as Islington weakened, she was kept up to her work by Dettori and the only remaining danger was Quarter Moon, who had manoeuvred into second after racing freely in the early stages. That eagerness had threatened to undermine her challenge, but to her credit Quarter Moon lengthened well to close on the game leader, who was starting to feel the strain. Just a few strides before the line it looked possible that she would take the race from the favourite, but Kazzia pulled out more for the victory. "She is very tough and I was going to give anybody a fight today if they wanted to come and beat me," said the winning rider. "We passed the furlong marker and I'd made plenty of use of her--she started to wander a bit and in the corner of my eye I saw Mick [Kinane] coming, but luckily she kept digging all the way to the line." Kazzia became the first filly to

achieve the Classic double since Salsabil in 1990. Enjoying their third taste of Epsom Oaks success after Balanchine in 1994 and Moonshell (Ire) in 1995, Godolphin were far from unhappy to see the consistent rain at the Surrey track over the past 48 hours. "It has been a long time since 1995, but this year in Dubai we knew we had some nice fillies," explained trainer Saeed bin Suroor afterwards. "This filly showed she had class all the time and because of that we decided to run her in the Guineas. After that we thought she can stay the mile and a half and handle the soft ground, so I was confident before the race. I think Frankie was the key to her today, he made the race." Jockey Kieren Fallon reported that Islington failed to handle the ground.

A Third Classic? Kazzia will now bid for triple Classic success by attempting the G1 St Leger at Doncaster Sept. 14. That triple was last accomplished in 1985 by Sheikh Mohammed's Oh So Sharp (GB). As for Kazzia's chances of completing the quest, Sheikh Mohammed said, "She certainly stays a mile and a half and, though obviously we can't know now if she will stay a mile and six in the St Leger at Doncaster, I certainly hope that she will."

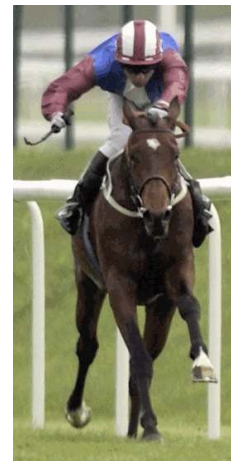

GROUNDS FOR CONCERN

If stamina doubts were not enough to concern the legion of fans of **Hawk Wing** (Woodman), the forces of nature are seeking to conspire against him in today's G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom. He is everybody's favourite conversation piece, prompting much conjecture over the weeks since his scintillating finish when runner-up in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4. One school believes he showed too much pace in making up several lengths on Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) to endure this Classic's test of staying power; the naysayers point to his record-breaking success in the G1 National S. at The Curragh last September as further proof. That argument is countered by those who believe that the inherent stamina influence on his dam's side is enough and that his speed can be harnessed and delivered late. The bay, a \$225,000 Keeneland November weanling and \$300,000 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga yearling, is out of La Lorgnette, champion three-year-old filly in Canada in 1985 and winner of the Queen's Plate over 10 furlongs. Hawk Wing is nevertheless essentially a fast-ground performer, and the heavy rain that arrived in mid-week may mean that the debate remains as unsettled as the weather this afternoon. In any other Epsom Derby, jockey Michael Kinane would relish the chance to ride a colt of the potential of **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who comes here off wins in the Listed Ballysax S. Apr. 14 and G3 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial S. May 12 at Leopardstown. He carried a seven-pound penalty in both and, while he was impressive in the former when winning by seven, he showed an almost complacent disdain for his rivals in the latter, winning by a length while never asked for his best. Godolphin will send out a pair of runners hoping to build on Kazzia's Oaks victory yesterday afternoon. Of the two, **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) may prove stronger than **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) judged on his smooth success in the G2 Dante S. at York May 15. However, Naheef has the full confidence of jockey Frankie Dettori. "I think you will see a better performance at Epsom," said Dettori. "This is the first Derby horse that I am riding that is suited to the race. Naheef will appreciate a mile and a half and he should handle the undulations of Epsom as he is well balanced. In the last two weeks, he has come into his own and has been very willing in his work. It is now a question of whether he is better than the others."

Northern Invasion Trainer Mark Johnston, who saddles both **Fight Your Corner (GB)** (Muhtarram) and **Bandari (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) this afternoon, appears to hold the best chance of denying Team O'Brien. The latter is arguably the better of the pair, as he showed when powering away with the May 11 G3 Lingfield Derby Trial by 13 lengths in his seasonal bow. That performance underlined the quality of his nine-length success from the smart Godolphin filly Infinite Spirit in the Listed Silver Tankard S. at Pontefract in October and he bids to become the first Northern-trained winner of the Derby since Dante in 1945.

The only previous Grade I winner in the field, You took advantage of a speed-favoring Belmont surface to earn a daylight victory in the Acorn while posting a new stakes record time. She had captured the GI Frizette S. last October over this surface, but finished fourth as the 4-5 favorite in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Oct. 27 and concluded her two-year-old season with a head loss to Habibt in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 16. She gained her revenge on that filly this year, defeating her in both the GI Las Virgenes S. Feb. 10 and the GI Santa Anita Oaks Mar. 9. Shipped to Churchill Downs, she weakened late to finish fourth in the nine-furlong GI Kentucky Oaks May 3, but figured to do better at this flat mile. You gained command soon after a quarter in :22.39 and posted three-quarters in 1:08.26 before galloping home well clear of her rivals. "Bella Bellucci didn't run her race today, so the race looked more impressive than it really was," acknowledged winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "My filly ran a huge effort today. She likes the one-turn mile and that definitely helped." The odds-on favorite, Bella Bellucci tried to rally three wide on the turn, but ran out of gas on her way to finishing third. "She wasn't handling the track too well," said trainer Neil Drysdale. "She's got speed, but she just couldn't get her feet out of it." Boreal repelled all comers under a strong Kieren Fallon ride to provide Germany with their first British Group 1 success since Star Appeal (Ire) took the Eclipse S. at Sandown in 1975. Racing in second early tracking Zindabad, he did not travel too easily down the hill to Tattenham Corner, but found himself in front when the leader began to tire soon after. Taken across to the stands' side, he had the rail advantage as Kutub (Ire) (In the Wings {GB}) attempted to challenge. As that horse hung badly left, it was Storming Home who arrived out of the pack to throw down the greater challenge, but he could never make a serious impression on Boreal, who stretched out well to secure success. "I always had loads of confidence in this horse as he's very good," Fallon explained. "I was impressed with his run in Dubai last time, especially as the ground was too fast for him there." Boreal showed last time that he handles a fast surface when third behind Nayef in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 23, but he is much better suited to this ground, evidenced by his success in very testing conditions in the G1 Deutsches Derby in July. Back at Cologne in September, he fell in the G1 Deutsche Post Euro Express Preis von Europa. Peter Schiergen, whose previous best in Britain came when saddling Sumitas (Ger) to finish runner-up in the G1 Prince of Wales' S. at Royal Ascot in 2000, will prepare Boreal for the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Ascot July 27. Coral Eurobet quote him at odds of 14-1 from 25-1 for that mile-and-a-half contest.

John Velazquez (aboard Windsor Lodge) was scheduled to undergo X-rays on his right knee. Renegade Warrior suffered a compound fracture of both sesamoids in his left foreleg and was euthanized on the track. Windsor Lodge came out of the spill with just a laceration on his right knee. 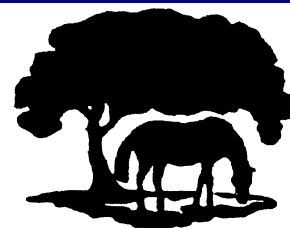

MURTAGH HOPES TO MAKE DERBY RIDE

Jockey Johnny Murtagh will have to pass the race-course doctor today in order to ride **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) in the G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom after giving up his final ride on yesterday's card. He told *PA Sport* yesterday: "I had a bit of a sore throat and I was feeling wet and miserable after the Oaks. The doctor said I would be better off going home and having a Lemsip. But I am sure I'll be fit to ride on Saturday." Today's Epsom Derby will officially be run on soft ground, according to Andrew Cooper, director of racing at United Racecourses: "We have given out the overnight going as soft, but where we end up is very much dependent on the weather. Showers are possible for tomorrow. On Monday, we put on four millimetres of water on the three furlongs of the home straight and also between the eight and nine furlong poles on the back straight. Showers, albeit light ones, were always a possibility within the weather forecast, but it wasn't until Monday evening that any suggestion was given as to the possible intensity of Wednesday's rain. Our over-riding aim at Epsom is to provide safe ground and in order to guarantee that for racing, we're always likely to make a positive decision to water earlier than would be the case on most other courses." Frankie Dettori commented after his success on Kazzia that "there is a very bad patch on the rail just after Tattenham Corner." Aidan O'Brien walked the course immediately after yesterday's Classic, particularly the part of the track from the six-furlong marker on the far side that has been railed off and saved for tomorrow's racing.
