**Bright Sky (Ire)** (Wolfhound) went from *TDN* "Dark Horse" to Classic winner, taking yesterday's G1 Prix de Diane Hermes at Chantilly by two lengths over **Dance**

**Routine (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). For owner Alec Wildenstein, whose father Daniel died last year, it was a moment tinged with sorrow.

"This is a very special day and we really hoped that she would run a great race; the only person missing here is my father," he

said. The 37-10 favourite, Bright Sky followed in the hoofsteps of stable companion Aquarelliste (Fr), who took the French Oaks for Wildenstein and trainer Elie Lellouche last season.

### Putting It Together on Oaks Day...

The runner-up in all three of her trials for this Classic, Bright Sky went down by a neck to **Marotta (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}) in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp May 19 last time, having been beaten by a short head by **Ana Marie (Fr)** (Anabaa) in the G3 Prix Vanteaux at Longchamp Apr. 28 and by 3/4 of a length by **Turtle Bow (Fr)** (Turtle Island {Ire}) in the Listed Prix Finlande over the Chantilly course Apr. 7. Nevertheless, she left those fillies trailing here with her decisive turn of foot. Held up in 10th off the furious pace cut out in the early stages by her stable companion **Blue Lightning (Fr)** (Alzao), she was patiently ridden and was asked for her best effort inside the final quarter of a mile. Turtle Bow had wrested the advantage from **Monturani (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), but that lead was short lived as Bright Sky swooped on her outside to hit the front with 250 yards remaining, and her dramatic show of acceleration carried her clear. "She is a very nice filly," winning jockey Dominique Boeuf said. "She was not too lucky last time in the Prix Saint-Alary, but she gave me a lovely ride here. I was always travelling comfortably and although there was a fast pace, mine was one of a few fillies that was not pulling and I had a lot of horse in the straight. When I pulled her out she was really powerful." **Dance Routine (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) stayed on well in the closing stages to get second, thus rewarding her connections' decision to run only a week after her success in the G3 Prix de Royaumont. **Bustling (GB)** (Danehill) lost all chance by veering sharply left exiting the stalls, almost unseating Frankie Dettori, while Turtle Bow, who crossed the line in third, was demoted to fourth behind Ana Marie for interference.

### Future Plans...

Bright Sky was impressive in winning the 12-furlong French Oaks, but her connections will look to shorten her up in the future. "I have discussed it with the trainer and we feel her future might not be over a mile and a half, so we will not take her to the G1 Prix Vermeille [Longchamp, Sept. 15] and instead probably get her ready for the G1 Prix de l'Opera [at Longchamp Oct. 6]," Alec Wildenstein said.

Named the champion three-year-old filly last year after winning nine of her 13 starts and running a game second in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, Xtra Heat picked up two more stakes wins to start 2002. She then ventured to Nad al Sheba and was third in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 23. The diminutive bay proved the trip took little out of her when she came back to post a one-length victory in the GII Genuine Risk H. May 12 and she began yet another winning streak here. Breaking on top, as always, she had Gold Mover at her neck after the opening quarter, shook off a challenge from La Galerie (Southern Halo) when that rival took a breather on the far turn, then held off a resurgent Gold Mover in the final strides to win while handing her four foes from nine to 13 pounds. "They came at her from all sides... but I never give up on her," trainer John Salzman Sr. said. "I've seen too many of her races where they come up to her and she has something left. She is so game." **War Emblem Exits Belmont in Good Order:**

**War Emblem** (Our Emblem), who ended his Triple Crown attempt with a disastrous trip and an eighth-place finish in Saturday's GI Belmont S., came out of the race "absolutely fine" according to Terence Collier, consultant to The Thoroughbred Corporation. Collier also reiterated that, contrary to media speculation, Prince Ahmed Salman was not absent from the race because of security concerns. The Prince issued a statement yesterday, saying, "I would never have considered asking my brother, Prince Faisal, to represent me if I had any worries about security. Unfortunately, business obligations had piled up in Riyadh, which at the very last minute prevented me from attending the Belmont."

**Baffert Deals with Disappointment:**

Trainer Bob Baffert quipped yesterday, "They've got to bump the Belmont [purse] up to \$5 million if they want me to come back here." Saturday, Baffert watched as his third Triple Crown hopeful in the past six years failed to get it done on Belmont Day. While Silver Charm (1997) and Real Quiet (1998) went down to narrow defeats, finishing second in their attempts at immortality, **War Emblem** (Our Emblem) stumbled badly at the start and finished 19 1/2 lengths behind upset winner **Sarava** (Wild Again). "For us, the race was over at the start," Baffert said. "He can't have any horses in front of him. That's just him. He's a big, free-running horse." He added, "The shame of the whole thing is that all of those fans never got a chance to see the real War Emblem. That's what's disappointing for me. Silver Charm and Real Quiet at least got to run their races." War Emblem headed back to Churchill Downs yesterday morning, but plans for his future have not been decided.

**Sarava AOK After Belmont Upset:**

GI Belmont S. winner **Sarava** (Wild Again) also headed back to Kentucky yesterday morning. "He came out of the race great," trainer Ken McPeck said. While there are no immediate plans for the colt, McPeck, who will stable his entire string at Saratoga this summer, said the GI Travers S. Aug. 24 is the next major goal on the agenda. "You'll see him at Saratoga," he said. "Absolutely."

### Hawk Wing to July Cup?

Trainer Aidan O'Brien hinted Saturday that **Hawk Wing** (Woodman), runner-up to **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the G1 Vodafone Derby, could revert to the six furlongs of the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 11 next time out. Although a possible for the G1 Coral Eurobet Eclipse S. at Sandown July 6, a crack at the sprint was not ruled out by O'Brien. "Staying at a mile and a half is possible for Hawk Wing, but I wouldn't mind going back to six furlongs for the July Cup," he said. "He could run over any trip from six furlongs upwards." The last to attempt the Epsom Classic before winning the July Cup was Ajdal in 1987. Hawk Wing's stable companion, champion juvenile **Johannesburg** (Hennessy), is currently the 7-2 favourite for the race with Coral Eurobet.

### Surgery for Fight Your Corner:

**Fight Your Corner (GB)** (Muhtarram), who suffered a serious injury to his near hind leg while finishing fifth in the Vodafone Derby, underwent surgery yesterday. The colt sustained a condylar fracture of the cannon bone and was taken to the Greenwood Ellis veterinary practice in Newmarket. Trainer Mark Johns told *PA Sport* yesterday, "It is not thought to be life-threatening so long as all goes well. He'll have screws fitted to a condylar fracture of the hind cannon bone and the surgeons were suggesting last night that the long-term outlook is good." Fight Your Corner was purchased by Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum for his son Sheikh Hamdan after winning the G3 Chester Vase May 7 and was supplemented for the Epsom Classic at a fee of £90,000.

### Autopsy for Coshocton:

**Coshocton** (Silver Hawk), who fell in the final 50 yards and was euthanised by racecourse vets after he was found to have fractured his near-fore leg, may have suffered a heart attack prior to the fall, trainer Michael Jarvis told *Racing Post* yesterday. "A post mortem is being carried out, but there is a possibility the horse had a heart attack and then, when he went down, his leg snapped," Jarvis said. "He was a particularly sound horse--he never took a lame step in his life and he never had a bandage on a leg, so it was completely unexpected."

### Bandari Sore:

Trainer Mark Johnston reported yesterday that **Bandari (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) was sore after his eighth-place finish at Epsom. Despite being sent off the third favourite, the colt, purchased by Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum and supplemented for the Classic, failed to land a blow. "He's not too bad this morning," Johnston told *PA Sport* yesterday. "He was a bit sore after the race as well, which is not surprising, but we think he's okay."

### Moon Ballad to Go Back in Trip:

*TDN* "Dark Horse" **Moon Ballad (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}), third in the Vodafone Derby, will be dropped back in trip according to Godolphin. "We will drop him in distance," said trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "There is a good future for him; he learnt from his last race and was much more relaxed. He had to make the running [Saturday] and I think a mile and a quarter and faster ground will suit him much better." Of the seventh-placed **Naheef (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}), he added, "Naheef was disappointing and the reason was the ground--he just didn't like it. The distance was no problem and we will look for something on faster ground."

### Jelani Leger Bound:

Andy Turnell's **Jelani (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), a staying-on fourth Saturday, will head the G1 St Leger at Doncaster Sept. 14. "He did us proud," said Turnell. "The long-term plan will be the St Leger. These Darshaans seem to keep improving with age."

### Belmont Wrap-up cont.

#### Sunday Break "Stiff" After Third-Place Finish:

**Sunday Break (Jpn)** (Forty Niner), a distant third in the Belmont, came out of the race feeling a little sore behind, but it doesn't appear to be serious. "He was a little wide on the turn and his hind end went out from under him," trainer Neil Drysdale said. "[Jockey Gary Stevens] told me he was going to be stiff this morning and he was right." The colt could remain at Belmont Park to train for his summer campaign, or could fly back to California, but his next start will be on the East Coast. "His next objective will be the Jim Dandy [GII, Saratoga, Aug. 4] or the Haskell [GI, Monmouth Park, Aug. 4]," Drysdale said. Belmont runner-up **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) will also be pointed for one of those two races.

Two years after trainer Andreas Schutz sent Samum (Ger) to glory in the G1 Deutsches Derby, he witnessed that horse's sister Salve Regina complete the Classic double for the family in the filly counterpart. Schutz, who was collecting his third Diana following wins with Elle Danzig (Ger) in 1998 and Flamingo Road (Ger) a year later, is likely to send Salve Regina to the Derby at Hamburg June 30. Victorious in a Dusseldorf maiden Mar. 24, she impressed with a fluid 3 1/2-length win in the Listed Diana-Trial-Las Vegas-Slenderella-Rennen over this course May 19. Aiming to keep her unbeaten record intact in her Group 1 debut, she raced keenly in the early stages as she disputed the lead with stable companion Mamounia (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}). The winner had settled by the time Midnight Angel passed the pair on the outside at the halfway marker, then went after the leader as they turned into the straight. Quickening impressively to grab the advantage with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, Salve Regina was pushed out to go clear from the game runner-up. The winner is Monsun's third individual Group 1 and Classic winner, following Samum and Guadalupe, and his eighth overall pattern scorer; five of them are out of mares by sires from the Northern Dancer line.

One year after his famous victory in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) over this course, Anabaa Blue returned to the winner's enclosure following an impressive victory here. Lightly backed following a disappointing fifth behind Aquarelliste (Fr) in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp Apr. 28 last time, he travelled easily in fourth early as the tough St Expedit was taken to the front by jockey Darryll Holland. In the straight, jockey Christophe Soumillon was searching for racing room as Thierry Jarnet kept him boxed in aboard Ange Gabriel, but when the gap arrived, Anabaa Blue's response was immediate. He picked up the long-time leader with a furlong remaining and, pushed out to assert from there, he lengthened all the way to the line for a comfortable score. Following his Classic success last June, Anabaa Blue was taken to Ascot to take on Epsom Derby winner Galileo (Ire) in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at the end of July. He could manage only seventh there and found Golan (Ire) 3/4 of a length too strong in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp in September before disappointing when ninth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe the following month. "I knew he was training really well and that he would bounce back on his favourite track," said winning trainer Carlos Lerner. "He might have needed his run in the Ganay and was very fresh that day. He is definitely better over a mile and a half and he has shown here that he retains his ability. All being well, he will go to the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud [June 30]."

Belcore, the first foal to be bred from Brangane, herself a dual Guineas winner in the Czech and Slovenian Republics and a granddaughter of the Trigo S. scorer Bowbee, was a fair third last time in the Listed Preis der Firma Jungheinrich Gabelstapler at Hannover May 9. Giving weight to all rivals here, he raced in second early as Zorn (Ger) (Lavirco {Ger}) was sent into a clear lead. Asked to quicken at the top of the straight, he passed the long-time leader with 2 1/2 furlongs remaining before lengthening away for a decisive success. Despite the impressive victory, the outcome of this trial did little to clarify the picture surrounding the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg June 30, as Whisperer (Ger) (Spectrum {Ire}), third in the German 2000 Guineas, did not corner well on the first bend and never got into the race, finishing fifth.

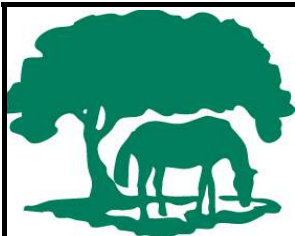
