

### SARAVA DENIES WAR EMBLEM

We don't know if trainer Kenny McPeck is a Grateful Dead fan, but their tune "What A Long Strange Trip It's Been" could serve as the theme for the conditioner's 2002 Triple Crown campaign. Repent spent much of the early spring as the pre-Derby favorite, but was sidelined by injury. That's when Harlan's Holiday stepped to the fore, his victories in the GI Florida Derby and GI Toyota Blue Grass vaulting him to Derby Day favoritism. Seventh at Churchill Downs and an improved fourth in the Preakness, the McPeek team took their biggest hit of the spring when owner Jack Wolf decided to transfer that colt to a new barn. McPeek took it in stride, at least on the outside, but had a chance to ease that pain with Sir Barton S. winner **Sarava** (Wild Again) in yesterday's GI Belmont S.

### *Promise in the Ring, Disappointment at the Track*

Bred in Kentucky by Timber Bay Farm, Sarava was consigned to the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Yearling Sale by Highclere Sales and was purchased by bloodstock agent Buzz Chace for \$190,000, the fourth highest price of the three-day sale. Given just a bit of time to mature, the colt was entered in Fasig-Tipton's two-year-olds in training sale at Calder and was hammered down to British trainer Brian Meehan on behalf of Newmarket International for a quarter million dollars. Sent immediately to his conditioner's British base, Sarava made his debut in an Aug. 19 conditions event at Sandown, finishing a midpack fourth before filling the same spot behind this year's Italian and German 2000 Guineas hero Dupont in a similar event at Lingfield 11 days hence. Given one more chance on the grass, he finished a dismal 13th in a Doncaster maiden, prompting the ownership to consider returning the horse to the sales ring. Entered for last year's Tattersalls Autumn Sale in early November, the fateful decision was made to withdraw the colt and return him to his homeland.

### *Things Begin Looking Rosier*

Despite a pedigree well suited to the main track, Sarava went off at odds of 36-1 in his U.S. bow at Churchill Nov. 21, but rallied four wide to win by 2 1/4 lengths and finished second in his two-year-old finale at Turfway Dec. 9. Beset with a nasty quarter crack problem which cost the colt 25 percent of his hoof wall, Sarava's sophomore unveiling was delayed until Apr. 14 when he ran second to Wiseman's Ferry at Keeneland in his first start for McPeek. That effort, and the subsequent success of the the winner in the GIII Lone Star Derby, earned Sarava his first stakes test, one he passed with flying colors when he unleashed a strong finishing kick to take the Sir Barton. He ran about as fast as the Preakness winner the same afternoon. Could he play the role of Triple Crown spoiler?

**War Emblem's Crown Lost at the Start**

With the Triple Crown on the line for **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) and little margin for error, disaster struck as soon as the field was sent on its mile-and-a-half journey. The dark bay colt stumbled badly just out of the gate and took a few strides before he got his feet back underneath him, but had lost several lengths in the process. **Wiseman's Ferry** (Hennessy) showed the way into the first turn from **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) as War Emblem rushed up to try to get back into the race. As the field rounded into the backstretch, jockey Victor Espinoza his hands full aboard the Derby and Preakness winner, who resisted his jockey's urgings to relax, while tucked in just behind that one raced Sarava, who bided his time beneath Edgar Prado in fifth while going smoothly. Angled to the inside approaching the far turn, the 70-1 second longest shot in the field waited patiently while gaining on Medaglia d'Oro at the quarter pole, knifed through an opening between that one and **Proud Citizen** (Gone West) (see sidebar) in upper stretch and got the better of the Bobby Frankel-trainee under right-handed encouragement. "I'm not totally surprised," the winning trainer commented. "The colt has been doing great. I think the distance was a non-issue. We didn't know how good he was. He proved himself and I'm really proud of everybody involved."

**"The Only Thing That Can Beat Us Is A Bad Break"**

Those words were part of a pre-race conversation between Bob Baffert, trainer of War Emblem, and his jockey Victor Espinoza. Little did Baffert know how that would come into play. "You know, I worried about this track," he commented. "It was drying out. It looked like he lost his footing away from there, stumbled and got behind horses. When you have a front-running horse, I knew that was going to be a problem. We just feel fortunate that we won the Derby and the Preakness, had some fun with him." The loss marks the third time that the California-based trainer has missed a chance at the Triple Crown, following the tough-luck defeats of Silver Charm in 1997 and Real Quiet in 1998. "They were in it from the start and you knew you were in good shape the whole way," he said, referring to his two previous candidates. "This horse...it was just gut wrenching to have to watch the whole race because the poor horse was trying so hard. I wanted to do it but it's tough. Next time I win the Derby, I'm going home."

**Proud Citizen Suffers Injury**

Fifth-place finisher Proud Citizen was vanned off the track following the race and has been diagnosed with a cracked left shin, according to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He'll be out about 90-120 days," the conditioner said. "I'm happy it isn't more serious. I don't know when it happened. Maybe he caught the hoof of another horse. He's got no swelling in his ankle or knee. He's comfortable right now and is standing with full weight on it. I tell you, the Belmont has been great to me, but I've also had my bad luck in it." Triple Crown aspirant Charismatic suffered a career-ending injury in the 1999 Belmont, but Lukas returned the following year to send out Commendable to win the 2000 renewal.

**Perfect Drift Anything But Perfect**

Kentucky Derby third-place finisher **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer), sent off the second choice in the wagering at odds of 5-1, never fired and finished 10th, beaten over 50 lengths. It marks the first time the gelding has finished outside of the top three in eight career starts. "My horse didn't run at all," explained jockey Eddie Delahoussaye. "He wasn't the same horse today. He went to switching leads before he should have. He just wasn't right. Something's bugging him."

**Prince Ahmed Not In Attendance**

Despite the possibility of a Triple Crown, Prince Ahmed bin Salman, whose nom de course is The Thoroughbred Corporation, was unable to attend the Belmont. "He's back in Riyadh right now. He had some family obligations that he had to take care of," his racing manager Richard Mulhall explained during an impromptu press conference. "He just took too much time with the Preakness and the Kentucky Derby, which he didn't expect to do, and he couldn't get out of his commitments." It was uncertain as to whether the Prince would have been able to view the race live.

**GOING TO THE CHAPARRAL** In what proved an exceptional display of Ballydoyle's superiority, **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), the 7-2 second choice, and the 9-4 favourite **Hawk Wing** (Woodman) pulled away from the rest of the field in yesterday's G1 Vodafone Derby at Epsom, with the former having the call by two lengths at the line. In finishing 12-lengths clear of the early pace-setter **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}), Hawk Wing proved conclusively that the distance is not a problem, but evidently not quite as strongly as his stable companion. "It was great--the two horses were very well up to the race and everything went very well," said winning trainer Aidan O'Brien. "The two lads gave them a beautiful ride--they are two very serious colts I'd say."

**The Makings of a Derby Hero...**

Last year, High Chaparral broke his maiden at Tipperary just 20 days before being sent to the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. He was ignored in the market in favour of stable-companion Castle Gandolfo there, but proved 3/4-of-a-length too strong for that colt, giving the impression he had more to give as a three-year-old. He confirmed that belief in the Listed Ballysax S. at Leopardstown Apr. 14, beating Twentytwoandchange (Ire) by seven lengths and although less spectacular in the G3 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial S. at that track May 12, he showed enough there in a fast time to suggest he was capable of Classic glory. Passed over by jockey Michael Kinane, High Chaparral was left to Johnny Murtagh, the finest and most successful substitute in the game.

**A Clash of Ballydoyle Titans...**

For the first half-mile the Derby followed the script, as Moon Ballad moved to the front followed closely by the outsider **Frankies Dream (Ire)** (Grand Lodge) and the free-running **Coshocton** (Silver Hawk). Kinane was content to sit in eighth aboard Hawk Wing with Murtagh tracking that colt in 10<sup>th</sup>. As they started the descent downhill, High Chaparral was asked to lengthen on the outside of the field and he responded by closing on the smooth-travelling leader before racing into third at Tattenham Corner. With five lengths to make up on Moon Ballad as they entered the straight, the once-beaten colt was reaching top gear and surged to the front inside the three pole, but now had Hawk Wing travelling strongly in pursuit. The American-bred colt closed to within a head of his stable companion with 400 yards remaining, but could not match the staying power of High Chaparral, who asserted from there. "Everything went well--I was supposed to be handy, but I just didn't jump that well and then I was following Mick all the way," commented Johnny Murtagh. "Five out I kicked down the outside and let stamina come into play, but when Mick came to him there was only going to be one winner." The winner could be bound for The Curragh and the G1 Irish Derby June 30. "You can't say these things before the race, but we always felt these were two really good horses and we really thought we could be first and second," said Michael Tabor. What we didn't really know was who would be first and who would be second, but we were pretty confident." Coshocton fell when placed in fourth in the closing stages and was euthanized, with his stricken rider Philip Robinson being sent to hospital.

Beat Hollow put up a tour-de-force performance, making every yard of the running for his second straight Grade I victory. Third to Sinndar (Ire) and Sakhee in the G1 Epsom Derby exactly two years ago in his third lifetime start, he bounced back to take the G1 Grand Prix de Paris two weeks later, but didn't put in another appearance until January of this year, when he impressively captured a \$100,000 optional claimer at Santa Anita. A narrow second in the GII Explosive Bid H. at Fair Grounds Mar. 24, the blaze-faced bay looked sharp in winning the GI Woodford Reserve May 4 and was sent off as the favorite of a record New York crowd. Away alertly, Beat Hollow dragged Alex Solis to the front, clipped off solid fractions over the good turf and maintained his authority to the wire. "I told Alex to put him on the lead," explained winning trainer Bobby Frankel, getting his second Grade I of the weekend. "He ran a great race. He may be trained in California, but Explicit has shown his best when taking his show on the road. The chestnut bested Entrepreneur when winning both the Pelleteri Breeders' Cup H. at Fair Grounds Mar. 17 and the Gill Count Fleet Sprint H. Apr. 11 at Oaklawn Park. He settled for second in his latest, the Gill Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup Sprint H. May 11, but was sent off as the favorite this time to improve over his third-place effort in last year's True North. Yonaguska (Cherokee Run) surprisingly held a narrow advantage over Explicit through the opening quarter, but the five-year-old was travelling easily under a chilly Lonnie Meche. He took charge entering the stretch and held sway over the persistent Entrepreneur. "This year, he caught a bit of an easier field," remarked winning trainer Ian Jory. "He's definitely a better horse this year than he was last year. He is settling down and maturing. We're going to give him a break and bring him back in the Forego [GI, 6.5f, Sept. 1 at Saratoga], with the Breeders' Cup Sprint as the main goal." **French Oaks preview cont.**

With doubts surrounding the fitness of **Marotta (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}) here, this afternoon's Classic has a wide-open feel to it. Add to that the prospect of heavy ground and a lack of previous Classic form and an upset is on the cards. Certainly Marotta, the impressive winner of the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 19 last time, is opposable due to a subsequent training setback. She had trainer Elie Lellouche's **Bright Sky (Ire)** (Wolfhound), from the stable of last year's winner Aquarelliste (Fr), back in second there and that consistent filly has every chance of reversing the form. Andre Fabre, the only other trainer represented to have won this before, will be hoping that **Summertime Legacy (GB)** (Darshaan {GB}), two lengths further back in third on that occasion, can improve and provide him with his third Diane. **Ana Marie (Fr)** (Anabaa), who beat Bright Sky by a short head in the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp Apr. 28, was fourth in the Saint-Alary, but may prefer faster conditions. She had previously finished behind Bright Sky when fourth to **Turtle Bow (Fr)** (Turtle Island {Ire}) in the Listed Prix Finlande over this course Apr. 7. Turtle Bow followed up in the G3 Prix Cleopatre at Saint-Cloud May 13 and will relish the ease underfoot this time. While Zainta (Ire) was the last winner of the Saint-Alary to follow up here in 1998, Aquarelliste last year used the Listed Prix Melisande at Longchamp as a stepping stone to this. Aquarelliste's half sister Arms Ancienne (GB) was third, beaten over three lengths by **Music Club** (Dixieland Band) in this year's renewal May 23, and that filly may hold the aces here. She bids to become the seventh overseas winner of this since 1970 and provide trainer John Gosden with his second French Classic of 2002 after the success of Zenda (GB) in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas). Music Club is unbeaten, having taken a competitive Newmarket maiden in October, where Black Sam Bellamy (Ire) was sixth. Further British interest was added this week by the supplemented **Monturani (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), winner of the Listed Swinley S. at Ascot May 1 and Listed Fillies' Trial S. at Newbury May 17.
